YARN

Felted Tweed and Kidsilk Haze

NEEDLES

3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) circular needle no more than 40 cm long
4mm (no 8) (US 6) circular needle no more than 40 cm long

TENSION

20 sts and 28 rounds to 10 cm measured over st st using 4mm (US 6) needles and one strand each of Felted Tweed and Kidsilk Haze held together.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed scarf is 25 cm (9¾ in) wide and 219 cm (86½ in) long.

SCARF

Using 3¼mm (US 3) circular needle and one strand each of yarns E and F held together cast on 120 sts.

Taking care not to twist cast-on edge, work in rounds as follows:

Round 1 (RS): *K2, P2, rep from * to end. Rep last round 16 times more.

Round 18 (RS): (K2, P2tog, K2, P2, K2tog, P2) 10 times. 100 sts.

Break off yarns E and F.

Change to 4mm (US 6) circular needle.

Joining in and breaking off colours as required, now work in striped st st (K every round) as follows: Using one strand each of yarns A and B held together, work 20 rounds.

Using one strand each of yarns C and D held together, work 20 rounds.

These 40 rounds form striped st st.

Cont in striped st st until 15th stripe using yarns A and B held together has been completed – scarf should meas approx 213 cm.

Break off yarns A and B.

Change to 3¼mm (US 3) circular needle.

Using one strand each of yarns E and F held together, complete scarf as follows:

Next round (RS): (K2, inc knitwise in next st, K2) 20 times. 120 sts.

Now work in rib as given for cast-on edge for 17 rounds.

Cast off in rib.

NEEDLES

1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles

1 pair 3¼mm (no 9) (US 5) needles

1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) circular needle no more than 40 cm long

TENSION

24 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 3¼mm (US 5) needles.

BACK


Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn A cast on 113 [125: 137: 149: 161: 173] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: P1, *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 10 rows, ending with



RS facing for next row.
 Change to 3¼mm (US 5) needles.
 Beg with a K row, now work in st st throughout as folls:
 Cont straight until back meas 42.5 [43: 43.5: 44: 44.5: 45] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.
 Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.
 Beg and ending rows as indicated and using the **fairisle** technique as described on the information page, cont in patt from chart, which is worked entirely in st st beg with a K row, as folls:
 Work 2 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.
Shape armholes
 Keeping patt correct, cast off 4 [5: 6: 7: 8: 9] sts at beg of next 2 rows.
 105 [115: 125: 135: 145: 155] sts.
 Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 [5: 7: 7: 9: 9] rows, then on foll 2 [2: 1: 1: 0: 0] alt rows.
 91 [101: 109: 119: 127: 137] sts.
 Work 1 row, ending after chart row 14 and with RS facing for next row.
 Change to 3¼mm (US 5) needles.
 Break off yarn A and cont in st st, beg with a K row, using yarn B **only** as folls:
 Dec 1 st at each end of next and foll 1 [3: 3: 5: 5: 6] alt rows, then on foll 4th row.
 85 [91: 99: 105: 113: 121] sts.
 Cont straight until armhole meas 20 [21.5: 23: 24.5: 26: 27.5] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.
Shape shoulders and back neck
Next row (RS): Cast off 6 [6: 7: 8: 8: 9] sts, K until there are 22 [24: 26: 28: 31: 33] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.
 Work each side of neck separately.
 Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 4 rows **and at same time** cast off 6 [6: 7: 8: 9: 9] sts at beg of 2nd row, then 6 [7: 7: 8: 9: 10] sts at beg of foll alt row.
 Work 1 row.
 Cast off rem 6 [7: 8: 8: 9: 10] sts.
 With RS facing, slip centre 29 [31: 33: 33: 35: 37] sts onto a holder (for neckband), rejoin yarn and K to end.
 Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

FRONT

Work as given for back until 40 [40: 44: 44: 46: 46] rows less have been worked than on back to beg of shoulder shapings, ending with RS facing for next row.
Divide for front neck
Next row (RS): K42 [45: 49: 52: 56: 60] and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.
 Work each side of neck separately.
 Dec 1 st at neck edge of 2nd and foll 16 [18: 18: 18: 19: 21] alt rows, then on 1 [0: 1: 1: 1: 0] foll 4th row. 24 [26: 29: 32: 35: 38] sts.
 Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.
Shape shoulder
 Cast off 6 [6: 7: 8: 8: 9] sts at beg of next and foll 2 [1: 2: 2: 0: 1] alt rows, then - [7: -: -: 9: 10] sts at beg of foll - [1: -: -: 2: 1] alt rows.
 Work 1 row.
 Cast off rem 6 [7: 8: 8: 9: 10] sts.
 With RS facing, slip centre st onto a holder (for neckband), rejoin yarn and K to end.
 42 [45: 49: 52: 56: 60] sts.
 Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.
