Knit sweater

Do you love knitting, working on sophisticated details and really sinking into your project? Then the [#hoodie_jasmina](#) is perfect for

you. The casual hoodie in abbreviated form combines patent ribs as well as additions and decreases in new ways.

Strick Instructions Step by Step

size

36/38 and (40/42)

The information for size 40/42 is in brackets. If only one entry is made, this applies to all sizes.

(All sizes are based on the [Burda dimension table](#))

material

Mixed yarn made of alpaca and merino wool, barrel length 100 m / 50 g for knitting needles 5 – 6 mm

500 (550) g beige

Knitting needles 5 and 6 mm

1 circular needle 5 and 6 mm, each 40 cm long

3 needles of a double pointed needles 6 mm

1 pin

Stitch sample

Smooth left with needles 6 mm: 15 stitches and 20 rows = 10 cm wide and 10 cm high.

Needle size

5 mm and 6 mm

pattern

Rib pattern

1 stitch on the right, 1 stitch on the left alternately.

Smooth left

Knit back rows left, knit back rows right.

Patent rib (= 3 stitches)

1. Row (= back row): 1 stitch with 1 yarn over as if to knit on the left, 1 stitch on the left, 1 stitch with 1 yarn over as if to knit on the left.

2nd Row (= Back row): Knit the stitch and the yarn over on the

left, knit 1 stitch on the right, knit the stitch and the yarn over on the left. The 1st and 2nd Repeat row always.

Nodular rim mesh


Knit right in back and forth rows.

Concrete increases

Right margin: Knit the knotted edge stitch, 2 stitches on the left, knit out of the cross thread to the next stitch 1 stitch on the left.

Left margin: Knit out 1 stitch on the left, 2 stitches on the left, knotted edge stitch from the cross thread to the next stitch.

Step 1

Front part

Cast on 86 (92) stitches with needles 5 mm. Knit in the rib pattern, in the 1st Row = Back row, divide stitches as follows: nodule edge stitch, 1 stitch on the left, 1 stitch on the right always repeat, nodule edge stitch.

Step 2

Continue working after 5 cm with needles 6 mm and divide the stitches as follows: nodule edge stitch, 10 (13) stitches smooth left, 3 stitches patent rib, 20 stitches smooth left, 3 stitches patent rib,

35 stitches smooth left, 3 stitches patent rib, 10 (13) stitches smooth left, nodule edge

Step 3

The 3-mesh patent rib at the beginning and end of the part runs vertically. The middle patent rib runs diagonally to the left and is crossed in each row by 1 stitch to the left as follows: 3 stitches of patent rib on a pin in front of the work, knit 1 stitch on the left, then knit the stitches of the pin. If the middle, diagonal patent rib meets the vertical patent rib on the left edge, the 6 stitches are crossed as follows: 3 stitches of patent rib on a pin in front of the work, knit 3 sts of patent rib, then knit the stitches of the braid needle. The diagonal patent rib continues in every 2nd Cross the row to the left by 1 stitch.

Step 4

Increase 1 x 1 stitch on both sides in a 23 cm total height for the side slope, then in every 4th Increase row 5 x 1 stitch on both sides, with emphasized increases working = 98 (104) stitches. Knit the increased stitches smoothly on the left.

Step 5

Cast off 1 x 5 stitches on both sides in 20 (21) cm arm cut-out height for the shoulder bevels, then in every 2nd Cast off 4 x 5 stitches and 2 x 6 stitches (1 x 5 stitches and 5 x 6 stitches) on both sides.

Step 6

Cast off the middle 14 stitches for the neckline at a total height of 55 (56) cm, at the same time as the shoulder bevel begins, then in every 2nd Remove 1 x 2 stitches and 3 x 1 stitch.

Step 7

Back part

Basically work like the front part, but after the cuff, divide the stitches equally and the diagonal line of 3 patent stitches in every 2nd Cross the row by 1 stitch to the right as follows: Place 1 left stitch on a pin behind the work, knit 3 stitches of patent rib, then knit the stitch of the pin on the left.

Step 8

If the middle, diagonal patent rib meets the vertical patent rib on the right edge, the 6 stitches are crossed as follows: 3 stitches of patent rib on a pin behind the work, knit 3 sts of patent rib, then knit the stitches of the braid needle. The diagonal patent rib continues in every 2nd Row by 1 stitch to the right.

Step 9

The side and shoulder bevels work like the front part.

Step 10

The back part has no neckline. Bind off the remaining 24 stitches at a total height of 62 (63) cm.

Step 11

sleeve

Cast on 50 stitches with needles 5 mm. Knit in a rib pattern, in the 1st Row, = Back row, divide stitches as for the back part. After 5 cm in the last row of the back, increase 1 stitch in the middle = 51 stitches. Continue with needles 6 mm and divide the stitches as follows: nodule edge stitch, 7 stitches smooth left, 3 stitches patent rib, 5 stitches smooth left, 3 stitches patent rib, 31 stitches smooth left, nodule edge.

Step 12

The first patent rib at the beginning of the sleeve is vertical. The second patent rib runs diagonally to the left and is crossed in each row by 1 stitch to the left as follows: 3 stitches of patent rib on a pin in front of the work, knit 1 stitch on the left, then knit the stitches of the pin.

Step 13

For the cuffs in the 3rd Increase row 1 x 1 stitch on both sides, then in every 12. Row 5 x 1 stitch (in the following 12. R 1 x 1 M and every 10. Row 5 x 1 stitch) increase on both sides. = 63 (65) stitches.

Step 14

Bind off all stitches at a total height of 43 cm. 2nd Work sleeves as well.

Step 15

Finish

parts to span, moisten and let dry. Close shoulder seams.

Step 16

For the **hooded** Pick up 62 stitches from the neckline, leaving the middle 4 cm free on the front neckline. Knit smoothly with circular needle 6 mm in open work. Mark the middle 8 stitches for the hood size and increase stitches on both sides of the marked stitches as follows: Before the 8 marked stitches from the cross thread to the next stitch, knit out 1 stitch on the left, knit 8 stitches on the left, after the marked stitch from the cross thread to the next stitch Knit out 1 stitch on the left. These increases in every 2nd Row still work 5 times = 74 stitches.

Step 17

Start with the decreases for the head shape at a total height of 30 cm, mark the middle 18 stitches: Starting from the right edge, knit 1 stitch in front of the 1st marked stitch. Knit this stitch with the 1st marked stitch on the left, knit 16 stitches, knit the last marked stitches together with the following stitch on the left = 72 sts. In the following back row knit up to 1 stitch before the 1st marked stitch, mark this stitch with the 1st marked stitch on the right, knit 16 stitches Repeat these decreases 3 times in each back and forth row. = a total of 8 stitches removed = 66 stitches.

Step 18

Now shut down the stitches on both sides of the marked 18 stitches and then work like a cap when knitting socks, for this spread the stitches on 3 needles of a double pointed needles 6 mm: 1st and 3rd Needle: 24 stitches, 2nd Needle: 18 stitches.

Step 19

Now work as follows: back row: *the last stitch of the middle 18 stitches with the 1st Knit the stitch of the following needle on the left, turn work, the 1st Take off the stitch, knit 16 sts on the right, the last stitch of the middle 18 marked stitches with the 1st Knit the stitch of the following needle on the right, turn work, the 1st Take off the stitches on the right *repeat until all side stitches are

used up. There are still 18 stitches on the needle. Now hold 18 stitches from the hooded edge on both sides 53 stitches each = 124 stitches. Knit 5 mm in a rib pattern with a circular needle, in the 1st Row, = Back row, divide the stitches as follows and at the same time increase 1 stitch in the middle: nodule edge stitch, * 1 stitch on the left, 1 stitch on the right, 1 stitch on the left, nodule edge stitch = 125 stitches.

Step 20

Cast off all sts as they appear after 4 cm rib pattern. Place the ribs on top of each other in the front center, on the right above the left, and sew narrow sides on the neckline edge. Sew the sleeves on both sides of the shoulder seam each 20 (21) cm. Close the side and sleeve seams.
