





 Knitting needles: 5 mm
 Circular knitting needles: 4,5 mm with
 a 40 cm cable

STITCHES

2x2 Ribbing
 Stocking st
 Edge st
 Small honeycomb relief st (see graph A)
 Circular 2x2 ribbing:
 1st rnd: * k2, p2 * rep from * to *.
 2nd rnd and all foll rnds: Work same as
 1st rnd.

TENSION

Using 5 mm needles in Small
 honeycomb relief st:
 20 sts and 42 rows = 10 x 10 cm

BACK

Using 5 mm needles **cast on** –a) 118 –b) 128 –c) 136 –d) 146 sts and continue working in 2x2 Ribbing. Start ribbing with k2 and finish with –a) k2 –b) p2 –c) p2 –d) k2.

When back measures 10 cm from start, continue working in Small honeycomb relief st foll letter –a) A –b) B –c) B –d) A of graph A, **except** first and last sts which are worked in Edge st.

Raglan armholes: When back measures 34 cm from start, **cast off** at each edge = at start of next 2 rows, as foll: 3 sts 1 time. Total: –a) 112 –b) 122 –c) 130 –d) 140 sts. Continue **dec** at each edge (= 2 sts in from edges) of every right side row of work as foll: –a) 1 st 38 times –b) 1 st 40 times –c) 1 st 42 times –d) 1 st 44 times.

Note: Work dec as foll: At right side edge: 1 simple dec, and at left side edge: k2 tog. Work 2 Edge sts in Stocking st.

Neckline: When back measures –a) 18 –b) 19 –c) 20 –d) 21 cm from start of raglan armhole shaping, **cast off** rem –a) 36 –b) 42 –c) 46 –d) 52 sts.

FRONT

Using 5 mm needles **cast on** –a) 118 –b) 128 –c) 136 –d) 146 sts and continue working in 2x2 Ribbing. Start ribbing with k2 and finish with –a) k2 –b) p2 –c) p2 –d) k2.

When front measures 10 cm from start, continue working in Small honeycomb relief st foll letter –a) A –b) B –c) B –d) A of graph A, **except** first and last sts which are worked in Edge st.

Raglan armholes: When the front measures 34 cm from start, **cast off** at each edge = at start of next 2 rows, as foll: 3 sts 1 time. Total: –a) 112 –b) 122 –c) 130 –d) 140 sts. Continue **dec** at each edge (= 2 sts in from edges) of every right side row of work as foll: –a) 1 st 33 times –b) 1 st 35 times –c) 1 st 37 times –d) 1 st 39 times.

Note: Work dec as foll: At right side edge: 1 simple dec, and at left side edge: k2 tog. Work 2 Edge sts in Stocking st.


Neckline: When front measures –a) 14 –b) 15 –c) 16 –d) 17 cm from start of raglan armhole shaping, **cast off** central –a) 16 –b) 22 –c) 26 –d) 32 sts and continue working each side separately, **casting off** at start of every right side row of work at neckline edge as foll: 4 sts 1 time, 3 sts 2 times, 2 sts 1 time, 1 st 2 times. Work other side in same manner, but **reverse** shaping.

SLEEVES

Using 5 mm needles, **cast on** –a) 86 –b) 90 –c) 94 –d) 98 sts and continue working in 2x2 Ribbing. Start and finish ribbing with k2. When sleeve measures 8 cm from start, continue working in Small honeycomb relief st foll letter A of graph A, **except** first and last sts which are worked in Edge st.

-a) 80 **-b)** 84 **-c)** 88 **-d)** 92 sts. Continue **dec** at each edge (= 2 sts in from edges).

Note: Work dec as foll: At right side edge: 1 simple dec, and at left side edge: k2 tog. Work 2 Edge sts in Stocking st.

Right side edge: -a) On every 2nd row: * dec 1 st 5 times, work 1 right side row without dec * work from * to * a total of 5 times and finish on every 2nd row with: 1 st 5 times. Then **cast off** at start of every right side row of work as foll: 6 sts 3 times.

-b) On every 2nd row: * dec 1 st 5 times, work 1 right side row without dec * work from * to * a total of 5 times and finish on every 2nd row with: 1 st 7 times. Then **cast off** at start of every right side row of work as foll: 6 sts 3 times.

-c) On every 2nd row: * dec 1 st 5 times, work 1 right side row without dec * work from * to * a total of 5 times and finish on every 2nd row with: 1 st 9 times. Then **cast off** at start of every right side row of work as foll: 6 sts 3 times.

-d) On every 2nd row: * dec 1 st 5 times, work 1 right side row without dec * work from * to * a total of 5 times and finish on every 2nd row with: 1 st 11 times. Then **cast off** at start of every right side row of work as foll: 6 sts 3 times.

Left side edge: -a) On every 2nd row: * dec 1 st 5 times, work 1 right side row without dec * work from * to * a total of 5 times and finish on every 2nd row with: 1 st 7 times.

-b) On every 2nd row: * dec 1 st 5 times, work 1 right side row without dec * work from * to * a total of 5 times and finish on every 2nd row with: 1 st 9 times.

-c) On every 2nd row: * dec 1 st 5 times, work 1 right side row without dec * work from * to * a total of 5 times and finish on every 2nd row with: 1 st 11 times.

-d) On every 2nd row: * dec 1 st 5 times, work 1 right side row without dec * work from * to * a total of 5 times and finish on every 2nd row with: 1 st 13 times. Work another sleeve the same, but **reverse** shaping.

FINISHING

Sew shortest part of raglan armhole on sleeve to front.

Neckband: Using 4,5 mm circular needles **pick up -a)** 100 **-b)** 116 **-c)** 128 **-d)** 144 sts around the neckline and continue working in Circular 2x2 ribbing. Start ribbing with k2 and finish with p2. When neckband measures 22 cm from start, **cast off** all sts.

Sew underarm seams and sides.

WOLMUS (foto bo)

MATERIALS

KATIA LOVE WOOL TONES

(85% virgin wool, 15% superfine alpaca): 1 ball col. 200

Stitch markers

Circular knitting needles: 10 mm with a 60 cm cable

STITCHES

Circular 1x1 ribbing

Circular stocking st

TENSION

Using 10 mm needles in Circular stocking st:

9 sts and 12 rows = 10 x 10 cm

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 46 sts and continue working in Circular 1x1 ribbing.

Note: Place a st marker at start of each round to keep a better check on number of rnds being worked.

When hat measures 4 cm, continue working in Circular stocking st. When hat measures 16 cm from start, start to **dec** in foll manner:

1st rnd: k2 tog a total of 23 times = 23 sts.


2nd rnd: k2 tog a total of 11 times and k1 = 12 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a longish length. Thread a wool sewing needle with yarn, pass yarn through all sts on needle and pull **as firmly as possible** to draw all sts together. Secure in place with a few sts.

MATERIALS

KATIA REIKI (60% superfine alpaca, 29% merino, 11% polyamide): –a) 7 –b) 7

–c) 7 –d) 8 balls col. 107

Stitch markers

Circular knitting needles: 6 mm with 100 cm, 60 cm and 40 cm cables

STITCHES

Circular 1x1 ribbing

Circular stocking st

Circular eyelet st (see graph A)

TENSION

Using 6 mm circular needles in

Circular stocking st:

13 sts and 22 rows = 10 x 10 cm

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: This **top-down** jumper is made in the round on circular needles from the top downwards. It is made in one piece only. Therefore, it is a seamless jumper. It is started at the neckband with the right side facing, distributing increases throughout the yoke as far as the sleeves. The sleeves are then left on hold and brought back into work later.

Neckband: Using 60 cm cable, **cast on** –a) 64 –b) 68 –c) 72 –d) 76 sts and continue working in Circular 1x1 ribbing.

Note: To keep a better check on number of rnds being worked, place a stitch marker at start of each rnd and **change** to 100 cm cable when necessary due to a larger number of sts on needle. When neckband measures 4 cm, continue working with foll st distribution:

Yoke: Raglan armholes: Distribute the parts, place stitch markers (= **M**) and, **at the same time, inc** in foll manner: **M**, 23 sts in Circular eyelet st foll graph A (back), **M**, 1 st in Circular stocking st, 1 yo, –a) 7 –b) 9 –c) 11 –d) 13 sts in Circular stocking st, 1 yo, 1 st in Circular stocking st (sleeve), **M**, 23 sts in Circular eyelet st foll graph A (front), **M**, 1 st in Circular stocking st, 1 yo, –a) 7 –b) 9 –c) 11 –d) 13 sts in Circular stocking st, 1 yo, 1 st in Circular stocking st (sleeve).

Note: The increases on front and back are represented on graph A. Continue **inc** in same manner on every 2nd rnd a total of: –a) 1 st 23 times –b) 1 st 24 times –c) 1 st 25 times –d) 1 st 26 times. Total: –a) 248 –b) 260 –c) 272 –d) 284 sts. When work measures –a) 20 cm –b) 21 cm –c) 22 cm –d) 23 cm from start of raglan armhole shaping and after finishing all inc [= finish foll the letter –a) A –b) B –c) C –d) D of graph A], **separate** sleeves from body in foll manner: –a) 55 –b) 59 –c) 63 –d) 67 sts from stitch marker to stitch marker for each sleeve and –a) 69 –b) 71

–c) 73 –d) 75 sts for each part of body. **Body: Bring back into work** –a) 69 –b) 71 –c) 73 –d) 75 sts from back and work in Circular eyelet st foll letter –a) A –b) B –c) C –d) D of graph A continuing on the rnd that finished after increases, **add** –a) 8 –b) 8 –c) 9 –d) 10 sts for underarm and work in Circular stocking st. **Bring back into work** –a) 69 –b) 71 –c) 73 –d) 75 sts from front and work in Circular eyelet st foll letter –a) A –b) B –c) C –d) D of graph A, continuing on the rnd that finished after increases, **add** –a) 8 –b) 8 –c) 9 –d) 10 sts for other underarm and work in Circular stocking st.

Note: Leave 1 stitch marker only to indicate start of each rnd. Total: –a) 154 –b) 158 –c) 164 –d) 170 sts. When body measures 38 cm from start of body, continue working in Circular 1x1 ribbing. When work measures 7 cm from start of ribbing, loosely **cast off** all sts as they present themselves.

Sleeves: Using 40 cm cable, **bring back into work** –a) 55 –b) 59 –c) 63 –d) 67 sts from one sleeve and **add** –a) 8 –b) 8 –c) 9 –d) 10 sts for underarm.








-a) 3rd row: 2 sts * 8 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times and finish with 2 sts (= 76 sts). **5th row:** 2 sts * 7 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times and finish with 2 sts (= 68 sts). **7th row:** 2 sts * 6 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times and finish with 2 sts (= 60 sts). **9th row:** 2 sts * 5 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times and finish with 2 sts (= 52 sts). **11th row:** 2 sts * 4 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times and finish with 2 sts (= 44 sts). **13th row:** 2 sts * 3 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times and finish with 2 sts (= 36 sts).

-b) 3rd row: * 9 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times (= 80 sts). **5th row:**

* 8 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times (= 72 sts). **7th row:** * 7 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times (= 64 sts). **9th row:** * 6 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times (= 56 sts).

11th row: * 5 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times (= 48 sts). **13th row:** * 4 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times (= 40 sts).

-c) 3rd row: 2 sts * 9 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times and finish with 2 sts (= 84 sts). **5th row:** 2 sts * 8 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times and finish with 2 sts (= 76 sts). **7th row:** 2 sts * 7 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times and finish with 2 sts (= 68 sts).

9th row: 2 sts * 6 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times and finish with 2 sts (= 60 sts). **11th row:** 2 sts * 5 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times and finish with 2 sts (= 52 sts). **13th row:** 2 sts * 4 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times and finish with 2 sts (= 44 sts).

-d) 3rd row: * 10 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times (= 88 sts). **5th row:** * 9 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times (= 80 sts). **7th row:** * 8 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times (= 72 sts). **9th row:** * 7 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times (= 64 sts).

11th row: * 6 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times (= 56 sts). **13th row:** * 5 sts, k2 tog *, rep from * to * a total of 8 times (= 48 sts).

When hat measures **-a)** 16 cm **-b)** 17 cm **-c)** 18 cm **-d)** 19 cm from start, **cut** yarn leaving a longish length. Thread a wool sewing needle with yarn and **pass it through** inside of all sts and pull as firmly as possible to draw them all together. Use same yarn to **sew** back seam of hat.

FINISHING

Pompon: Cut cardboard disks with a diameter 5 cm and make a pompon using lime. **Sew** onto top of hat.

3 Wrap yarn over hook and draw through 2 loops on hook.

4 The first dc has been worked. To make the following stitch, insert hook in next ch st and repeat steps 2 and 3.

5 Work 1 dc in each base ch st. When all stitches have been completed, turn work to begin next row.

6 Start the following row with 1 ch st, insert hook in next base st and work 1 dc.

TREBLE STITCH (tr)

1 Wrap yarn over hook and insert hook in 4th ch, counting from the stitch on the hook.

2 Wrap yarn over hook and draw through first loop of the 3 on hook (= 3 loops).

3 Wrap yarn over hook and draw through first 2 loops on hook (= 2 loops).


4 Wrap yarn over hook and draw through 2 remaining loops.

5 The first dc has been worked. Wrap yarn over hook and insert in next ch st.




