

Horai Scarf by roko



Use any yarn you like. To take advantage of the pattern, knit loosely using a somewhat larger needle size. This will emphasize its delicate and lacy effect.

Shown here:

Yarn: 2ply lace weight mohair (Gray-purple gradation) 100g (900m / 985 yard), 2 strands held together.



Excellent Mohair (Count 10) Gradation by RichMore

Needle: 7.0 mm


Gauge: 22 sts / 4" in pattern stitch

Finished size: 35 cm / 14" wide, 226 cm / 90" long



Special instruction

Horai Stitch (HS) : (k3tog, yo, k3tog) into one stitch. (See following photos)

PATTERN

Cast on 79 stitches (Or multiple of 4 plus 3 stitches).

K 2 rows.

Row 1: (HS, k1) to last 3 stitches, HS.

Row 2: K to end.

Row 3: k2, (HS, k1) to last 1 stitch, k1.

Row 4: K to end.

Repeat these 4 rows to your desired length.

K 1 row.

Bind off all stitches. Enjoy!
