****** Lamb Shelly and Shaun will be 22 cm tall if using similar materials. The measurement would change if you choose different weight yarns or hook size. Also, since it is a handmade work, the toy you knit will be different from the toy I knit. All of our handcrafts are different!

****** I can not wait to see your lambs. Please tag me on your photos, I will be happy to see them.

MATERIALS

-%100 combed and mercerised cotton Schachenmayr Catania Originals (50 g and 125 m)

Color codes of lamb in green rompers

-130: cream -404: sand -427: orange -402: green -433: pink

Color codes of lamb in mustard dress

-130: cream -404: sand -399: lilac -249: mustard -433: pink

Color codes of lamb in dark grey rompers

-437: brown -130: cream -393: dark grey -402: green -433: pink

Color codes of lamb in yellow dress

-437: brown -130: cream -433: pink -206: yellow

Apple color codes

-390: red -402: green -437: brown

-2.20 mm or a hook that fits your yarn -Polyester Fiberfill -Scissors
-1 pair of 8mm amigurumi safety eye -Stitch marker -Wire for glasses
-Tapestry needle for sewing -4 buttons for dress and rompers

Mr: Magic ring

Sc: Single crochet

Ch: Chain

(...): The number of sts you should have at the end of each round or row.

(...)- times: Repeat the instructions x times.

NOTES

** Do not forget to stuff the pieces as you move forward!

** Use stitch markers or a piece of yarn to follow the rounds neatly.

PATTERN

HEAD

Rnd 1) 6sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3) (1sc, 1inc)- 6 times (18)

Rnd 4) 1sc, 1inc, (2sc, 1inc x 5 times), 1sc (24)

Rnd 5) (3sc, 1inc)- 6 times (30)

Rnd 6) 2sc, 1inc, (4sc, 1inc x 5 times), 2sc (36)

Rnd 7) (5sc, 1inc)- 6 times (42)

Rnd 8) 3sc, 1inc, (6sc, 1inc x 5 times), 3sc (48)

Rnd 9) (7sc, 1inc)- 6 times (54)

Rnd 10-19) (10 rnds) 1sc in each st around (54)

PS: Insert the safety eyes between round 18 and 19 with a 10 sts distance between them. Let's embroider the nose with pink yarn between the 20th and 21th round.

Rnd 20) 15sc, (1sc, 1inc x 12 times), 15sc (66)

Rnd 21-28) (8 rnds) 1sc in each st around (66)

Rnd 29) 15sc, (1sc, 1dec x 12 times), 15sc (54)

Rnd 30) (7sc, 1dec)- 6 times (48)

Rnd 31) (6sc, 1dec)- 6 times (42)

Rnd 32) (5sc, 1dec)- 6 times (36)


Rnd 33) (4sc, 1dec)- 6 times (30)

Rnd 34) (3sc, 1dec)- 6 times (24)

PS: Finish with a slip stitch, fasten off.

PS: Stuff the head!

PS: Glasses optional! I made it myself with a thin wire. I wrapped thin yarn on the wire!



FUR

Rnd 1) BLO; 6sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2) BLO; 2sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3) BLO; (1sc, 1inc)- 6 times (18)

Rnd 4) BLO; 1sc, 1inc, (2sc, 1inc x 5 times), 1sc (24)

Rnd 5) BLO; (3sc, 1inc)- 6 times (30)

Rnd 6) BLO; 2sc, 1inc, (4sc, 1inc x 5 times), 2sc (36)

Rnd 7) BLO; (5sc, 1inc)- 6 times (42)

Rnd 8) BLO; 3sc, 1inc, (6sc, 1inc x 5 times), 3sc (48)

Rnd 9) BLO; (7sc, 1inc)- 6 times (54)

Rnd 10) BLO; 4sc, 1inc, (8sc, 1inc x 5 times), 4sc (60)

Rnd 11-21) (11 rnds) BLO; 1sc in each st around (60)

Continue without cutting the yarn. Turn around and continue.

1) Ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. And ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. Continue until the end of the row.

2) Skip a row.

3) Ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. And ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. Continue until the end of the row.

4) Skip a row.

5) Ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. And ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. Continue until the end of the row.

6) Skip a row.

7) Ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. And ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. Continue until the end of the row.

8) Skip a row.

9) Ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. And ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. Continue until the end of the row.

10) Skip a row.

11) Ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. And ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. Continue until the end of the row.

12) Skip a row.

13) Ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. And ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. Continue until the end of the row.

14) Skip a row.

15) Ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. And ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. Continue until the end of the row.

16) Skip a row.

17) Ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. And ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. Continue until the end of the row.

18) Skip a row.

19) Ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. And ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. Continue until the end of the row.

20) Skip a row.

21) Ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. And ch6, 1sc skip, 1sc the next st. Continue until the end of the row.

PS: Finish with a slip stitch, fasten off.

PS: Do not stuff the fur!

PS: Sew the fur on the head as photo as.







CHEEKS

Rnd 1) 6sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12)

PS: Finish with a slip stitch, fasten off.

PS: Sew the cheeks between round 23 and 25 of the head.



EARS

****** An ear consists of two parts (two different colors). First, let's crochet with the first color and fasten off. Then let's crochet with the second color and join the two pieces without cutting the yarn.

Rnd 1) 6sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3) (1sc, 1inc)- 6 times (18)


Rnd 4) (2sc, 1inc)- 6 times (24)

Rnd 5) (3sc, 1inc)- 6 times (30)

PS: Break the yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.

PS: Do NOT stuff the ears.

PS: Sew the ears as photo as.





BODY

With the cream color;

Rnd 1) 6sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3) (1sc, 1inc)- 6 times (18)

Rnd 4) (2sc, 1inc)- 6 times (24)

Rnd 5) (3sc, 1inc)- 6 times (30)

Rnd 6) (4sc, 1inc)- 6 times (36)

Rnd 7) (5sc, 1inc)- 6 times (42)

Rnd 8) (6sc, 1inc)- 6 times (48)

Rnd 9) (7sc, 1inc)- 6 times (54)

Rnd 10-16) (7 rnds) 1sc in each st around (54)

With continue the pink color

Rnd 17) BLO; 1sc in all sts around (54)

Rnd 18-20) (3 rnds) 1sc in each st around (54)

Rnd 21) (7sc, 1dec)- 6 times (48)



Rnd 22-24) (3 rnds) 1sc in each st around (48)

Rnd 25) (6sc, 1dec)- 6 times (42)

Rnd 26-27) (2 rnds) 1sc in each st around (42)

Rnd 28) (5sc, 1dec)- 6 times (36)

Rnd 29-30) (2 rnds) 1sc in each st around (36)

Rnd 31) (4sc, 1dec)- 6 times (30)

Rnd 32) 1sc in all sts around (30)

With continue the cream color

Rnd 33) BLO; 1sc in all sts around (30)

Rnd 34) (3sc, 1dec)- 6 times (24)

Rnd 35-36) (2 rnds) 1sc in each st around (24)

PS: Finish with a slip stitch, fasten off.

PS: Stuff the body!

ARMS

With the cream color;

Rnd 1) 6sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3) (3sc, 1inc) - 3 times (15)

Rnd 4-5) (2 rnds) 1sc in all sts around (15)

With continue the pink color

Rnd 6) BLO; 1sc in all sts around (15)

Rnd 7) (3sc, 1dec) - 3 times (12)

Rnd 8-26) (19 rnds) 1sc in all sts around (12)

Rnd 27) Flatten the piece and close the opening by making sc stitches through both layers of remaining sts.

PS: Stuff the arms until Round 24.

PS: Sew the arms between Round 31 and 32 of the body.



FEET AND LEGS

Rnd 1) 6sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3) (1sc, 1inc) - 6 times (18)

Rnd 4) (2sc, 1inc) - 6 times (24)

Rnd 5) (3sc, 1inc) - 6 times (30)

Rnd 6-8) (3 rnds) 1sc in all sts around (30)

Rnd 9) 6sc, (1dec, 2sc x 4 times), 1dec, 6sc (25)

Rnd 10) 6sc, (1dec, 1sc x 4 times), 1dec, 5sc (20)

Rnd 11) 1sc in all sts around (20)

Rnd 12) 6sc, 1dec, 1sc, 1dec, 1sc, 1dec, 6sc (17)

Rnd 13) 1sc in all sts around (17)

Rnd 14) 4sc, 1dec, 2sc, 1dec, 2sc, 1dec, 3sc (14)

Rnd 15-35) (21 rnds) 1sc in all sts around (14)

Rnd 36) Flatten the piece and close the opening by making sc stitches through both layers of remaining sts.

PS: Stuff feet and legs until Round 34.

PS: Sew the feet between Round 10 and 11 of the body.



DRESS

Row 1) Ch48, hdc into the 9th st from your hook (first buttonhole is formed)

Row 2) 6hdc, (1hdc-ch1-1hdc in the same st), 7hdc, (1hdc-ch1-1hdc in the same st), 10hdc, (1hdc-ch1-1hdc in the same st), 7hdc, (1hdc-ch1-1hdc in the same st), 6hdc

Row 3) Ch2 and turn; 7hdc, (1hdc-ch1-1hdc into the corner we formed on the previous row), 9hdc, (1hdc-ch1-1hdc into the corner we formed on the previous row), 12hdc, (1hdc-ch1-1hdc into the corner we formed on the previous row), 9hdc, (1hdc-ch1-1hdc into the corner we formed on the previous row), 7hdc

Row 4) Ch2 and turn; 8hdc, (1hdc-ch1-1hdc into the corner we formed on the previous row), ch8 and into the next corner 1hdc, 14hdc, into the corner 1hdc, ch8 and into the next corner 1hdc-ch1-1hdc into the corner we formed on the previous row, 8hdc. **In the meantime, follow the photos. We create arm spaces.**

Rnd 5) Ch2 and turn; 1hdc in each st around (54)

Rnd 6) BLO; Ch2 and turn; (1hdc, 1hdcinc x 27 times) (81)

Rnd 7) Ch2 and turn; 1hdc in each st around (81)

Rnd 8) Ch8, turn, and sl st into the next st (we formed our second buttonhole); starting from the st we made sl st; 1hdc in each st around (81)

Rnd 9) Join the piece together with the other side with a sl st; 1hdc in each st around (81)

Rnd 10-21) (12 rnds) 1hdc in each st around (81)

Rnd 22) (Ch3 and 1sc into the next st, 1sc, ch3 and 1sc into the next st, 1sc) repeat until the end of the round.

PS: Sew the buttons as photo as.





ROMPERS

****** First of all, crochet the first piece of the leg and cut the yarn. In the same way crochet the second leg and continue crocheting by combining it with the first piece without cutting yarn.

1) Ch31 and sl st in the first loop. Ch2, turn and starting from the st we slip stitched into: 31hdc

2-6) (5 rnds) BLO; 1hdc in each st around (31hdc)

****** Hold the legs side by side, ch2 and join the legs by making 1sl st into the first leg. Please check the pictures for guidance.

7) BLO; Hdc in all sts around including the ch sts we made while joining the pieces; 64hdc

8-16) (9 rnds) BLO; 1hdc in each st around (64hdc)

****** Don't cut the yarn. Ch38, sl st into the 9th st from your hook (we formed a buttonhole), 1sc in all sts end of the row. From the waist part of the rompers 8sc. Again Ch38, sl st into the 9th st from your hook (we formed a buttonhole), 1sc in all sts end of the row. The rompers hangers are finished. Sew the buttons as photo as.





ROMPERS'S FRONT PIECE

****** Determine a symmetrical starting point for the front part of the rompers.
Insert new yarn and start.

1) BLO; 16hdc

2) FLO; Ch2, turn; 1hdcdec, 12hdc, 1hdcdec

3) BLO; Ch1, turn; 14sc

PS: Finish with a slip stitch, fasten off.

PS: Sew the buttons as photo as.



APPLE BAG

Rnd 1) 6sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3) (1sc, 1inc) - 6 times (18)

Rnd 4) (1sc, 1inc) - 9 times (27)

Rnd 5) (2sc, 1inc) - 9 times (36)

Rnd 6-12) (7 rnds) 1sc in all sts around (36)

Rnd 13) (2sc, 1dec) - 9 times (27)

Rnd 14) (1sc, 1dec) - 9 times (18)

Rnd 15) (1sc, 1dec) - 6 times (12)

Rnd 16) 6dec

PS: Cut the yarn. And insert yarn and knot between the end point and the starting point as shown in the photo. Give the apple a beautiful form in this way.

APPLE STEEL

Rnd 1) 6sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2-5) (4 rnds) 1sc in all sts around (6)

PS: Cut the yarn and sew the steel on the apple.

LEAVES



1) Ch9, starting from the 2nd st from your hook; 1slst, 1sc, 1hdc, 2dc, 1hdc, 1sc, 1slst. And continue from the opposite side of the loops 1slst, 1sc, 1hdc, 2dc, 1hdc, 1sc, 1slst in the first loop.

PS: Cut the yarn and sew the leaves on the apple.

BAG HANDLE

1) Ch65 and cut the yarn.

PS: Sew the hanger from both sides of the apple.
