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Construction:

The Hailey sweater is knitted by starting at the back from the top down to the base of the armholes. Then, both fronts are picked up and knitted separately, working from the top down to the edge of front neck. After joining both pieces, the front is worked to the base of the armhole, and then the front and back are joined and knitted in the round down to the hem. Pick up and knit for the sleeves.

The chart on page 14~15 only shows the main pattern section. Please follow the written instructions while knitting.

Gauge / With 4 mm (US 6) needle :

17 sts x 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm / 4 x 4" in stockinette stitch after blocking.


20 sts x 25 rows = 10 x 10 cm / 4 x 4" in pattern stitch after blocking. (The gauge mentioned here is based on the finished garment's body circumference and the total number of stitches)

Recommended ease : 0~40 cm / 0~15.75"

To pick your size, I recommend making a swatch in stockinette stitch with your yarn, then check your gauge and adjust needle size accordingly. Measure around your full bust, add your desired ease, then choose the closest size from the finished bust circumference.

Size:

1 (2, 3, 4) The sample in dark blue is size 1, and the light blue is size 2, both with 33 cm/13" positive ease.

Yarn:

Dark blue: De Rerum Natura, Ulysse/sport, color: baleine bleue, 100% Merino, 185m/202yd per 50g, 5 (6.5, 8, 9.5) Balls. Approx. 925 (1202, 1480, 1757) m/1011 (1314, 1618, 1921)yds

Light blue: De Rerum Natura, Robinson/worsted, color: muscari, 70% Merino, 30% Cotton, 250m/270yd per 100g, 4 (5, 6, 7) Balls. Approx. 1000 (1250, 1500, 1750) m/1094 (1367, 1640, 1913)yds

(You may need more yardage when extending the length of body; My light blue version is knitted in size 2, but since I shortened the body length, I only used 4 balls of yarn.)

Needles:

4 mm (US 6) for the body. Use circular needles ranging from 60~120 cm according to the requirements of each section.

3.5 mm (US 4) for the neckband, hem and cuffs. DPNs or preferred needles (Magic Loop) for small circumference knitting.

Other Materials:

Stitch markers, removable markers, cable needle, waste yarn.

Instructions

Back

With 4 mm (US 6) needle, long tail cast on 43 sts for all sizes.

Next Row (WS): p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 20 (WS): Same as Row 14. TS: 83

Row 21 (RS): k2, p1, k1, M1L, k2, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to M, SM, p2, k4, p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p2, k4, p1, k4, p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p2, k4, p2, SM, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 6 sts, k2, M1R, k1, p1, k2. TS: 85

Row 22 (WS): Same as Row 14. TS: 87

Row 23 (RS): k2, p1, k1, M1L, k4, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to M, SM, p2, 2/2 LC, p2, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, ssk, p2, 2/2 LC, p1, 2/2 RC, p2, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, ssk, p2, 2/2 RC, p2, SM, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 8 sts, k4, M1R, k1, p1, k2. TS: 89

Row 24 (WS): Same as Row 14. TS: 91

Rep Rows 13~24, 1 (1, 2, 3) more times, until you have completed Row 36 (36, 48, 60).
TS: 115 (115, 139, 163)

Note: Before working on Section 2, use removable stitch markers to mark both ends of the pieces at Row 36 (36, 48, 60). You can mark it in a way that's convenient for yourself. This is for identification purposes when picking up the front pieces later.

Section 2: Continue working on the Back piece

Note: If needed, you may refer to Chart C for the following Rows 1~12.

Row 1 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to M, SM, p2, k4, p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p2, k4, p1, k4, p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p2, k4, p2, SM, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.

Row 2 (WS): p2, k1, p to M, SM, k2, p4, k2, p9, k2, p4, k1, p4, k2, p9, k2, p4, k2, SM, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 3 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to M, SM, p2, 2/2 LC, p2, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, ssk, p2, 2/2 LC, p1, 2/2 RC, p2, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, ssk, p2, 2/2 RC, p2, SM, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.

Row 4 (WS): Same as Row 2.

Row 5 (RS): Same as Row 1.

Row 6 (WS): Same as Row 2.

Row 7 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to M, SM, p2, 2/2 LC, p2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, s2kp, yo, k1, yo, ssk, p2, 2/2 LC, p1, 2/2 RC, p2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, s2kp, yo, k1, yo, ssk, p2, 2/2 RC, p2, SM, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.

Row 8 (WS): Same as Row 2.


Row 9 (RS): Same as Row 1.

Row 10 (WS): Same as Row 2.

Row 11 (RS): Same as Row 3.

Row 12 (WS): Same as Row 2.

Rep Rows 1~12, 2 (3, 3, 3) more times, until you have completed Row 36 (48, 48, 48).
Break the working yarn.



Left Front

With 4 mm (US 6) needle and right side facing, as shown in the schematic above, pick up and knit 38 (38, 50, 62) sts for the Left Front. (Pick up and knit one stitch from each row, includes the CO row, the next row, and the rows in Section 1 combined)

Next Row (WS): p4, k1, p to end.

Note: If needed, you may refer to Chart D for the following Rows 1~44.

Row 1 (RS): k2, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 6 sts, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, k1.
TS: 37 (37, 49, 61)

Row 2 (WS): p3, k1, p to end.

Row 3 (RS): k2, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 5 sts, k1, p1, k2tog, k1.
TS: 36 (36, 48, 60)

Row 4 (WS): p2, k1, p to end.

Row 5 (RS): k2, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.

Row 6 (WS): p2, k1, p to end.

Row 7 (RS): k2, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.

Row 8 (WS): p2, k1, p to end.

Rep Rows 5~8, 6 more times, until you have completed Row 32.

Row 33 (RS): k2, M1L, PM, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.
TS: 37 (37, 49, 61)

Row 34 (WS): p2, k1, p to M, SM, k1, p2.

Row 35 (RS): k2, M1L, p1, SM, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.
TS: 38 (38, 50, 62)

Row 36 (WS): p2, k1, p to M, SM, k2, p2.

Row 37 (RS): k2, M1L, p2, SM, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.
TS: 39 (39, 51, 63)

Row 38 (WS): p2, k1, p to M, SM, k2, p3.

Row 39 (RS): k2, M1L, k1, p2, SM, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.
TS: 40 (40, 52, 64)

Row 40 (WS): p2, k1, p to M, SM, k2, p4.

Row 41 (RS): k2, M1L, k2, p2, SM, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.
TS: 41 (41, 53, 65)

Row 42 (WS): p2, k1, p to M, SM, k2, p3, M1pL, p2. TS: 42 (42, 54, 66)

Row 43 (RS): k2, M1L, k4, p2, SM, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.
TS: 43 (43, 55, 67)

Row 44 (WS): p2, k1, p to M, SM, k2, p4, k1, M1pL, p2. TS: 44 (44, 56, 68)

Break the working yarn and leave the sts on hold, then proceed to do the Right Front.

Right Front

With 4 mm (US 6) needle and right side facing, as shown in the schematic on page 7, pick up and knit 38 (38, 50, 62) sts for Right Front. (Pick up and knit one stitch from each row, includes the CO row, the next row, and the rows in Section 1 combined)

Next Row (WS): p to last 5 sts, k1, p4.

Note: If needed, you may refer to Chart E for the following Rows 1~44.

Row 1 (RS): k1, ssk, k1, p1, k1, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 2 sts, k2.
TS: 37 (37, 49, 61)

Row 2 (WS): p to last 4 sts, k1, p3.

Row 3 (RS): k1, ssk, p1, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 2 sts, k2.
TS: 36 (36, 48, 60)

Row 4 (WS): p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 5 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 6 (WS): p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 7 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 8 (WS): p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Rep Rows 5~8, 6 more times, until you have completed Row 32.

Row 33 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 2 sts, **PM**, M1R, k2.
TS: 37 (37, 49, 61)

Row 34 (WS): p2, k1, **SM**, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 35 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to M, **SM**, p1, M1R, k2.
TS: 38 (38, 50, 62)

Row 36 (WS): p2, k2, **SM**, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 37 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to M, **SM**, p2, M1R, k2.
TS: 39 (39, 51, 63)

Row 38 (WS): p3, k2, **SM**, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 39 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to M, **SM**, p2, k1, M1R, k2.
TS: 40 (40, 52, 64)

Row 40 (WS): p4, k2, **SM**, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 41 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to M, **SM**, p2, k2, M1R, k2.
TS: 41 (41, 53, 65)

Row 42 (WS): p2, M1pR, p3, k2, **SM**, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2. TS: 42 (42, 54, 66)

Row 43 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to M, **SM**, p2, k4, M1R, k2.
TS: 43 (43, 55, 67)

Row 44 (WS): p2, M1pR, k1, p4, k2, **SM**, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2. TS: 44 (44, 56, 68)

Continue to the next row of Right Front then join the Left Front as follows:

Join Row(RS): k2, p1, k1, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to M, **SM**, p2, k4, p2, k2, use backwards loop cast on method, CO 27 sts, then join the Left Front piece: k2, p2, k4, p2, **SM**, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2. TS: 115 (115, 139, 163)

Next Row(WS): p2, k1, p to M, **SM**, k2, p4, k2, p31, k2, p4, k2, **SM**, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Next Row(RS): k2, p1, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to M, **SM**, p2, 2/2 LC, p2, k9, p2, k4, p1, k4, p2, k9, p2, 2/2 RC, p2, **SM**, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.

Next Row(WS): p2, k1, p to M, **SM**, k2, p4, k2, p9, k2, p4, k1, p4, k2, p9, k2, p4, k2, **SM**, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Continue working on the front piece: (you may refer to Chart C for the following Rows 1~12)

Row 1 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to M, **SM**, p2, k4, p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p2, k4, p1, k4, p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p2, k4, p2, **SM**, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.

- Row 2 (WS): p2, k1, p to M, SM, k2, p4, k2, p9, k2, p4, k1, p4, k2, p9, k2, p4, k2, SM, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.
- Row 3 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to M, SM, p2, 2/2 LC, p2, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, ssk, p2, 2/2 LC, p1, 2/2 RC, p2, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, ssk, p2, 2/2 RC, p2, SM, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.
- Row 4 (WS): Same as Row 2.
- Row 5 (RS): Same as Row 1.
- Row 6 (WS): Same as Row 2.
- Row 7 (RS): k2, p1, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to M, SM, p2, 2/2 LC, p2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, s2kp, yo, k1, yo, ssk, p2, 2/2 LC, p1, 2/2 RC, p2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, s2kp, yo, k1, yo, ssk, p2, 2/2 RC, p2, SM, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.
- Row 8 (WS): Same as Row 2.
- Row 9 (RS): Same as Row 1.
- Row 10 (WS): Same as Row 2.
- Row 11 (RS): Same as Row 3.
- Row 12 (WS): Same as Row 2.

Rep Rows 1~12, 2 (3, 4, 5) more times, until you have completed Row 36 (48, 60, 72).

Continue to next row of the Front then join the Back for working in the round.

- Joining Rnd: *k2, p1, k1, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to M, SM, p2, k4, p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p2, k4, p1, k4, p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p2, k4, p2, SM, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2**, use backwards loop cast on method, CO 1 st for the Left-underarm, PM, then join the Back piece: rep *~**, use backwards loop cast on method, CO 1 st for the Right-underarm, PM for BOR. TS: 232 (232, 280, 328)
- Next Rnd: *k2, p1, k to M, SM, p2, k4, p2, k9, p2, k4, p1, k4, p2, k9, p2, k4, p2, SM, k to 4 sts before M, p1, k2, p1**, SM, rep *~**, SM(BOR).

Body

- Rnd 1: *k2, p1, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to M, SM, p2, 2/2 LC, p2, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, ssk, p2, 2/2 LC, p1, 2/2 RC, p2, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, ssk, p2, 2/2 RC, p2, SM, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to 5 sts before M, k1, p1, k2, p1**, SM, rep *~**, SM(BOR).
- Rnd 2: *k2, p1, k to M, SM, p2, k4, p2, k9, p2, k4, p1, k4, p2, k9, p2, k4, p2, SM, k to 4 sts before M, p1, k2, p1**, SM, rep *~**, SM(BOR).

- Rnd 3: *k2, p1, k1, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to M, SM, p2, k4, p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p2, k4, p1, k4, p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p2, k4, p2, SM, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to 5 sts before M, k1, p1, k2, p1**, SM, rep *~**, SM(BOR).
- Rnd 4: Same as Rnd 2.
- Rnd 5: *k2, p1, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to M, SM, p2, 2/2 LC, p2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, s2kp, yo, k1, yo, ssk, p2, 2/2 LC, p1, 2/2 RC, p2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, s2kp, yo, k1, yo, ssk, p2, 2/2 RC, p2, SM, [k3, yo, s2kp, yo] rep to 5 sts before M, k1, p1, k2, p1**, SM, rep *~**, SM(BOR).
- Rnd 6: Same as Rnd 2.
- Rnd 7: Same as Rnd 3.
- Rnd 8: Same as Rnd 2.
- Rnd 9: Same as Rnd 1.
- Rnd 10: Same as Rnd 2.
- Rnd 11: Same as Rnd 3.
- Rnd 12: Same as Rnd 2.

Rep Rnds 1~12, 2 more times. (Or repeat until 3 cm/1.25" less than your desired length; My light blue sample only repeated once)

Hem

Switch to 3.5 mm (US 4) needle:

- Rnd 1: *k2, p1, k2tog, k1, p1, [k2, p1] rep to M, RM, [k2, p1] rep to 2 sts before M, k2, RM, p1, [k2, p1] rep to 7 sts before M, k1, k2tog, p1, k2, p1**, RM, rep *~**, SM(BOR). TS: 228 (228, 276, 324)
- Rnd 2: [k2, p1] rep to end.

Rep last Rnd, until the ribbing measures approx. 3 cm/1.25".
BO in pattern. (Or use your preferred BO method)

Neckband

With 3.5 mm (US 4) needle and right side facing, beginning at the back neck CO edge, pick up and knit 41 sts from the CO edge of the back neck, pick up and knit 34 sts down the neckline edge (3 sts for every 4 rows evenly), pick up and knit 27 sts from the front neck CO edge, pick up and knit 34 sts up the neckline edge (3 sts for every 4 rows evenly), PM for BOR.

TS: 136

Next Rnd: k2tog, k1, p1, [k2, p1] rep to end. TS: 135

Working in [k2, p1], until the ribbing measures approx. 3 cm/1.25".
BO in pattern. (Or use your preferred BO method)

Sleeves (Both alike)

With 4 mm (US 6) needle and right side facing, beginning at the underarm, pick up and knit 1 st from the CO edge of the underarm, then pick up and knit 93 (111, 117, 129) sts (3 sts for every 4 rows) around the armhole edge, you can make slight adjustments while picking up stitches to match the stitch count, **PM** for BOR.

TS: 94 (112, 118, 130)

Next Rnd: p1, k to end.

Rnd 1: p1, k2tog, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 6 sts, yo, s2kp, yo, k1, ssk.
TS: 92 (110, 116, 128)

Rnd 2: p1, k to end.

And all the even Rnds are the same as Rnd 2.

Rnd 3: p1, k5, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 2 sts, k2.

Rnd 5: p1, k2tog, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 5 sts, yo, s2kp, yo, ssk.
TS: 90 (108, 114, 126)

Rnd 7: p1, k4, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 1 st, k1.

Rnd 9: p1, k2tog, k5, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 4 sts, k2, ssk.
TS: 88 (106, 112, 124)

Rnd 11: p1, k3, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to end.

Rnd 13: p1, k2tog, k4, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 3 sts, k1, ssk.
TS: 86 (104, 110, 122)

Rnd 15: p1, k2, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 5 sts, yo, s2kp, yo, k2.

Rnd 17: p1, k2tog, k3, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 2 sts, ssk.
TS: 84 (102, 108, 120)

Rnd 19: p1, k1, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 4 sts, yo, s2kp, yo, k1.

Rnd 21: p1, k2tog, k2, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 7 sts, yo, s2kp, yo, k2, ssk.
TS: 82 (100, 106, 118)

Rnd 23: p1, k6, [yo, s2kp, yo, k3] rep to last 3 sts, k3.

Rnd 24: Same as Rnd 2.

Rep Rnds 1~24, 3 more times, then rep Rnds 1~8, one more time, until you have completed Rnd 104. (Or repeat until 3 cm/1.25" less than your desired length) TS: 42 (60, 66, 78)

Cuffs (Both alike)

Switch to 3.5 mm (US 4) needle:

Rnd 1: **Size 1:** [p1, k2] rep to end.

Size 2: p1, [k2tog, k1, p1] rep to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Sizes 3, 4: [p1, k2] 2 times, [p1, k2tog, k1] rep to end.

TS: 42 (45, 51, 60)

Rnd 2: [p1, k2] rep to end.

Rep last Rnd, until the ribbing measures approx. 3 cm/1.25".
BO in pattern. (Or use your preferred BO method)

Finishing

Weave in the ends and wet block to measurements.









