

Knittingforsif



Erantis Gloves Mini

Sizes: 0-3 (3-6) 6-12 months.

Recommended needles: Double – pointed needles 2,5 mm + 3 mm.

Recommended yarn: Knitting for Olive: Merino, Cotton Merino, Pure silk (meterage 250 m/ 50g).

Amount of yarn: Approx 14 (16) 18 g (yardage for 2 gloves).

Gauge: 28 sts x 38 rows in stockinette stitch on needle 3 mm = 10 x 10 cm.

Erantis Gloves Mini are worked in the round in stockinette stitch from the wrist to the fingertips.
On the wrist the Erantis lace is knitted.

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The pattern and the finished project are for private use only.

Cast on 36 (36) 36 sts on dpn 3 mm with the provisional cast on (if you are not familiar with this method, you might want to search Youtube). This method is important because the sts will later be knitted in the opposite direction.

Place 1 stm at the beginning of the round = stm1.

Knit 2 rnds in stockinette stitch.

Work eyelets for the I-cord as follows:

k2tog, yo repeat from * to * around.

Sizes (3–6) 6–12 months only:

Knit 1 rnd.

Knit 1 rnd and at the same time increase (2) 4 sts evenly across the round (pick up the bar between 2 sts and knit it tbl) = (38) 40 sts.

All sizes:

Continue in stockinette stitch until the work measures 6 (7) 7.5 cm.

Place stm2 as follows:

Round begins at stm1.

Knit 18 (19) 20 sts, place stm2, knit to stm1.

Knit decreases as follows:

1st rnd: K1, ssk, knit until 3 sts before stm, k2tog, k1, slip stm to right needle, k1, ssk, knit until 3 sts before stm, k2tog, k1, slip stm to right needle.

2nd rnd: Knit all sts.

Repeat rnds 1–2 a total of 3 times = 24 (26) 28 sts.

Work rnd 1 another 3 (3) 4 times = 12 (14) 12 sts.

Knit k2tog around.

Cut the yarn and pull it through the remaining sts.

Now the lace is knit from the right side from the bottom up. Begin at **stm1**.

Transfer the sts from the provisional cast-on thread to 3 mm double pointed needles.

You will now be knitting upwards from the wrist.

With a provisional cast on, every other stitch will be twisted.

Knit 1 rnd and at the same time untwist the twisted sts so all sts are knitted normally.

Knit 7 sts, place 1 stm – **the round now begins here**. Remove stm1.

The lace will ripple as you knit it, but it evens out beautifully after washing and blocking.

Avoid working the 9in3 stitch too tightly.

Knit the lace as follows:

Rnd 1: *9in3, k2tog tbl, k5, k2tog* repeat from * to * around.

Rnd 2: *k9, k2tog tbl, k3, k2tog* repeat from * to * around.

Rnd 3: *k3, yo, k3, yo, k3, k2tog tbl, k1, k2tog* repeat from * to * around.

Rnd 4: *k11, k3tog* repeat from * to * around.

Rnd 5: *s1kp, yo, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, yo, s1kp, k1* repeat from * to * around.

Rnd 6: Knit all sts.

Rnd 7: Move the stm 1 stitch forward and slip this stitch purlwise onto the right needle, so the first stitch of the round now becomes the last stitch of the next round.

k3, yo, s1kp, yo, k3, yo, k3tog, yo repeat from * to * around.

Knit the edge as follows: Work 1 rnd purl, 1 rnd knit, 1 rnd purl and cast off loosely.

Knit the I-cord strap as follows: cast on 3 sts on double pointed needles 2.5 mm. *K3, push all sts to the other end of the needle, without turning the needle*. Place the yarn behind your work, tighten properly. Repeat from * to *, until the strap measures approx. 30-32 cm or has the desired length.

Finishing: Weave in all ends. Thread I-cord through eyelets. Wash and block the mittens.

Abbreviations

|-----------|---|--|
| st(s) | = | stitch(es) |
| k | = | knit |
| p | = | purl |
| stm | = | stitch marker |
| yo | = | yarn over |
| k2tog | = | knit 2 sts together |
| k2tog tbl | = | knit 2 sts together through the back loop |
| P2tog tbl | = | purl 2 sts together through the back loop (check the video on www.knittingforsif.dk) |
| rs | = | right side |
| s1kp | = | decrease: slip 1 st purlwise, k1, pass the slipped st over |
| s2kp | = | double decrease: slip 2 sts purlwise, k1, pass the slipped sts over |
| M1L | = | pick up the bar between 2 sts and knit the bar through the back loop |
| 9in3 | = | k3tog, but keep st on left needle, (yo, k1) 4 times into these 3 sts, let the 3 sts glide off the left needle (Check out the video at www.knittingforsif.dk, where I explain 9in3) |
