This shawl will get you wrapped in nature — just watch while you knit how roots and leaves appear, and strive towards the light to go to seed.

The shawl is worked sideways starting with one side of the triangle. Hence, the shawl grows progressively faster as you have fewer and fewer stitches in a row, fuelling your motivation to finish swiftly. The shawl is knit in one piece — the borders are worked as you go. If desired, use beads to highlight the roots and seeds.

Instructions are provided for two sizes. With either set of instructions you can use fingering or DK weight yarn to create a petite, regular, or large shawl. Instructions for custom size shawl are included.

The pattern is available individually and as part of the Knit Light e-book.

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SIZES, YARDAGE AND MEASUREMENTS

Each knitter is unique and each yarn behaves differently, so probably no two shawls can be made to exactly the same size. However, with a similar gauge you will get a shawl of the size indicated in the table.

* The gauge is given for 10 cm (4") stockinette square after wet blocking (stretch aggressively, dry and unpin the swatch before measuring).

Please note that the needle sizes here are only suggestions. You may need to go up or down a needle size to achieve the recommended gauge, and to get a fabric of pleasing drape with the yarn of your choice. Similarly, yarn amounts are approximate – you may use less or more yarn depending on your gauge.

** Length at top edge x depth.

YARN

If the shawl is worked from fingering weight:

100% Merino, 350 m/394 yds in 100 g/3.53 oz, e.g. Madelinetosh Tosh Merino Light

If the shawl is worked from DK weight:

51% Silk, 49% Merino, 274 m/300 yds in 100 g /3.53 oz, e.g. Malabrigo Silky Merino.

The sample shawl is worked from fingering weight: 380 meters (416 yards) of Tosh Merino Light (100% Merino, 384 m/420 yds per skein) in Tern colourway.

BEADS


399 beads for S version or 519 beads for M version in 8/0 or 6/0 size for fingering and 6/0 or 5/0 size for DK weight. Beads are optional. Beads are placed using a crochet hook/dental floss/beading wire after working a stitch to be beaded. The sample shawl uses 8/0 Toho Permanent Finish—Matte Galvanized Orchid TR-08-PF563F.

NOTIONS

80 cm (32") or longer circular needles of a size suitable to obtain gauge, 0.5 mm larger ndls for CO, 7 (9) stitch markers, 0.6 mm crochet hook /dental floss/beading wire for placing beads, cable needle, yarn needle, blocking pins/wires.

SCHEMATIC

The measurements are given for shawls worked according to S (M) instructions in centimetres/inches.

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s): stitch(es)

CO: cast on

BO: bind off — k1 at the beginning of a row, [k1, return two sts to LH ndl, k2tog tbl]

► **Note on BO for written instructions:** Once the indicated number of sts are bound off, one knit st will already be on the RH needle. Therefore, when “BO4, k1, inc1to5tbl” is written, after binding off 4 sts you will have one st on the RH needle knit already and you shall continue by working inc1to5tbl.

RS: right side

WS: wrong side

tbl: through back loop(s)

LH: left-hand

RH: right-hand

ndl(s): needle(s)

CN: cable needle

M: stitch marker

PM: place marker

RM: remove marker

SM: slip marker

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

[] pattern repeat (repeat instructions inside brackets for indicated number of times)

() repeat instructions inside brackets for indicated number of times

underlined stitches mean that a bead should be placed on them; place bead onto stitch with a small crochet hook *after* working the stitch. Do not pre-string beads on the working yarn.

k: knit

p: purl

yo: yarn over

sl: slip

sl1 wyif: slip 1 st purlwise wyif

k2tog: knit 2 together as one
(2 sts decreased to 1)

p2tog: purl 2 together as one
(2 sts decreased to 1)

k3tog: knit 3 together as one
(3 sts decreased to 1)

ssp: slip 2 sts knitwise one at a time, return them to LH ndl, and p2 together tbl
(2 sts decreased to 1)

ssk: slip 2 sts knitwise one at a time, return them to LH ndl, and k2tog tbl
(2 sts decreased to 1)

sssk: slip 3 sts knitwise one at a time, return them to LH ndl, and k3tog tbl
(3 sts decreased to 1)

sk2p: slip 1 knitwise, k2tog, pass slipped st over (3 sts decreased to 1)

inc1to5tbl: (k1, yo, k1, yo, k1) into the same st tbl (1 st increased to 5). On the next (WS) row purl each of these 5 sts

inc1to3tbl: (k1, yo, k1) into the same st tbl (1 st increased to 3). On the next (WS) row purl each of these 3 sts tbl

r5-5tbl: return 1 st to LH ndl, sl2 wyib knitwise, return 2 sts to LH ndl, (k5tog, yo, k5tog, yo, k5tog) into the same 5 sts tbl (sts rearranged and 5 sts worked to 5 sts)

1/1 RPT: slip next st to CN and hold at back, k1 tbl, then p1 from CN

1/1 LPT: slip next st to CN and hold at front, p1, then k1 tbl from CN

M1T: place a backwards loop onto the RH ndl, so the working yarn is pointing towards you (1 st increase). On the next WS row knit the loop, so it is twisted twice. Refer to photos below.

SET UP

- Instructions are given for sizes: S (M).
With these instructions, fingering weight yarn will give you a shawl of size petite (regular); DK weight yarn will give you a shawl of size regular (large).

CO 142 (178) sts with larger ndls using the long tail method with two ndls held together. Place markers while casting on (can be made of scrap yarn) as follows: CO9, PM, (CO18, PM) *six (eight) times*, CO25. Continue with smaller ndls.


- Slip markers as you go unless indicated otherwise.

► **Note:** Beads are placed on the underlined stitches. Place bead with *after* working them with a crochet hook/dental floss/beading wire.

Row 0 (WS): K across row.

Row 1 (RS): K1, (yo, k2tog, SM when present) to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): K across row.

CUSTOMISATION OPTIONS

To adjust the size of the shawl, you can increase or reduce the number of pattern repeats during the cast-on.

The number of stitches to CO can be calculated according to this formula: $52+(18*X)$, where X is the number of pattern repeats. Each pattern repeat adds a 'stalk' to the final pattern (size S is 5 pattern repeats, M is 7 pattern repeats).

Each additional pattern repeat will require an extra repeat of 36 rows of Charts C1 to C3.

To count the number of beads needed use this formula: $94+(60*X)$, where X is the number of pattern repeats.

FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends (trim after blocking).

Soak the shawl at least for 20 minutes, wash if needed. Handle carefully when wet. Roll in a thick towel and press out the remaining water. Transfer to blocking board.

Stretch the shawl aggressively while blocking. If you use blocking wires, thread them through the garter stitch edge of the shawl and through the triangles on the other straight edge. Pin the CO edge of the shawl using 3 pins for each "petal". Pin the sides of the shawl to form a triangle. Take the shawl off the blocking board after it is completely dry. Trim the yarn ends.






When working for the first time, repeat 4 (6) times on each row. For each subsequent repeat of the chart work the pattern repeat one fewer time.

CHART C1



When working Chart C1 for the first time (starting with Row 7) you will work the pattern repeat 5 (7) times on each row. For each subsequent repeat of the chart work the pattern repeat one fewer time.

After Chart B, work Rows 7-12 of Chart C1 *once*, then work through charts C2 and C3 (30 rows in total). Then work Charts C1 to C3 *once each* (36 rows in total). Work these 36 rows 3 (5) times in total (until one "stalk" is left). Finally, work Rows 1-12 of Chart C1 *once*, then move on to Chart D.

THE TALLEST ONE

Cut yarn and draw through the remaining stitch.



Tip: If you are running out of yarn you may work k3tog instead of this k2tog on the first row of each repeat starting with the 2nd, 4th, or 6th pattern repeat. This reduces the number of repeats to be worked to 7, 8, or 9 instead of 10.

29 sts on the first pattern repeat, 2 sts on the last pattern repeat






ROOTS AND THE FIRST LEAVES

CHART A

- Work rows 1-24 of Chart A *once*.
The text in bold font located between []'s (18 sts) is one pattern repeat.
You will repeat these instructions 6 (8) times on each row.

- Place beads on the underlined stitches *after* working them.
- Use markers to separate pattern repeats as set up during the cast-on. If not indicated otherwise, slip markers as you go.

Row 1 (RS): Sl1 wyif, inc1to5tbl, M1T, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k3, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, p1, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k3, p1**], k3, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, p1, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k6, k2tog, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, p12, k1, p8, [(**k1, p8**) twice], k2, p2, k1, p1, k2, p5, k1.

Row 3: Sl1 wyif, ssk, k1, k2tog, p1, k1tbl, M1T, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k2, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k2, p1**], k2, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k4, k2tog, k3.

Row 4: K3, p11, k1, p8, [(**k1, p8**) twice], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k1, p3, k1.

Row 5: Sl1 wyif, yo, sk2p, yo, p1, k1tbl, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k1, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, k1, k1, p1, k1, k1, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k1, p1**], k1, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, k1, k1, p1, k1, k1, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k2, k2tog, k3.

Row 6: K3, p10, k1, p8 [(**k1, p8**) twice], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k5.

▶ **Note:** After you BO4, one st will already be on the RH ndl. Therefore after binding off 4 sts you shall proceed by working inc1to5tbl.

Row 7: BO4, k1, inc1to5tbl, M1T, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k2tog, k2, k1, yo, k2, k1, p1, k1, k2, yo, k1, k2, ssk, p1**], k2tog, k2, k1, yo, k2, k1, p1, k1, k2, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k2tog, k3.

Row 8: K3, p9, k1, p8, [(**k1, p8**) twice], k2, p2, k1, p1, k2, p5, k1.

Row 9: Sl1 wyif, ssk, k1, k2tog, p1, k1tbl, M1T, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k3, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, p1, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k3, p1**], k3, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, p1, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k2, k2tog, k3.

Row 10: K3, p8, k1, p8, [(**k1, p8**) twice], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k1, p3, k1.

Row 11: Sl1 wyif, yo, sk2p, yo, p1, k1tbl, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k2, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k2, p1**], k2, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k2tog, k3.

Row 12: K3, p7, k1, p8, [(**k1, p8**) twice], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k5.

Row 13: BO4, k1, inc1to5tbl, M1T, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k1, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, k1, k1, p1, k1, k1, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k1, p1**], k1, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, k1, k1, p1, k1, k1, yo, k1, k1, k3tog, k3.

Row 14: K3, p6, k1, p8, [(**k1, p8**) twice], k2, p2, k1, p1, k2, p5, k1.

Row 15: Sl1 wyif, ssk, k1, k2tog, p1, k1tbl, M1T, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k2tog, k2, k1, yo, k2, k1, p1, k1, k2, yo, k1, k2, ssk, p1**], k2tog, k2, k1, yo, k2, k1, p1, k1, k2, yo, k3tog, k3.

Row 16: K3, p5, k1, p8, [(**k1, p8**) twice], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k1, p3, k1.

Row 17: Sl1 wyif, yo, sk2p, yo, p1, k1tbl, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k3, k2tog, k2, (k1, yo) twice, k1, k2, ssk, k3, p1**], k3, k2tog, k2, (k1, yo) twice, k1, k1, k3tog, k3.

Row 18: K3, p3, k1, p1, k1, p7, [**k1, p7, k1, p1, k1, p7**], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k5.

Row 19: BO4, k1, inc1to5tbl, M1T, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k2, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, p1, k1, p1, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k2, p1**], k2, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, p1, k1, p1, yo, k3tog, k3.

Row 20: K3, (p1, k2) twice, p6, [**k1, p6, k2, p1, k2, p6**], k2, p2, k1, p1, k2, p5, k1.

Row 21: Sl1 wyif, ssk, k1, k2tog, p1, k1tbl, M1T,

ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k1, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, p2, k1, p2, yo, k1, k2, ssk, k1, p1**], k1, k2tog, k2, k1, yo, p2, k1, p1, k2tog, k3.

Row 22: K3, p1, k1, p1, k3, p5, [**k1, p5, k3, p1, k3, p5**], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k1, p3, k1.

Row 23: Sl1 wyif, yo, sk2p, yo, p1, k1tbl, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k2tog, k2, k1, yo, p3, k1, p3, yo, k1, k2, ssk, p1**], k2tog, k2, k1, yo, p3, k1, k2tog, k3.

Row 24: K3, p2, k4, p4, [**k1, p4, k4, p1, k4, p4**], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k5.

CHART B

→ Work rows 1-6 of Chart B *once*.

You will repeat the instructions located between []'s 5 (7) *times* on each row.

→ Place beads on the underlined stitches *after* working them.

Row 1 (RS): BO4, k1, inc1to5tbl, M1T, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**ssk, k2, yo, p2, k2tog, yo, k1tbl, yo, ssk, p2, yo, k2, k2tog, p1**], ssk, k2, yo, p4, inc1to5tbl, p4, yo, k2, k2tog, p1, RM, ssk, k2, yo, p4, k2tog, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, p1, k5, p3, k1, p3, k5, p5, k5, p3, [**k1, p3, k3, p2, p1tbl, p2, k3, p3**], k2, p2, k1, p1, k2, p5, k1.

Row 3: Sl1 wyif, ssk, k1, k2tog, p1, k1tbl, M1T, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**ssk, k1, yo, p1, k3tog, yo, k1, yo, k1tbl, yo, k1, yo, sssk, p1, yo, k1, k2tog, p1**], ssk, k1, yo, p5, ssk, k1, k2tog, p5, yo, k1, k2tog, p1, ssk, k1, yo, p4, k2tog, k3.

Row 4: K3, p1, k5, p2, k1, p2, k6, p1, p1, p1, k6, p2, [**k1, p2, k2, p4, p1tbl, p4, k2, p2**], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k1, p3, k1.

Row 5: Sl1 wyif, yo, sk2p, yo, p1, k1tbl, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**ssk, yo, k3tog, yo, k3, yo, k1tbl, yo, k3, yo, sssk, yo, k2tog, p1**], ssk, yo, p6, sk2p, p6, yo, k2tog, p1, ssk, yo, p4, k2tog, k3.

Row 6: K3, p1, k24, [**k1, p8, p1tbl, p8**], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k5.

LEAVES AND SEEDPODS

→ After finishing Chart B, work Rows 7-12 of Chart C1 *once*, then work through charts C2 and C3 (30 rows in total). Then work Charts C1 to C3 *once each* (36 rows in total). Work these 36 rows 3 (5) *times* in total (until one "stalk" is left). Finally, work Rows 1-12 of Chart C1 *once*, then move on to Chart D.

CHART C1

→ Start with *Row 7* when working for the first time.

→ When working Chart C1 for the first time (starting with Row 7) you will repeat the instructions located between []'s 5 (7) *times* on each row. For each subsequent repeat of the chart you will work the pattern repeat one fewer time.

Row 1: BO4, k1, inc1to5tbl, M1T, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**p2, k2tog, yo, p2, k2tog, yo, k1tbl, yo, ssk, p2, yo, ssk, p3**], p to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

Row 2: K3, p1, k to M, SM, [**k3, p1, k3, p2, p1tbl, p2, k3, p1, k2**], k2, p2, k1, p1, k2, p5, k1.

Row 3: Sl1 wyif, ssk, k1, k2tog, p1, k1tbl, M1T, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**p1, k2tog, yo, p1, k3tog, yo, k1, yo, k1tbl, yo, k1, yo, sssk, p1, yo, ssk, p2**], p to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

Row 4: K3, p1, k to M, SM, [**k2, p1, k2, p4, p1tbl, p4, k2, p1, k1**], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k1, p3, k1.

Row 5: Sl1 wyif, yo, sk2p, yo, p1, k1tbl, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k2tog, yo, k3tog, yo, k3, yo, k1tbl, yo, k3, yo, sssk, yo, ssk, p1**], p to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

Row 6: K3, p1, k to M, SM, [**k1, p8, p1tbl, p8**], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k5.

Row 7: BO4, k1, inc1to5tbl, M1T, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [**k3tog, yo, k5, yo, k1tbl, yo, k5, yo, sssk, p1**], p to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

Row 8: K3, p1, k to M, SM, [k1, p8, p1tbl, p8], k2, p2, k1, p1, k2, p5, k1.

Row 9: Sl1 wyif, ssk, k1, k2tog, p1, k1tbl, M1T, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [k1, yo, k1, ssk, p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k1tbl, yo, k1, ssk, p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k1, p1], p to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

Row 10: K3, p1, k to M, SM, [k1, p4, k1, p3, p1tbl, p3, k1, p4], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k1, p3, k1.

Row 11: Sl1 wyif, yo, sk2p, yo, p1, k1tbl, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [k1, yo, k1, ssk, p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k1tbl, yo, k1, ssk, p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k1, p1], p to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

Row 12: K3, p1, k to M, RM, [k1, p1, (k1, p2) twice, k1, p1tbl, k1, (p2, k1) twice, p1], k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1tbl, k5.

CHART C2

→ You will repeat the instructions located between []'s 4 (6) times on each row when working Chart C2 for the first time. For each subsequent repeat of the chart you will work the pattern repeat one fewer time.

Row 1: BO4, k1, inc1to5tbl, M1T, p1, ssk, yo twice, k2tog, p2, [k1, p1, yo, ssk, p1, k2tog, yo, p1, inc1to5tbl, p1, yo, ssk, p1, k2tog, yo, p1, k1, p1], k1, p1, yo, ssk, p1, k2tog, yo, p1, k1tbl, p1, yo, ssk, p1, k2tog, yo, p1, k1, PM, p to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

Row 2: K3, p1, k to M, SM, p1, k2, p1, k1, p1, k2, p1tbl, k2, p1, k1, p1, k2, p1, [k1, p1, k2, p1, k1, p1, k2, p5, k2, p1, k1, p1, k2, p1], k2, p2, k1, p1, k2, p5, k1.
