

Hudson River socks

Knit

Easy

SIZE

34/35 40/41 42/43 46/47 48/49

Instructions are for smallest size, with changes for larger sizes noted in different colors. When only one figure is given, it applies for all sizes.

MATERIALS

REGIA 4-fädig Uni, 100 g ball
Col. 06844 (eisblau shiné) 1 ball
Double pointed Needles 2.5 - 3.0 mm
1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

BASIC PATTERN

Ribbed pattern: k1 tbl, p1, repeat to the end.

Stockinette stitch:

In Rows: RS: knit all sts, WS: purl all sts.

In Rd: knit all sts.

Checked pattern:

Multiples of 8 stitches.

Rd 1 and 2: * k1 tbl, p7, repeat from * to the end.

Rd 3 – 6: * k1 tbl, p2, k3, p2, repeat from * to the end.

Rd 7 and 8: * k1 tbl, p7, repeat from * to the end.

Rd 9: * k1 tbl, k7, repeat from * to the end.

Rd 10: * k1 tbl, p7, repeat from * to the end.

Rd 11: * k1 tbl, k7, repeat from * to the end.

Repeat Rd 1 - 11 throughout.

GAUGE

Stockinette stitch, size 2.5 - 3.0 mm needles:

30 sts and 42 R/Rd = 10 x 10 cm

Checked pattern, size 2.5 – 3.0 mm needles:

30 sts and 45 R/Rd = 10 x 10 cm

If your gauge differs from the given gauge, use needles of a larger or smaller size accordingly.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 56/64/64/72/72st, divide the st evenly over 4 needles and join to work in the round (= 14/16/16/18/18 st on each needle).

For the cuff, work in ribbed pattern for 2 cm, then continue

working the leg shaft in the checkered pattern.

Beginning from the *, work the 8-st repeat 7/8/8/9/9x. When you have worked 14 cm = 63 Rd from the end of the cuff, continue working all st in stockinette st.

Work 1 Rd in stockinette st; then work a boomerang heel over the 28/32/32/36/36st on Needles 1 and 4, following the tutorial "Knitting Socks with a Boomerang Heel."

Stitch division for boomerang heel: 9/10/9 10/12/10 10/12/10 12/12/12 12/12/12 st.

When you have completed the boomerang heel, continue working in stockinette st across all 4 needles.

When the foot measures 18/21/22/24/24.5 cm, work the toe shaping over all 56/64/64/72/72 st, following the tutorial "Knitting Socks with a Boomerang Heel."

After the 1st decrease round, repeat the toe decreases as follows: 0/1/1/1/1x in the following 4th round, 2x in every following 3rd Rd, 3/3/3/4/4x in every 2nd Rd and 6/7/7/8/8x in every Rd.

FINISHING

Thread the working yarn through the 8 remaining stitches and pull to close. Weave in the end.

Work the second sock in the same way.

TIP:

Since the checkered pattern repeats over 8 st, not all sizes can automatically be achieved according to the size chart. If you can't find your desired size here, you may proceed as follows:

Cast on the appropriate number of st according to the size chart.

In the last cuff row, increase 1 st on each needle by knitting through the back loop in the bar between 2 st.

Work the shaft over the resulting number of st.

In the first stockinette st Rd after the shaft, k2tog once on each needle.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit
p = purl
RS = right side
st(s) = stitch(es)
WS = wrong side
