



Jasmine Sweater

Jasmine Sweater is worked top down with circular yoke, then divided for sleeves and body part. The sweater is seamless.

While initially the pattern was designed for children it includes a bonus – instructions for adult size S-M! You can achieve larger size too using slightly thicker yarn and/or bigger crochet hook!

Materials



approx. 540 (675, 810, 1080, 1215, 1485)m or 592 (740, 888, 1184, 1332, 1628)yards of any DK weight

Suggested yarn: Rowan baby merino silk DK, shade Pebble (690), 50g - 135m/148y

- crochet hook 4mm or size needed to obtain gauge

Gauge

With DK weight yarn – work 18 sts and 10 rows in dc to measure 10x10cm or 4x4in using 4mm hook, or size required to obtain the gauge

Stitches and abbreviations

st(s) – stitch(es)	sp - space
ch – chain stitch	sl st – slip stitch
sc – single crochet	WS – wrong side
dc – double crochet	RS – right side



Pattern is written for size 1-2y, changes for sizes 3-4y, 5-6y, 7-8y, 9-10y and S-M are in (...)

Ch1 at the beginning of rnd doesn't count as stitch

Special stitches

Bobble (bo): *yarn over, insert hook in specified st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops*, two loops on hook (*photo 1*), repeat from * two more times working in same stitch, (*photo 2*) yarn over and draw through all four loops (*photo 3*)

Crossed double crochet (crossed dc)

Worked over 3sts, skip 2sts, dc in next st (*photo 1*), ch1, dc in first skipped stitch working over dc just made (*photo 2*)

V-stitch (v-st)

Work (dc, ch1, dc) into specified stitch



Front post double crochet (FPdc)

Yarn over, insert hook from front to back around next stitch, yarn over, pull through (*photo 1*), three loops on hook (*photo 2*); finish front post double crochet (FPdc) as normal dc (*photo 3*)

Back post double crochet (BPdc)

Yarn over, insert hook from back to front around next stitch, yarn over, pull through (*photo 1*), three loops on hook (*photo 2*); finish back post double crochet (BPdc) as normal dc (*photo 3*)

Yoke

The Yoke is worked in rounds, mainly on RS, but for rows with bobbles you will have to turn and work on WS

Foundation chain: work loosely, ch60 (66, 66, 72, 72, 78), join with sl st in first st

Rnd 1 (RS): ch1, but pull it to the height of dc here and throughout where next st is dc or bo, dc in first and in each next ch to end, join with sl st in first dc; 60 (66, 66, 72, 72, 78) dc

Rnd 2 (RS): ch1, sc in first st, *ch2, skip next st, sc in next st*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last sc join with sl st in first sc, turn and work on WS; 30 (33, 33, 36, 36, 39) ch2sp made (*photo 1*)

Rnd 3 (WS): ch1, bo in first sc, *sc in next ch2sp, bo in next sc*, repeat from * to last ch2sp, sc in last ch2sp, join with sl st in first bo, turn and work on RS; 30 (33, 33, 36, 36, 39) bo made (*photo 2*)

Rnd 4 (RS): ch1, 2dc in first st, 2dc in each next st to end, join with sl st in first dc; 120 (132, 132, 144, 144, 156)dc (*photo 3*)

Rnd 5 (RS): ch1, skip first and next dc, dc in next st, ch1, dc in skipped st working over dc just made, *crossed dc worked over next 3sts*, repeat from * to end, join with sl st in first dc; 40 (44, 44, 48, 48, 52) crossed dc made (*photo 4*)

Rnd 6 (RS): ch1, skip first dc, sc in next ch1sp, *ch2, skip next 2dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last sc join with sl st in first sc; 40 (44, 44, 48, 48, 52) ch2sp made

Rnd 7 (RS): ch1, sc in previous ch2sp, *ch2, skip next sc, sc in next ch2sp*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last sc join with sl st in first sc, turn and work on WS; 40 (44, 44, 48, 48, 52) ch2sp made (*photo 5*)

Rnd 8 (WS): ch1, bo in first sc, *sc in next ch2sp, bo in next sc*, repeat from * to last ch2sp, sc in last ch2sp, join with sl st in first bo, turn and work on RS; 40 (44, 44, 48, 48, 52) bo made

Rnd 9 (RS): ch1, 1 (3, 3, 2, 2, 1)dc in first st, 2dc in each next st to end, join with sl st in first dc; 159 (177, 177, 192, 192, 207) dc

Rnd 10 (RS): ch1, skip first and next dc, dc in next st, ch1, dc in skipped st working over dc just made, *crossed dc worked over next 3sts*, repeat from * to end, join with sl st in first dc; 53 (59, 59, 64, 64, 69) crossed dc made

Rnd 11 (RS): ch1, skip first dc, sc in next ch1sp, *ch2, skip next 2dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last sc join with sl st in first sc; (53 (59, 59, 64, 64, 69) ch2sp made

Rnd 12 (RS): ch1, sc in previous ch2sp, *ch2, skip next sc, sc in next ch2sp*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last sc join with sl st in first sc, turn and work on WS; 53 (59, 59, 64, 64, 69) ch2sp made

Rnd 13 (WS): ch1, bo in first sc, *sc in next ch2sp, bo in next sc*, repeat from * to last ch2sp, sc in last ch2sp, join with sl st in first bo, turn and work on RS; 53 (59, 59, 64, 64, 69) bo made

For sizes 1-2y and 3-4y continue with Divide for Sleeves and Body

For all other sizes work next rnds

Rnd 14 (RS): ch1, (3, 2, 2, 2) dc in first st, *2dc in each of next 2sts, dc in next st*, repeat from * to end (to last st, dc in last st), join with sl st in first dc; (198, 213, 213, 231) dc

Rnd 15 (RS): ch1, skip first and next dc, dc in next st, ch1, dc in skipped st working over dc just made, *crossed dc worked over next 3sts*, repeat from * to end, join with sl st in first dc; (66, 71, 71, 77) crossed dc made

Rnd 16 (RS): ch1, skip first dc, sc in next ch1sp, *ch2, skip next 2dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last sc join with sl st in first sc; (66, 71, 71, 77) ch2sp made

Rnd 17 (RS): ch1, sc in previous ch2sp, *ch2, skip next sc, sc in next ch2sp*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last sc join with sl st in first sc, turn and work on WS; (66, 71, 71, 77) ch2sp made

Rnd 18 (WS): ch1, bo in first sc, *sc in next ch2sp, bo in next sc*, repeat from * to last ch2sp, sc in last ch2sp, join with sl st in first bo, turn and work on RS; (66, 71, 71, 77) bo made

For sizes 5-6y and 7-8y continue with Divide for Sleeves and Body

For sizes 9-10y and S-M work next rnds

Rnd 19 (RS): ch1, dc in first st and in each next (3, 1) sts, *2dc in each of next 2sts, dc in next st*, repeat from * to end, join with sl st in first dc; (234, 255) dc

Rnd 20 (RS): ch1, skip first and next dc, dc in next st, ch1, dc in skipped st working over dc just made, *crossed dc worked over next 3sts*, repeat from * to end, join with sl st in first dc; (78, 85) crossed dc made

Rnd 21 (RS): ch1, skip first dc, sc in next ch1sp, *ch2, skip next 2dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last sc join with sl st in first sc; (78, 85) ch2sp made

Rnd 22 (RS): ch1, sc in previous ch2sp, *ch2, skip next sc, sc in next ch2sp*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of

last sc join with sl st in first sc, turn and work on WS; (78, 85) ch2sp made

Rnd 23 (WS): ch1, bo in first sc, *sc in next ch2sp, bo in next sc*, repeat from * to last ch2sp, sc in last ch2sp, join with sl st in first bo, turn and work on RS; (78, 85) bo made

For size 9-10y continue with Divide for Sleeves and Body

For size S-M work next rnds

Rnd 24 (RS): ch1, dc in first st and in each next 3sts, *2dc in each of next 2sts, dc in next st*, repeat from * to last 4st, 2dc in next st, dc in next 3sts, join with sl st in first dc; (279) dc

Rnd 25 (RS): ch1, skip first and next dc, dc in next st, ch1, dc in skipped st working over dc just made, *crossed dc worked over next 3sts*, repeat from * to end, join with sl st in first dc; (93) crossed dc made

Rnd 26 (RS): ch1, skip first dc, sc in next ch1sp, *ch2, skip next 2dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last sc join with sl st in first sc; (93) ch2sp made

Rnd 27 (RS): ch1, sc in previous ch2sp, *ch2, skip next sc, sc in next ch2sp*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last sc join with sl st in first sc, turn and work on WS; (93) ch2sp made

Rnd 28 (WS): ch1, bo in first sc, *sc in next ch2sp, bo in next sc*, repeat from * to last ch2sp, sc in last ch2sp, join with sl st in first bo, turn and work on RS; (93) bo made, continue with Divide for Sleeves and Body

Divide for body and sleeves

Rnd 1 for size 1-2y (RS): ch1, dc in first st, *2dc in next st, 1dc in next st*, repeat from * 13 more times, 2dc in next st, ch6, skip next 23 sts for an armhole, repeat from * 15 more times, ch6, skip next 23 sts for an armhole, join with sl st in first dc; 102 sts (photo 6)

Rnd 1 for sizes 3-4y, 5-6y, 7-8y (RS): ch1, dc in first st, *2dc in next st, 1dc in next st*, repeat from * (6, 7, 7) more times, dc in each of next (5, 7, 7)sts, repeat from * (7, 7, 8) more times, ch(8, 8, 10), skip next (25, 28, 31)sts for an armhole, dc in next st, repeat from * (7, 8, 8) more times, dc in each of next (5, 7, 7)sts, repeat from * (7, 7, 8) more times, ch(8, 8, 10), skip next (25, 28, 31)sts for an armhole, join with sl st in first dc; (112, 122, 132)sts (photo 6)

Rnd 1 for sizes 9-10y, S-M (RS): ch1, dc in first st, *2dc in next st, dc in each of next 2sts*, repeat from * (14, 17) more times, ch(10, 12), skip next (32, 38)sts for an armhole, dc in next st, repeat from * (15, 18) more times, ch(10, 12), skip next (32, 38)sts for an armhole, join with sl st in first dc; (142, 170)sts (photo 6)

Rnd 2 (RS): ch1, sc in first st, v-st in next st, skip next st, *sc in next st, v-st in next st, skip next st*, repeat from * to end, for sizes 3-4y and 9-10y last repeat work in following way (skip next st, sc in next st, skip next st, v-st in next st), join with sl

st in first sc, turn and work on WS; 34 (37, 41, 44, 47, 57) v-st made

Rnd 3 (WS): ch1, dc in first sc, *skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp, skip next dc, v-st in next sc*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last v-st work (dc, ch1) in same st as first dc and join with sl st in first dc, turn and work on RS; 34 (37, 41, 44, 47, 57) v-st made

Rnd 4 (RS): ch1, sc in next ch1sp, *skip next dc, v-st in next sc, skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * to last sc, v-st in last sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn and work on WS; 34 (37, 41, 44, 47, 57) v-st made

Repeat Rnds 3 and 4 – 6 (8, 8, 10, 10, 14) more times

Repeat Rnd 3 once more and continue with Back

Decreasing

Back Decreasing

Work in rows

Row 1 (RS): ch1, sc in next ch1sp, *skip next dc, v-st in next sc, skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * 13 (15, 16, 17, 19, 24) more times, turn; 14 (16, 17, 18, 20, 25) v-st made

Row 2 (WS): ch2 (doesn't count as st), skip first st and skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp, *skip next dc, v-st in next sc, skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * 12 (14, 15, 16, 18, 23) more times, skipping last sc turn; 13 (15, 16, 17, 19, 24) v-st made

Row 3: ch2 (doesn't count as st), skip first st and skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp, *skip next dc, v-st in next sc, skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * to end, skipping last sc turn; 12 (14, 15, 16, 18, 23) v-st made

Repeat Row 3 – 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 8) more times; 8 (10, 11, 10, 12, 15) v-sts, fasten off

Front Decreasing

On RS, skip 2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 3) v-sts from the Back and join yarn into the next ch1sp; work in rows

Row 1 (RS): ch1, sc in sp at the base of ch1, *skip next dc, v-st in next sc, skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * 13 (14, 15, 17, 18, 23) more times, turn; 14 (15, 16, 18, 19, 24) v-st made

Row 2 (WS): ch2 (doesn't count as st), skip first st and skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp, *skip next dc, v-st in next sc, skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * 12 (13, 14, 16, 17, 22) more times, turn; 13 (14, 15, 17, 18, 23) v-st made

Row 3: ch2 (doesn't count as st), skip first st and skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp, *skip next dc, v-st in next sc, skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * to end, turn; 12 (13, 14, 16, 17, 22) v-st made

Repeat Row 3 – 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 8) more times; 8 (9, 10, 10, 11, 14) v-sts, don't fasten off, but continue with Edging

Edging

Rnd 1 (RS): ch1, but pull it longer, 3dc in st at the base of ch1, work evenly dc across the Front and the Back, on corners work 3dc in one st, at the end of rnd work only once 3dc in one st as you started the rnd with 3dc, join with sl st in first dc (*number of sts is not important here but it has to be even number*) (photo 7)

Rnd 2 (RS): ch1, FPdc around first dc, *BPdc around next dc, FPdc around next dc*, repeat from * to last dc, BPdc around last dc, join with sl st in first dc

Repeat Rnd 2 but on the corners work (2BPdc around next BPdc, FPdc around next FPdc, 2BPdc around next BPdc) (photo 8)

Repeat Rnd 2 working FPdc around each FPdc and BPdc around each BPdc

Last Rnd (optional): ch1, FPdc around first FPdc, *sc in next BPdc, FPdc around next FPdc, (sc, ch3, sc) in next BPdc, FPdc around next FPdc*, repeat from * to end, where you have 2BPdc work (sc in next BPdc, ch3, sc in next BPdc), join with sl st in first FPdc, fasten off (photo 9)

Sleeves

On RS, join yarn in the middle of the underarm (photo 10), turn after each round and work on both RS and WS

Rnd 1 (RS): ch1, sc in st at the base of ch1, work evenly 10 (11, 11, 12, 13, 15) repeats of (skip 1st, v-st in next st, skip 1st, sc in next st) around the armhole, instead of last sc join with sl st in first sc, turn and work on WS; 10 (11, 11, 12, 13, 15) v-sts made

Rnd 2 (WS): ch1, dc in first sc, *skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp, skip next dc, v-st in next sc*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last v-st work (dc, ch1) in same st as first dc and join with sl st in first dc, turn and work on RS; 10 (11, 11, 12, 13, 15) v-sts made

Rnd 3 (RS): ch1, sc in next ch1sp, *skip next dc, v-st in next sc, skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * to last sc, v-st in last sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn and work on WS; 10 (11, 11, 12, 13, 15) v-sts made

Sleeves are supposed to be fitted from the start, but if necessary you can decrease as described below, otherwise repeat Rnds 2 and 3 – 7 (9, 11, 13, 15, 17) more times or until the sleeve is 16 (18, 21, 23, 25, 30) cm long, measured from underarm, or until desired length, (cuff will add approx.. 3 (4, 4, 5, 5, 6) cm)

Decreasing

Rnd 1 (WS): ch1, skip first sc, *skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp, skip next dc, v-st in next sc*, repeat from * to last v-st, sc in last ch1sp and join with sl st in first sc, turn and work on RS; 9 (10, 10, 11, 12, 14) v-sts made

Rnd 2 (RS): ch1, dc in first sc, skip next sc, *skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp, skip next dc, v-st in next sc*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last v-st work (dc, ch1) in same st as first dc and join with sl st in first dc, turn and work on WS; 9 (10, 10, 11, 12, 14) v-sts made

Rnd 3 (WS): ch1, sc in next ch1sp, *skip next dc, v-st in next sc, skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp*, repeat from * to last sc, v-st in last sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn and work on WS; 9 (10, 10, 11, 12, 14) v-sts made

Rnd 4 (RS): ch1, dc in first sc, *skip next dc, sc in next ch1sp, skip next dc, v-st in next sc*, repeat from * to end, in last repeat instead of last v-st work (dc, ch1, in same st as first dc and join with sl st in first dc, turn and work on RS; 9 (10, 10, 11, 12, 14) v-sts made

If you need to decrease more, repeat Rnds 1 through 4 as many times as needed, keeping in mind that in each repeat you decrease by one v-st

After decreasing to desired width, repeat Rnds 3 and 4 until desired length or until the sleeve is 16 (18, 21, 23, 25, 30) cm long, measured from underarm, (cuff will add approx.. 3 (4, 4, 5, 5, 6) cm), continue with Cuff

Cuff

Rnd 1 (RS): ch1, skip first dc, dc in next sc, *skip next dc, 2dc in next ch1sp, skip next dc, dc in next sc*, repeat from * to last v-st, 2dc in last ch1sp and join with sl st in first dc

Rnd 2 (RS): ch1, FPdc around first dc, *BPdc around next dc, FPdc around next dc*, repeat from * to last st, BPdc around last dc, join with sl st in first dc

Rnd 3 (RS): ch1, FPdc around first FPdc, *BPdc around next BPdc, FPdc around next FPdc*, repeat from * to last st, BPdc around last BPdc, join with sl st in first dc

Repeat Rnd 3 – 1 (3, 3, 5, 5, 7) more times

Last Rnd: ch1, FPdc around first FPdc, *sc in next BPdc, FPdc around next FPdc, (sc, ch3, sc) in next BPdc, FPdc around next FPdc*, repeat from * to last st, sc in last BPdc, join with sl st in first FPdc, fasten off, (*photo 11*)

Second sleeve work in exact same way

Collar

Rnd 1 (RS): join yarn into first st of collar and work ch1, FPdc around first dc, *BPdc around next dc, FPdc around next dc* repeat from * to last st, BPdc around next st, join with sl st in first st

Rnd 2 (RS): ch1, FPdc around first FPdc, *BPdc around next BPdc, FPdc around next FPdc*, repeat from * to last st, BPdc around last BPdc, join with sl st in first dc

Repeat Rnd 2 – 0 (1, 1, 1, 2, 2) more times, fasten off

Weave in ends, wash and block
