


• LUZ (cardigan) •





SCHEMATIC, MEASUREMENTS & INFORMATIONS

A : 35 (38.5 - 41.75 - 45)(48 - 50.75 - 54.25 - 57.5)
 B : 11 (11 - 11 - 12)(12 - 13.5 - 13.5 - 13.5) adjustable
 C : 17.25 (adjustable)
 D : 7.5 (8.5 - 9.75 - 10.25)(11.25 - 11.75 - 12.5 - 13.75)
 E : 13.5 (15.5 - 17.5 - 18.25)(19.75 - 20.5 - 22.25 - 24)



A : 89 (98 - 106 - 114)(122 - 129 - 138 - 146)
 B : 28 (28 - 28 - 30)(30 - 32 - 32 - 32) adjustable
 C : 44 (adjustable)
 D : 18,5 (21,5 - 24,5 - 26)(28,5 - 30 - 32 - 35)
 E : 34 (39 - 44,5 - 46,5)(50 - 52 - 56,5 - 61)



SIZES: 1 (2 - 3 - 4)(5 - 6 - 7 - 8)

Approximately finished bust circumference : 35 (38.5 - 41.75 - 45)(48 - 50.75 - 54.25 - 57.5) inches/ 89 (98 - 106 - 114)(122 - 129 - 138 - 146) cm.



GAUGE: 18 sts x 26 rows for 4 x 4 inches/10 x 10 cm in stockinette st with 4.5 mm/US 7 needles.



YARN: The cardigan is knitted with two strands of lace yarn (mohair silk). Approximately 1440 (1610 - 1840 - 1985)(2160 - 2305 - 2520 - 2635) yards/1315 (1470 - 1680 - 1815)(1975 - 2105 - 2305 - 2410) m in total.



NOTIONS: needles sizes 3 mm/US 2.5 (cuff ribs) 3.5 mm/US 4 (body ribs) and 4.5 mm/US 7 (body and sleeves), tapestry needle, cable to hold live stitches, 10 stitches markers and 6 buttons 10 to 12 mm.



NOTES: The pattern is knitted in kidsilk lace (kid silk mohair - 25g = 210m) from Gregoria Fibers color Ballerine.

Recommended ease : 4 to 8 inches or 10 to 20 cm of positive ease. To pick your best size, measure your full bust and add your desired ease, then pick the finished bust circumference closest to that number.

Sample is shown in size 3 with 5.5 inches/14 cm of positive ease.

LUZ (cardigan) is a little cardigan with a very simple but very feminine shape. Knitted in mohair your cardigan will be an soft and airy. To be declined in all colors !

It is knitted seamlessly from top to bottom with raglan armholes. The body (back and front) is worked flat and puffed sleeves are worked in round. No stitches are picked up.



ABBREVIATIONS, STITCHES & TECHNIQUES



BOR beginning of round

DS double stitch

inc increase

k knit

K2tog knit 2 sts together (decrease)

M marker

M1L (make 1 left) Increase leans to the left :

pick up the horizontal bar between the sts from front to back, knit through back leg

M1R (make 1 right) Increase leans to the right :

pick up the horizontal bar between the sts from back to front, knit through front leg

PM place marker

p purl

p2tog purl 2 sts together (decrease)

RM remove marker

RS right side

SM slip marker

SR Short row

st(s) stitch(es)

ssk slip, slip, knit (decrease)

WS wrong side

I-cord edging (3 sts):

RS 1: k1, sl1wyif, k1

WS : sl1wyif, k1, sl1wyif

Repeat this 2 rows for I-cord edging.

St st (stockinette stitch): (worked in round) knit to end

(worked flat) knit stitches on RS, purl stitches on WS

German short rows: work to the instructed stitch and turn your work. Slip the last st purlwise from left needle to right needle with yarn in front. Pull the yarn towards the back, to reveal the two strands of the last row. It's the "double st" (DS). Work even remaining st. On next row, work DS with the two strands.

You can even work "wrap&turn" short rows but the result will be less clean.

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INSTRUCTIONS



NECKBAND

With 3.5 mm/US 4 needles, cast on 99 (99 - 103 - 107)(111 - 115 - 123 - 123) sts. (Tubular cast-on is recommended.). Do not join in round.

Set up row (RS): 3 sts l-cord edging on RS, p1, k1, p1, k1, (buttonband), PM, *p1, k1*, rep to 8 sts to end of row, p1, PM, k1, p1, k1, p1, 3 sts l-cord edging on RS (buttonband).

Row 2 (WS): 3 sts l-cord edging on WS, k1, p1, k1, p1, SM, *k1, p1*, rep to 8 sts to end of row, k1, SM, p1, k1, p1, k1, 3 sts l-cord edging on WS

Note: the buttonband is knitted at the same time with the body. The first buttonhole (k2 tog, 1 yo) is placed 0.5 inches /1 cm from the edge and then the next buttonholes at regular intervals of 2.75 (3 - 3 - 3.25)(3.5 - 3.75 - 4 - 4) inches/7 (7,5 - 8 - 8,5)(9 - 9,5 - 10 - 10,5) cm. This interval is given for recommended height but if the model is lengthened or shortened it will affect this interval.

Continue as established for 0.5 inches /1 cm then on RS work first buttonhole : work as established until second M, SM, k1, p2 tog, 1 yo, p1, 3 sts l-cord edging.

Continue as established for 1 inches/2 cm ending with RS.

YOKE (FRONT, BACK AND SLEEVES)

Change to 4.5 mm/US 7 needles.

Set up row (WS): 7 sts of buttonband, SM, p 12 (12 - 12 - 13)(14 - 15 - 16 - 16) sts (right front), PM, p1 (raglan), PM, p 14 (14 - 16 - 16)(16 - 16 - 18 - 18) sts (right sleeve), PM, p1 (raglan), PM, p 29 (29 - 29 - 31)(33 - 35 - 37 - 37) sts (back), PM, p1 (raglan), PM, p 14 (14 - 16 - 16)(16 - 16 - 18 - 18) sts (left sleeve), PM, p1 (raglan), PM, p 12 (12 - 12 - 13)(14 - 15 - 16 - 16) sts (left front), SM, 7 sts of buttonband.

Raglan (increases for front, sleeves, back and German short rows):

The neckline is worked in shorts rows (using German short rows).

The raglan increases are worked on either side of each raglan marker.

SR 1 (RS/inc): 7 sts of buttonband, SM, *k to next M, M1R, SM, k1, SM, M1L*, repeat 3 more times, k2, turn. (8 sts inc)

SR 2 (WS): make DS, p to the 8th M, SM, p2, turn.

SR 3 (RS/inc): make DS, *k to next M, M1R, SM, k1, SM, M1L*, repeat 3 more times, k to DS, k DS, k2 and turn. (8 sts inc)

SR 4 (WS): make DS, p to the DS, p DS, p2 and turn.

Repeat **SR 3 and 4**, 3 (3 - 3 - 4)(4 - 5 - 5 - 5) more time.

Row 1 (RS/inc): *k to next M, M1R, SM, k1, SM, M1L*, repeat 3 more times, k to next M, SM, 7 sts of buttons band. (8 sts inc)

Row 2 (WS): 7 sts of buttonband, SM, p to last M, SM, 7 sts of buttonband.

48 (48 - 48 - 48)(56 - 56 - 64 - 64) sts inc in total)

You have 147 (147 - 151 - 163)(167 - 179 - 187 - 187) sts in total : 18 (18 - 18 - 20)(21 - 23 - 24 - 24) sts for front, 41 (41 - 41 - 45)(47 - 51 - 53 - 53) sts for back, 26 (26 - 28 - 28)(30 - 30 - 34 - 34) sts for each sleeve, 14 sts for buttonbands and 4 sts raglan.

Raglan (increases sleeves, back, front) :

Row 1 (RS/inc) : 7 sts of buttonband, SM, *k to next M, M1R, SM, k1, SM, M1L*, repeat 3 more times, k to next M, SM, 7 sts of buttonband. (8 sts inc)

Row 2 (WS) : 7 sts of buttonband, SM, p to last M, SM, 7 sts of buttonband.

Repeat **rows 1 and 2**, 17 (21 - 25 - 26)(29 - 30 - 33 - 37) more times. (144 (176 - 208 - 216)(240 - 248 - 272 - 304) sts inc in total.)

You have 291 (323 - 359 - 379)(407 - 427 - 459 - 491) sts in total : 36 (40 - 44 - 47)(51 - 54 - 58 - 62) sts for front, 77 (85 - 93 - 99)(107 - 113 - 121 - 129) sts for back, 62 (70 - 80 - 84)(90 - 94 - 102 - 110) sts for each sleeve, 14 sts for buttonbands and 4 sts raglan.

BODY AND SLEEVES SEPARATION

7 sts of buttonband, SM, k 36 (40 - 44 - 47)(51 - 54 - 58 - 62) sts (front), RM, k1, RM, place 62 (70 - 80 - 84)(90 - 94 - 102 - 110) sts on waste yarn or holder (sleeve), RM, k1, RM, k 77 (85 - 93 - 99)(107 - 113 - 121 - 129) sts (back), RM, k1, RM, place 62 (70 - 80 - 84)(90 - 94 - 102 - 110) sts on waste yarn or holder (sleeve), RM, k1, RM, k 36 (40 - 44 - 47)(51 - 54 - 58 - 62) sts (front), SM, 7 sts of buttonband.

You have 167 (183 - 199 - 211)(227 - 239 - 255 - 271) sts in total.

Continue in st st until piece measure 8.5 (8.5 - 8.5 - 9.5)(9.5 - 11 - 11 - 11) inches/22 (22 - 22 - 24)(24 - 28 - 28 - 28) cm (or 2.25 inches/6 cm less than desired length).

Change to 3.5 mm/US 4 circular needles.

Row 1 (RS): 7 sts of buttonband, SM *p1, k1* rep to last M, p1, 7 sts of buttonband.

Row 2 (WS): 7 sts of buttonband, SM *k1, p1* rep to last M, k1, 7 sts of buttonband.

Continue in established ribbing pattern for 2.25 inches /6 cm. Bind off loosely. Tubular sewn bind off is recommended.

SLEEVES (Both sleeves alike)

The sleeves are worked in round using 4.5 mm/US 7 DPNs or circular needles in st st.

Note: when picking up stitches, a hole is often formed at underarm. To solve this problem you can:

- close the hole when finishing by weaving in the ends.
- pick up 2 additional stitches and work 2 decreases on the first and last stitches of the next row. We then obtain the recommended number of stitches.

Starting from the center of the underarm, PM (BOR) and knit 62 (70 - 80 - 84)(90 - 94 - 102 - 110) sts left on hold.

Continue in st st until sleeve measures 15 inches/38 cm (or 2.25 inches/6 cm less than desired length).

Decreases round :

Sizes 1: SM, *(k2tog) 5 times, k2*, rep *to* 3 more time, (k2tog) 6 times, k2.

Sizes 2: SM, *(k2tog) 17 times, k1*, rep *to* 1 more time.

Sizes 3 and 4: SM, * k2tog*, rep to end of round.

Sizes 5: SM, *(k2tog) 22 times, k1*, rep *to* 1 more time.

Sizes 6: SM, *(k2tog) 23 times, k1*, rep *to* 1 more time.

Sizes 7: SM, *(k2tog) 25 times, k1*, rep *to* 1 more time.

Sizes 8: SM, *(k2tog) 27 times, k1*, rep *to* 1 more time.

You have 36 (36 - 40 - 42)(46 - 48 - 52 - 56) sts.

With 3 mm/US 2.5 circular needles, *k1, p1* rep to BOR. Continue in the established ribbing pattern for 2.25 inches /6 cm. Bind off loosely. Tubular sewn bind off is recommended.

FINISHING

Sew the little holes at underarms if there's any, weave in all ends and block to finished measurements.
