



## *Hogwarts socks*

*by Pauliina Mathlin*

*Socks designed and manufactured with my sister, to keep her legs warm for future trips. <3*

## **Materials and Supplies:**

Novita 7 brothers, (part of the colors left the production)

A dark red (cherry 588)

Honey (289)

Mustard / Gold

Yellow (sunflower 268)

Red (December 549)

Black (soot 099)

Light gray (lichen 047)

Gray (043 stone)

Brown

Dark Green

Dark Blue (denim 160)

Socks weight n.240g

Needle size 3.5mm, 3mm ribbing

## **Knitting tension and the finished sock size:**

25 sts and 28 rows = 10cm

Calf circumference narrow (32-34 cm) length before the heel

39-40 cm

Size 38-39

### **At first:**

Coat of arms is made up entirely of duplicate stitch, which imitates a looping. (A good how-to video can be found on Drops Design site by typing Google search for duplicate stitch.)

Fairisle section layer change is made in each section of the sock, the foot bottom. Calf decreases are made in the middle of the back. You can skip a few decrease stitches, wherein the constriction point should not be so steep.


### **Start:**

Cast on 64 sts in dark red with 3mm needles. Join, being careful not to twist. Knit in 2x2 ribbing for 5 cm. Switch to 3.5mm needles.


Knit one round, and start the holes for the ties by knitting \*k2tog, yo, k2\*. Repeat from \* - \* the entire round. Knit 50 rounds of plain stocking stitch with dark red and then do the coat of arms with duplicate stitch.

The height of the coat of arms is 47 rounds, start with the coat of arms 1-2 rounds under the holes for the ties.






After the coat of arms is completed, fairisle and calf decreases according to the diagram. The chart is read from bottom to top, right to left.



### Right sock:



## Heel:

After the heel is knitted chart (standard fixed heel). Separate your stitches on needles so that the decreases will remain the center of the back and heel loops is 26 sts and 26 sts are others waiting. Transfer the heel stitches on one needle and knit heel flap back and forth.

Work the heel flap where every row starts with a slipped knit stitch. You will work the first and all odd rows as slip knit stitch, purl, across the row. The second row, and all even rows, will be slip knit stitch, purl across. You will work this for 24 rows.

Heel is made 8-10-8 sts.

Gusset: Start decrease on the underside of the round. Purl until 9 stitches are left. Knit two stitches together and turn the work. Slip the first stitch as if to knit, knit across, 9. Knit two together to close the edges together.


Turn piece and work for so long that the loops on the edge of the remainder is always one less than the previous round.

Continue decrease rounds so long that the needle is 10s.

Remember to always slip the first stitch as if to knit when you turn the work.

After picking up the heel edge 13 sts, 26 sts knit waiting for the label and pick up one edge of the 13 sts. Knit 5 sts and you're in the middle of the bottom, where the next chart starts.

Gusset and fairisle knit according to the diagram:



After the start of charted wide band narrowing. Dec 1 and 3. The two needles together so well that after the decrease remains to be one stitch, and the 2nd and 4th needles taper is made so that the first finger loop is knitted and thereafter made Slip.

Knit the first dec round immediately after the chart, followed by one round without decreasing, while the third round and the fourth is narrowed without decreasing. The fifth round dec from the round until all the remaining stitches

a total of 4. Cut the yarn and pull through the last stitch, pull the yarn to the wrong side. Weave in the ends and complete the knitting by soaking or steaming.

Using the mustard blends yarn, twist the length of approx. 100cm using 6 strands.
