Pica Pau Cotton 8/7 Nude

2 skeins of color 09
1 skein of color 01

Pica Pau Cotton 8/7

1 skein of color 08
1 skein of color 22
1 skein of color 27
1 skein of color 28
1 skein of color 32
1 skein of color 37

Crochet hook 2.75 mm / US C2
2 safety eyes 8 mm
Stuffing
Tapestry needle
Stitch marker

YARN QUALITY

Pica Pau Cotton 8/7 Nude, Hobbii

100% Cotton
50 g (1.75 oz) = 90 m (98 yds)

Pica Pau Cotton 8/7, Hobbii

100% Cotton
50 g (1.75 oz) = 90 m (98 yds)

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: Approx. 22 cm / 8.6"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Harmony Pig is an intermediate project, worked in a continuous spiral. To keep track of the rounds you may use a stitch marker or safety pin to mark the beginning of a round.

The head and the body are worked in a single piece. Harmony Pig also has 2 accessories: a hat and a skirt.

Remember that it's always advisable to give the entire pattern a read before starting crocheting and, most importantly, be patient with yourself!

ABBREVIATIONS

US terms

mr = magic ring

st = stitch

Rnd = round

slst = slip stitch

BLO = back loop only

FLO = front loop only

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dec = decrease (2 sts together)

inc = increase (2 sts in the same st)

5-dc-bobble = 5 double crochet bobble stitch

INFO AND TIPS

Head, body and legs are worked in one piece.

CHEEKS (make 2)

Work with Pica Pau Cotton color (08)

Rnd 1: 8 sc in mr [8]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

SNOUT

Start with Pica Pau Cotton color (08)

Rnd 1: start 8 sc in a mr [8]

Rnd 2: inc in all 8 st [16]

Change to Pica Pau Cotton Nude color (09)

Rnd 3: BLO, sc in all 16 st [16]

Rnd 4-6: sc in all 16 st [16]

Rnd 7: 4 sc, (inc in next st, sc in next st) 3 times, inc in next st, sc in next 5 st [20]

Rnd 8: sc in all 20 st [20]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Embroider the nose and mouth with Pica Pau Cotton color (37).

Stuff the snout lightly with fiberfill.

HEAD AND BODY

Start with Pica Pau Cotton Nude color (09)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6)

Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Continue working with alternating yarns, Pica Pau Cotton Nude color (09) and Pica Pau Cotton color (32). The color you work with is indicated before each part.

Rnd 3: (*color 09*) (sc in next st, inc in next st) 2 times, (*color 32*) sc in next st, inc in next st, (*color 09*) (sc in next st, inc in next st) 3 times [18]

Rnd 4: (*color 09*) (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) 2 times, (*color 32*) sc in next 2 st, inc in next st, sc in next st (*color 09*) sc in next st, inc in next st, (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) 2 times [24]

Rnd 5: (*color 09*) (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st) 2 times, (*color 32*) sc in next 3 st, inc in next st, sc in next st (*color 09*) sc in next 2 st, inc in next st, (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st) 2 times [30]

Rnd 6: (*color 09*) (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) 2 times, (*color 32*) sc in next 4 st, inc in next st, sc in next st (*color 09*) sc in next 3 st, inc in next st, (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) 2 times [36]

Rnd 7: (*color 09*) (sc in next 5 st, inc in next st) 2 times, (*color 32*) sc in next 5 st, inc in next st, sc in next st (*color 09*) sc in next 4 st, inc in next st, (sc in next 5 st, inc in next st) 2 times [42]

Rnd 8: (*color 09*) (sc in next 6 st, inc in next st) 2 times, (*color 32*) sc in next 6 st, inc in next st, sc in next st (*color 09*) sc in next 5 st, inc in next st, (sc in next 6 st, inc in next st) 2 times [48]

Rnd 9-11: (*color 09*) sc in next 16 st, (*color 32*) sc in next 9 st (*color 09*) sc in next 23 st [48]

Rnd 12: (*color 09*) sc in next 17 st, (*color 32*) sc in next 7 st (*color 09*) sc in next 24 st [48]

Rnd 13: (*color 09*) sc in next 18 st, (*color 32*) sc in next 3 st (*color 09*) sc in next 25 st [48]

Continue in Pica Pau Cotton Nude color (09)

Rnd 14-19: sc in all 48 st [48]

Sew the snout between rounds 11 and 18. Take the eucalyptus (*color 32*) spot on the head into account when sewing the snout. Insert the safety eyes between rounds 15 and 16, about 2 stitches away from the snout. Sew the cheeks below the safety eyes.

Continue in a stripe pattern, changing color every round, alternating Pica Pau Cotton color (27) and Pica Pau Cotton Nude color (01)

Rnd 20: (sc in next 11 st, inc in next st) 4 times [52]

Rnd 21-24: sc in all 52 st [52]

Rnd 25: (sc in next 12 st, inc in next st) 4 times [56]

Rnd 26-29: sc in all 56 st [56]

Change to Pica Pau Cotton Nude color (09)

Rnd 30: BLO sc in all 56 st [56]

Rnd 31-37: sc in all 56 st [56]

Rnd 38: (sc in next 5 st, dec) 8 times [48]

Rnd 39-40: sc in all 48 st [48]

Rnd 41: (sc in next 4 st, dec) 8 times [40]

Rnd 42-43: sc in all 40 st [40]

Rnd 44: (sc in next 8 st, dec) 4 times [36]

Do not fasten off.

The legs

To make the legs, divide the work identifying 4 stitches for the front central space between the legs, 4 stitches for the back and 14 stitches for each leg (you may find it useful to use stitch markers). Join the first marked stitch for the leg on the back side to the marked stitch on the front side, working a single crochet stitch (this sc will be the first stitch of the leg). Now the stitches of the first leg are joined in the round. Continue working the first leg:

Rnd 45-49: sc in all 14 st [14]

Stuff the body and leg firmly.

Rnd 50: (sc in next 5 st, dec) 2 times [12]

Rnd 51: dec 6 times [6]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Using a tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end.

Second leg

Rejoin Pica Pau Cotton Nude color (09) yarn in the fifth unworked stitch at the back of round 44. This is where we start the first stitch of the second leg. Leave a long starting yarn tail.

Rnd 45: sc in next 14 st. When you reach the 14th st of the leg, sc in first st to join the round [14]

Rnd 46-51: repeat the pattern for the first leg.

Stuff the second leg and add more stuffing to the body if needed. Using a tapestry needle and the starting yarn tail, sew the 4 stitches between the legs closed.

ARMS (make 2)

Start with Pica Pau Cotton Nude color (09)

Rnd 1: start 6 sc in a mr [6]

Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Rnd 3-4: sc in all 12 st [12]

Rnd 5: sc in next st, 5-dc-bobble in next st, sc in next 10 st [12]

Change to Pica Pau Cotton color (27) and continue in a stripe pattern, changing color every round, alternating Pica Pau Cotton color (27) and Pica Pau Cotton Nude color (01)

Rnd 11-15: sc in all 12 st [12]

Rnd 16: (sc in next 4 st, dec) 2 times [10]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff with fiberfill. Sew the arms on both sides between rounds 28 and 29.

HAT

Work with Pica Pau Cotton color (22)

Rnd 1: start 8 sc in a mr [8]

Rnd 2: inc in all 8 st [16]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) 8 times [24]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) 8 times [32]

Rnd 5: BLO sc in next 32 st [32]

Rnd 6-8: sc in all 32 st [32]

Rnd 9: (sc in next 6 st, dec) 4 times [28]

Rnd 10: inc in next 8 st, ch 9, skip 4 st, sc in next st, inc in next 2 st, sc in next st, ch 9, skip 4 st, inc in next 8 st [56].

Rnd 11-12: sc in all 56 st [56]

Rnd 13: (sc in next 6 st, inc in next st) 8 times [64]

Rnd 14: sc in all 64 st [64]

Rnd 15: (sc in next 7 st, inc in next st) 8 times [72]

Rnd 16: sc in all 72 st [72]

Rnd 17: FLO slst in next 72 st [72]

Fasten off and weave in the yarn ends.

EARS (make 2)

Work one ear with Pica Pau Cotton color (32) and the other ear with Pica Pau Cotton Nude color (09)

Rnd 1: start 5 sc in a mr [5]

Rnd 2: sc in all 5 st [5]

Rnd 3: inc in all 5 st [10]

Rnd 4: sc in all 10 st [10]

Rnd 5: (sc in next st, inc in next st) 5 times [15]

Rnd 6: sc in all 15 st [15]

Rnd 7: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) 5 times [20]

Rnd 8-12: sc in all 20 st [20]

Rnd 13: (sc in next 2 st, dec) 5 times [15]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Do not stuff. Flatten, pinch the ears and sew them on top of the head, between rounds 3 and 6, taking into account the holes on the hat.

SKIRT

Start with Pica Pau Cotton color (27)

Ch 56. Make sure your chain isn't twisted, then put the hook through the first ch stitch and close into a ring by crocheting a slst. Continue working in a spiral.

Rnd 1: sc in all 56 st [56]

Rnd 2: (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st) 14 times [70]

Rnd 3-5: sc in all 70 st [70]

Rnd 6: (sc in next 6 st, inc in next st) 10 times [80]

Rnd 7-8: sc in all 80 st [80]

Change to Pica Pau Cotton color (28)

Rnd 9: sc in all 80 st [80]

Rnd 10: slst in all 80 st [80]

Fasten off, weave in the yarn ends.

Waistband

Work with Pica Pau Cotton color (28)

Rejoin the Pica Pau Cotton color (28) in the first stitch of the round 1 of the skirt.

Rnd 1: sc in all 56 st [56]

Rnd 2: BLO slst in all 56 st [56]

Fasten off and weave in the yarn ends.
