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**HARVEST shawl** english

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
## About design

**HARVEST SHAWL** has a **triangular shape** and is worked from one point to the other by a play of increases and decreases. The patterns are composed of lace stitches and columns of slipped knit stitches.

The size of the shawl is easily modified. Just keep adding more rows for a bigger version.

# MATERIAL

- ★ 1 strand of Knitting for Olive Merino (250m) 4 balls held together with 1 strand of Knitting for Olive Soft Silk Mohair (225m) 4 balls. Sample in Merino cream colorway and Soft Silk Mohair cream colorway
- ★ Circular needle 4 mm with a cable of at least 80cm
- ★ 1 sewing needle
- ★ 1 cable needle
- ★ some markers if you need to separate your work for each motif.



# Infos

The shawl measures approximately 185cm in length and wingspan 70cm.  
These dimensions are given after blocking.

## Gauge

24 sts and 24 rounds of cable/  
lace pattern (needle 4mm)  
after blocking

## Level

Beginner adventurer -  
intermediate

# Stitches

## ssk

Slip 1 st purlwise, slip 1 st knitwise, knit 2 stitches together through their back loops

## K2tog

Knit 2 stitches together

## m1R(make one right)

Make 1 Right: With left needle tip, pick up the running thread between stitch just worked and first stitch on left needle from back to front. Knit the running thread through the front loop. (1 stitch increased; leans right)

Sl1wyif : Slip one stitch purlwise with yarn in front



# INSTRUCTIONS

## SET UP

CO 5 sts with the Long Tail Cast on Method. Do not join in round

**FIRST : sl2wyif, knit to 2 stitches before end, sl2wyif, turn work and start tip :**

**Set-Up Row 1 (RS):** K2, m1R, knit to end (6 stitches)

**Set-Up Row 2 (WS):** sl2wyif, knit to 2 stitches before end, sl2wyif

**Set-Up Row 3 (RS):** K3, m1R, knit to end (7 stitches)

**Set-Up Row 4 (WS):** sl2wyif, knit to 2 stitches before end, sl2wyif

**Set-Up Row 5 (RS):** K3, m1R, knit to end (8 stitches)

**Set-Up Row 6 (WS):** sl2wyif, knit to 2 stitches before end, sl2wyif

## **START PATTERN**

### **SECTION 1**

Note: the first and last 4 stitches of each row are always worked in garter stitch (i.e. knit every row)

**Row 1 (RS):** K4, pm, work Row 1 of Chart A, pm, K4

**Row 2 (WS):** **SL2WYIF**, K2, sm, work Row 2 of Chart A, sm, K2, **SL2WYIF**

continue working **Row 3 to Row 24** of Chart A

At the end of this section you will have 20 stitches on your needles, 4 stitches of garter stitch border on each end, and 12 stitches between markers.

### **SECTION 2**

Work the garter border as established, continue increasing according to Chart B and work Chart B over the rest of the stitches as follows

**Row 1 (RS):** K4, sm, [work Row 1 of Chart B], sm, K4

**Row 2 (WS):** **SL2WYIF**, K2, sm, work Row 2 of Chart B, sm, K2, **SL2WYIF**

continue working **Row 3 to Row 24 of Chart B**

Repeat Rows 1-24 another 10 more times and repeat rows 1 to 4 of chart B. At the end of this section you have 154 sts and 12 full pattern repeats on your needles (4 sts for each garter stitch border, 146 sts in pattern, 12 sts for each pattern repeat).

### **SECTION 3 - MIDDLE POINT**

Work the garter border as established, and now decreasing 1st at right side and work the Chart C over the rest of the stitches as follows:

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, sm, ssk, rm \*[work Row 1 of Chart C], \* repeat to last 4 sts, sm, K4

**Row 2 (WS):** **SL2WYIF**, K2, sm, \*[work Row 2 of Chart C] repeat from\* until 1 stitch before marker, K1, sm, K1, **SL2WYIF**

continue working **Row 3 to Row 24 of Chart C** with decreasing every RS row.

**Repeat Rows 1-24 11 more times** or until you have **20 sts** on your needles (4sts for each garter stitch border, 12 sts in pattern).

Continue increasing with working rows 1 to 24 of Chart D

## **SECTION 4 - END**

At the end of this section you have 8 stitches, now continue as follows:

R1 (RS): K4, rm, ssk, rm, K2 (7 stitches)

R2 (WS) : **SL2WYIF**, K3, **SL2WYIF**

R3 (RS) : K3, ssk, K2 (6 stitches)

R4 (WS): **SL2WYIF**, K2, **SL2WYIF**

R5 (RS): K2, ssk, K2


R6 (WS): **SL2WYIF**, K1, **SL2WYIF**

R7 (RS): bind off all stitches


## **FINISHING**

Weave in all yarn ends neatly. Wet block to measurements

# CHART A - INCREASE




## CHART B - MAIN CHART + increasing




- RS: endroit - knit

## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>BO</b>	Bind off
<b>CO</b>	Cast off
<b>CN</b>	Cable Needle
<b>est</b>	Established
<b>K/k</b>	Knit
<b>K2tog</b>	Knit 2 stitches on L needle together (1 stitch decreased; leans right)
<b>L</b>	Left
<b>m</b>	Marker
<b>m1L</b>	Make one new stitch, left-leaning
<b>p</b>	Purl
<b>pm</b>	Place a marker
<b>R</b>	Right
<b>RS</b>	Rigth Side
<b>sl2wyif</b>	slip 2 stitches <u>purlwise</u> with yarn in front
<b>sm</b>	Slip marker
<b>st/sts</b>	Stitch/Stitches
<b>WS</b>	Wrong Side
<b>yo</b>	Yarn over
<b>*</b>	Repeat from here



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
