



# Granada

Granada, the city of dreams, was a cherished memory for my grandmother, filled with its traditions, religious rites, foods, colours, flowers, dances and trees. Her parents had come from a small town nearby and visits to Granada were always a special occasion. This sweater cherishes the city's soft terracotta colours while the wide sleeves evoke the customs and traditions that were so important in my childhood home.

## SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: 2-4" / 5-10 cm of positive ease.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Bust Circumference:** 34.5 (38, 42, 46, 50) (54, 58.5, 62.5, 66)" / 88 (96.5, 106, 117, 127) (137, 149, 159, 167.5) cm.

**Body Length to Underarm (Front):** 10 (10, 11, 12, 12.5) (12.5, 13, 13.5, 14)" / 25.5 (25.5, 28, 30.5, 31.75) (31.75, 33, 34.25, 35.5) cm.

**Sleeve Length to Underarm:** 16.5 (16.5, 17, 17.5, 17.5) (18, 18, 18.5, 18.5)" / 42 (42, 43, 44.5, 44.5) (46, 46, 47, 47) cm.

**Upper Arm Circumference:** 16.25, (17, 17.5, 18.5, 20) (21.5, 23, 24.5, 25)" / 41 (43, 44.5, 47, 51) (54.5, 58.5, 62, 63.5) cm.

**Armhole Depth:** 7.75 (8.25, 9.5, 10, 10) (10.5, 11.75, 12.75, 13.75)" / 19.5 (21, 24, 25.5, 25.5) (27, 30, 32.5, 35) cm.

**Back Neck Width:** 7.25 (7.5, 8, 8, 8.25) (8.5, 9, 9.5, 10)" / 18.5 (19, 20.5, 20.5, 21) (21.5, 23, 24, 25.5) cm.

## MATERIALS

**Yarn A:** 2 (2, 3, 3, 3) (3, 4, 4, 4) skeins of Kinu by Ito (100% silk, 464 yds / 425 m - 50 g), colourway Peach. Or approx. 696 (874, 1045, 1161, 1277) (1393, 1509, 1625, 1741) yds / 637 (800, 956, 1062, 1168) (1274, 1380, 1486, 1592) m of lace-weight yarn.

**Yarn B:** 5 (6, 6, 7, 7) (8, 9, 10, 10) skeins of Sensai by Ito (60% mohair, 40% silk, 262 yds / 239 m - 25 g), colourway Cinnamon (302). Or approx. 1264 (1410, 1551, 1681, 1884) (2064, 2221, 2422, 2533) yds / 1156 (1290, 1419, 1538, 1723) (1892, 2031, 2215, 2317) m of lace-weight mohair.

1 strand of Yarn A along with 1 strand of Yarn B are held together throughout body and sleeve cuffs. Yarn B is used for the crochet sleeve.

**Needles:** US 2.5 / 3 mm 16" / 40 cm circular needles or DPNs, US 4 / 3.5 mm 32" / 80 cm (or longer for larger sizes) circular needles, US 1 / 2.25 mm set of DPNs. US C-2 2.75 mm crochet hook.

**Notions:** Stitch markers, waste yarn or stitch holders, tapestry needle.

## GAUGE

24 sts x 32 rnds = 4" / 10 cm on US 4 / 3.5 mm needles in St St with 2 strands of yarn held together, after blocking.

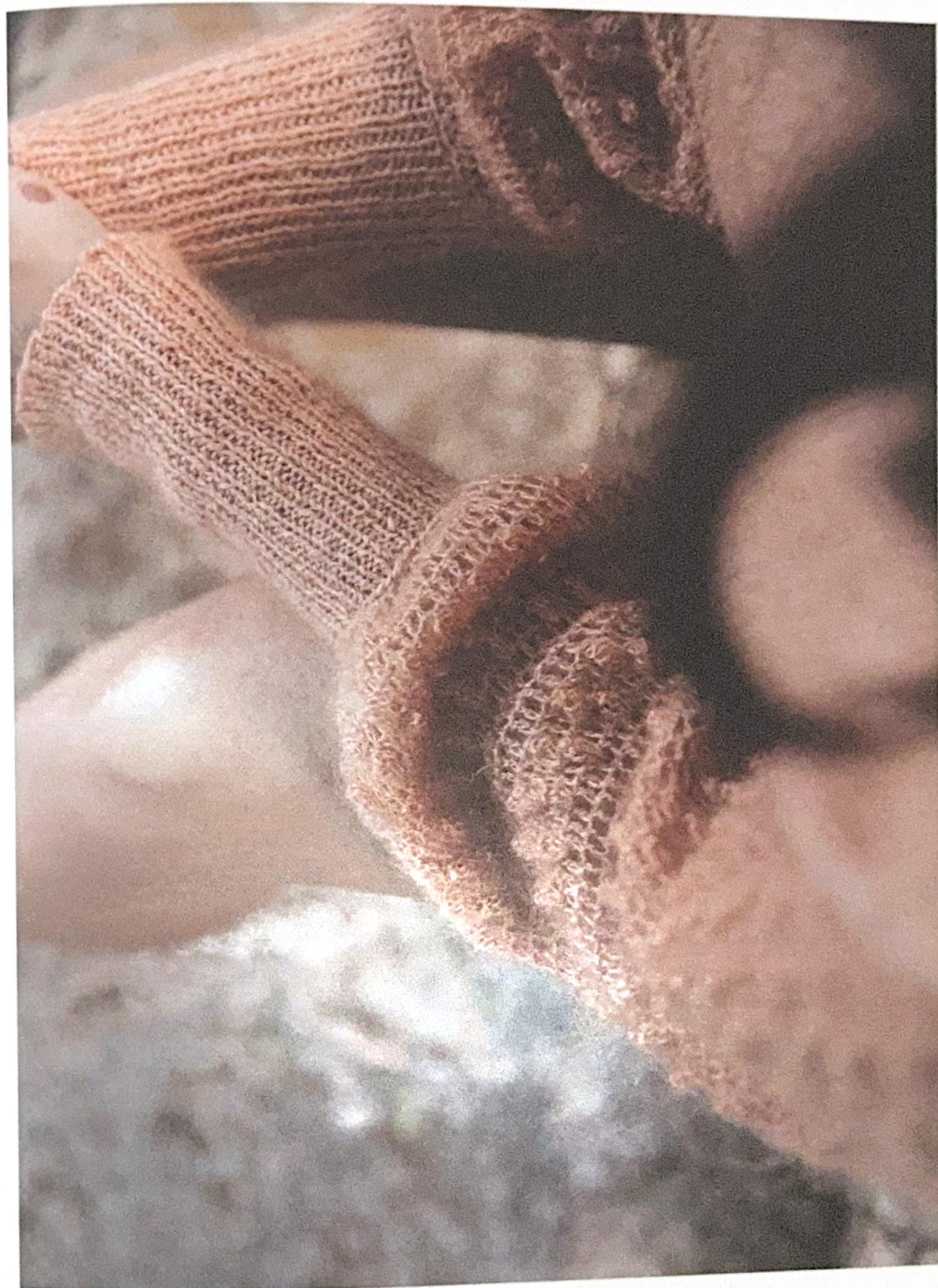
20 dc x 15 rows = 4 x 4.5" / 11.25 x 10 cm on 2.75 mm crochet hook in crochet stitch pattern with 1 strand of Yarn B, after blocking.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**MB:** Bobble Stitch. Yo, insert hook into the ch sp, yo, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yo, pull through 2 loops, \*yo, insert hook into the same ch sp, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2\* rep \*-\* 3 more times (6 loops on hook), yo, pull through all 6 loops, ch 1. (When a ch 1 is listed after a bo in the pattern it is in addition to the ch 1 for the st.)

## DIRECTIONS

This sweater is worked seamlessly from the top down. First the back is cast on, short rows are worked to shape shoulders and the back is worked to underarms. Fronts are picked up from back and the shoulders and neckline are shaped. The front and back are then joined and the body is worked in the round. The sleeves are worked in crochet with short rows to shape the sleeve cap and sleeves are finished with knit ribbing. A crochet collar is worked and can be sewn on or worn as a cowl.



**BACK**

With US 4 / 3.5 mm longer circular needles and one strand of Yarn A and Yarn B held together throughout, CO 76 (82, 86, 92, 98) (104, 112, 118, 122) sts using the Long-Tail CO Method.

**Shape Back Shoulders**

**SHORT ROW 1 (RS):** K65 (69, 71, 76, 80) (85, 91, 96, 100), w&t.

**SHORT ROW 2 (WS):** P54 (56, 56, 60, 62) (66, 70, 74, 78), w&t.

**SHORT ROW 3:** K2 (3, 4, 4, 5) (5, 6, 6, 6) sts past last wrap, concealing wrapped st as you come to it, w&t.

**SHORT ROW 4:** P2 (3, 4, 4, 5) (5, 6, 6, 6) sts past last wrap, concealing wrapped st as you come to it, w&t. Rep Short Rows 3-4 twice more.

**SHORT ROW 9 (RS):** K to end.

**NEXT ROW (WS):** P to end.

Work even in St St until piece measures 5 (5, 5.5, 5.75, 5.75) (6.25, 6.75, 7, 7.5)" / 13 (13, 14, 14.5, 14.5) (16, 17, 18, 19) cm when measured along side edge, ending with a WS row.

**Shape Back Armholes**

**INC ROW (RS):** K1, m1l, k to 1 st from end, m1r, k1. (2 sts inc'd)

**NEXT ROW (WS):** P to end.

Rep last 2 rows 7 (9, 11, 12, 12) (12, 14, 16, 18) more times. [92 (102, 110, 118, 124) (130, 142, 152, 160) sts]

Break yarn leaving a tail to weave in later and place sts on waste yarn or holders.

**Left Front**

With US 4 / 3.5 mm longer circular needles, one strand of Yarn A and Yarn B held together, RS facing and beg 15 (17, 19, 21, 23) (25, 28, 30, 30) sts in from left edge, pick up and k 15 (17, 19, 21, 23) (25, 28, 30, 30) sts from back for left shoulder.

P 1 row.

**Shape Left Front Shoulder**

**SHORT ROW 1 (RS):** K3 (3, 3, 4, 4) (5, 5, 6, 6), w&t.

**SHORT ROW 2 (WS):** P to end.

**SHORT ROW 3:** K2 (3, 4, 4, 5) (5, 6, 6, 6) sts past last wrap, concealing wrapped st as you come to it, w&t.

**SHORT ROW 4 (WS):** P to end.

Rep Short Rows 3-4 twice more. [15 (17, 19, 21, 23) (25, 28, 30, 30) sts]

**Shape Left Neck**

In the next row, conceal remaining wrap as you pass it.

**NEXT ROW:** K1, m1r, k to end. (1 st inc'd)

**NEXT ROW:** P to end.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. [18 (20, 22, 24, 26) (28, 31, 33, 33) sts]

**NEXT ROW (RS):** Using the Cable CO Method, CO 2 sts at beg of row, k to end.

**NEXT ROW (WS):** P to end.

**NEXT ROW:** Using the Cable CO Method, CO 3 sts at beg of row, k to end.

**NEXT ROW:** P to end.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. [29 (31, 33, 35, 37) (39, 42, 44, 44) sts]

Break yarn leaving a tail to weave in later and place sts on waste yarn or holder.

**Right Front**

With US 4 / 3.5 mm longer circular needles, RS facing and starting at right armhole edge, pick up and k 15 (17, 19, 21, 23) (25, 28, 30, 30) sts from back for right shoulder.

**Shape Right Front Shoulder**

**SHORT ROW 1 (WS):** P3 (3, 3, 4, 4) (5, 6, 6, 6), w&t.

**SHORT ROW 2 (RS):** K to end.

**SHORT ROW 3:** P2 (3, 4, 4, 5) (5, 6, 6, 6) sts past last wrap, concealing wrapped st as you come to it, w&t.

**SHORT ROW 4 (RS):** K to end.

Rep Short Rows 3-4 twice more.

P 1 row, concealing remaining wrap as you pass it. [15 (17, 19, 21, 23) (25, 28, 30, 30) sts]

**Shape Right Neck**

**INC ROW (RS):** K to 1 st from end, m1l, k1. (1 st inc'd)

**NEXT ROW (WS):** P to end.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. [18 (20, 22, 24, 26) (28, 31, 33, 33) sts]

K 1 row.

**NEXT ROW (WS):** Using the Cable CO Method, CO 2 sts at beg of row, p to end.

**NEXT ROW (RS):** K to end.

**NEXT ROW:** Using the Cable CO Method, CO 3 sts at beg of row, p to end.

**NEXT ROW:** K to end.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. [29 (31, 33, 35, 37) (39, 42, 44, 44) sts]

**JOIN FRONTS**

With RS facing, k29 (31, 33, 35, 37) (39, 42, 44, 44) from right front, using the Backwards Loop CO Method, CO 18 (20, 20, 22, 24) (26, 28, 30, 34) for centre front of neck, place sts from left front onto needle and k29 (31, 33, 35, 37) (39, 42, 44, 44) from left front. [76 (82, 86, 92, 98) (104, 112, 118, 122) sts]

Work even in St St until piece measures 5 (5, 5.5, 5.75, 5.75) (6.25, 6.75, 7, 7.5)" / 13 (13, 14, 14.5, 14.5) (16, 17, 18, 19) cm at armhole edge, ending with a WS row.

**Shape Front Armholes**

**INC ROW (RS):** K1, m1l, k to 1 st from end, m1r, k1. (2 sts inc'd)

**NEXT ROW (WS):** P to end.

Rep last 2 rows 7 (9, 11, 12, 12) (12, 14, 16, 18) more times. [92 (102, 110, 118, 124) (130, 142, 152, 160) sts]

**JOIN BODY**

With RS facing, K92 (102, 110, 118, 124) (130, 142, 152, 160) from front, using the Backwards Loop CO Method, CO on 6 (6, 8, 10, 13) (16, 17, 18, 19) sts, PM for side, CO 6 (6, 7, 10, 13) (16, 17, 18, 19) sts, k92 (102, 110, 118, 124) (130, 142, 152, 160) from back, using the Backwards Loop CO Method, CO 6 (6, 8, 10, 13) (16, 17, 18, 19) sts, place BOR m, CO 6 (6, 7, 10, 13) (16, 17, 18, 19) sts, and join to work in the rnd. [208 (228, 250, 276, 300) (324, 352, 376, 396) sts]

**BODY**

**NEXT RND:** K to end.

Work in St St for 1" / 2.5 cm

**INC RND:** \*K1, m1r, k to 1 st from m, m1l, k1, SM, rep from \* once more. (4 sts inc'd)

Rep Inc Rnd every 14th (14th, 16th, 14th, 16th) (16th, 14th, 14th, 14th, 14th) rnd 3 (3, 4, 4, 4) (5, 5, 5, 6) more times. [224 (244, 270, 296, 320) (348, 376, 400, 424) sts]

Work even in St St until piece measures 9.5, (9.5, 10.5, 11.5, 12) (12, 12.5, 13, 13.5)" / 24 (24, 26.5, 29, 30.5) (30.5, 32, 33, 34) cm or 0.5" / 1.25 cm less than desired length.

BO using the I-Cord BO Method.

**SLEEVES**

Join Yarn B with a sl st at the middle of the underarm with RS facing, and with US C-2 / 2.75 mm crochet hook, sc 92 (94, 98, 106, 116) (128, 136, 146, 152) sts around, sl st to join.

**Sleeve Cap**

**ROW 1:** Sl st to 10 sts bef the top of the shoulder, ch 1, working toward the shoulder, \*dc in next st, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* to 10 sts after top of shoulder (20 dc worked), sl st in next edge st, and next 2 edge sts, tw.

**ROW 2:** Ch 1, \*dc in ch 1 sp, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* in each ch 1 sp across, sk next edge st, sl st in next edge st, and next 2 edge sts, tw. (22 sts)

**ROW 3:** As Row 2. (24 sts)

**ROW 4:** Ch 1, \*(dc, ch 1) in each of the next 2 ch 1 sps, mb, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* across ending with 2 (dc, ch 1) sts, sk next edge st, sl st in next edge st, and next 2 edge sts, tw. (26 sts)

**ROW 5:** Ch 1, \*(dc, ch 1) in each of the next 2 ch 1 sps, mb, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* across ending with 1 dc, ch 1 sts, sk next edge st, sl st in next edge st, and next 2 edge sts, tw. (28 sts)

**ROWS 6-8:** As Row 2. (34 sts)

**ROW 9:** Ch 1, \*(dc, ch 1) in each of the next 2 ch 1 sps, mb, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* across, sk next edge st, sl st in next

edge st, and next 2 edge sts, tw. (36 sts)

**ROW 10:** Ch 1, \*dc, ch 1, in each of the next 2 ch 1 sps, mb, ch 1\* rep \*-\* across ending with 2 dc, ch 1 sts, sk next edge st, sl st in next edge st, and next 2 edge sts, tw. (38 sts)

*Sizes 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 only*

**ROWS 11-12:** As Row 2 [- (-, - 42, 42) (42, 42, 42, 42) sts]

*Sizes 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 only*

**ROW 13:** As Row 2.

**ROW 14:** Ch 1, \*(dc, ch 1) in each of the next 2 ch 1 sps, mb, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* across ending with 1 dc, ch 1 st, sk next edge st, sl st in next edge st, and next 2 edge sts, tw. [- (-, -, -, 46) (46, 46, 46, 46) sts]

*Sizes 6, 7, 8 and 9 only*

**ROW 15:** Ch 1, \*(dc, ch 1) in each of the next 2 ch 1 sps, mb, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* across, sk next edge st, sl st in next edge st, and next 2 edge sts, tw.

**ROW 16:** As Row 2. [- (-, -, -, -) (50, 50, 50, 50) sts]

*Sizes 7, 8 and 9 only*

**ROW 17:** As Row 2. [- (-, -, -, -) (-, 52, 52, 52) sts]

*Sizes 8 and 9 only*

**ROW 18:** As Row 2.

**ROW 19:** Ch 1, \*(dc, ch 1) in each of the next 2 ch 1 sps, mb, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* across ending with 2 dc, ch 1 sts, sk next edge st, sl st in next edge st, and next 2 edge sts, tw. [- (-, -, -, -) (-, -, 56, 56) sts]

*Size 9 only*

**ROW 20:** Ch 1, \*(dc, ch 1) in each of the next 2 ch 1 sps, mb, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* across ending with 1 dc, ch 1 sts, sk next edge st, sl st in next edge st, and next 2 edge sts, tw. (58 sts)

*Sizes 5 and 8 only*

**RND 1:** Ch 1, \*(dc, ch 1) in each of the next 2 ch 1 sps, mb, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* across to last ch 1 sp, rep around entire edge working one dc into each edge st, sl st to first dc to join. PM. [- (-, -, -, 88) (-, -, 108, -) sts]

*Sizes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 9 only*

**RND 1:** Ch 1, \*dc in ch 1 sp, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* across to last ch 1 sp. [dc in next edge st, ch 1] rep around entire edge, sl st to first dc to join. PM. [72 (76, 78, 82, -) (96, 102, -, 112) sts]

*All sizes resume*

Continue working in rnds in est stitch pattern of 3 rnds of dc and 2 rnds of mb, beginning each rnd with a ch 3, until sleeve measures 11 (11, 11.5, 12, 12) (12.5, 12.5, 13, 13)" / 28 (28, 29, 30.5, 30.5) (32, 32, 33, 33) cm.

**Decrease for Cuff**

*Size 1 only*

\*Sc 2, sc2tog, sc 3, sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* to end. (16 sts dec'd) (56 sts)

*Size 2 only*

Sc2tog, \*sc 2, sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* to last 2 sts, sc2tog. (20 sts dec'd) (56 sts)

*Size 3 only*

\*Sc2tog, sc 2, sc2tog, sc\*, rep \*-\* to last st, sc. (22 sts dec'd) (56 sts)

*Size 4 only*

[Sc2tog, sc 3] 2x, \*sc2tog, sc, sc2tog, sc 2\*, rep \*-\* 10 times, sc 2. (22 sts dec'd) (60 sts)

*Size 5 only*

\*[Sc, sc2tog] 13x, sc 3, sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* to end. (28 sts dec'd) (60 sts)

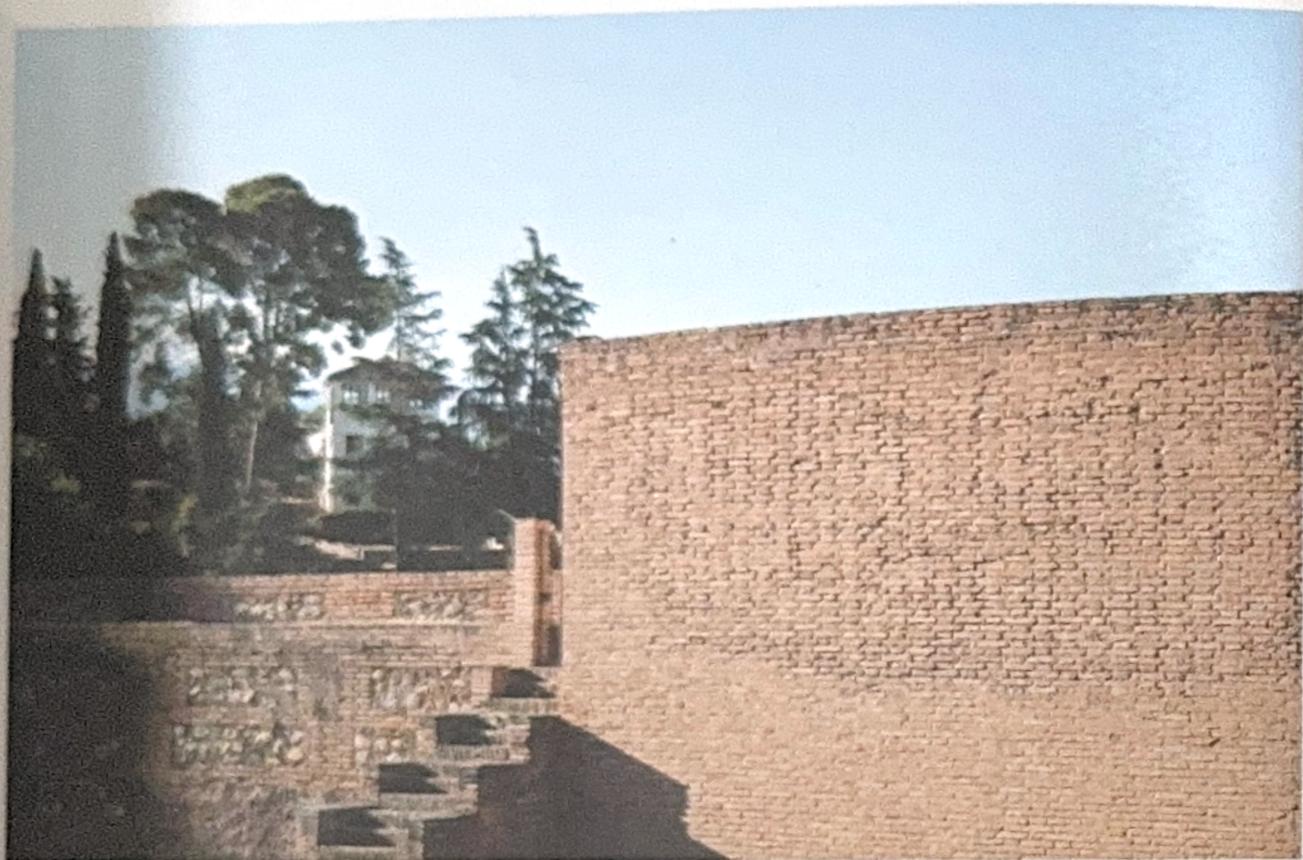
*Size 6 only*

**RND 1:** \*Sc2tog, sc 2\*, rep \*-\* to end. (24 sts dec'd)  
**RND 2:** \*Sc 4, sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* to end. (12 sts dec'd) (60 sts)

*Size 7 only*

**RND 1:** \*Sc2tog, sc 4\*, rep \*-\* to end. (17 sts dec'd)  
**RND 2:** Sc2tog, sc 2, \*sc2tog, sc 3, sc2tog, sc 2\*, rep \*-\* to end. (19 sts dec'd) (66 sts)



*Size 8 only*

**RND 1:** \*Sc2tog, sc 2\*, rep \*-\* to end. (27 sts dec'd)

**RND 2:** Sc 2, sc2tog, \*sc 3, sc2tog, sc 4, sc2tog\*, rep \*-\* to end. (15 sts dec'd) (66 sts)

*Size 9 only*

**RND 1:** \*Sc2tog, sc 2\*, rep \*-\* to end. (28 sts dec'd)

**RND 2:** Sc 3, \*sc2tog, sc 3, sc2tog, sc 2\*, rep \*-\* to end. (18 sts dec'd) (66 sts)

**Cuff**

With US 1 / 2.25 mm DPNs or shorter circular needles, one strand of Yarn A and B held together and with RS facing, pick up and k 56 (56, 56, 60, 60) (60, 66, 66, 66) sts from final row of crochet

**RND 1:** \*K1, p1\* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for 1 x 1 rib until it measures 5.5" / 14 cm. BO in rib.

**NECKBAND**

With US 2.5 / 3 mm DPNs or shorter circular needles, one strand of Yarn A and Yarn B held together, RS facing and starting at top left shoulder, pick up and k 100 (104, 104, 108, 112) (116, 120, 124, 126) sts evenly spaced around neck. PM for BOR.

BO using the I-Cord BO Method.

**CROCHET COLLAR**

With a US C-2 / 2.75 mm crochet hook, ch 194 (198, 202, 210, 214) (218, 226, 234, 246), sl st to first ch being careful not to twist the ch.

**RND 1:** Ch 4, (count as a (dc, ch 1) here and throughout), sk 1, \*dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sk 1\*, rep \*-\* to end, sl st in 3rd ch, sl st into ch 1 sp. [97 (99, 101, 105, 107) (109, 113, 117, 123) dc]

**RND 2:** Ch 4, dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, mb in next ch 1 sp, \* [dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1] 2 times, mb in next ch 1 sp, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* to end, sl st in 3rd ch, sl st into ch 1 sp.

**RND 3:** Ch 1, \*mb in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, [dc in ch 1 sp, ch 1] 2 times\*, rep \*-\* to end, sl st in mb, sl st into ch 1 sp.

**RND 4:** Ch 4, \*dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* 17 (19, 17, 17, 19) (21, 21, 21, 23) more times, dc2tog over next 2 ch 1 sps, [rep \*-\* 17 (17, 18, 19, 19) (19, 20, 21, 22) more times, dc2tog over next 2 ch 1 sps] 4 times, sl st in 3rd ch, sl st into ch 1 sp. [92 (94, 96, 100, 102) (104, 108, 112, 118) dc]

**RND 5:** Ch 4, \*dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* 16 (18, 16, 16, 18) (20, 20, 20, 22) more times, dc2tog over next 2 ch 1 sps, [rep \*-\* 16 (16, 17, 18, 18) (18, 19, 20, 21) more times, dc2tog over next 2 ch 1 sps] 4 times, sl st in 3rd ch, sl st into ch 1 sp. [87 (89, 91, 95, 97) (99, 103, 107, 113) dc]

**RND 6:** Ch 4, \*dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* 15 (17, 15, 15, 17) (19, 19, 19, 21) more times, dc2tog over next 2 ch 1 sps, [rep \*-\* 15 (15, 16, 17, 17) (17, 18, 19, 20) more times, dc2tog over next 2 ch 1 sps] 4 times, sl st in 3rd ch, sl st into ch 1 sp. [82 (84, 86, 90, 92) (94, 98, 102, 108) dc]

**RND 7:** Ch 4, dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, mb in next ch 1 sp, \* [dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1] 2x, mb in next ch 1 sp, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* to end, sl st in 3rd ch, sl st into ch 1 sp.

**RND 8:** Ch 1, \*mb in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, (dc in ch 1 sp, ch 1) 2 times\*, rep \*-\* to end, sl st in mb, sl st into ch 1 sp.

**RND 9:** Ch 4, \*dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* 14 (16, 14, 14, 16) (18, 18, 18, 20) more times, dc2tog over next 2 ch 1 sps, [rep \*-\* 14 (14, 15, 16, 16) (16, 17, 18, 19) more times, dc2tog over next 2 ch 1 sps] 4 times, sl st in 3rd ch, sl st into ch 1 sp. [77 (79, 81, 85, 87) (89, 93, 97, 103) dc]

**RND 10:** Ch 4, \*dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* 13 (15, 13, 13, 15) (17, 17, 17, 19) more times, dc2tog over next 2 ch 1 sps, [rep \*-\* 13 (13, 14, 15, 15) (15, 16, 17, 18) more times, dc2tog over next 2 ch 1 sps] 4 times, sl st in 3rd ch, sl st into ch 1 sp. [72 (74, 76, 80, 82) (84, 88, 92, 98) dc]

**RND 11:** Ch 4, \*dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* 12 (14, 12, 12, 14) (16, 16, 16, 18) more times, dc2tog over next

2 ch 1 sps, [rep \*-\* 12 (12, 13, 14, 14) (14, 15, 16, 17) more times, dc2tog over next 2 ch 1 sps] 4 times, sl st in 3rd ch, sl st into ch 1 sp. [67 (69, 71, 75, 77) (79, 83, 87, 93) dc]

**RND 12:** Ch 4, dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, mb in next ch 1 sp, \* [dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1] 2 times, mb in next ch 1 sp, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* to end, sl st in 3rd ch, sl st into ch 1 sp.

**RND 13:** Ch 1, \*mb in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, (dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 2 times\*, rep \*-\* around, sl st in mb, sl st into ch 1 sp.

**RND 14:** Ch 4, \*dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1\*, rep \*-\* around, sl st in 3rd ch.

Fasten off.

**FINISHING**

Weave in ends. Block to measurements. Attach collar with a crochet slip stitch or wear it as a cowl.
