## MATERIALS

### Divina

Main Color (MC): Natural White (02)

5 (5, 6, 6) **[7, 7, 7]** (8, 9, 9) skeins

*Approx: 660 (711, 792, 864) **[930, 972, 1038]**  
(1098, 1221, 1326) meters / 722 (778, 866,  
945) **[1017, 1063, 1136]** (1201, 1336, 1451)  
yards*

Contrast Color (CC): Cinnamon (13)

1 skein for all sizes

*Approx: 24-30 meters / 26-33 yards*

Circular needles, 4.5mm / US 7 and  
5.5mm / US 9.

Cable 80 cm / 32" length for hem and  
body

Cable 40 cm / 16" length for collar and  
sleeves

Optionally Double pointed needles or  
Magic loop can be used.

Stitch markers

Tapestry needle

Stitch holders

Cable needle

## YARN QUALITY

 **Divina**, Hobbii

65% Alpaca, 28% Polyamide, 7% Wool

50 g (1.75 oz) = 150 m (164 yds)

## GAUGE

17 sts x 28 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

In stockinette in the round

## MEASUREMENTS

Finished body circumference: 80 (87, 97, 104)

**[108, 113, 120]** (127, 139, 150) cm /

31.5 (34.25, 38, 40.75) **[42.5, 44.5, 47.25]** (50,  
54.75, 59.25)"

Front body length from top of collar to

bottom of hem: 62 (62, 63, 64) **[65, 66, 67]**

(68, 70, 72) cm / 24.5 (24.5, 25, 25.25) **[25.5,**

**26, 26.25]** (26.75, 27.5, 28.25)"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Just the thing for December festivities, this soft, cozy sweater and matching mittens belong wherever a warming fire flickers and the smell of hot chocolate lingers.

Constructed top-down in the round in sizes for everyone, the sweater features a subtle cable yolk and a distinctive braided cuff like the mitts, shown here in Yuletide cinnamon. Really, it's great winter-round style!

- Knit top down in the round.

- The techniques used in the pattern include cables, ribbing, a braid, and stockinette.

- The pattern contains detailed written instructions and a chart.

Recommended 10 - 15cm / 4 - 6" of positive ease.

# Pattern



## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = approximately

Bo = bind off

Bor = beginning of round

CC = contrast color

CN = cable needle

Co = cast on

K = knit

Kwise = knitwise

K2tog = knit two stitches together

LN = left needle

M = marker

MC = main color

M1L (make one left leaning stitch) = Insert the LN from front to back, under the bar between the Sts, lifting it onto the LN. Then knit this bar through the back loop.

P = purl

Patt = pattern

Pm = place marker

Rem = remain

Rep = repeat

Rnd(s) = round(s)

Sl = slip

St(s) = stitch(es)

Ssk = slip the next 2 Sts, one by one, Kwise; insert tip of LN, from left to right into fronts of those 2 sts and K them t

2/1LC = 2/1 left cross. Place 1 St on cable needle, hold to front, K2; K1 from cable needle

2/1RC = 2/1 right cross. Place 1 St on cable needle, hold to back, K2; K1 from cable needle

2/2LC = 2/2 left cross, Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front, K2, K2 from cable needle

2/2RC = 2/2 right cross, Slip 2 sts to cable needle, hold in back, K2, K2 from cable needle

## INFO AND TIPS

The Hearth Sweater is worked top down in the round from collar to armholes. After armhole separation, front and back pieces are worked in the round to the hem. The sweater features a cabled yoke. The sleeves are worked in the round to the cuff. The cuffs are adorned with a braid.

## MEASUREMENTS

**Finished body circumference:** 80 (87, 97, 104) **[108, 113, 120]** (127, 139, 150)cm / 31.5 (34.25, 38, 40.75) **[42.5, 44.5, 47.25]** (50, 54.75, 59.25)"

**Front body length from top of collar to bottom of hem:** 62 (62, 63, 64) **[65, 66, 67]** (68, 70, 72) cm / 24.5 (24.5, 25, 25.25) **[25.5, 26, 26.25]** (26.75, 27.5, 28.25)"

**Body length from underarm to hem:** 30cm / 12" or to desired length.

**Sleeve length from underarm:** 42 (42, 40, 40) **[39, 38, 38]** (37, 36, 36)cm / 16.5 (16.5, 15.75, 15.75) **[15.5, 15.25, 15.25]** (14.75, 14, 14)" (Shorter lengths for longer yokes).

**Upper arm circumference:** 28 (32, 34, 38) **[40, 42, 43]** (43, 46, 47)cm / 11.25 (12.5, 13.5, 15) **[15.75, 16.5, 17]** (17, 18, 18.5)"

**Yoke depth:** 20 (20, 22, 23) **[24, 25, 26]** (27, 29, 30)cm / 8 (8, 8.75, 9) **[9.25, 9.75, 10]** (10.5, 11.25, 12)"

## INSTRUCTIONS

### COLLAR

Using MC, smallest sized needle, and long tail Co (or preferred method), Co 68 (72, 80, 80) **[84, 88, 88]** (96, 100, 104) Sts. Join for working in the round being careful not to twist Sts. Pm for Bor (centre back), work the following Rnds.

**All Rnds:** \*(K1, P1), Rep from \* to end.

Work this way until collar measures 12cm / 4.75" from Co edge, then work yoke.

### YOKE SET UP

Switch to gauge sized needle and work the following increase Rnd according to size.

**Size 1:** K3, (M1L, K7) 4 times, M1L, K6, (M1L, K7) 4 times, M1L, K3.

**Size 2:** K3, (M1L, K6) 11 times, M1L, K3.

**Size 3:** K2, (M1L, K5) 15 times, M1L, K3.

**Size 4:** K2, (M1L, K3) 4 times, (M1L, K4) 13 times, (M1L, K3) 4 times, M1L, K2.

**Size 5:** K2, (M1L, K3) 6 times, (M1L, K4) 11 times, (M1L, K3) 6 times, M1L, K2.

**Size 6:** K2, (M1L, K3) 8 times, (M1L, K4) 9 times, (M1L, K3) 8 times, M1L, K2.

**Size 7:** K2, (M1L, K3) 12 times, (M1L, K4) 3 times, (M1L, K3) 12 times, M1L, K2.

**Size 8:** K2, (M1L, K4) 23 times, M1L, K2.

**Size 9:** K2, (M1L, K3) 2 times, (M1L, K4) 21 times, (M1L, K3) 2 times, M1L, K2.

**Size 10:** K2, (M1L, K3) 4 times, (M1L, K4) 19 times, (M1L, K3) 4 times, M1L, K2.


10 (12, 16, 22) **[24, 26, 28]** (24, 26, 28) Sts increased. 78 (84, 96, 102) **[108, 114, 114]** (120, 126, 132) Sts. Work Yoke pattern Chart or written instructions that follow.

### YOKE CHART INSTRUCTIONS (SKIP AHEAD FOR WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS)

**How to work the chart:** Work all 44 Rows of chart, right to left starting with Row 1. Each row is repeated 13 (14, 16, 17) **[18, 19, 19]** (20, 21, 22) times in the round.

- Refer to the symbol key for more guidance.
- Refer to the "Yoke Continued Section" after the chart is complete.
- When the chart is complete there will be 130 (140, 160, 170) **[180, 190, 190]** (200, 210, 220) Sts increased. 204 (224, 256, 272) **[288, 304, 304]** (320, 336, 352) Sts total.




M1L: Using LN, Lift the bar between sts from front to back, then knit this St through the back loop



Purl



2/1RC: Place 1 St on CN, hold to back, K2; K1 from CN



2/1LC: Place 1 St on CN, hold to front, K2; K1 from CN



2/2RC: Place 2 Sts on CN, hold to back, K2; K2 from CN



2/2LC: PLace 2 Sts on CN, hold to front, K2; K2 from CN

**YOKE WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS START HERE**

**Rnds 1, 2:** \*(K5, P1), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 3:** \*(K5, M1L, P1), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 4, 5:** \*(K6, P1), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 6:** \*(M1L, K6, P1), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 7:** \*(2/1RC, P1, 2/1LC, P1), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 8:** \*(K3, P1, K3, M1L, P1), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 9:** \*(K3, P1, K4, P1), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 10:** \*(M1L, K3, P1, K4, P1), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 11:** \*(K4, P1), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 12:** \*(2/2RC, P1, 2/2LC, P1), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 13:** \*[(K4, P1)x 2, M1L], Rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 14, 15:** \*[(K4, P1)x 2, K1], Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 16:** \*[M1L, (K4, P1)x 2, K1], Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 17:** \*(P1, 2/2RC, P1, 2/2LC, P1, K1), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 18:** \*[(P1, K4)x 2, P1, K1], Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 19:** \*(P1, K9, P1, K1), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 20:** \*(P1, K9, P1, K1, M1L), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 21:** \*(P1, K9, P1, K2), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 22:** \*(M1L, P1, K9, P1, K2), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 23, 24, 25:** \*(K1, P1, K9, P1, K2), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 26:** \*(K1, P1, K9, P1, K2, M1L), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32:** \*(K1, P1, K9, P1, K3), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 33:** \*(K1, P1, 2/2RC, P1, 2/2LC, P1, K3), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 34, 35, 36, 37:** \*[K1, (P1, K4)x 2, P1, K3], Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 38:** \*(K1, P1, 2/2RC, P1, 2/2LC, P1, K3), Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 39:** \*[M1L, K1, (P1, K4)x 2, P1, K3], Rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 40, 41, 42:** \*[K2, (P1, K4)x 2, P1, K3], Rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 43:** \*(K2, P1, 2/2RC, P1, 2/2LC, P1, K3), Rep from \* to end.

**Row 44:** \*[K2, (P1, K4)x 2, P1, K3], Rep from \* to end.

130 (140, 160, 170) **[180, 190, 190]** (200, 210, 220) Sts increased. Yoke contains 204 (224, 256, 272)

**[288, 304, 304]** (320, 336, 352) Sts total.

**YOKE CONTINUED (start here following chart)**

Work the following Rnd according to size.

**Size 1:** K8, (M1L, K17) 11 times, M1L, K9.

**Size 2:** K14, (M1L, K28) 7 times, M1L, K14.

**Sizes 3, 4, 5, 6:** Move onto next instruction for yoke.

**Size 7:** K19, (M1L, K38) 7 times, M1L, K19.

**Size 8:** K40, (M1L, K80) 3 times, M1L, K40.

**Size 9:** K21, (M1L, K42) 7 times, M1L, K21.

**Size 10:** K11, (M1L, K22) 15 times, M1L, K11.

12 (8, 0, 0) **[0, 0, 8]** (4, 8, 16) Sts increased.

216 (232, 256, 272) **[288, 304, 312]** (324, 344, 368) Sts total.

## YOKE CONTINUED

**All Rnds:** K all Sts to end.

Work this way until yoke measures approx. 20 (20, 22, 23) **[24, 25, 25.5]** (27, 29, 30)cm / 8 (8, 8.75, 9) **[9.25, 9.75, 10]** (10.5, 11.25, 12)" from bottom of front collar, not Co.

Then divide the body and sleeves.

## Sleeve separation

K32 (34, 38, 40) **[42, 44, 46]** (49, 53, 57), Sl the next 44 (48, 52, 56) **[60, 64, 64]** (64, 66, 68) Sts on hold on St holder for sleeve, Co 4 (6, 6, 8) **[8, 8, 10]** (10, 12, 12) for underarm, K64 (68, 76, 80) **[84, 88, 92]** (98, 106, 116) across front, Sl the next 44 (48, 52, 56) **[60, 64, 64]** (64, 66, 68) Sts onto St holder for the other sleeve, Co 4(6, 6, 8) **[8, 8, 10]** (10, 12, 12) for underarm, K32 (34, 38, 40) **[42, 44, 46]** (49, 53, 57) to end. 136 (148, 164, 176) **[184, 192, 204]** (216, 236, 256) Sts total.

Then work body.

## BODY

**All Rnds:** K all Sts to end.

Work this way until body measures approx. 27cm / 10.5" from underarm (or to desired length, keeping in mind that hem will add 4cm / 1.5" to length).

## Hem

Switch to smallest sized circular needle and work the following Rnds.

**All Rnds:** \*(K1, P1), Rep from \* to end.

Work rib for 4 cm / 1.5". Then Bo in Patt.

## SLEEVES (both alike)

**Set Up Rnd:** Sl the 44 (48, 52, 56) **[60, 64, 64]** (64, 66, 68) on hold Sts onto gauge sized needle, pick up and K4 (6, 6, 8) **[8, 8, 10]** (10, 12, 12) Sts across underarm. Pm for Bor in centre of underarm.

48 (54, 58, 64) **[68, 72, 74]** (74, 78, 80) Sts total.



**All Rnds:** K all Sts to end.

Work this way until sleeve measures 3cm / 1" from underarm.

**Next Rnd:** K1 Ssk, K to 3 Sts before Bor M, K2tog, K1. 2 Sts decreased, 46 (52, 56, 62) **[66, 70, 72]** (72, 76, 78) Sts Rem.

**All Rnds to cuff:** K all Sts to end.

Work this way until sleeve measures 38 (38, 36, 36) **[35.5, 35, 35]** (34, 32, 32)cm /15 (15, 14.25, 14.25) **[14, 13.75, 13.75]** (13.25, 12.5, 12.5)" from underarm (or to desired length, keeping in mind that cuff will add 4cm / 1.5" to length). Work braid cuff set up.

### **BRAID CUFF SET UP**

Starting with 46 (52, 56, 62) **[66, 70, 72]** (72, 76, 78) Sts.

**Size 1:** K1, K2tog, (K2tog, K1) 13 times, K2tog 2 times.

**Size 2:** K1, K2tog, (K2tog, K1) 15 times, K2tog 2 times.

**Size 3:** K1, K2tog 2 times, (K2tog, K1) 15 times, K2tog 3 times.

**Size 4:** K1, K2tog 2 times, (K2tog, K1) 17 times, K2tog 3 times, K2tog.

**Size 5:** K1, K2tog 3 times, (K2tog, K1) 17 times, K2tog 4 times.

**Sizes 6:** K1, K2tog 4 times, (K2tog, K1) 17 times, K2tog 5 times.

**Sizes 7 and 8:** K1, K2tog 3 times, (K2tog, K1) 19 times, K2tog 4 times.

**Size 9:** K1, K2tog, (K2tog, K1) 23 times, K2tog 2 times.

**Size 10:** K1, K2tog 3 times, (K2tog, K1) 21 times, K2tog 4 times.

16 (18, 20, 22) **[24, 26, 26]** (26, 26, 28) Sts decreased. 30 (34, 36, 40) **[42, 44, 46]** (46, 50, 50) Sts Rem.

### **CUFF BRAID**

**Useful Tutorial:** <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DAmDr9UKrH0>

**Set Up Rnd:** Join CC. \*K1 with CC, K1 with MC; Rep from \* to end of Rnd.

**NOTE:** Rnd 1 twists your yarn but Rnd 2 will untwist them.

**Rnd 1:** Bring both strands of colours to the front. P1 with CC, \*(Bring MC under CC, P1 with MC, bring CC under MC, P1 with CC), Rep from \* to last St, bring MC under CC, P last with MC.

**Rnd 2:** P1 with CC, \*(Bring MC over CC, P1 with MC, bring CC over MC, P1 with CC), Rep from \* to last St, bring MC over CC, P last MC. Bring both yarns to back, break CC, then work cuff.

### **CUFF**

**All Rnds:** \*(K1, P1), Rep from \* to end. Work rib for 1.5" / 4cm. Bo in Patt.

**FINISHING**

Weave in all loose ends. Gently block if necessary. Wear with delight!
