



GLOWHAIR FROST SHAWL

This large semi-circular shawl is knit top-down with a collage of lace stitches and simple textures. Gather three colors of fingering weight yarn in a colorful fade or gradient from light to dark, then add three coordinating colors of lace weight mohair from light to dark. The three mohair accents are held together with the lightest color at the beginning of the shawl in a beautiful dip stitch pattern. The mohair colors are also used on their own with decorative eyelets and stripes in the border. This subtle mohair frost gives a beautiful halo and silky sheen to the fabric. The lace patterns feature delightful details like twisted ribbing, cables, and bold geometric formations. A chevron border frames the shawl for a dramatic final edge.



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Finished Measurements: 86" / 218cm wingspan length, 31" / 79cm from CO to BO edge measured along the center of the shawl. Measurements taken after blocking.

Yarn: Fingering weight with lace weight mohair contrast colors

Yardage: Fingering weight wool

Color A - 360yds / 329m

Color B - 350yds / 320m

Color C - 380yds / 347m

Lace weight mohair

CC1 - 180yds / 165m

CC2 - 180yds / 165m

CC3 - 180yds / 165m

Shown in: Life in the Long Grass Singles (100% Superwash Merino Wool; 400yds / 366m per 100g skein)

Color A - Lavender Ice (lightest wool)

Color B - Frozen

Color C - Beautyberry (darkest wool)

West Wool Glowhair (64% Mohair, 36% Mulberry Silk; 229yds / 210m per 25g ball)

CC1 - Unicorn (light lavender)

CC2 - Fandango (bright purple)

CC3 - Aubergine (dark purple)

I recommend using a fade of 3 fingering weight wool colors for Colors A, B, & C along with a gradient of 3 coordinating shades of lace weight mohair for CC1, CC2, & CC3.

Needles: US 5 / 3.75mm circular in 40" / 100cm length or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: 2 stitch markers, tapestry needle

Gauge: 20 sts & 34 rows = 4" / 10cm in stockinette stitch after blocking

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Abbreviations

BO: bind off

C4B: (cable 4 back) slip 2 sts onto cable needle and hold in back of work, knit next 2 sts, k2 sts from cable needle

CO: cast on

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 sts together

kyokyok: k1 (leave stitch on the needle), yo/k1/yo/k1 into the same stitch resulting in 5 sts coming out of 1 stitch. 4 sts increased.

m1: (make 1) increase 1 st using the backwards loop cast on method

p: purl

p3tog: purl 3 sts together

RS: right side

s2kp: slip 2 sts together knit-wise, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over. 2 sts decreased.

sk2p: slip 1 knit-wise, k2tog, pass slipped stitch over. 2 sts decreased.

sl: slip stitch purl-wise unless instructed otherwise

ssk: (slip slip knit) slip first stitch knit-wise, slip second stitch knit-wise, knit those 2 sts together tbl

st/s: stitch/es

tbl: through back loop

WS: wrong side

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

INSTRUCTIONS

This shawl begins with an I-cord Tab Cast On. Watch this Westknits video to assist with the I-cord Tab Cast On.

Using A, CO 3 sts. *K3, sl3 sts onto left needle; repeat from * twice more, k3, pick up and k3 sts along I-cord edge. Turn to work WS. 6 sts.

Next Row (WS): Pick up and k3 sts along the I-cord CO edge, p3, sl3 wyif. 9 sts.

SECTION 1 - Reverse Stockinette Stripes

Row 1 (RS): K3, yo, (k1, yo) 3 times, sl3 wyif. 13 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 3 (RS): K3, yo, (k1, yo) 7 times, sl3 wyif. 21 sts.

Row 4 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 5 (RS): K3, yo, p to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 23 sts.

Row 6 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 7 (RS): K3, yo, (k1, yo) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. 41 sts.

Row 8 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 9 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 43 sts.

Row 10 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 11 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 45 sts.

Row 12 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 13 (RS): K3, yo, p to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 47 sts.

Row 14 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 15 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 49 sts.

Row 16 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 17 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 51 sts.

Row 18 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 19 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 53 sts.

Row 20 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 21 (RS): K3, yo, p to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 55 sts.

Row 22 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

SECTION 2 - Fir Rib Dip Stitch

This section features color A throughout the entire section. Color A is always held together with one strand of a CC in this section to create mohair halo in the fabric.

Row 1 (RS): Using A held together with CC1, k3, yo, (k1, yo) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. 105 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K4, p3, (k2, p3) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 3 (RS): K3, yo, k3, (p2, k3) to last 4 sts, p1, yo, sl3 wyif. 107 sts.

Row 4 (WS): K3, (k2, p3) to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif.

Break CC1 and replace it with CC2 for the next row.

Watch this Westknits video and refer to this "DIP1, k3, DIP1" abbreviation to assist with the Fir Rib DIP1 technique.

DIP1, k3, DIP1: Insert right needle 3 rows below into the middle of the second knit stitch, wrap the yarn around and pull it through, creating a long stitch, k3, insert right needle 3 rows below into the same location (into the middle of the same 3 knit sts), wrap the yarn around and pull it through, creating another long stitch.

Row 5 (RS): Using A held together with CC2, k3, yo, p1, (DIP1, k3, DIP1, p2) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 2 edge sts increased.

Row 6 (WS): K3, p1, k2, (sl1 wyif, p3, sl1 wyif, k2) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 7 (RS): K3, yo, p2, (ssk, k1, k2tog, p2) to last 4 sts, k1, yo, sl3 wyif. 111 sts.

Row 8 (WS): K3, p2, k2, (p3, k2) to last 4 sts, p1, sl3 wyif.

Break CC2 and replace it with CC3 for the next row.

Row 9 (RS): Using A held together with CC3, k3, yo, k1, p2, (DIP1, k3, DIP1, p2) to last 5 sts, k2, yo, sl3 wyif. 2 edge sts increased.

Row 10 (WS): K3, p3, k2, (sl1 wyif, p3, sl1 wyif, k2) to last 5 sts, p2, sl3 wyif.

Row 11 (RS): K3, yo, k2, p2, (ssk, k1, k2tog, p2) to last 6 sts, k3, yo, sl3 wyif. 115 sts.

Row 12 (WS): K4, p3, (k2, p3) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break CC3 and replace it with CC1 for the next row.

Row 13 (RS): Using A held together with CC1, k3, yo, DIP1, k3, DIP1, (p2, DIP1, k3, DIP1) to last 4 sts, p1, yo, sl3 wyif. 2 edge sts increased.

Row 14 (WS): K5, sl1 wyif, p3, sl1 wyif, (k2, sl1 wyif, p3, sl1 wyif) to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif.

Row 15 (RS): K3, yo, p1, (ssk, k1, k2tog, p2) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 119 sts.

Row 16 (WS): K3, p1, k2, (p3, k2) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break CC1 and replace it with CC2 for the next row.

Row 17 (RS): Using A held together with CC2, k3, yo, p2, (DIP1, k3, DIP1, p2) to last 4 sts, k1, yo, sl3 wyif. 2 edge sts increased.

Row 18 (WS): K3, p2, k2, (sl1 wyif, p3, sl1 wyif, k2) to last 4 sts, p1, sl3 wyif.

Row 19 (RS): K3, yo, k1, p2, (ssk, k1, k2tog, p2) to last 5 sts, k2, yo, sl3 wyif. 123 sts.

Row 20 (WS): K3, (p3, k2) to last 5 sts, p2, sl3 wyif.

Break CC2 and replace it with CC3 for the next row.

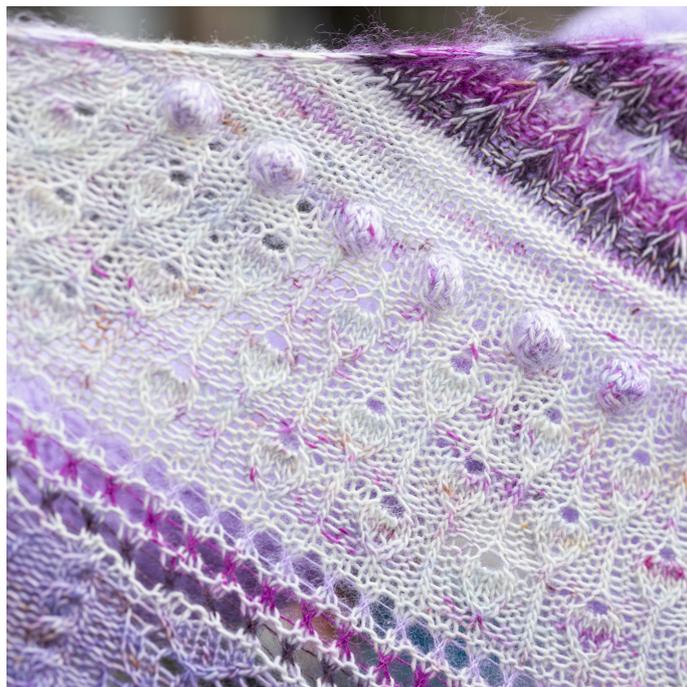
Row 21 (RS): Using A held together with CC3, k3, yo, k2, (p2, DIP1, k3, DIP1) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 2 edge sts increased.

Row 22 (WS): K4, (sl1 wyif, p3, sl1 wyif, k2) to last 6 sts, p3, sl3 wyif.

Row 23 (RS): K3, yo, k3, (p2, ssk, k1, k2tog) to last 4 sts, p1, yo, sl3 wyif. 127 sts.

Row 24 (WS): K3, (k2, p3) to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif.

Break CC3. Continue using color A on its own for the next row.



SECTION 3 - Reverse Stockinette Stripes

Row 1 (RS): Using A, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 129 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 3 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 131 sts.

Row 4 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 5 (RS): K3, yo, p to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 133 sts.

Row 6 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 7 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 135 sts.

Row 8 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 9 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 137 sts.

Row 10 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 11 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 139 sts.

Row 12 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 13 (RS): K3, yo, p to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 141 sts.

Row 14 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 15 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 143 sts.

Row 16 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

SECTION 4 - Bobbles

Each bobble accounts for 1 stitch during Row 1 (RS). When instructions say "Make Bobble" follow these step-by-step instructions as you work Row 1. Watch this Westknits video at the 38:05 minute mark to assist with the bobble technique.

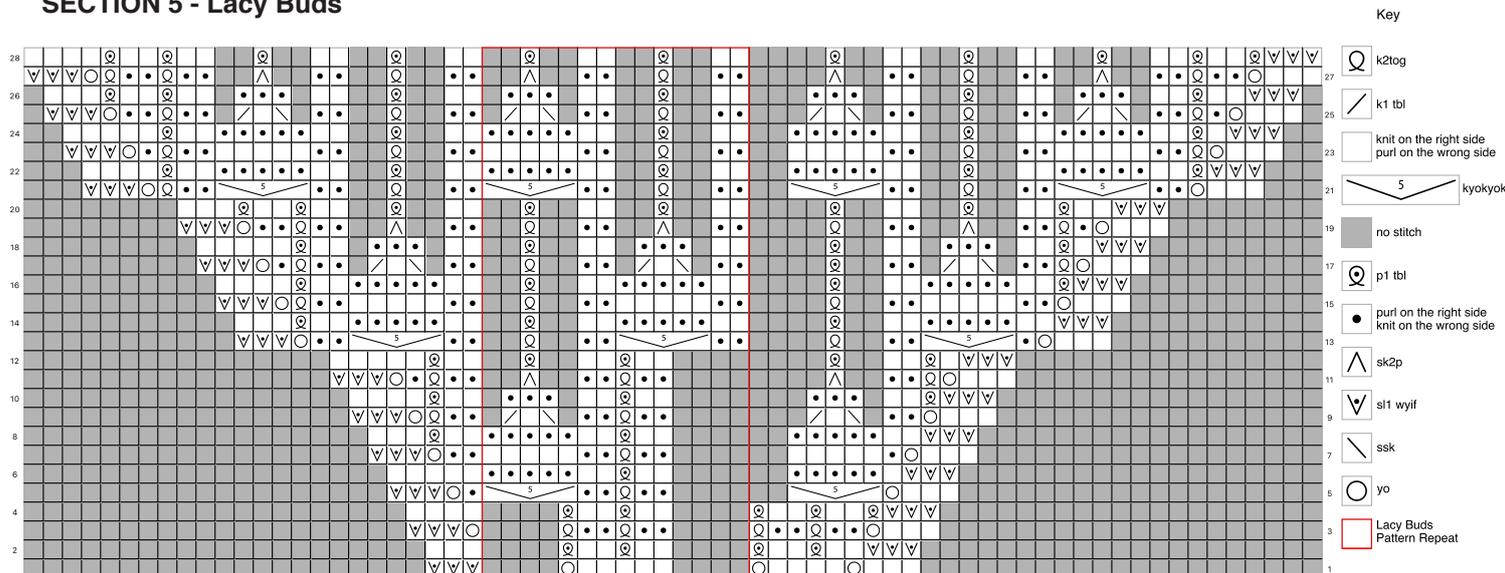
Make Bobble: kyokyok into 1 stitch, resulting in 5 sts coming out of 1 st, (sl5 sts onto left needle, k5) 4 times, (pass the second st from the right needle over the first st to decrease 1 stitch) 4 times. There should be 1 remaining stitch.

Row 1 (RS): Using A held together with CC1, k3, yo, k5, (Make Bobble, k4) to last 5 sts, k2, yo, sl3 wyif. 145 sts.

Break CC1. Continue using color A on its own.

Row 2 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

SECTION 5 - Lacy Buds



Follow the chart or the written instructions to knit this section. The chart is read from bottom to top starting with Row 1. The odd numbered RS rows in the chart are read from right to left while the even numbered WS rows are read from left to right.

Row 1 (RS): K3, yo, k4, yo, (k5, yo) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. 174 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K3, (p1 tbl, k2) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 3 (RS): K3, yo, (p2, k1 tbl) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 176 sts.

Row 4 (WS): K4, (p1 tbl, k2) to last 4 sts, p1tbl, sl3 wyif.

Row 5 (RS): K3, yo, kyokyo, (p2, k1 tbl, p2, kyokyo) to last 4 sts, p1, yo, sl3 wyif. 294 sts.

Row 6 (WS): K5, p5, (k2, p1 tbl, k2, p5) to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif.

Row 7 (RS): K3, yo, p1, k5, p2, (k1 tbl, p2, k5, p2) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 296 sts.

Row 8 (WS): K3, p1 tbl, k2, p5, k2, (p1 tbl, k2, p5, k2) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 9 (RS): K3, yo, p2, ssk, k1, k2tog, p2, (k1 tbl, p2, ssk, k1, k2tog, p2) to last 4 sts, k1 tbl, yo, sl3 wyif. 240 sts.

Row 10 (WS): K3, k1, p1 tbl, k2, p3, k2, (p1 tbl, k2, p3, k2) to last 4 sts, p1 tbl, sl3 wyif.

Row 11 (RS): K3, yo, (k1 tbl, p2, sk2p, p2) to last 5 sts, k1 tbl, p1, yo, sl3 wyif. 184 sts.

Row 12 (WS): K3, (k2, p1 tbl) to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif.

Row 13 (RS): K3, yo, p1, kyokyo, p2, (k1 tbl, p2, kyokyo, p2) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 306 sts.

Row 14 (WS): K3, (p1 tbl, k2, p5, k2) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 15 (RS): K3, yo, (p2, k5, p2, k1 tbl) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 308 sts.

Row 16 (WS): K4, p1 tbl, (k2, p5, k2, p1 tbl) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 17 (RS): K3, yo, k1 tbl, (p2, ssk, k1, k2tog, p2, k1 tbl) to last 4 sts, p1, yo, sl3 wyif. 250 sts.

Row 18 (WS): K5, p1 tbl, (k2, p3, k2, p1 tbl) to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif.

Row 19 (RS): K3, yo, p1, k1 tbl, p2, (sk2p, p2, k1 tbl, p2) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 192 sts.

Row 20 (WS): K3, (p1 tbl, k2) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 21 (RS): K3, yo, p2, kyokyo, p2, k1 tbl, (p2, kyokyo, p2, k1 tbl) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 318 sts.

Row 22 (WS): K4, p1 tbl, (k2, p5, k2, p1 tbl) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 23 (RS): K3, yo, k1 tbl, (p2, k5, p2, k1 tbl) to last 4 sts, p1, yo, sl3 wyif. 320 sts.

Row 24 (WS): K5, p1 tbl, (k2, p5, k2, p1 tbl) to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif.

Row 25 (RS): K3, yo, p1, k1 tbl, p2, (ssk, k1, k2tog, p2, k1 tbl, p2) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 260 sts.

Row 26 (WS): K3, p1 tbl, k2, p1 tbl, k2, (p3, k2, p1 tbl, k2) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 27 (RS): K3, yo, p2, k1 tbl, p2, (sk2p, p2, k1 tbl, p2) to last 4 sts, k1 tbl, yo, sl3 wyif. 200 sts.

Row 28 (WS): K4, p1 tbl, (k2, p1 tbl) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

SECTION 6 - Eyelet Stripes

Row 1 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 202 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Carry color A along the edge while striping colors. Watch this Westknits video to assist with carrying yarn along the edge while striping colors.

Row 3 (RS): Using CC1, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 204 sts.

Row 4 (WS): K3, (k2tog, yo) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break CC1.

Row 5 (RS): Using A, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 206 sts.

Row 6 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 7 (RS): Using CC2, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 208 sts.

Row 8 (WS): K3, (k2tog, yo) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break CC2.

Row 9 (RS): Using A, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 210 sts.

Row 10 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 11 (RS): Using CC3, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 212 sts.

Row 12 (WS): K3, (k2tog, yo) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break CC3.

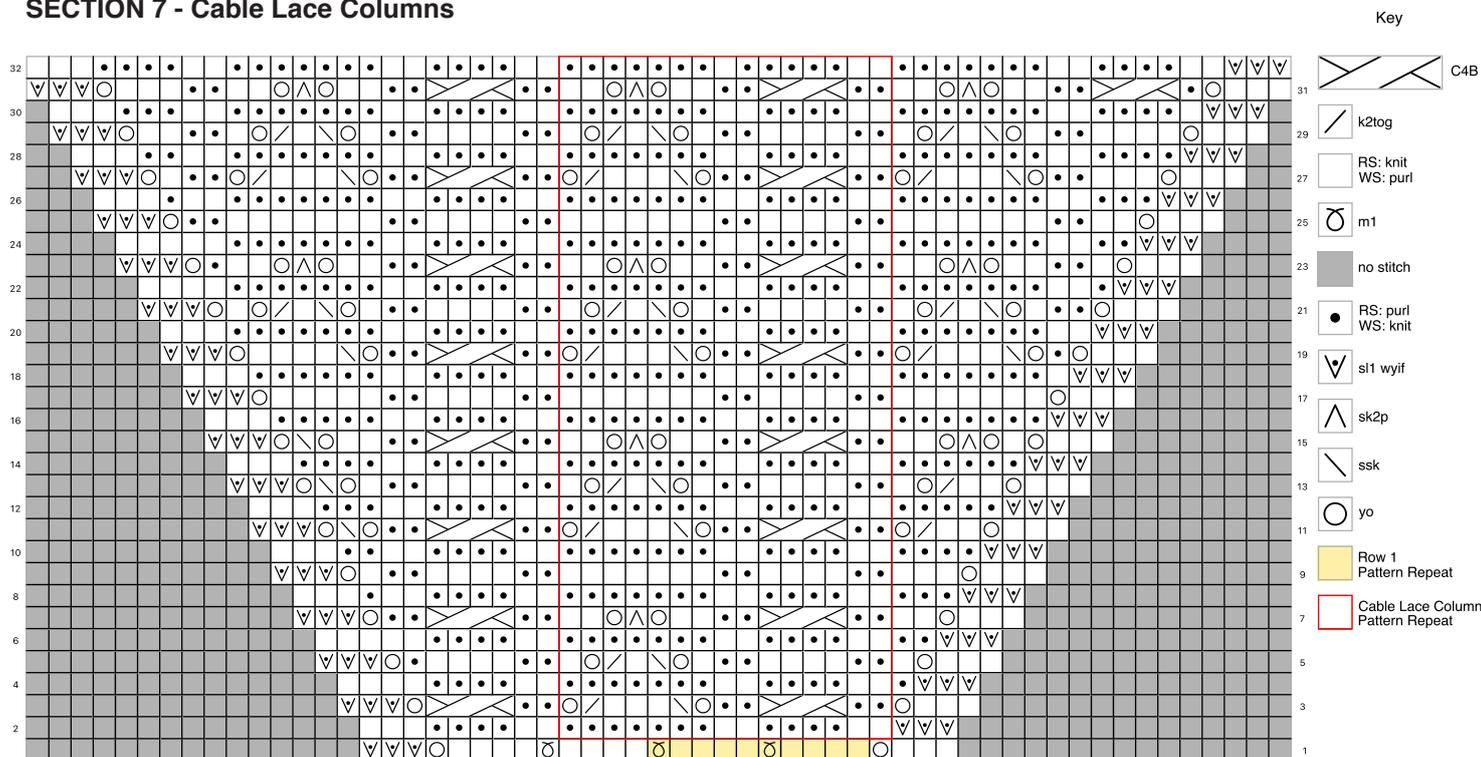
Row 13 (RS): Using A, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 214 sts.

Row 14 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break color A.



SECTION 7 - Cable Lace Columns



Row 1 (RS): Using B, k3, yo, (k4, m1) to last 7 sts, k4, yo, sl3 wyif. 267 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K3, p4, k2, (p7, k2, p4, k2) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 3 (RS): K3, yo, p2, C4B, (p2, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, p2, C4B) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 269 sts.

Row 4 (WS): K4, p4, k2, (p7, k2, p4, k2) to last 4 sts, p1, sl3 wyif.

Row 5 (RS): K3, yo, k1, p2, k4, (p2, k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, p2, k4) to last 4 sts, p1, yo, sl3 wyif. 271 sts.

Row 6 (WS): K5, p4, k2, (p7, k2, p4, k2) to last 5 sts, p2, sl3 wyif.

Row 7 (RS): K3, yo, k2, p2, C4B, p2, (k2, yo, sk2p, yo, k2, p2, C4B, p2) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 273 sts.

Row 8 (WS): K3, p1, k2, p4, k2, (p7, k2, p4, k2) to last 6 sts, p3, sl3 wyif.

Row 9 (RS): K3, yo, k3, p2, k4, p2, (k7, p2, k4, p2) to last 4 sts, k1, yo, sl3 wyif. 275 sts.

Row 10 (WS): K3, p2, k2, p4, k2, (p7, k2, p4, k2) to last 7 sts, p4, sl3 wyif.

Row 11 (RS): K3, yo, k2, k2tog, yo, p2, C4B, p2, (yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, p2, C4B, p2) to last 5 sts, yo, ssk, yo, sl3 wyif. 277 sts.

Row 12 (WS): K3, p3, k2, p4, k2, (p7, k2, p4, k2) to last 8 sts, p5, sl3 wyif.

Row 13 (RS): K3, yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, p2, k4, p2, (k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, p2, k4, p2) to last 6 sts, k1, yo, ssk, yo, sl3 wyif. 279 sts.

Row 14 (WS): K3, p4, k2, p4, k2, (p7, k2, p4, k2) to last 9 sts, p6, sl3 wyif.

Row 15 (RS): K3, yo, k1, yo, sk2p, yo, k2, p2, C4B, p2, (k2, yo, sk2p, yo, k2, p2, C4B, p2) to last 7 sts, k2, yo, ssk, yo, sl3 wyif. 281 sts.

Row 16 (WS): K3, p5, (k2, p4, k2, p7) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 17 (RS): K3, yo, (k7, p2, k4, p2) to last 8 sts, k5, yo, sl3 wyif. 283 sts.

Row 18 (WS): K3, p6, (k2, p4, k2, p7) to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif.

Row 19 (RS): K3, yo, p1, (yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, p2, C4B, p2) to last 9 sts, yo, ssk, k4, yo, sl3 wyif. 285 sts.

Row 20 (WS): K3, p7, (k2, p4, k2, p7) to last 5 sts, k2, sl3 wyif.

Row 21 (RS): K3, yo, p2, (k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, p2, k4, p2) to last 10 sts, k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, sl3 wyif. 287 sts.

Row 22 (WS): K4, p7, (k2, p4, k2, p7) to last 6 sts, k2, p1, sl3 wyif.

Row 23 (RS): K3, yo, k1, p2, (k2, yo, sk2p, yo, k2, p2, C4B, p2) to last 11 sts, k2, yo, sk2p, yo, k2, p1, yo, sl3 wyif. 289 sts.

Row 24 (WS): K5, p7, (k2, p4, k2, p7) to last 7 sts, k2, p2, sl3 wyif.

Row 25 (RS): K3, yo, k2, p2, k7, p2, (k4, p2, k7, p2) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 291 sts.

Row 26 (WS): K3, p1, k2, p7, k2, (p4, k2, p7, k2) to last 6 sts, p3, sl3 wyif.

Row 27 (RS): K3, yo, k3, p2, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, p2, (C4B, p2, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, p2) to last 4 sts, k1, yo, sl3 wyif. 293 sts.

Row 28 (WS): K3, p2, k2, p7, k2, p4, (k2, p7, k2, p4) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 29 (RS): K3, yo, k4, p2, k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, p2, (k4, p2, k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, p2) to last 5 sts, k2, yo, sl3 wyif. 295 sts.

Row 30 (WS): K3, p3, k2, p7, k2, p4, (k2, p7, k2, p4) to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif.

Row 31 (RS): K3, yo, p1, C4B, p2, k2, yo, sk2p, yo, k2, p2, (C4B, p2, k2, yo, sk2p, yo, k2, p2) to last 6 sts, k3, yo, sl3 wyif. 297 sts.

Row 32 (WS): K3, p4, k2, (p7, k2, p4, k2) to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

SECTION 8 - Reverse Stockinette Stripes

Row 1 (RS): Using B held together with CC1, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 299 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 3 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 301 sts.

Row 4 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 5 (RS): K3, yo, p to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 303 sts.

Row 6 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break CC1.

Row 7 (RS): Using B held together with CC2, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 305 sts.

Row 8 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 9 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 307 sts.

Row 10 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 11 (RS): K3, yo, p to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 309 sts.

Row 12 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break CC2.

Row 13 (RS): Using B held together with CC3, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 311 sts.

Row 14 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 15 (RS): K3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 313 sts.

Row 16 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

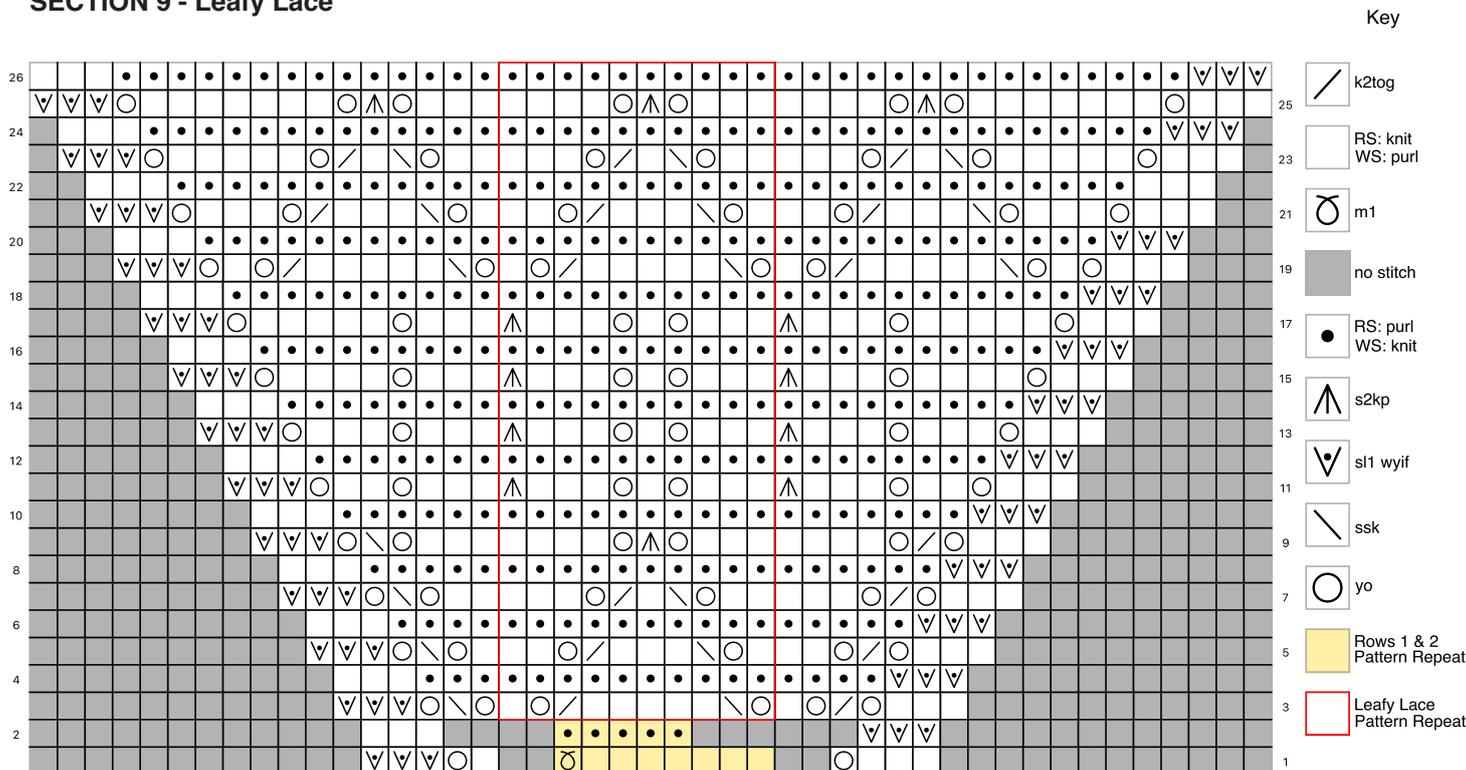
Row 17 (RS): K3, yo, p to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 315 sts.

Row 18 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break color B & CC3.



SECTION 9 - Leafy Lace



Row 1 (RS): Using C, k3, yo, (k7, m1) to last 4 sts, k1, yo, sl3 wyif. 361 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 3 (RS): K3, yo, k2tog, yo, k1, (yo, ssk, k5, k2tog, yo, k1) to last 5 sts, yo, ssk, yo, sl3 wyif. 363 sts.

Row 4 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 5 (RS): K3, yo, k2tog, yo, k2, (k1, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k2) to last 6 sts, k1, yo, ssk, yo, sl3 wyif. 365 sts.

Row 6 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 7 (RS): K3, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, (k2, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k3) to last 7 sts, k2, yo, ssk, yo, sl3 wyif. 367 sts.

Row 8 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 9 (RS): K3, yo, k2tog, yo, k4, (k3, yo, s2kp, yo, k4) to last 8 sts, k3, yo, ssk, yo, sl3 wyif. 369 sts.

Row 10 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 11 (RS): K3, yo, k2, yo, k3, s2kp, (k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, s2kp) to last 8 sts, k3, yo, k2, yo, sl3 wyif. 371 sts.

Row 12 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 13 (RS): K3, yo, k3, yo, k3, s2kp, (k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, s2kp) to last 9 sts, k3, yo, k3, yo, sl3 wyif. 373 sts.

Row 14 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 15 (RS): K3, yo, k4, yo, k3, s2kp, (k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, s2kp) to last 10 sts, k3, yo, k4, yo, sl3 wyif. 375 sts.

Row 16 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 17 (RS): K3, yo, k5, yo, k3, s2kp, (k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, s2kp) to last 11 sts, k3, yo, k5, yo, sl3 wyif. 377 sts.

Row 18 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 19 (RS): K3, yo, k1, (yo, ssk, k5, k2tog, yo, k1) to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 379 sts.

Row 20 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 21 (RS): K3, yo, k2, (k1, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k2) to last 4 sts, k1, yo, sl3 wyif. 381 sts.

Row 22 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 23 (RS): K3, yo, k3, (k2, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k3) to last 5 sts, k2, yo, sl3 wyif. 383 sts.

Row 24 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 25 (RS): K3, yo, k4, (k3, yo, s2kp, yo, k4) to last 6 sts, k3, yo, sl3 wyif. 385 sts.

Row 26 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

SECTION 10 - Seed Stitch

Row 1 (RS): Using C held together with CC1, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 387 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K3, (k1, p1) to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif.

Row 3 (RS): K3, yo, (k1, p1) to last 4 sts, k1, yo, sl3 wyif. 389 sts.

Row 4 (WS): K3, (p1, k1) to last 4 sts, p1, sl3 wyif.

Break CC1.

Row 5 (RS): Using C held together with CC2, k3, yo, (p1, k1) to last 4 sts, p1, yo, sl3 wyif. 391 sts.

Row 6 (WS): K3, (k1, p1) to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif.

Row 7 (RS): K3, yo, (k1, p1) to last 4 sts, k1, yo, sl3 wyif. 393 sts.

Row 8 (WS): K3, (p1, k1) to last 4 sts, p1, sl3 wyif.

Break CC2.

Row 9 (RS): Using C held together with CC3, k3, yo, (p1, k1) to last 4 sts, p1, yo, sl3 wyif. 395 sts.

Row 10 (WS): K3, (k1, p1) to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif.

Row 11 (RS): K3, yo, (k1, p1) to last 4 sts, k1, yo, sl3 wyif. 397 sts.

Row 12 (WS): K3, (p1, k1) to last 4 sts, p1, sl3 wyif.

Break color C & CC3.

SECTION 11 - Chevron Border

Row 1 (RS): Using CC1, k3, yo, k5, pm, k1, (yo, k9, yo, k1) to last 8 sts, pm, k5, yo, sl3 wyif. 475 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 3 (RS): K3, yo, k to m, slm, k1, (yo, k11, yo, k1) to m, slm, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 553 sts.

Row 4 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break CC1.

Row 5 (RS): Using A, k3, yo, k to m, slm, k1, (yo, k5, s2kp, k5, yo, k1) to m, slm, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 555 sts.

Row 6 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 7 (RS): K3, yo, p to m, slm, p1, (yo, p5, p3tog, p5, yo, p1) to m, slm, p to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 557 sts.

Row 8 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break color A.

Row 9 (RS): Using CC2, k3, yo, k to m, slm, k1, (yo, k5, s2kp, k5, yo, k1) to m, slm, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 559 sts.

Row 10 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 11 (RS): K3, yo, k to m, slm, k1, (yo, k5, s2kp, k5, yo, k1) to m, slm, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 561 sts.

Row 12 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break CC2.

Row 13 (RS): Using B, k3, yo, k to m, slm, k1, (yo, k5, s2kp, k5, yo, k1) to m, slm, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 563 sts.

Row 14 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 15 (RS): K3, yo, p to m, slm, p1, (yo, p5, p3tog, p5, yo, p1) to m, slm, p to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 565 sts.

Row 16 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break color B.

Row 17 (RS): Using CC3, k3, yo, k to m, slm, k1, (yo, k5, s2kp, k5, yo, k1) to m, slm, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 567 sts.

Row 18 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 19 (RS): K3, yo, k to m, slm, k1, (yo, k5, s2kp, k5, yo, k1) to m, slm, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 569 sts.

Row 20 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Break CC3.

Row 21 (RS): Using C, k3, yo, k to m, slm, k1, (yo, k5, s2kp, k5, yo, k1) to m, slm, k to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 571 sts.

Row 22 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Row 23 (RS): K3, yo, p to m, slm, p1, (yo, p5, p3tog, p5, yo, p1) to m, slm, p to last 3 sts, yo, sl3 wyif. 573 sts.

Row 24 (WS): K to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

If you want to add more border stripes, you can repeat 17 – 24 using other CC's or colors A, B, & C. If you decide to knit more border rows, then I recommend using a kitchen scale to help weigh your yarn, so you don't run out of yarn during a stripe. Weigh a color before knitting, then work 1 row to know how many grams 1 row requires for your shawl. This will help determine how many extra stripes you can create. Make sure to leave enough yarn for an I-cord BO.

FINISHING

Using C, BO all sts on the next RS row using an I-cord BO. Watch this Westknits video to assist with the I-cord Bind Off.

I-cord BO: *K2, k2tog tbl, sl3 sts onto left needle; repeat from * to last 3 sts. 6 final sts remain.

Break yarn leaving an 8" / 20cm tail. Place the first 3 sts onto your right needle and the last 3 sts onto your left needle with the purl bumps facing each other and both needles pointing to the right. Graft the remaining 6 sts together.

Weave in ends and wet block the finished shawl to smooth the fabric.
