



Jacquard Sweater

Jacquard Sweater is worked top down. On one shoulder there is a button opening so that you don't need to worry about too tight collar.

Color changes might seem challenging at first, but once you learn small tricks you might even enjoy them! If you still find it challenging or simply want to omit color changes - you can do it as well. Simply work necessary amount of rounds in sc using same color yarn. I do suggest that you work puff stitches though.

The sweater has $\frac{3}{4}$ sleeves, but you can adjust them and make in any other length you like. Same with the length of the sweater.

Sizes and measurements of finished garment:

Gauge

20sts and 20rows in sc to measure 10x10cm or 4x4in using 3.5mm hook, or size required to obtain the gauge

Materials



approx. 525 (700, 875, 1050, 1225) m or 573 (764, 955, 1146, 1337) yards of any sport weight yarn

- small amount of contrasting color yarn

Suggested yarn: Schachenmayr Peach Cotton, 60% Cotton 40% Acrylic, 50g/ 175m (191yds)

- crochet hook 3.5mm or size needed to obtain gauge
- one small button (1.5cm)
- tapestry needle

Stitches and abbreviations

st(s) – stitch(es)

ch – chain stitch

sc – single crochet

dc – double crochet

MC – main color yarn

sp - space

sl st – slip stitch

WS – wrong side

RS – right side

CC – contrasting color yarn

Rnd B: Repeat Rnd A – (1, 2, 3, 4) more times, fasten off and continue with Divide for Sleeves and Body

Divide for Sleeves and Body

Rnd 1 (RS): skip 18 (18, 19, 20, 21) sts from the last stitch you fastened off (including it), join yarn in next st and work, ch1, 3dc in same st where joined, *skip next 2sts, 3dc in next st, skip next st, 3dc in next st*, repeat from * 8 (8, 9, 9, 10) more times, (for size 3-4y – skip next 2sts, 3dc in next st), (for size 7-8y - skip next st, 3dc in next st), ch6 (6, 9, 9, 12), skip next 35 (35, 37, 39, 42) sts (for an armhole), 3dc in next st, repeat from * 9 (9, 10, 10, 11) more times, (for size 3-4y – skip next 2sts, 3dc in next st), (for size 7-8y - skip next st, 3dc in next st), ch6 (6, 9, 9, 12), skip last 17 (17, 18, 19, 21) sts (for an armhole) and join with sl st in first dc; 38 (40, 42, 44, 46) groups of 3dc made; *photo 8-9*

Rnd 2 (RS): ch1, skip first dc, *(sc, ch2, sc) in next st, ch2, skip next 2sts*, repeat from * to end, (all chains worked for underarms count as stitches), join with sl st in first sc; 42 (44, 48, 50, 54) sets of (sc, ch2, sc) made; *photo 10*

Rnd 3 (RS): ch1, skip first sc, 3dc in next ch2sp, *skip next sc, skip next ch2sp, skip next sc, 3dc in next ch2sp*, repeat from * to end, skip next sc, skip next ch2sp, join with sl st in first dc; 42 (44, 48, 50, 54) groups of 3dc made; *photo 11*

Rnd 4 (RS): ch1, skip first dc, *(sc, ch2, sc) in next st, ch2, skip next 2st*, repeat from * to end, join with sl st in first sc; 42 (44, 48, 50, 54) sets of (sc, ch2, sc) made; *photo 12*

Repeat Rnds 3 and 4 – 8 (10, 12, 14, 16) more times or until desired length, fasten off

Sleeves

On RS, join yarn into the middle of the underarm and work

Rnd 1 (RS): ch1, 3dc in same st as ch1, *skip 3sts or space approximately 3sts long, 3dc in next st*, repeat from * to end; join with sl st in first dc; 13 (13, 14, 15, 16) groups of 3dc made; *photo 13*

Rnd 2 (RS): ch1, skip first dc, *(sc, ch2, sc) in next st, ch2, skip next 2sts*, repeat from * to end, join with sl st in first sc; 13 (13, 14, 15, 16) sets of (sc, ch2, sc) made

Rnd 3 (RS): ch1, skip first sc, 3dc in next ch2sp, *skip next sc, skip next ch2sp, skip next sc, 3dc in next ch2sp*, repeat from * to end, skip next sc, skip next ch2sp, join with sl st in first dc; 13 (13, 14, 15, 16) groups of 3dc made

Repeat Rnds 2 and 3 - 5 (7, 9, 11, 13) more times or until desired length

Last Rnd (RS): ch1, skip first dc, *(sc, ch2, sc) in next st, skip next 2sts*, repeat from * to end, join with sl st in first sc; 13 (13, 14, 15, 16) sets of (sc, ch2, sc) made, fasten off; *photo 14*

Second sleeve work in exact same way

Collar Edging

On RS, join yarn on corner of the button opening and work:

Rnd 1: ch1, work evenly sc across the button opening, on second corner make button loop working (sc, ch5, sc), *photo 15*, then work *ch3, skip next 2dc, sc in next sp after last skipped dc*, repeat from * to end and join with sl st in first sc, fasten off

Weave in all ends

Sew on the button opposite the button loop
