SIZE

One size
See measurements on page 2

GAUGE

16 stitches/38 rows for 10 cm in garter stitch,
after blocking

NEEDLES

4 mm circular 80 cm

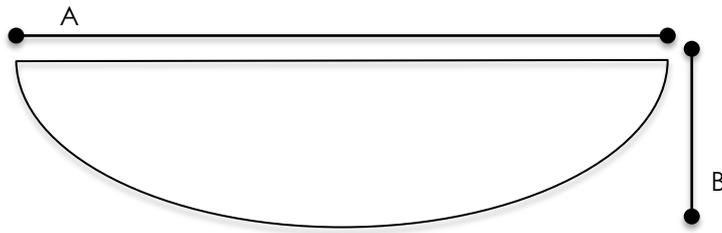
YARN

2 skeins of La Bien Aimée "Merino Singles"
shown here in
Yellow Brick Road (C1) and *Namu* (C2),
or approx 780 yards
(390 y of each color) of fingering weight yarn

NOTIONS

Stitch markers

ABBREVIATIONS & TECHNIQUES

s, sts	stitch, stitches
RS	right side
WS	wrong side
rep	repeat
M	marker
PM	place marker
SM	slip marker
sl1	slip 1 stitch, purlwise
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together
ssk	slip a stitch, knit the next stitch, pass the slipped stitch over the knitted one.
C1	color 1 (<i>here Yellow Brick Road</i>)
C2	color 2 (<i>here Namu</i>)

SHORT ROWS

For this pattern, two techniques are used.

The first one is the basic "wrap & turn" . It's a classical method to work short rows, and it works really great when knitting in garter stitch. There's no need to pick up the wrapped stitch !

The second one is using a yo. At the end of the row, you'll have to turn your project (at the mentioned point) without wrapping any stitch. Start the next row (WS) with a yo, that doesn't count as a stitch.

On the next RS row, you'll knit the yo with the next stitch, that will be a wrapped stitch.

NOTES

In order to have flexible edgings, it's possible to place a yo (made with the color needed for the row) after the 1m (slipped) st of each row. You will simply drop this yo, without knitting it, on the next row.

This will give you nice elastic edges.

SET UP

Using C1, loosely cast on 3 sts.

Knit in garter stitch, always slipping the first st of each row, for 4 rows. Rotate your work 90° clockwise, pick up and knit 2 sts along the side. Rotate 90° again, pick up and knit 3 sts along the cast on edge.

You have 8 sts.

Set up row (WS) : sl1, k2, PM, k2, PM, k3.

GARTER STITCH

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to M, yo, SM, k3.

Row 2 (WS) : sl1, k to end of row.

Section 1

Work rows 1-2 **9 total times**. You have 26 sts.

On the next row (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, *k1, yo* rep from *to* to M, SM, k3.

On the next row (WS): sl1, k to end of row.

You have 47 sts.

Section 2

Work rows 1-2 **9 total times**. You have 65 sts.

On the next row (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, *k3, yo* rep from *to* to 2 sts before M, k2, yo, SM, k3.

On the next row (WS): sl1, k to end of row.

You have 86 sts.

Section 3

Work rows 1-2 **9 total times**. You have 104 sts.

On the next row (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k4, *yo, k5* rep from *to* to 4 sts before M, yo, k4, yo, SM, k3.

On the next row (WS): sl1, k to end of row.

You have 125 sts.

Section 4

Work rows 1-2 **9 total times**. You have 143 sts.

On the next row (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k5 *yo, k7* rep from *to* to 6 sts before M, yo, k6, yo, SM, k3.

On the next row (WS): sl1, k to end of row.

You have 164 sts.

Section 5

Work rows 1-2 **9 total times**. You have 182 sts.

On the next row (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k7 *yo, k9* rep from *to* to 7 sts before M, yo, k7, yo, SM, k3.

On the next row (WS): sl1, k to end of row.

You have 203 sts.

Section 6

Work rows 1-2 **9 total times**. You have 221 sts.

On the next row (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k8 *yo, k11* rep from *to* to 9 sts before M, yo, k9, yo, SM, k3.

On the next row (WS): sl1, k to end of row.

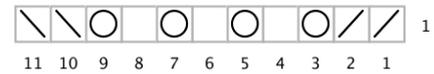
You have 242 sts.

Work rows 1-2 **once more**. You have 244 sts.
Cut C1.

STRIPES

The lace pattern used for the stripes is worked on a 11 stitches repeat.

Here's a chart and written explanations.



(k2tog) 2x, (yo, k1) 3x, yo, (ssk) 2x
rep from *to*

STRIPE 1

With C2 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k110, wrap the next st and turn.

Rows 2, 6, 10, 14 (WS) : p to M, SM, k3.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, *lace pattern* 10x, k1, turn your work.

Rows 4, 8, 12 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

Rows 5, 9, 13 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 20 sts before the wrapped st (**attention : the yo doesn't count as 1 st**), wrap the next st and turn.

Row 7 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k2, *lace pattern* 8x, k3, turn your work.

Row 11 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k1, yo, k1, ssk, *lace pattern* 6x, k5, turn your work.

Row 15 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, (k1, yo) 2x, ssk, ssk, *lace pattern* 4x, k7, turn your work.

Row 16 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

With C1 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k119 (= to the last wrapped stitch, working the yo from short rows as explained on page 2), k3, wrap the next st and turn.

Row 2 (WS) : k.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 3 sts after the wrapped st, wrap the next st and turn.

Row 4 (WS) : k.

STRIPE 2

With C2 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k132, wrap the next st and turn.

Rows 2, 6, 10, 14 (WS) : p to M, SM, k3.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, k1, yo, ssk, ssk, *lace pattern* 11x, k2, turn your work.

Rows 4, 8, 12 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

Rows 5, 9, 13 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 20 sts before the wrapped st (**attention : the yo doesn't count as 1 st**), wrap the next st and turn.

Row 7 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k1 *lace pattern* 10x, k4, turn your work.

Row 11 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k3, *lace pattern* 8x, k6, turn your work.

Row 15 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k3, yo, ssk, *lace pattern* 6x, k8, turn your work.

Row 16 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

With C1 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k141 (= to the last wrapped stitch, working the yo from short rows as explained on page 2), k3, wrap the next st and turn.

Row 2 (WS) : k.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 3 sts after the wrapped st, wrap the next st and turn.

Row 4 (WS) : k.

STRIPE 3

With C2 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k154, wrap the next st and turn.

Rows 2, 6, 10, 14 (WS) : p to M, SM, k3.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k4, yo, k1, yo, ssk, ssk, *lace pattern* 13x, k3, turn your work.

Rows 4, 8, 12 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

Rows 5, 9, 13 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 20 sts before the wrapped st (**attention : the yo doesn't count as 1 st**), wrap the next st and turn.

Row 7 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, *lace pattern* 12x, k5, turn your work.

Row 11 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k2, *lace pattern* 10x, k7, turn your work.

Row 15 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k1, yo, k1, ssk, *lace pattern* 8x, k9, turn your work.

Row 16 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

With C1 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k 163 (= to the last wrapped stitch, working the yo from short rows as explained on page 2), k3, wrap the next st and turn.

Row 2 (WS) : k.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 3 sts after the wrapped st, wrap the next st and turn.

Row 4 (WS) : k.

STRIPE 4

With C2 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k176, wrap the next st and turn.

Rows 2, 6, 10, 14 (WS) : p to M, SM, k3.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k3, yo, k1, yo, ssk, ssk, *lace pattern* 15x, k4, turn your work.

Rows 4, 8, 12 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

Rows 5, 9, 13 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 20 sts before the wrapped st (**attention : the yo doesn't count as 1 st**), wrap the next st and turn.

Row 7 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k2, k2tog, (yo, k1) 2x, yo, ssk, ssk, *lace pattern* 13x, k6, turn your work.

Row 11 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k1, *lace pattern* 12x, k8, turn your work.

Row 15 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k3, *lace pattern* 10x, k10, turn your work.

Row 16 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

With C1 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k 185 (= to the last wrapped stitch, working the yo from short rows as explained on page 2), k3, wrap the next st and turn.

Row 2 (WS) : k.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 3 sts after the wrapped st, wrap the next st and turn.

Row 4 (WS) : k.

STRIPE 5

With C2 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k198, wrap the next st and turn.

Rows 2, 6, 10, 14 (WS) : p to M, SM, k3.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, ssk, *lace pattern* 17x, k5, turn your work.

Rows 4, 8, 12 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

Rows 5, 9, 13 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 20 sts before the wrapped st (**attention : the yo doesn't count as 1 st**), wrap the next st and turn.

Row 7 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k1, k2tog, (yo, k1) 2x, yo, ssk, ssk, *lace pattern* 15x, k7, turn your work.

Row 11 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, *lace pattern* 14x, k9, turn your work.

Row 15 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k2, *lace pattern* 13x, turn your work.

Row 16 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

With C1 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k207 (= to the last wrapped stitch, working the yo from short rows as explained on page 2), k3, wrap the next st and turn.

Row 2 (WS) : k.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 3 sts after the wrapped st, wrap the next st and turn.

Row 4 (WS) : k.

STRIPE 6

With C2 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k220, wrap the next st and turn.

Rows 2, 6, 10, 14 (WS) : p to M, SM, k3.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k1, yo, k1, yo, ssk, ssk, *lace pattern* 19x, k6, turn your work.

Rows 4, 8, 12 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

Rows 5, 9, 13 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 20 sts before the wrapped st (**attention : the yo doesn't count as 1 st**), wrap the next st and turn.

Row 7 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k3, yo, k1, yo, ssk, ssk, *lace pattern* 17x, k8, turn your work.

Row 11 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k2, k2tog, (yo, k1) 2x, yo, ssk, ssk, *lace pattern* 15x, k10, turn your work.

Row 15 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k1, *lace pattern* 15x, k1, turn your work.

Row 16 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

With C1 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k229 (= to the last wrapped stitch, working the yo from short rows as explained on page 2), k3, wrap the next st and turn.

Row 2 (WS) : k.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 3 sts after the wrapped st, wrap the next st and turn.

Row 4 (WS) : k.

STRIPE 7

With C2 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 1 st before M, wrap the next st and turn.

Rows 2, 6, 10, 14 (WS) : p to M, SM, k3.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k5, *lace pattern* 26x, k7, turn your work.

Rows 4, 8, 12 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

Rows 5, 9, 13 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to 20 sts before the wrapped st (**attention : the yo doesn't count as 1 st**), wrap the next st and turn.

Row 7 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, ssk, *lace pattern* 24x, k9, turn your work.

Row 11 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k1, k2tog, (yo, k1) 2x, yo, ssk, ssk, *lace pattern* 23x, turn your work.

Row 15 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, *lace pattern* 22x, k2, turn your work.

Row 16 (WS) : yo, k to end of row.

With C1 :

Row 1 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to M (= working the yo from short rows as explained on page 2), yo, SM, k3.

Row 2 (WS) : k.

Row 3 (RS) : sl1, k2, SM, yo, k to M, yo, SM, k3.

Row 4 (WS) : k.

Bind off loosely on the next row : k1, *k1, insert left needle in the front of the next 2sts on the right needle, and k2tog through the back loop* repeat from *to* until all stitches are bound off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends.

Soak your project in a large quantity of lukewarm water, for at least 30 minutes.

Squeeze it gently – without twisting ! – between towels to pull out as much water as you can. Put the shawl in place, on a flat surface. Pin out the waves of the edging and let it dry.



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
