## **ABOUT JACKET NO. 2**

Jacket No. 2 is an oversized cabled cardigan with a v- neck.

The boxy shape and extra long sleeves give it a boyfriend fit, while the deep v-neck adds a feminine touch to the cardigan.

The style is classic with a special focus on the details. The shoulder construction, along with the neckline increases, creates a flattering fit.

The sleeves are designed with a slight flare that narrows at the cuffs.

The cardigan is worked from the top down without any addition seaming.

## **SIZES**

XS (S) M (L) XL (2XL) 3XL (4XL)

## **MEASUREMENTS**

Length (measured at the centre back, from below the neckline): 54 (54) 54 (57) 57 (57) 60 (60) cm  
[21.25 (21.25) 21.25 (22.5) 22.5 (22.5) 23.5 (23.5) inches]

Circumference: 108 (117) 126 (135) 144 (148) 157 (166) cm [42.5 (46) 49.5 (53.25) 56.75 (58.25) 61.75 (65.25) inches]

## **SUGGESTED NEEDLES**

5 mm [US 8] (80 or 100 cm) [32 or 40 inches]

4 mm [US 6] (80 or 100 cm) [32 or 40 inches]

## **GAUGE**

In textured cable pattern using 5 mm [US 8] needles

20 sts / 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm [4 x 4 inches]

## **MATERIALS**

Hold 2 strands of yarn together. One of each quality.

400 (450) 450 (500) 550 (600) 600-650 (650) g Jensen, Isager, 50 g / 125 m.

*held together with...*

150 (150) 200 (200) 200 (250) 250 (250) g Highland Wool, Isager, 50 g / 275 m.

*or held together with...*

150 (150) 150 (175) 175 (175) 200 (200) g Silk Mohair, Isager, 25 g / 212 m.

**or...**

Work with 1 strand only.

600 (600) 600 (700) 700 (800) 800 (800) g Håndværksgarn, Hjelholt Uldspinderi, 100 g / 200 m.

## **Other materials**

4 buttons, Ø 20-22 mm.

## BEFORE YOU START

Remember to work a gauge swatch to ensure your needle size gives you the correct gauge. If your gauge differs, it will result in wrong proportions on your cardigan. The given gauge is measured after washing.

Keep in mind that the cables will be quite tight and 'bouncy' while knitting. They open up in the wash which gives an even and flat texture. That is why it is essential for the fit of the cardigan to be either washed or steamed before use.

### Size guide

Jacket No. 2 has an oversize fit. Calculate a positive ease of approx. 25-30 cm [9.75-11.75 inches].

The sizes are equivalent to the European sizes 34/XS (36/S) 38/M (40/L) 42/XL (44/2XL) 46/3XL (48/4XL) and suit a chest measurement of approx. 80-85 (85-90) 90-95 (95-100) 100-110 (110-120) 120-130 (130-140) cm [31.5-33.5 (33.5-35.5) 35.5-37.5 (37.5-39.5) 39.5-43.5 (43.5-47.25) 47.25-51.25 (51.25-55) inches].

For example: You measure 87 cm [34.25 inches] at your widest + 25-30 cm [9.75-11.75 inches] = 112-117 cm [44.25-46 inches]. Meaning that you should choose size S with a finished circumference of 117 cm [46 inches].

### Introduction to the work flow

First, the stitches for the neck and shoulders are cast on to work the back section.

Then, the back is shaped with increases while being worked back and forth on circular needles.

Stitches are then picked up along the shoulder line, and the upper parts of the two front sections are worked separately.

Next, the front and back pieces are joined. The body is then worked back and forth on circular needles and finished with a ribbed edge.

Stitches for the front edge are picked up and worked. Finally, the sleeves are worked by first forming the sleeve cap with short rows, then working in the round on circular needles.

### Cables

**Twist:** Place 3 sts on a cable needle in front of the work, k3, then k3 from the cable needle.

**Twist-2:** Place 2 sts on a cable needle in front of the work, k2, then k2 from the cable needle.

### Gauge swatch

Cast on 26 sts using 5 mm [US 8]. Work **rows 1st – 10th** until the swatch measures +10 cm [4 inches] on both sides.

**1st row (WS):** P1, \*p6, k3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, p7.

**2nd row (RS):** K1, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, k7.

**3rd row (WS):** P1, \*p6, k3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, p7.

**4th– 9th rows:** Work as **rows 2nd – 3rd**.

**10th row (RS):** K1, \*twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, twist, k1.

### Increases (inc)

Increases lean towards the right (**M1R/M1Rp**) or left (**M1L/M1Lp**).

### Right slanting increases

**M1R:** With your left needle, pick up the bar (between the right and the left needle) from the back and knit it.

**M1Rp:** With your left needle, pick up the bar from the back and purl.

### Left slanting increases

**M1L:** With your left needle, pick up the bar from the front and knit through the back loop.

**M1Lp:** With your left needle, pick up the bar from the front and purl through the back loop.

When working increases for a cable, use the following method to avoid creating gaps in the work.

**CabM1L:**

Step 1: Place 3 sts on a cable needle in front of the work.

Step 2: K3 (NOTE! The 3rd of these sts is the same one used in step 4).

Step 3: K the 3 sts from your cable needle.

Step 4: Using your left needle, go behind the last of 3 knitted sts and catch it. Lift this st to your left needle from front to back, inserting the needle from front to back. K this st tbl.

**CabM1R:**

Step 1: Place 3 sts on a cable needle in front of the work.

Step 2: K 2 sts, then inc in the following st by first knitting 1 tbl and afterward k 1 in the same st.

Step 3: K the 3 sts from the cable needle.

## BEGIN YOUR WORK HERE

### BACK

Cast on 35 (35) 35 (35) 35 (44) 44 (44) sts using 5 mm [US 8] circular needles. This part of the cardigan is worked back and forth on circular needles.

First row is a WS row. Work as follows:

P1, \*p6, k3\* and repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, p7.

You are now on RS.

From here you begin working shoulder increases which shape the back and shoulders.

Increases are worked on 9th and 10th rows (both on RS and WS).

Work as follows.

K7, M1L, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1R, k7.

From here, repeat the following 10 rows:

**1st row (WS):** P7, M1Rp, k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Lp, k7.

**2nd row (RS):** K7, M1L, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1R, k7.

**3rd-5th row:** Work as **rows 1st and 2nd**.

**6th row (RS):** K7, M1Lp, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Rp, k7.

**7th row (WS):** P7, M1R, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1L, p7.

**8th row (RS):** Work as **6th row**.

**9th row (WS):** K over k and p over p. *NOTE! No inc on this row.*

**10th row (RS):** K1, cabM1L, \*p3, twist\* repeat from \* to \* to last 10 sts, p3, cabM1R, k1.

Work **rows 1st-10th** another 2 (2) 3 (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) times.

*NOTE! On the last of the 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 (4) 5 (5) repeats work 10th row without increases. That is: k1, \*twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, twist, k1.*

You have worked 27 (27) 36 (36) 36 (36) 45 (45) rows with increases. 54 (54) 72 (72) 72 (72) 90 (90) sts have been added to the back and you have in total 89 (89) 107 (107) 107 (116) 134 (134) sts on your needles.

From here, work back and forth across the 89 (89) 107 (107) 107 (116) 134 (134) sts while continuing to work cables.

**1st row (WS):** P1, \*p6, k3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, p7.

**2nd row (RS):** K1, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, k7.

**3rd row (WS):** P1 \*p6, k3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, p7.

**4th – 9th rows:** Work as **rows 2nd – 3rd**.

**10th row (RS):** K1, \*twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, twist, k1.

Work the above rows a total of 3 (3) 3 (3) 3 (3) 3 (3) times. On the last repeat finish with **9th row** (WS row).

*NOTE! On the first repeat, place a marker in each edge st after **2nd row** has been worked. This marks where to pick up sts for the front.*

In some sizes, work increases to add sts to the body.

Work **rows 1st – 10th** a total of 0 (1) 0 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) times.

**1st row (RS):** K1, cab M1L, \*p3, twist\* repeat from \* to \* to last 10 sts, p3, cabM1R, k1.

**2nd row (WS):** P1, p6, M1Rp \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Lp, p6, p1.

**3rd row (RS):** K1, k6, M1L, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1R, k6, k1.

**4th-6th rows:** Work as **rows 2nd and 3rd**.

**7th row (RS):** K1, k6, M1Lp, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Rp, k6, k1.

**8th row (WS):** P1, p6, M1R, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1L, p6, p1.

**9th row (RS):** Work as **7th row**.

**10th row (WS):** Work as **8th row**.

There are now 89 (107) 107 (125) 125 (134) 152 (152) sts on your needles.

Break the yarn and leave sts on hold using a helping needle or waste yarn, whilst working the front.

### **RIGHT FRONT**

Pick up 35 (35) 44 (44) 44 (44) 53 (53) sts along the right shoulder in the part between your marker and the neck. Begin at the marker. Pick up 1 st per st.

First row is a WS row.

**1st row (WS):** P1, \*p6, k3\* and repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, p6, p1.

**2nd - 9th rows:** K over k and p over p.

**10th row (RS):** K1, \*twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, twist, k1.

All sizes: Work **rows 1st - 10th** a total of 3 (4) 4 (4) 4 (4) 5 (5) times. On the last repeat, finish with **9th row** (WS row).

Now, the neckline is shaped by working increases.

**1st row (RS):** K1, \*twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, cabM1R, k1.

**2nd row (WS):** P7, M1Rp, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 remains, p1.

**3rd row (RS):** K1, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1R, k7.

**4th - 6th rows:** Work as **rows 2nd - 3rd**.

**7th row (RS):** K1, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Rp, k7.

**8th row (WS):** P7, M1R, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 remains, p1.

**9th row (RS):** K1, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Rp, k7.

**10th row (WS):** K over k and p over p. *NOTE! No inc on this row.*

There are now 44 (44) 53 (53) 53 (53) 62 (62) sts on your needles.

Next, work 10 rows without increases.

**1st row (RS):** K1, \*twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, twist, k1.

**2nd - 10th rows:** K over k and p over p.

Then, repeat the increase sequence. The work flow varies depending on the size you are making. Make sure you choose the right one before you continue.

### **Sizes XS and M:**

**1st row (RS):** K1, \*twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, cabM1R, k1.

**2nd row (WS):** P7, M1Rp, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, p1.

**3rd row (RS):** K1, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1R, k7.

**4th - 6th rows:** Work as **rows 2nd - 3rd**.

**7th row (RS):** K1, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Rp, k7.

**8th row (WS):** P7, M1R, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, p1.

**9th row (RS):** K1, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Rp, k7.

**10th row (WS):** K over k and p over p. *NOTE! No inc on this row.*

### **Sizes S, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL and 4XL:**

**1st row (RS):** K1, cabM1L, \*p3, twist\* repeat from \* to \* to last 10 sts, p3, cabM1R, k1.

**2nd row (WS):** P7, M1Rp, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Lp, k7.

**3rd row (RS):** K7, M1L, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1R, k7.

**4th - 6th rows:** Work as **rows 2nd - 3rd**.

**7th row (RS):** K7, M1Lp, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Rp, k7.

**8th row (WS):** P7, M1R, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1L, p7.

**9th row (RS):** K7, M1Lp, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7, M1Rp, k7.

**10th row (WS):** K over k and p over p. *NOTE! No in on this row.*

There are now 53 (62) 62 (71) 71 (71) 80 (80) sts on your needles.

Break the yarn and leave sts on hold, whilst working the left front.

## LEFT FRONT

Pick up 35 (35) 44 (44) 44 (44) 53 (53) sts along the left shoulder in the part between the neck and your marker. Begin at the neck. Pick up 1 at per st

First row is a WS row.

**1st row (WS):** P1, \*p6, k3\* and repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, p6, p1.

**2nd – 9th rows:** K over k and p over p.

**10th row:** K1, \*twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7sts, twist, k1.

All sizes: Work **rows 1st – 10th a total of** 3 (4) 4 (4) 4 (4) 5 (5) times. On the last row, finish with **9th row** (WS row).

Now, the neckline is shaped by working increases.

**1st row (RS):** K1, cabM1L, \*p3, twist\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1.

**2nd row (WS):** P1, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Lp, p7.

**3rd row (RS):** K7, M1L \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1.

**4th – 6th rows:** Work as **rows 2nd – 3rd**.

**7th row (RS):** K7, M1Lp, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1.

**8th row (WS):** P1, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1L, p7.

**9th row (RS):** K7, M1Lp, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1.

**10th row (WS):** K over k and p over p. *NOTE! No in on this row.*

There are now 44 (44) 53 (53) 53 (53) 62 (62) sts on your needles.

Next, work 10 rows without increases.

**1st row (RS):** K1, \*twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, twist, k1.

**2nd – 10th rows:** K over k and p over p.

Then, repeat the increase sequence. The work flow varies depending on the size you are making. Make sure you choose the right one before you continue.

### Sizes XS and M:

**1st row (RS):** K1, cabM1L, \*p3, twist\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1.

**2nd row (WS):** P1, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Lp, p7.

**3rd row (RS):** K7, M1L, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1.

**4th – 6th rows:** Work as **rows 2nd – 3rd**.

**7th row (RS):** K7, M1Lp, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k7.

**8th row (WS):** P1, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1L, p7.

**9th row (RS):** Work as **7th row**.

**10th row (WS):** K over k and p over p. *NOTE! No inc on this row.*

### Sizes S, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL and 4XL:

**1st row (RS):** K1, cabM1L, \*p3, twist\* repeat from \* to \* to last 10 sts, p3, cabM1R, k1.

**2nd row (WS):** P7, M1Rp, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Lp, k7.

**3rd row (RS):** K7, M1L, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1R, k7.

**4th – 6th rows:** Work as **rows 2nd – 3rd**.

**7th row (RS):** K7, M1Lp, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Rp, k7.

**8th row (WS):** P7, M1R, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1L, p7.

**9th row (RS):** K7, M1Lp, \*k over k and p over p\* repeat from \* to \* to last 7 sts, M1Rp, k7.

**10th row (WS):** K over k and p over p. *NOTE! No inc on this row.*

There are now 53 (62) 62 (71) 71 (71) 80 (80) sts on your needles.

On the next row, join the front and back together. Continue back and forth on circular needles.

## BODY

Begin on the left front. K1, twist, \*p3, twist\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, p1, cast on 10 (1) 10 (1) 10 (10) 1 (10) new sts in extension using the backwards loop method.

Now, continue over the back's sts. P1, twist, \*p3, twist\* repeat from \* to until 1 st remains, p1, cast on 10 (1) 10 (1) 10 (10) 1 (10) new sts in extension using the backwards loop method.  
Continue over the right front's sts. P1, twist, \*p3, twist\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1.

There are now 215 (233) 251 (269) 287 (296) 314 (332) sts on your needles.

Continue working back and forth in the cable pattern until the work measures approx. 47 (47) 47 (50) 50 (50) 53 (53) cm [18.5 (18.5) 18.5 (19.75) 19.75 (19.75) 20.75 (20.75) inches] centre back, which corresponds to 12 (12) 12 (13) 13 (13) 14 (14) cables. Finish with **1st row** (row with cable twists).

Change to 4 mm [US 6] circular needles. From here, work back and forth in ribbing, until the ribbed edge measures 7 cm [2.75 inches].

**1st row (WS):** P1, \*p1, k1\* repeat from \* to \* to last 2 sts, p2.

**2nd row (RS):** K1, \*k1, p1\* repeat from \* to \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Finish with a WS row.

Work 2 rows of double knitting.

**1st row (RS):** K1, \*k1, slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front\* repeat from \* to \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**2nd row (WS):** P1, \*slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, k1\* repeat from \* to \* to 2 last sts, slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, p1.

Bind off using the Italian/tubular bind off method.

## **BUTTON BAND**

The button band is worked back and forth in double knitting on 4 mm [US 6] circular needles.

Begin picking up sts at the bottom of the right front.

Pick up 1 st for each st all the way around the edge with 4 mm [US 6] circular needles. In the following instructions, this part will be referred to as *pick-up edge*.

Break the yarn

Try your cardigan on and place 4 markers along the right front edge, where you would like your buttonholes to be.

The top buttonhole is placed approx. 1 cm [0.5 inch] below the last increase for the v-neck. The bottom buttonhole is placed approx. in the middle of the ribbed edge.

Ensure that there are the same number of sts between each.

As you go, make buttonholes along the right edge of the cardigan. See the following section '**Buttonholes**'. Search 'double knitted edge' on YouTube, if you need further guiding.

Now, begin the double knitted edge. Join in new yarn and cast on 12 sts on the part of your circular needle that is on the right side of the cardigan (to the right when wearing the cardigan, use with Italian cast-on method).

To attach the double knitted band to the cardigan itself, knit 1 st from the band together with 1 st from the pick-up row along the front edge. First work along the right side of the cardigan, then the neck and then the left side.

Work *continuously back and forth across the 12 newly cast-on sts*. For each RS row include 1 st from the pick-up edge in the work. This ensures that the double knitted panel will follow the edge all the way around.

*TIP! Use a double-pointed needle to help to make the work easier.*

Work as follows (*NOTE! Remember buttonholes along the way*):

**1st row (RS):** \*Slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, k1\* repeat from \* to \* to last 2 sts, slip 1 st purlwise with yarn in front, k2tog tbl (the last st from the Italian cast-on and 1 st from the pick-up edge).

**2nd row (WS):** \*Slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, k1\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of row.

Work **rows 1st** and **2nd**, until you have worked all the way around the front edge and there is 1 st from the pick-up row that is not included. Remember to make buttonholes at your markers along the way.

Finish with a WS row.

Then bind off on the RS using the Italian/tubular bind off method.

### Buttonholes

Buttonholes are worked by dividing the double knitted edge in the middle of the front so that it is worked in two parts and then joined again. First work the outer part (6 sts), then the inner part (6 sts).

Work across the first 6 sts on the needle as follows:

**1st row (RS):** \*Slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, k1\* repeat from \* to \* 3 times. Turn.

**2nd row (WS):** \*Slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, k1 \* repeat from \* to \* 3 times. Turn.

Work **rows 1st** and **2nd** a total of two times. You have now worked a total of 4 rows.

Work **1st row** once more, so that you finish mid front of the button band, then make 3 yarn overs and then continue across the remaining 6 sts as follows:

**1st row (RS):** \*Slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, k1\* repeat from \* to \* 2 times, slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, k2tog tbl (the last st of newly cast on sts and 1 st from the pick-up edge). Turn.

**2nd row (WS):** \*Slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, k1\* repeat from \* to \* 2 times, slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, k2tog tbl (the last st of newly cast on sts and 1 st from the pick-up edge). Turn.

Work **rows 1st** and **2nd** a total of two times. You have now worked 4 rows in total.

Work **1st row** once more.

You are now on WS, and the two halves of the button band must be joined into one.

\*Slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, k1\* repeat from \* to \* 2 times, slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, k2tog tbl (the last st of newly cast on sts and a yarn over), \*slip 1 st purlwise with yarn in front, k1\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of row.

### SLEEVES

Now, it's time to work the sleeves. Depending on the size you are making, the workflow is different. Therefore, choose the instruction that is right for your size.

The pick-up frequency along the front and back is equivalent to 9 out of 10 sts. In all sizes, skip a stitch for each cable - that gives the neat pick-up edge.

#### Sizes S, L, 3XL

Begin your round 1 st to the right of the centre under the armhole.

**Right sleeve pick-up:** Pick up - (3) - (3) - (-) 3 (-) sts in the sts under the armhole, then pick up - (33) - (33) - (-) 33 (-) sts along the back, pick up 3 sts along the front, place a marker, M1, pick up - (24) - (24) - (-) 24 (-) sts along the front, place a marker, M2, pick up another - (36) - (36) - (-) 45 (-) sts along the front. Place a marker, M0 = beginning of the rnd.

**Left sleeve pick-up:** Pick up - (3) - (3) - (-) 3 (-) sts in the sts under the armhole, pick up - (36) - (36) - (-) 45 (-) sts along the front, place a marker, M1, pick up - (24) - (24) - (-) 24 (-) sts along the front, place a marker, M2, pick up another 3 sts along the front, then pick up - (33) - (33) - (-) 33 (-) sts along the back. Place a marker, M0 = beginning of the rnd.

There are now 90 (99) 99 (99) 108 (108) 108 (117) sts on your needles.

From here, work short rows.

**1st row (RS):** P3, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to M1, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 6 sts before M2, k6, slip M2, p3, k6, turn.  
**2nd row (WS):** P5 \*k3, p6\* repeat from \* to \* to 9 sts after M1, turn.  
**3rd row (RS):** K5, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to 9 sts after M2, p3, k3, turn.  
**4th row (WS):** P2, \*k3, p6\* repeat from \* to \* to 9 sts after M1, k3, p3, turn.  
**5th row (RS):** K2, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to 18 sts after M2, p3, turn.  
**6th row (WS):** K2, p6, \*k3, p6\* repeat from \* to \* to 18 after M1, k3, turn.  
**7th row (RS):** P2, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 21 sts after M2, k6, turn.  
**8th row (WS):** P5, k3, \*p6, k3\* repeat from \* to \* to 21 sts after M1, p6, turn.  
**9th row (RS):** K5, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to M0.  
**10th row (RS):** \*P3, twist\* repeat from \* to \* to M0.

Continue working in the round on circular needles. You can remove M1 and M2.

**1st – 9th rnds:** \*P3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.  
**10th rnd:** \*P3, twist\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

Work **rnds 1st – 10th** a total of - (4) - (4) - (-) 4 (-) times (*NOTE! The short rows are not counted*).

From here, work decreases every other round to shape the sleeve.

**1st rnd:** P3, k5, **k2tog tbl**, p2, k6, \*p3, k 6\* repeat from \* to \* to 9 sts before M0, p2, **k2tog**, k5.  
**2nd rnd:** K over k and p over p.  
**3rd rnd:** P3, k5, **k2tog tbl**, p1, k6, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to 8 sts before M0, p1, **k2tog**, k5.  
**4th rnd:** K over k and p over p.  
**5th rnd:** P3, k5, **k3tog tbl**, k6, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to 7 sts before M0, **k2tog**, k5.  
**6th rnd:** K over k and p over p.  
**7th rnd:** P3, k5, **k2tog tbl**, k5, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to 15 sts before M0, p3, k5, **k2tog**, k5.  
**8th rnd:** K over k and p over p.  
**9th rnd:** P3, k5, **k2tog tbl**, k4, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to 14 sts before M0, p3, k4, **k2tog**, k5.  
**10th rnd:** P3, twist, twist-2, \*p3, twist\* repeat from \* to \* to 13 sts before the end of rnd, p3, twist-2, twist.  
**11th rnd:** P3, k5, **k2tog tbl**, k3, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to 13 sts before M0, p3, k3, **k2tog**, k5.  
**12th rnd:** K over k and p over p.  
**13th rnd:** P3, k5, **k2tog tbl**, k2, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to 12 sts before M0, p3, k2, **k2tog**, k5.  
**14th rnd:** K over k and p over p.  
**15th rnd:** P3, k5, **k2tog tbl**, k1, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to 11 sts before M0, p3, k1, **k2tog**, k5.  
**16th rnd:** K over k and p over p.  
**17th rnd:** P3, k5, **k2tog tbl**, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to 10 sts before M0, p3, **k2tog**, k5.  
**18th – 19th rnds:** \*P3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.  
**20th rnd:** \*P3, twist\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

Work **rnds 1st – 20th** another - (1) - (1) - (-) 1 (-) time.

Continue in the round on circular needles without decreases.

**1st – 9th rnd:** \*P3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.  
**10th rnd:** \*P3, twist\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

Work **rnds 1st – 10th** a total of - (1) - (1) - (-) 1 (-) time.

Continue on to the section 'All sizes'

### Sizes XS, M, XL, 2XL, 4XL

**Right sleeve pick-up:** Begin your rnd before the cable under the armhole (3 sts right of the centre) and pick up 9 (-) 9 (-) 9 (9) - (9) sts, then pick up 24 (-) 24 (-) 33 (33) - (33) sts along the back, pick up 3 sts along the front, place a marker, M1, pick up 24 (-) 24 (-) 24 (24) - (24) sts along the front, place a marker, M2, pick up another 27 (-) 36 (-) 36 (36) - (45) sts along the front, pick up in the remaining 3 sts under the sleeve, place a marker, M0.

**Left sleeve pick-up:** Begin your rnd before the cable under the armhole (3 sts right of the centre) and pick up 9 ( - ) 9 ( - ) 9 (9) - (9) sts, then pick up 27 ( - ) 36 ( - ) 36 (36) - (45) sts along the front, place a marker, M1, pick up another 24 ( - ) 24 ( - ) 24 (24) - (24) sts along the front, place a marker, M2, pick up 3 sts along the front, pick up 24 ( - ) 24 ( - ) 33 (33) - (33) sts along the back, pick up in the remaining 3 sts under the armhole, place a marker, M0.

There are now 90 (99) 99 (99) 108 (108) 108 (117) sts on your needles.

From here, work short rows.

**1st row (RS):** \*K6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to M1, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 6 sts before M2, k6, slip M2, p3, k6, turn.

**2nd row (WS):** P5, \*k3, p6\* repeat from \* to \* to 9 sts after M1, turn.

**3rd row (RS):** K5, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to 9 sts after M2, p3, k3, turn.

**4th row (WS):** P2, \*k3, p6\* repeat from \* to \* to 9 sts after M1, k3, p3, turn.

**5th row (RS):** K2, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to 18 sts after M2, p3, turn.

**6th row (WS):** K2, p6 \*k3, p6\* repeat from \* to \* to 18 sts after M1, k3, turn.

**7th row (RS):** P2 \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 21 sts after M2, k6, turn.

**8th row (WS):** P5, k3, \*p6, k3\* repeat from \* to \* to 21 sts after M1, p6, turn.

**9th row (RS):** K5, p3, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to M0.

**10th row (RS):** \*Twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to M0.

Continue working in the round on circular needles. You can remove M1 and M2.

**1st – 9th rnds:** \*K6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

**10th rnd:** \*Twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

Work **rnds 1st – 10th** a total of 6 ( - ) 4 ( - ) 4 (4) - (4) times (*NOTE! The short rows are not counted*).

On the **10th rnd** in the last repeat, work to 1 st before M0. **K2tog** and move M0 forward so that it is placed after the st you have just knitted (meaning 1 st into the cable). The following rnds begin here.

From here, work decreases every 2nd rnd to shape the sleeve.

**1st rnd:** Slip M0, k4, **k2tog tbl**, p2, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 9 sts before M0, k6, p2, k1.

**2nd rnd:** K over k and p over p to 2 sts before M0.

**3rd rnd:** **K2tog**, slip M0, k4, **k2tog tbl**, p1, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 8 sts before M0, k6, p1, k1.

**4th rnd:** K over k and p over p to 2 sts before M0.

**5th rnd:** **K2tog**, slip M0, k4, **k2tog tbl**, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 7 sts before M0, k7.

**6th rnd:** K over k and p over p to 2 sts before M0.

**7th rnd:** **K2tog**, slip M0, k4, **k2tog tbl**, k5, p3, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 6 sts before M0, k6.

**8th rnd:** K over k and p over p to 2 sts before M0.

**9th rnd:** **K2tog**, slip M0, k4, **k2tog tbl**, k4, p3, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 5 sts before M0, k5.

*NOTE! M0 is removed when working the cable on 10th rnd and then placed back on the needle.*

**10th rnd:** Twist, k4, p3, \*twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 5 sts before M0, k3.

**11th rnd:** **K2tog**, slip M0, k4, **k2tog tbl**, k3, p3, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 4 sts before M0, k4.

**12th rnd:** K over k and p over p to 2 sts before M0.

**13th rnd:** **K2tog**, slip M0, k4, **k2tog tbl**, k2, p3, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 3 sts before M0, k3.

**14th rnd:** K over k and p over p to 2 sts before M0.

**15th rnd:** **K2tog**, slip M0, k4, **k2tog tbl**, k1, p3, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 2 sts before M0, k2.

**16th rnd:** K over k and p over p to 2 sts before M0.

**17th rnd:** **K2tog**, slip M0, k4, **k2tog tbl**, p3, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to 1 st before M0, k1.

**18 omg:** K over k and p over p.

**19th rnd:** K over k and p over p to 1 st before M0.

**20th rnd:** \*Twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

*OB!* In sizes M, XL and 4XL work to 2 sts before M0 on **20th rnd**. Then **k2tog** (only applies to this one rnd).

Work **rnds 1st – 20th** another - ( - ) 1 ( - ) 1 (1) - (1) time.

Now continue in the round on circular needles without decreases. Move M0 back to just before the cable under the sleeve (3 sts to the right of centre).

**1st – 9th rnds:** \*K6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

**10th rnd:** \*Twist, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

Work **rnds 1st – 10th** a total of 2 ( - ) 1 ( - ) 1 (1) - (1) time(s).

#### **All sizes**

The sleeve decreases are now completed.

There are now 72 (63) 63 (63) 72 (72) 72 (81) sts on your needles.

Change to 4 mm [US 6] circular needles.

**Sizes XS, 4XL:** \*K6, p1, p2tog\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

**Sizes. S, L:** P2tog, p1, k6, \*p3, k6\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

**Str. M:** K2tog, k4, p3, \*k6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

**XL, 2XL, 3XL:** \*K6, p3\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

There are now 64 (62) 62 (62) 72 (72) 72 (72) sts on your needles.

From here, work the ribbing.

Work \*k1, p1\* until the ribbed edge measures 6 cm [2.5 inches].

Work 2 rnds of double knitting.

**1st rnd:**\*K1, slip 1 st purlwise with yarn in front\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

**2nd rnd:** \*Slip 2 st purlwise with yarn in the back, p1\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of rnd.

Bind off using the Italian/tubular bind off method.

Work the second sleeve in the same way

#### **FINISHING**

Now weave in all loose ends

Sew the buttons to the left side of the button band.

Wash and block cardigan before use to get the right fit and an even cable pattern.
