

SHIBA DOG HEAD PATTERN

(for keychain/ bag charm)

BY HAINCHAN ®



MATERIALS

- I used Schachenmayr Catania, Scheepjes Maxi Sweet Treat
- Crochet hook
- Black embroidery thread
- Black safety eyes
- Fiberfill
- Yarn needle
- Stitch marker
- Pins

ABBREVIATIONS

- MR - magic ring
- ch - chain
- slst - slip stitch
- sc - single Crochet
- hdc - half double crochet
- inc - increase (2 single crochet in 1 stitch)
- dec - decrease (Use the invisible decrease)
- BLO - back loops only

- Color A : Orange or Yellow
- Color B : White

SCHEEPIES MAXI SWEET TREAT (25g ~ 140m)

- White : 105
- Black : 110
- Yellow : 383
- Bowtie: 388, 391
- Hook size 1mm
- Black safety eyes 3mm
- Height approx (include the ear) : 6cm ~ 2.36 inch

SCHACHENMAYR CATANIA (50g ~ 125m)

- White : 105
- Black : 110
- Orange : 431
- Hook size 2mm
- Black safety eyes 5mm
- Height approx : 5cm ~ 1.97 inch



EARS Make 2 in color A

Work in a continuous spiral

Rnd 1: 4 sc into MR (4)

Rnd 2: 4 inc (8)


Rnd 3: (3 sc, inc) x 2 (10)

Rnd 4: (4 sc, inc) x 2, (12)

Rnd 5: (5 sc, inc) x 2, (14)

Do not stuff the ears.

Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.



SNOUT Use color B



Work in a continuous spiral

Rnd 1: 6 sc in MR, sl st, ch 1 (6)

Rnd 2: 6 inc, sl st (12)

Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.

Embroider the snout with black embroidery thread



HEAD Use color A and B

Learn the technique of crocheting on both sides of the chain through our tutorial video.

Start with color A:

Make a chain of ch 9, start in the second ch from hook. Work in a continuous spiral

Rnd 1. Inc, 6 sc, 4 sc into the last stitch, work on a long the other side: 6 sc, inc (20)

Rnd 2. 2 inc, 6 sc, 4 inc, 6 sc, 2 inc (28)

Rnd 3. inc, 1 sc, inc, 8 sc, inc, 1 sc, 2 inc, 1 sc, inc, 8 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc (36)

Rnd 4. 2 sc, inc, 12 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, 12 sc, inc, 2 sc (40)

Rnd 5. 2 sc, inc, 14 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, 14 sc, inc, 2 sc (44)

Rnd 6. 44 sc (44)

Rnd 7. 2 sc, inc, 16 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, 16 sc, inc, 2 sc (48)

Rnd 8. 48 sc (48)

Rnd 9. 3 sc, inc, 16 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 16 sc, inc, 3 sc (52)

Rnd 10. [Color A] 7 sc, [Color B] 4 sc, [Color A] 5 sc, [Color B] 4 sc, [Color A] 32 sc (52)

Rnd 11. [Color A] 6 sc, [Color B] 6 sc, [Color A] 3 sc, [Color B] 6 sc, [Color A] 31 sc (52)

Rnd 12. [Color A] 3 sc, inc, 1 sc [Color B] 8 sc, [Color A] 1 sc, [Color B] 8 sc, [Color A] inc, 6 sc, inc, 18 sc, inc, 3 sc (56)

Rnd 13. [Color A] 4 sc, [Color B] 21 sc, [Color A] 31 sc (56)

Rnd 14. [Color A] 2 sc, [Color B] 25 sc, [Color A] 29 sc (56)

Rnd 15. [Color B] 3sc, inc, 20 sc, inc, 4 sc, [Color A] 2 sc, inc, 20 sc, inc, 3 sc (60)

Rnd 16-17. (2 rounds) [Color B] 31 sc, [Color A] 29 sc (60)

Rnd 18. [Color B] (8 sc, dec)x 3, 1 sc, [Color A] 7 sc, dec, (8 sc, dec) x 2 (54)

Rnd 19. [Color B] (7 sc, dec)x 3, 1 sc, [Color A] 6 sc, dec, (7 sc, dec) x 2 (48)

Rnd 20. [Color B] (2 sc, dec)x 6, 1 sc, [Color A] 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec) x 5 (36)

Rnd 21. [Color B] (4 sc, dec)x 3, 1 sc, [Color A] 3 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec) x 2 (30)

Rnd 22. [Color B] (3 sc, dec)x 3, 1 sc, [Color A] 2 sc, dec, (3 sc, dec) x 2 (24)

IF YOU WANT TO ATTACH THE BODY, THE HEAD WILL BE COMPLETED AT RND 22.

Insert the 5mm safety eyes between round 12 and 13 with 9sts apart.

Stuff the head with fiberfill.

Change to color A:

Rnd 23: (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)

Rnd 24: (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12)

Rnd 25: 6 dec (6)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Use needle pull the yarn through frontloops of all remaining stitches.



Cut a long piece of white yarn (or the same yarn color you used for crocheting the dog face), thread the yarn needle.

Insert the needle into point 1, pull it out from point 2, insert the needle into point 3 and pull it out from point 4.

Do the same with the second eyes: pull the needle out from point 4, insert the needle into point 5 and pull it out from point 6. (Pic 1)

Pull both tails out gently until you get the result you need, hide the tails inside the head.



Sew the snout on the head between round 13 and 16.

Sew the ears on top of the head.

MAKE UP: Use pink blush for the cheek.



Attach the yarn to the top of the head, make a chain of ch 6 and reconnected it to the head with slip stitch, fasten off and weave in ends.



BODY Use color A

Work in a continuous spiral

- Rnd 1. 8 sc into MR (8)
- Rnd 2. 8 inc (16)
- Rnd 3. (1 sc, inc) x 8 (24)
- Rnd 4. (2 sc, inc) x 8 (32)
- Rnd 5. (3 sc, inc) x 8 (40)
- Rnd 6. BLO 40 sc (40)
- Rnd 7-10. (4 rounds) 40 sc (40)
- Rnd 11. (8 sc, dec) x 4 (36)
- Rnd 12. 36 sc (36)
- Rnd 13. (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)
- Rnd 14. 30 sc (30)
- Rnd 15. (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)
- Rnd 16. 24 sc (24)

Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.

Sew the head to the body.



BOWTIE (Work in a round, color of your choice)






Make a chain of ch 20, make sure your chain isn't twisted. Insert the hook in the first chain stitch and join with a sl st, ch 1

- Rnd 1. 20 hdc, slst, ch 1 (20)
- Rnd 2. BLO: 20 hdc, slst, ch1 (20)
- Rnd 3. BLO: 20 hdc, slst to close the round (20)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail .

You will make the bowtie by wrapping the yarn tail around the middle of the rectangle and then securing it with a knot.

Now it's ready to be sewn on the neck.
