

Green Mile Scarf



**Knitted scarf with "waves" in 12 rows repeat.
The triangular scarf is knitted from bottom to top.
It is a reversible pattern with increases on each side.**

Material:

Vom Zaubergarten JollyKnits Green Mile, 100% Merino Extra Fine
Hand-wound gradient yarn, 3 ply
Needle 3.0 - 4.5 mm, used here: 3.0 mm
Lots of stitch markers are also needed. (I used 30 pieces)
The correct gauge is not important for this projekt. You can choose any yarn.

Consumption:

500 m - 100 g

Gauge:

28 sts x 32 r = 10 cm/4 inches

Size:

150 x 50 cm

Abbreviations:

KFB	2 stitches in 1 (knit in front and back of 1 stitch)
K	knit
K2tog	knit 2 stitches together
P2tog	purl 2 stitches together
P	purl
PM	place stitchmarker
R	row
rep	repeat
SM	slip stitchmarker to right hand needle
st(s)	stitch(es)
yo	yarn over

Loosely bind off with stitches through back loop:

K2, put stitches back to lefthand needle and knit together through back loop; repeat to end.

OR

Loosely bind off - "Yarn over" bind off metode:

K1, yo, K1, bind off yo and first st together, *yo, K1, bind off yo and st before together* repeat.

Instruction:

Cast on 6 sts and knit one row.

K1, yo, K to last st, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

Repeat this row until 14 sts are on needle.

The stitches between the *---* are knitted only once the first time and are widened once on each side after every 12th row.

Part I with stockinette knitting on front:

R1: K1, yo, PM, *K5, K2tog, K4, KFB; rep from *, end with PM, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

R2: K1, yo, P1, SM, *P5, P2tog, P4, KFB; rep from *, end with SM, P1, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

R3: K1, yo, K2, SM, *K5, K2tog, K4, KFB; rep from *, end with SM, K2, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

R4: K1, yo, P3, SM, *P5, P2tog, P4, KFB; rep from *, end with SM, P3, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

R5: K1, yo, K4, SM, *K5, K2tog, K4, KFB; rep from *, end with SM, K4, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

R6: K1, yo, P5, SM, *P5, P2tog, P4, KFB; rep from *, end with SM, P5, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

Part II with stockinette knitting on back:

R7: K1, yo, P6, SM, *P5, P2tog, P4, KFB; rep from *, end with SM, P6, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

R8: K1, yo, K7, SM, *K5, K2tog, K4, KFB; rep from *, end with SM, K7, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

R9: K1, yo, P8, SM, *P5, P2tog, P4, KFB; rep from *, end with SM, P8, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

R10: K1, yo, K9, SM, *K5, K2tog, K4, KFB; rep from *, end with SM, K9, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

R11: K1, yo, P10, SM, *P5, P2tog, P4, KFB; rep from *, end with SM, P10, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

R12: K1, yo, K11, SM, *K5, K2tog, K4, KFB; rep from *, end with SM, K11, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

Now there are 12 stitches + edge stitch more on the needle on each side and the 12 row pattern starts again.

R1: K1, yo, **PM**, *K5, K2tog, K4, KFB, **SM**; rep from *, end with **PM**, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

R2: K1, yo, P1, **SM**, *P5, P2tog, P4, KFB, **SM**; rep from *, end with **SM**, P1, yo, K1 (+ 2 sts)

Repeat in same manner these 12 rows until the desired size is reached.

Bind off loosely.
