

Halloween Death Doll

The toy is knitted round and that is why the pattern is recommended for *Advanced Beginner Knitters*.

Toy related knit stitch.

The finished cat doll is approximately 4,33" (11 cm) tall.

Abbreviations

K = knit
P = purl
Sts = stitches
Kfb = knit into front and back of stitch
K2tog = knit 2 together
P2tog = purl 2 together
CO = cast on
RND = round

Materials needed

- 4 double-pointed needles in a size suitable for the yarn weight you are using. I recommend using needles a size or two smaller than the yarn calls for, to produce a firm fabric. I used Needles size 2½ (3mm)

- White colored yarn for head. I used ‘Nako baby. Hoş geldin’ /100gr – 230m; 60% bambu, 40% Polyamid /
- Black yarn for dress. I used ‘ Nako Vison ‘ / 100 gr – 195 m; 100% Acrylic /
- Black yarn for hair
- Toy stuffing
- Yarn needle
- Stitch holder
- 2 plastic eyes
- Wire for arms

All time I am working in the round. This help avoids the ugly seams .

Head

Knitted with white yarn.

Cast on 6 stitches. Distribute among 3 needles and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker.

<i>RND1: Kfb</i>	<i>(6times)</i>	<i>(12 sts)</i>
<i>RND2: Kfb, K1</i>	<i>(6times)</i>	<i>(18 sts)</i>
<i>RND3: Kfb, K2</i>	<i>(6times)</i>	<i>(24 sts)</i>
<i>RND4:Kfb, K3</i>	<i>(6times)</i>	<i>(30 sts)</i>
<i>RND5:Kfb, K4</i>	<i>(6times)</i>	<i>(36 sts)</i>
<i>RND6:Kfb, K5</i>	<i>(6times)</i>	<i>(42 sts)</i>
<i>RND7-19: 13 Rnds K all</i>		<i>(42 sts)</i>
<i>RND20: K2tog, K5</i>	<i>(6times)</i>	<i>(36 sts)</i>
<i>RND21: K2tog, K4</i>	<i>(6times)</i>	<i>(30 sts)</i>
<i>RND22: K2tog, K3</i>	<i>(6times)</i>	<i>(24 sts)</i>
<i>Work decrease rounds, adding stuffing as you go</i>		
<i>RND23: K2tog, K2</i>	<i>(6times)</i>	<i>(18 sts)</i>
<i>RND24: K2tog, K1</i>	<i>(6times)</i>	<i>(12 sts)</i>
<i>RND25: K2tog</i>	<i>(6times)</i>	<i>(6 sts)</i>

Cut yarn and thread through six remaining sts (add more stuffing if required).



Weave in ends.

Body

Knitted with black yarn.

Cast on 6 stitches. Distribute among 3 needles and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker.

RND1: Kfb (6times) (12 sts)

RND2: Kfb, K1 (6times) (18 sts)

RND3: Kfb, K7, Kfb (2times) (22 sts)

RND4: P all (22 sts)

RND5-8: 4Rnds K all (22 sts)

RND9: K2tog, K7, K2tog (2times) (18 sts)

RND10-12: 3 Rnds K all (18 sts)

RND13: K2tog, K5, K2tog (2times) (14 sts)

RND14-17: 4 Rnds K all (14 sts)

Work decrease rounds, adding stuffing as you go

RND18: K2tog, K3, K2tog (2times) (10 sts)

RND19-21: 3 Rnds K all (10 sts)

RND22: (K2tog) 5times (5 sts)



Cut yarn and thread through remaining 5 sts (add more stuffing if required).
Weave in ends.

Hood.

Knitted with black yarn.



Cast on 6 stitches. Distribute among 3 needles and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker.

RND1: Kfb	(6times)	(12 sts)
RND2: Kfb, K1	(6times)	(18 sts)
RND3: Kfb, K2	(6times)	(24 sts)
RND4:Kfb, K3	(6times)	(30 sts)
RND5:Kfb, K4	(6times)	(36 sts)
RND6:Kfb, K5	(6times)	(42 sts)
RND7:Kfb, K6	(6times)	(48 sts)
RND8:Kfb, K7	(6times)	(54 sts)
RND9:Kfb, K8	(6times)	(60 sts)
RND10-20: 11 Rnds K all		(60 sts)

Now we starting knit flat with 2 needles

Row21: P all		(60 sts)
Row22: K all		(60 sts)
Row23: P all		(60 sts)
Row24: K all		(60 sts)
Row25: P all		(60 sts)
Row26: Kfb, K9	(6times)	(66 sts)
Row27: P all		(66 sts)
Row28: Kfb, K64, Kfb		(68 sts)

Row29: K all (68 sts)

Row30: Kfb, K64, Kfb (70 sts)

Row31: K all (70 sts)

Bind off.

Arms (make2 pieces)

Knitted with white yarn.



Cast on 5 stitches. Distribute among 3 needles and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker.

RND1-14: 14 Rnds K all (5 sts)

Do not stuff.

Cut yarn and thread through 5 remaining sts.
Weave in ends.

Sleeves. (make2 pieces)

Knitted with black yarn.



Cast on 6 stitches. Distribute among 3 needles and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker.

RND1-4: 4 Rnds K all (6 sts)

RND5: Kfb, K1 (3times) (9 sts)

RND6-7: 2Rnds K all (9 sts)

RND8: Kfb, K2 (3times) (12 sts)

RND9-10: 2Rnds K all (12 sts)

RND11: Kfb, K3 (3times) (15 sts)

RND12-14: 3Rnds K all (15 sts)

Bind off.


FINISHING DOLL.

Fixing head and body.

Use a long needle with a yard of strong thread, doubled and knotted at the end.

Start at the underside of the body. Push the needle thru to the outside of the torso.

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Push the needle thru the head and out on the opposite side. Go back thru to the inside of the head taking a small stitch on the outside. Repeat this procedure thru the head and body gently pulling the thread to tighten the joint with each pass thru, one or two more times, but do not indent too deeply. End on the underside of the body. Bury the thread into the body.



Embroider the doll hair like this.





Take 20 cm of wire.



Insert wire into the body at the place for arms.



Fold the wire in half as at the picture.



Pull the arms onto the wire.



And sew on the knitted arms to the body.

Dress the sleeve onto the arm.



And sew on it to the body.



Sew on hood to the neckline of the body.



Glue the plastic eyes to the head.

Apply pink blush .



That's all 8)))
