



# INSTRUCTIONS

## GAUGE SWATCH



### Before you begin knitting...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm.


Cast on and bind off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment.

Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles.

If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

## DESIGN 1

### Short-sleeve

### Jacket

### Solo Lino

### Mélange

Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only

one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

**Materials:** 450 (500, 550) g of Lana Grossa **Solo Lino Mélange** (80% recycled linen (viscose), 20% linen; 105 m/50 g) in Grey-Green Melange (**col 109**). Size 5 mm needles; size 4.5 and 5 mm circular needles, each 80 cm long; two 23 mm mother-of-pearl buttons [by Union Knopf, item 37604, col 12 natural].

**Slip garter selvage:** Slip first st of every row as if to knit and knit last st of every row.

**Garter st:** K every row.

**Chart patterns A – C:** Numbers at left edge of charts indicate WS rows, numbers at right edge of charts indicate RS rows. Beg chart pat with sts before first arrow, work 2 sts between arrows for pat repeat, end with sts after 2nd arrow. Chart pat begin with a WS row. Repeat rows 1 – 4 throughout.

**Moss stitch A:** Work according to chart A.



**Moss stitch B with a slip stitch selvage at left edge:** Work according to chart B.

**Moss stitch C with a slip stitch selvage at right edge:** Work according to chart C.

**Gauge:** 18 sts and 25 rows = 10 x 10 cm in moss st A – C on size 5 mm needles.

**Back:** With size 5 mm needles, cast on 88 (96, 104) sts. Beg with a WS row, work in moss st A according to chart A until back measures 37 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeves: Cast on 25 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 138 (146, 154) sts. Work increased sts into moss st. Change to size 5 mm circular needle and cont in moss st until sleeve measures 18 (19, 20) cm from last sleeve cast-on row, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 12 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge once, 2 sts once. Bind off remaining 58 (62, 66) shoul-

der/overarm sts in pat.

**Left front:** With size 5 mm needles, cast on 53 (57, 61) sts. Beg with a WS row, work in moss st B according to chart B, working 2 selvage sts at left [= front] edge as shown on chart until left front measures 20 (21, 22) cm from cast-on, ending with a RS row. Shape front edge: Bind off 10 sts at beg of next WS row, 3 sts at beg of next WS row, 2 sts at beg of next WS row, 1 st at beg of next 3 WS rows, 1 st at beg of every other WS row twice = 33 (37, 41) sts. Maintaining the 2 selvage sts at left edge, cont in moss st until left front measures same length as back to sleeve. Shape sleeve at right edge same as for back = 58 (62, 66) sts. Work increased sts into moss st. Change to size 5 mm circular needle and cont in moss st until sleeve measures 20 (21, 22) cm from sleeve cast-on row. Bind off all sts in pat.

**Right front:** With size 5 mm needles, cast on 53

(57, 61) sts. Beg with a WS row, work in moss st C according to chart C, working 2 selvage sts at right [= front] edge as shown on chart. Cont same as for left front and at same time, when right front measures 18 (19, 20) cm from cast-on, work 2 buttonholes on next RS row as foll: Work the 2 selvage sts, work next 3 sts in moss st as established, [k2tog or p2tog maintaining pat, yo] for first buttonhole, work next 8 sts in moss st as established, [k2tog or p2tog maintaining pat, yo] for 2nd buttonhole, work to end.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder/overarm seams. With size 4.5 mm circular needle, beg at shaped edge of right front and end at shaped edge of left front, pick up and knit 156 sts along right front, back neck and left front edge. Working a slip garter selvage at beg and end of row, work in garter st for 2 cm, then

bind off all sts. With size 4.5 mm circular needle, pick up and knit 62 (66, 70) sts along left sleeve edge. Working a slip garter selvage at beg and end of row, work in garter st for 2 cm, then bind off all sts. Repeat along right sleeve edge. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons to match buttonholes.



**DESIGN 2**

**Poncho Pullover**  
**Cashsilk Degradé**  
**Size 36 – 42**

**Materials:** 750 g of Lana Grossa **Cashsilk Degradé** (40% polyamide, 30% bamboo, 15% cashmere, 15% silk; 75 m/ 50 g) in Pink/Peach/Beige/

Green-Grey (col 109). Size 9 mm circular needle, 80 cm long; size 8 mm crochet hook.

**Slip stitch selvage:** Knit the first st of every row and slip the last st of every row as if to purl with yarn in front of work.

**Rib and eyelet pattern:** Work according to chart. Number at right edge of chart indicate RS row; number at left edge of chart indicate WS row. Beg chart pat with st(s) before first arrow, work 3 sts between arrows for pat repeat, end with st(s) after 2nd arrow. Repeat rows 1 and 2 throughout.

**Gauge:** 11 sts and 20.5 rows = 10 x 10 cm in rib and eyelet pat on size 9 mm needles, measured laying flat.

**Note:** Poncho pullover is worked as a long rectangle which is later folded and seamed to create the garment. Arrows on schematics show direction of work. A indicates center back seam, the 32 cm between B and B indicate neck opening, C indi-

cates shoulder/overarm seams and D indicates sleeve openings.


**Instructions:** With size 9 mm circular needle, cast on 86 sts. Working a slip st selvage at beg and end of rows, work in rib and eyelet pat according to chart until piece measures 188 cm from cast-on, ending with a chart row 2. Bind off all sts in pat, knitting all yos.

**Finishing:** Pin piece to measurements and block. With WS facing up, lay piece flat. Fold left and right bottom corner up so that they meet at center of top edge [see arrows on schematic 1]. Following schematic 3, sew seam A at center of piece over 40 cm [= center back]. Sew left and right shoulder/overarm seams at top edge of piece


over 60 cm, leaving center 32 cm between B and B open for neck. With size 8 mm crochet hook, work 1 rnd single crochet around neck edge.





## DESIGN 3

### Cardigan Cashsilk

Size 36/38 (40/42)

Instructions are given for first size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

**Materials:** 500

(550) g of Lana Grossa **Cashsilk** (40% polyamide, 30% bamboo, 15% cashmere, 15% silk; 75 m/ 50 g) in Rosé (col 50). Size 7 mm needles; one 28 mm button in peach [by Union Knopf, item 452570, col 42].

**Slip stitch selvage:** Knit the first st of every row and slip the last st of every row as if to purl with yarn in front of work.

**Twisted rib:** On RS rows, k1tbl, p1; on WS rows, work sts as they appear.

**Chart patterns A – C:** Number at right edge of charts indicates RS row; number at left edge of charts indicates WS row. Beg chart pat with sts before first arrow, work 2 sts between arrows for pat repeat, end with sts after 2nd arrow. Repeat rows 1 and 2 throughout.

**Mesh pattern A:** Work according to chart A.

**Mesh pattern B with a 6-st slip st selvage at left edge:** Work according to chart B.

**Mesh pattern C with a 6-st slip st selvage at right edge:** Work according to chart C.

**Gauge:** 12 sts and 22 rows = 10 x 10 cm in mesh pat A – C on size 7 mm needles.

**Back:** With size 7 mm needles, cast on 58 (62) sts and work in mesh pat A according to chart A until back measures 15 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next, work in twisted rib for 4 cm for waistband, ending with a WS row. Next, work in mesh pat A according to chart A again for 13 cm, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 1 st at beg of next 4 rows = 50 (54) sts. Cont until armhole measures 20 (21) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: Bind off 4 (3) sts at each shoulder edge once, 3 (4) sts 3 times.

At same time, on 3rd row of shoulder shaping, shape neck: Bind off center 20 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge once. No sts remain after shoulder and neck shaping is complete.

**Left front:** With size 7 mm needles, cast on 33 (35) sts and work in mesh pat B according to chart B, working the 6-st slip st selvage at left [= front] edge as shown on chart. Work in pat as established until left front measures 15 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next RS row: Selvage st, work in twisted rib over next 16 sts, work in mesh pat B as established to end. Work in pat as established for 4 cm for waistband, ending with a WS row. At same time, when left front measures 18 cm

from cast-on, shape front edge on next RS row as foll: Work to last 8 sts, k2tog, work to end. Repeat dec row every foll 4th row 7 times, then every foll 6th row twice. At same time, after having worked the waistband, cont in mesh pat B according to chart B across all sts, working armhole shaping at right edge same as for back. Cont until armhole measures 7 cm, ending with a WS row. Sl the 6 selvage sts to a holder and cont in mesh pat B over remaining 13 (15) sts only until left front measures same length as back to shoulder. Shape shoulder at right edge same as for back. No sts remain. Front band: Sl the 6 selvage st back to working needle, cast on 1 selvage st at right edge = 7 sts. Working the newly cast-on selvage st as a slip st selvage, cont in pat as established for 27 (28) cm, then bind off all sts.

**Right front:** With size 7 mm needles, cast on 33 (35) sts and work in mesh pat C according to chart C, working the 6-st slip st selvage at right [= front] edge as shown on chart. Cont same as for left front and at same time, when right front measures 18 cm from cast-on, work buttonhole on next RS row as foll: Work first 4 sts as established, bind off next st, work to end. On foll WS row, cast on 1 st over the bound-off st. At same time, when right front measures same length as left front to front edge shaping, shape front edge on RS rows as foll: Work the 6-st slip st selvage, SKP, work to end.

**Sleeves:** Work two separate halves first as foll: With size 7 mm needles, cast on 21 (23) sts for right half. Next RS row: Selvage st, work in mesh pat B according to chart B over next 14 (16) sts, work the 6-st slip st selvage as shown on chart [= slit edge]. Work in pat as established for 6 cm, ending with a WS row. Sl sts to a holder. Following chart C, work left half same as for right half. Next RS row: Work in mesh pat A according to chart A across sts of both halves and k2tog 6 times across center 12 sts [= slip st selvage] = 36 (40) sts. Cont in mesh pat as established and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at beg and end of 13th [= RS] row, then every foll 12th row 3 times = 44 (48) sts. Work increased sts into mesh pat A. Cont until sleeve measures 30 cm from top of slit, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 4 (8) rows, 2 sts at beg of next 10 (6) rows. Bind off remaining 12 sts.



⊞ = SKP: slip 1 st as if to knit, k1, pass slipped st over knitted st

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Sew left and right front band tog. Beg at center back neck edge, sew side edges of front bands over 7 cm along back neck edge, leaving remainder of front bands unsewn to create a cutout effect. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on button.

### INFO

To make sure that your garment will have the same measurements once it has been washed, draw a rough schematic with the key measurements. Let the garment soak for a short time, squeeze out any excess water without wringing the garment. Lay flat to dry on absorbent towels, out of direct sunlight.

## DESIGN 4

### Pullover Wakame Size 36/38 (40/42)

Instructions are given for first size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

**Materials:** 150 (200) g each of Lana Grossa **Wakame** (75% cotton, 25% viscose; 125 m/50 g) in Pistachio (col 35) and Natural (col 2) and 100 (150) g in Camel (col 34). Size 4.5 mm needles; size 4.5 mm circular needle, 80 cm long; size 4 mm circular needle, 60 cm long.

**2 selvage stitches:** At beg of RS rows, knit first st, slip next st as if to purl with yarn in back of work; at end of RS rows, work to last 2 sts, slip next st as if to purl with yarn in back of work, knit last st. At beg of WS rows, slip first st as if to purl with yarn in front of work, purl next st; at end of WS rows, work to last 2 sts, purl next st, slip last st as if to purl with yarn in front of work.

**Rib pattern in rows:** Row 1 [RS]: 2 selvage sts, p1, k2, p2, \* k1, p2; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k2, p1, 2 selvage sts. Row 2 [WS]: 2 selvage sts, work sts as they appear, end 2 selvage sts. Repeat rows 1 and 2 throughout.

**Rib pattern in rnds:** Rnd 1: \* K1, p2; rep from \*

around. On foll rnds, work sts as they appear.


**Stockinette:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Stripe sequence:** Since 2 RS rows and 2 WS rows are worked successively, stripe sequence should be worked on circular needle. After having worked 1 of the 2 RS [WS] rows, sts are slid to other end of circular needle, where appropriate color is ready to be worked.

**Gauge:** 20 sts and 27 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette on size 4.5 mm needles.

**Back:** Work rib pat and next 12.5 cm with Pistachio, work next 16 cm with Natural, then work 2 rows with Pistachio, 8 rows with Camel, [1 row with Pistachio, 1 row with natural] 21 times, 1 row with Pistachio and remainder of back with Camel. With size 4.5 mm needles and Pistachio, cast on 63 (72) sts and work in rib pat for 6 rows = approx. 2 cm. Next RS row: Work first 3 sts as established [= 2 selvage sts, p1], M1R, work in stockinette to last 3 sts, M1R, work last 3 sts as established [= p1, 2 selvage sts]. Repeat last RS inc row every foll RS row 38 times = 141 (150) sts. Work even until back measures 53.5 (54.5) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 41 (42) sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge once, 2 sts once, 1 st twice. Bind off remaining 43 (47) sts for each shoulder/overarm.

**Front:** Work same as for back until front measures 51.5 (52.5) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 29 (30) sts. Working each side separately, bind off 5 sts at each neck edge once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once, 1 st



3 times and when front measures same length as back to shoulders/overarms, bind off remaining 43 (47) sts for each shoulder/overarm.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder/overarm seams. With size 4 mm circular needle and Pistachio, pick up and knit 108 sts around neck edge. Join for working in rnds and work rib pat in rnds for 2 cm, then bind off all sts in rib. Sew side seams over 11 cm, leaving bottom 30.5 cm open for side slits and top 16 (17) cm open for armholes.



## DESIGN 5

### Crochet Jacket Solo Lino Mélange

Instructions are given for first size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

**Materials:** 700 (750) g of Lana Grossa **Solo Lino Mélange** (80% recycled linen (viscose), 20% linen; 105 m/50 g) in Natural/Grey Melange (col 102). Size 4 mm crochet hook; size 4.5 mm circular needle, 60 cm long.

**Rib pattern:** K2, p2.

**Crochet pattern A:** Multiple of 6 + 1 + 3. Work according to chart A. Beg each row with the number of chains indicated on chart. Numbers at right and left edge of chart indicate rows. Beg chart pat

with sts before first arrow, work sts between arrows for pat repeat, end with sts after 2nd arrow. Work rows 1 – 11 once, then repeat rows 2 – 11 throughout.

**Crochet pattern B:** Work according to chart B. Beg each row with ch3 (count as 1 dc). On rows 2 and 5, work into ch-sp on row below. Numbers at right and left edge of chart indicate rows. Work sts between arrows once. Work rows 1 – 7 once, then repeat rows 2 – 7 throughout.

**Gauges:** On size 4 mm crochet hook, 3 pat reps and 9 rows = 10 x 10 cm in crochet pat A; sts between arrows and 7 rows = 20 x 10 cm in crochet pat B.

**Note:** Arrows on schematics show direction of work.

**Back:** With size 4 mm crochet hook, ch97 (103) + ch3. Working first dc on first row in 5th ch from hook, work in crochet pat A according to chart A = 16 (17) pat reps for 35 rows and back measures approx. 39 cm from beg. Place a locking marker at right and left edge to indicate beg of armholes. Cont until 20 rows have been worked from armhole markers = approx. 23 cm. Cut yarn and fasten off.

**Left front:** Worked in 2 panels as foll: For left panel [worked from the bottom up], ch43 + ch3.

Working first dc on first row in 5th ch from hook, work in crochet pat B according to chart B, working sts between arrows once, until 45 rows have been worked and panel measures approx. 62 cm from beg. Place a locking marker at right edge to indicate beg of armhole. Cont until 16 rows have been worked from armhole marker = approx. 23 cm and a total of 61 rows worked. Cut yarn and fasten off. For right panel [worked side to side along long right edge of left panel], join yarn with a sl st to first st on first row of left panel. Next row: Work chart row 1 of crochet pat A as foll: Ch3 (count as 1 dc), 2 dc in next row, [2 dc in next row, 3 dc in next row] 6 times, 3 dc in each of next 2 rows, [2 dc in next row, 3 dc in next row] 7 times, 3 dc in each of next 2 rows, [2 dc in next row, 3 dc in next row] 6 times, 3 dc in each of next 2 rows, [2 dc in next row, 3 dc in next row] 7 times, 3 dc in each of next 2 rows = 157 dc and 26 pat reps. Work a total of 11 (13) rows in crochet pat A according to chart A = approx. 12 (13.5) cm. Cut yarn and fasten off.


**Right front:** Work same as for left front, reversing panels.

**Sleeves:** Worked from the top down. Arrow on schematic shows direction of work. With size 4 mm crochet hook, ch85 + ch3. Working first dc on first row in 5th ch from hook, work in crochet pat A according to chart A = 85 dc = 14 pat reps after row 1. Work a total of 6 rows = approx. 6 cm, then cut yarn and fasten off. With size 4.5 mm circular needle, pick up and knit 82 sts along last crochet row. Next WS row: Selvage st, p1, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Work in rib pat as established for 10 cm, then bind off all sts loosely in pat.


**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Leaving bottom 23 cm of fronts unsewn, sew side seams over 39 cm, sew shoulder seams over 20 (21.5) cm. Sew sleeve seams. Sew on sleeves. Fold top corners of left and right front to outside.




**Crochet Lesson**



Everyone has their own personal way of holding the hook. Hold the hook like a knitting needle as shown in illustration 1 or like a pencil as shown in illustration 2.



Wrap the yarn around the fingers of your left hand as shown in illustration 3 with the yarn behind your pinkie, in front of your ring and middle finger and behind your index finger. Wrap the yarn from front to back around your left thumb and hold the yarn across your palm.



To form the next loop, wrap the yarn counterclockwise over the hook and draw the yarn through the loop on the hook. Keep forming loops in this way to make as many chains as specified for the pattern (illustration 7 and 8).







Illustration 8a shows how to hold the hook and the yarn to form the chains.

**Foundation Chain**




Insert the hook upward through the yarn on your thumb, wrap the yarn over the hook, then draw the yarn through the loop on your thumb to form a loop.




Work the first loop as shown in illustration 4 and 5, then gently tighten the loop that's on the hook as shown in illustration 6.

**Slip stitch**

The slip stitch is the shortest of the basic stitches. Insert the hook into the chain as shown in illustration 9, wrap the yarn over the hook and draw the yarn through the chain. When working in rounds, join the foundation row into a ring by working a slip stitch into the first of the chains as shown in illustration 10.





## DESIGN 6

### Hat Cashsilk

To fit size 54 – 56 head circumference; brim to crown = approx. 19.5 cm

**Materials:** 50 g each of Lana Grossa **Cashsilk** (40% polyamide, 30% bamboo, 15% cashmere, 15% silk; 75 m/ 50 g) in

Pale Purple (col 48), Antique Pink (col 49), Rosé (col 50), Apricot (col 46) and Pale Blue (col 39). One set size 7 mm double-pointed needles [dpns]; size 6 mm crochet hook.

**Stockinette in rnds:** K every rnd.

**Stripe sequence:** Work \* 1 rnd each with Rosé, Pale Blue, Apricot, Antique Pink, Pale Purple; rep from \* throughout. When changing colors, carry yarn not in use loosely along WS of work, twisting around working color.

**Gauge:** 15 sts and 24 rnds = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette on size 7 mm needles.

**Instructions:** With size 7 mm dpns and Pale Purple, cast on 64 sts. Arrange sts evenly on 4 needles = 16 sts per needle. Join for working in rnds and work stockinette in rnds following stripe sequence for 41 rnds = approx. 17 cm.

Next, work decreases to shape the crown as foll:


**Rnd 42:** K2tog every 3rd and 4th st 16 times = 48 sts.

**Rnd 43:** K2tog every 2nd and 3rd st 16 times = 32 sts.

**Rnd 44:** K2tog around = 16 sts.

**Rnd 45:** K2tog around = 8 sts.

**Finishing:** Cut yarn, draw yarn end through remaining 8 sts and pull tight. Carefully weave in all ends. With size 6 mm crochet hook and Pale Purple, work 1 rnd double crochet [dc] around brim. Join yarn with a slip st to brim, ch2 [count as 1 dc]. Join rnd with a sl st in first ch. Cut yarn and fasten off.



size 8 mm circular needle, 100 cm long; hook-and-eye closure in gold [by Union Knopf, item 500325, size 40, col 842].

**Slip garter selvage:** Slip first st of every row as if to knit and knit last st of every row. Work a slip garter selvage throughout.

**Garter st:** K every row.

**Stockinette:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Full-fashion decreases:** At beg of RS row, selvage st, k1, k2tog; at end of RS row, work to last 4 sts, SKP (slip 1 st as if to knit, k1, pass slipped st over knitted st), k1, selvage st.

**Gauges:** 14 sts and 21 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette on size 8 mm needles; 14.5 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in garter st on size 7 mm needles.

**Back:** With size 7 mm needles and Pale Purple, cast on 66 (72, 78) sts and work in garter st for 15 cm, ending with a WS row. Next, work in stockinette for 20 (21, 22) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 1 st at beg of next 4 rows = 52 (58, 64) sts. Cont until armhole measures 18 (19, 20) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: Bind off 7 (9, 10) sts at each shoulder edge once, 7 (8, 10) sts once. At same time, on first row of shoulder shaping, shape neck: Bind off center 20 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge once. No sts remain after shoulder and neck shaping is complete.

**Pocket linings:** Make 2 alike. With size 8 mm needles and Pale Purple, cast on 14 sts and work in stockinette for 10 cm, ending with a RS row. Sl sts to a holder.

**Left front:** With size 7 mm needles and Pale Purple, cast on 34 (37, 40) sts and work in garter st for 14.5 cm, ending with a WS row. Work pocket opening: Work first 10 (12, 13) sts in garter st, bind off next 14 sts

for pocket opening, work in garter st to end. Next WS row: Work in garter st and knit the 14 pocket lining sts from holder over the 14 bound-off sts. Change to size 8 mm needles and work in stockinette for 15 (17, 19) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape front edge: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at end of next RS row, [then every other RS row, then every foll RS] 4 times, then every other RS row 4 times.

At same time, when left front measures same length as back to armhole, shape armhole at right edge same as for back and when left front measures same length as back to shoulder, shape shoulder at right edge same as for back. No sts remain after shoulder and front edge shaping is complete.

**Right front:** Work same as for left front, reversing all shaping.

**Sleeves:** With size 7 mm needles and Pale Purple, cast on 47 (50, 53) sts and work in garter st for 9 cm, ending with a WS row. Change to size 8 mm needles and work in stockinette for 35 cm, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows, 1 st at beg of next 4 rows, [work 2 rows even, bind off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows] 3 times, then bind off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Bind off remaining 7 (10, 13) sts.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew down pocket linings on WS. Sew shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Front edge trim: With size 8 mm circular needle and Pale Purple, cast on 195 (203, 211) sts. Work in stockinette, working 1 row each with Rosé, Pale Blue, Apricot and Antique Pink. Bind off all sts knitwise on next RS row. Beg at bottom edge of right front and end at bottom edge of left front, sew cast-on edge of trim to right front, back neck and left front edge as foll: Sew first 9 sts of the trim to right front edge, then twist trim around itself once, leave next 2 – 3 rows of right front edge as well as next 4 trim sts unsewn, then sew the next 9 sts of the trim to right front edge. Cont in this manner until entire trim is sewn on, end sewing the last 9 sts of the trim to left front edge. Sleeve trim: With size 8 mm needles and Pale Purple, cast on 53 (56, 59) sts and work trim same as for front edge. Beg and end at sleeve seam, sew cast-on edge of trim to cast-on edge of left sleeve, twisting trim around itself 3 times and leaving 2 – 3 sts at sleeve edge unsewn at each twist. Sew short edges of trim tog. Repeat for right sleeve. Sew hook-and-eye closure to left and right front edge at beg of front edge shaping.



## DESIGN 7

### Cardigan Cashsilk

Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46)


Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.


**Materials:** 550 (600, 650) g of Lana Grossa **Cashsilk** (40% polyamide, 30% bamboo, 15% cashmere, 15% silk; 75 m/ 50 g) in Pale Purple (col 48) and 50 g each in Antique Pink (col 49), Rosé (col 50), Apricot (col 46) and Pale Blue (col 39). Size 7 and 8 mm needles;

### MATTRESS STITCH SEAM

This invisible seam is worked from the right side and is used to join side and sleeve seams. It is perfect for matching stripes and patterns.

Insert the yarn needle under the horizontal bar between the first and second stitches. Insert the needle into the corresponding bar on the other piece. Continue alternating from side to side.





## DESIGN 8

### Pullover

#### Il Puro

Size 34/36 (38/40, 42/44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to

all sizes.

**Materials:** 200 (250, 300) g each of Lana Grossa **Il Puro** (100% silk; 100 m/50 g) in Grey/Brown (col 21) and Pistachio (col 10). Size 5 and 6 mm needles; size 5 mm circular needle, 60 cm long.

**Rib pattern in rows:** Row 1 [RS]: Selvage st, \* k1, p2; rep from \* to last st, selvage st. Row 2 [WS]: Selvage st, work sts as they appear to last st, selvage st. Repeat rows 1 and 2 throughout.

**Rib pattern in rnds:** K1, p2 around. On foll rnds, work sts as they appear.

**Garter st:** K every row.

**Stockinette:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Stripe sequence:** Work \* 1 row with Grey-Brown, 1 row with Pistachio; rep from \* throughout.

Since 2 RS rows and 2 WS rows are worked successively, stripe sequence should be worked on circular needle. After having worked 1 of the 2 RS [WS] rows, sts are slid to other end of circular needle, where appropriate color is ready to be worked.

**2-st full-fashion decreases:** At beg of RS row, selvage st, k1, SK2P (slip 1 st as if to knit, k2tog,

pass slipped st over knitted st); at end of RS row, work to last 5 sts, k3tog, k1, selvage st.


**1-st full-fashion decreases:** At beg of RS row, selvage st, k1, SKP (slip 1 st as if to knit, k1, pass slipped st over knitted st); at end of RS row, work to last 4 sts, k2tog, k1, selvage st.

**Gauges:** On size 6 mm needles, 17 sts and 25.5 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette; 17 sts and 31 rows = 10 x 10 cm in garter st.

**Back:** With size 5 mm needles and Grey-Brown, cast on 74 (80, 86) sts and work in rib pat for 6 cm, ending with a WS row. Change to size 6 mm needles and Pistachio and work in garter st for 4.5 cm, ending with a WS row. Next, work in stockinette following stripe sequence for 21 cm, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeves: Inc 1 st at beg and end of next RS row. Cast on 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 12 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 110 (116, 122) sts. Cont until sleeve measures 21 (22, 23) cm from last sleeve cast-on row, ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulders/overarms and neck: Bind off 6 sts at each shoulder edge 5 times, 10 (13, 16) sts once. At same time, when back measures 2.5 cm from beg of shoulder/overarm shaping, shape neck on next RS row as foll: Bind off center 28 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 1 st at each neck edge once. No sts remain after shoulder/overarm and neck shaping is complete.

**Front:** Work same as for back until front measures 21 (22, 23) cm in stockinette and stripe sequence, ending with a WS row. Shape V-neck: Divide front at center. Working each side separately and working full-fashion dec, dec 2 sts at each neck edge once, then every foll 4th row 6 times, then dec 1 st at each neck edge every foll 4th row once. At same



time, when front measures same length as back to sleeves, shape sleeves same as for back and when front measures same length as back to shoulders/overarms, shape shoulder/overarms same as for back. No sts remain after shoulder and neck shaping is complete.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder/overarm seams. With size 5 mm circular needle and Grey-Brown, pick up and knit 132 sts around neck edge. Join for working in rnds, work rib pat in rnds, positioning sts so that there is a knit st at bottom of center V and dec 1 st before and after center V st every other rnd. When neckband measures 2.5 cm, bind off all sts in pat. With size 5 mm circular needle and Pistachio, pick up and knit 54 (58, 62) sts along left sleeve edge and work in garter st for 3.5 cm. Bind off all sts. Repeat for right sleeve edge. Sew side and sleeve seams.



## DESIGN 9

### Short-sleeve Jacket

#### Organico

Size 34/36 (38/40)

Instructions are given for first size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both

sizes.

**Materials:** 150 g of Lana Grossa **Organico** (100% organic cotton; 90 m/50 g) in Light Steel Blue (col 81) and 100 g each in Brown-Grey (col 94), Salmon (col 85), Midnight Blue (col 13), Ecru (col 6), Yellow-Green (col 91), Reed (col 89) and Antique Pink (col 86). Size 6.5 and 7 mm needles; size 7 mm crochet hook; five 25 mm snaps in light grey

[by Union Knopf, item 19630, col 74].

**Note:** Work with 2 strands of yarn held tog throughout.

**Slip stitch selvage:** Knit the first st of every row and sl the last st of every row as if to purl with yarn in front of work. Work a slip st selvage throughout.

**Rib pattern:** K1, p1.

**Reverse stockinette:** P on RS, k on WS.

**Stripe sequence:** Work 2 rows with Light Steel Blue, \* 4 rows each with Brown-Grey, Salmon, Midnight Blue, Ecru, Yellow-Green, Reed, Antique Pink, Light Steel Blue; rep from \* throughout. **Note:** Do not carry yarns along side edge, but cut and rejoin for each stripe.


**Slip stitch edge:** Worked over 5 sts at left and right front edge: On RS rows, [sl 1 st as if to purl with yarn in back of work, p1] twice, sl 1 st as if to purl with yarn in back of work; on WS rows, [p1, k1] twice, p1.

**Full-fashion decreases:** On RS rows, p2tog, 2 sts in from each edge.

**Gauge:** 13 sts and 18 rows = 10 x 10 cm in reverse stockinette with size 7 mm needles

and 2 strands of yarn held tog.

**Back:** With size 6.5 mm needles and 2 strands of Light Steel Blue held tog, cast on 60 (64) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in rib pat for 4 cm. Change to size 7 mm needles, work in reverse stockinette following stripe sequence and shape sides as foll: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at



beg and end of 13th, 25th and 39th row = 54 (58) sts. Cont until back measures approx. 34 cm from cast-on and 54 rows have been worked in reverse stockinette and stripe sequence. Shape armholes: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows, 1 st at beg of next 2 rows = 44 (48) sts. Cont until armhole measures approx. 16 (17) cm and 28 (30) rows have been worked from beg of armhole shaping. Shape neck: Bind off center 22 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge once. Bind off remaining 9 (11) sts for each shoulder.

**Left front:** With size 6.5 mm needles and Light Steel Blue, cast on 34 (36) sts. Next WS row: Slip st selvage, work 5 sts for slip st edge as instructed for front band; beg with k1, work in rib pat to last st, slip st selvage. Work in pat as established for 4 cm, ending with a WS row. Change to size 7 mm needles. Next RS row: Slip st selvage, work in reverse stockinette following stripe sequence to last 6 sts, work 5 sts for slip st edge, slip st sel-

vage. **Note:** Work front band sts in stripe sequence. Work in pat as established and work side shaping at right edge same as for back. Cont until left front measures same length as back to armhole. Shape armhole at right edge same as for back = 26 (28) sts. Cont until armhole measures 12 (13) cm and 20 (22) rows have been worked from beg of armhole shaping. Shape front neck edge: Bind off 10 sts at beg of next WS row, 2 sts at beg of next 2 WS rows, 1 st at beg of next 3 WS rows and when left front measures same length as back to shoulder, bind off remaining 9 (11) shoulder sts.

**Right front:** Work same as for left front, reversing all shaping and pattern placement.

**Sleeves:** With size 6.5 mm needles and 2 strands Light Steel Blue held tog, cast on 46 (49) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in rib pat for 4 cm. Change to size 7 mm needles, work in reverse stockinette following stripe sequence and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st

at beg and end of 7th, 15th and 23rd row = 40 (43) sts. Cont until sleeve measures approx. 22 cm from cast-on and 32 rows have been worked in reverse stockinette and stripe sequence. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 6 rows, 1 st at beg of next 2 (4) rows, [work 2 rows even, bind off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows] twice, then bind off 1 st at beg of next 4 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows. Bind off remaining 10 (11) sts.)

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. With size 7 mm crochet hook and 2 strands Light Steel Blue held tog, work 1 row single crochet, then 1 row crab st [work single crochet from left to right] along right front, back and left front neck edge. Sew in sleeves, matching stripes of back and front armholes to stripes of sleeve cap. Sew side and sleeve seams, matching stripes. Sew on snaps, top pair 1 cm down from left and right front neck shaping and remaining 4 pairs spaced 9 cm apart.



## DESIGN 10

### Poncho Organico Print Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

**Materials:** 600 (650, 700) g of Lana Grossa **Organico Print** (100% organic cotton; 90 m/50 g) in Natural/Pale Purple (col 403). Size 5.5 mm circular needle, 80 cm long; size 5 mm crochet hook.

**Slip garter selvage:** Slip first st of every row as if to knit and knit last st of every row.

**Seed Stitch:** K1, p1; on foll rows, knit all purl sts, purl all knit sts.

**Gauge:** 17 sts and 27 rows = 10 x 10 cm in seed st on size 5.5 mm needles.

**Back:** With size 5.5 mm circular needle, cast on 122 (128, 134) sts. Working a slip garter selvage throughout, work in seed st for 28 cm. Place marker at each end of last row and cont in seed st for 5 cm. Place second set of markers at each end of last row to indicate beg of armholes and cont in seed st for 26 (27, 28) cm. Shape neck and shoulders/overarms: Bind off center 20 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge once, 2 sts once, 1 st 3 times.

**At same time,** on 3rd row of neck shaping, shape shoulders/overarms: Bind off 5 (7, 7) sts at each shoulder edge once, then 6 sts 6 times (then 7 sts once, 6 sts 5 times / then 7 sts 4 times, 6 sts


twice). No sts remain after neck and shoulder/overarm shaping is complete.

**Front:** Work same as for back.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder/overarm seams. With size 5 mm crochet hook, work 1 rnd single crochet, then 1 rnd crab st [work single crochet from left to right] around neck edge. Sew the 5 cm side seam between markers with 2 vertical rows of back stitch [see illustration].

Make and attach fringe: For each fringe, cut 4 strands of yarn, each strand 25 cm long. Insert crochet hook into fabric from WS, fold 4 strands of yarn in half to form a loop, draw loop through fabric, then draw yarn ends through loop and tighten. Attach 50 (52, 54) fringe each along cast-on edge of back and front, spaced approx. 0.5 cm apart. Trim fringe to 12 cm.

**Tip:** Refer to page 30 on how to make and attach fringe.



## DESIGN 11

### Cardigan Cashsilk + Cashsilk Degradé Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to

all sizes.

**Materials:** 350 (350, 400) g of Lana Grossa **Cashsilk** (40% polyamide, 30% bamboo, 15% cashmere, 15% silk; 75 m/ 50 g) in Midnight Blue (col 14) and 200 (200, 250) g in Steel Blue (col 52) and 200 (200, 250) g of Lana Grossa **Cashsilk Degradé** (40% polyamide, 30% bamboo, 15% cashmere, 15% silk; 75 m/ 50 g) in Blue-Grey/Jeans/Steel Blue/Midnight Blue (col 111). Size 9 mm needles; size 8 cm circular needle, 60 cm long; one pair of 30 mm snaps in brass [by Union Knopf, item 59217, col 851].

**Slip stitch selvage:** Knit the first st of every row and sl the last st of every row as if to purl with yarn in front of work.

**Slip garter selvage:** Slip first st of every row as if to knit and knit last st of every row.

**Garter st:** K every row.

**Full-fashion decreases:** At beg of RS row, selvage st, k1, k2tog; at end of RS row, work to last 4 sts, SKP (slip 1 st as if to knit, k1, pass slipped st over knitted st), k1, selvage st.

**Gauge:** 13 sts and 25 rows = 10 x 10 cm in garter st on size 9 mm needles.

**Back:** With size 9 mm needles and Cashsilk col 52, cast on 62 (67, 72) sts. Beg with a WS row and working a slip garter selvage at beg and end of rows, work in garter st for 18 cm, ending with a WS row. Change to Cashsilk Degradé and cont in garter st until back


measures 32 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 1 st at beg of next 2 rows = 50 (55, 60) sts. Cont until a total of 18 cm has been worked with Cashsilk Degradé, ending with a WS row. Change to Cashsilk col 14 and work remainder of back with col 14. Cont until armhole measures 21 (22, 23) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: Bind off 2 (4, 4) sts at each shoulder edge once, 3 (3, 4) sts 3 times. At same time, on third row of shoulder shaping, shape neck: Bind off center 24 (25, 24) sts. Working each side separately, bind off 1 st at each neck edge twice. No sts remain after shoulder and neck shaping is complete.

**Left front:** With size 9 mm needles and Cashsilk col 52, cast on 38 (40, 42) sts. Working a slip garter selvage at right edge and a slip st selvage at left [= front] edge, work in garter st and change colors same as for back until left front measures same length as back to armhole. Shape armhole at right edge same as for back = 32 (34, 36) sts. Cont until armhole measures 16 (17, 18) cm, ending with a RS row. Shape front neck edge: Bind off 10 sts at beg of next WS row, 3 sts at beg of next WS row, 2 sts at beg of next 2 WS rows, 1 st at beg of next 4 (4, 3) WS rows and when left front measures same length as back to shoulder, shape shoulder at right edge same as for back. No sts remain after shoulder and neck shaping is complete.

**Right front:** Work same as for left front, reversing all shaping.

**Sleeves:** With size 9 mm needles and Cashsilk col 14, cast on 49 (51, 54) sts. Beg with a WS row and working a slip garter selvage at beg and end of rows, work in garter st and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at beg and end of 12th row from cast-on, then every foll 12th row 3 times = 41 (43, 46) sts. Cont until sleeve measures 26 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 1 st at beg of next 2 rows, [work 10 rows even, bind off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows] twice, [work 2 rows even, bind off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows] twice, 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Bind off remaining 7 (9, 12) sts.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. With size 8 mm circular needle and Cashsilk col 14, pick up and knit 70 sts along right front, back and left front neck edge and work in garter st for 2 rows. Bind off all sts. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew snaps to left and right front neck edge.

**Pullover**  
**Wakame** +  
**Cashsilk**  
**Size 36/38 (40/42,**  
**44/46)**

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

**Materials:** 400 (450, 500) g of Lana Grossa **Wakame** (75% cotton, 25% viscose; 125 m/50 g) in Violet Blue (col 29) and 50 g of Lana Grossa **Cashsilk** (40% polyamide, 30% bamboo, 15% cashmere, 15% silk; 75 m/50 g) in Jeans (col 22). Size 4 mm needles; size 6 mm crochet hook.

**Rib pattern:** K1, p1.

**Stockinette:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Full-fashion decreases:** At beg of RS row, selvage st, k1, k2tog; at end of RS row, work to last 4 sts, SKP (slip 1 st as if to knit, k1, pass slipped st over knitted st), k1, selvage st.

**Gauge:** 20 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette on size 4 mm needles.


**Back:** With size 4 mm needles and Wakame, cast on 102 (110, 118) sts and work in rib pat for 2 rows = approx. 1 cm. Next, work in stockinette for 37 cm, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeves: Inc 1 st at beg and end of next 2 RS rows, then cast on 2 sts at beg of next 8 rows = 122 (130, 138) sts. Cont until sleeves measure 14 (15, 16) cm from last sleeve cast-on row, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 26 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge once, 1 st once. Bind off remaining 45 (49, 53) sts for each shoulder/overarm.

**Front:** Work same as for back until front measures 34 (35, 36) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape V-neck: Divide front at center. Working each side separately and working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each neck edge every RS row twice, then every other RS row 14 times. At same time, when front measures same length as back to sleeves, shape sleeves same as for back and when front measures same length as back to shoulders/overarms, bind off remaining 45 (49, 53) sts for each shoulder/overarm.

**Sleeves:** With size 4 mm needles and Wakame, cast on 58 (62, 66) sts and work in rib pat for 2 rows = approx. 1 cm. Next, work in stockinette and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at beg and end of 5th row, then every foll 6th row twice, then every foll 4th row 3 times = 70 (74, 78) sts. Cont until sleeve measures 14 cm from cast-on, then bind off all sts loosely.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. With size 6 mm crochet hook and Cashsilk, work 1 row half double crochet [hdc] along front and back

shoulders/overarms, working 1 hdc in every other bound-off st. With crochet hook and Cashsilk, join shoulder/overarms with a row of slip st. With size 6 mm crochet hook and Cashsilk, work 1 rnd hdc around neck edge and 1 row hdc along left and right sleeve cast-on edge, always working 1 hdc in every other st and/or row. Sew on sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.

**Scarf**  
**Wakame Print** +  
**Cashsilk**  
**Size** Approx. 120 x  
15 cm

**Materials:** 100 g of Lana Grossa **Wakame Print** (75% cotton 25% viscose; 125 m/50 g) in Pale-/Light-/

Medium Blue/Marine/Midnight (col 103) and 50 g of Lana Grossa **Cashsilk** (40% polyamide, 30% bamboo, 15% cashmere, 15% silk; 75 m/50 g) in Jeans (col 22). Size 4 mm needles; size 6 mm crochet hook.


**Stockinette:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Gauge:** 20 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette on size 4 mm needles.


**Instructions:** With size 4 mm needles and Wakame Print, cast on 30 sts and work in stockinette for 120 cm, leaving just enough yarn to bind off. Bind off all sts.

**Finishing:** Pin scarf to measurements and block. With size 6 mm crochet hook and Cashsilk, work 1 rnd half double crochet [hdc] around entire edge of scarf. Join yarn with a slip stitch to one corner of scarf, ch2 (count as 1 hdc). Work 3 hdc in each corner, 1 hdc in every other st along cast-on and bound-off edge and 2 rows in from edge and 1 hdc around every selvage st.


## HOW TO MAKE AND ATTACH FRINGE




1 Wrap yarn around a piece of cardboard or cutting board that is the desired length of the fringe. Cut one edge to free the wrapped strands. Desired length is twice the length of the finished fringe plus approx. 1 cm for knotting.



2 Fold 2 – 4 strands of yarn in half to form a loop, draw loop through fabric from back to front with crochet hook.



3 Draw yarn ends through loop and tighten. Trim the strands.



4 If you prefer a knotted fringe, take one half of the strands from each fringe and knot them with half the strands from the neighboring fringe.





5 Repeat this process for desired result. Remember to cut strands longer to account for extra knotting. You may want to cut a few test strands first.

### TIP: HOW TO MAKE A TASSEL

Wrap yarn around 3 to 4 fingers of your left hand. Carefully take the strands off your hand and lay them down flat. Thread a strand of yarn and tie off the strands at the top, leaving a long end. Cut the lower edge to free the wrapped strands. Wrap the long end of the yarn around the upper edge, insert the yarn under the shank and pull tight.

**Rib pattern:** Work according to chart A. Numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows, number at right edge of chart indicates RS row. Beg chart pat with sts before first arrow, work 2 sts between arrows for pat repeat, end with sts after 2nd arrow. First and last 3 sts are worked as a slip st edge. Work rows 1 – 3 once, then repeat rows 2 and 3 throughout.

**Fisherman's rib:** Work according to chart B. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows, number at left edge of chart indicates WS row. Beg





Next, work in Fisherman's rib according to chart B for 10 cm, ending with a WS row. Shape sides: Working full-fashion dec, dec 2 sts at beg and end of next RS row, then every foll 22nd row once = 73 (79) sts. Cont until back measures 67.5 cm from cast-

on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 41 sts. Working each side separately and working full-fashion dec, dec 2 sts at each neck edge every other RS row twice. Bind off remaining 12 (15) sts for each shoulder.

**Front:** Note that front is 10 cm shorter than back. Work same as for back, working decs for side shaping on 11th and 23rd row worked in Fisherman's rib and work neck shaping when front measures 57.5 cm from cast-on.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Place markers at side seams, 16.5 cm and 22.5 cm up from lower edge of back. Sew side seams between markers. With size 5 mm crochet hook, work 1 rnd crab st [work single crochet from left to right] around neck edge.

edge and a slip st selvage at left [= front] edge, work same as for back to armhole, ending with a WS row. **Left sleeve:** With size 3.5 mm needles, cast on 60 (64, 68) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in garter st for 5 rows = approx. 1.5 cm, working a slip garter selvage at beg and end of rows. Maintaining slip garter selvage, work in ridge pat and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at beg and end of 9th (13th, 11th) row, then every foll 16th (12th, 10th) rows 7 (9, 11) times = 76 (84, 92) sts. Cont until sleeve measures 43 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan sleeve cap: Bind off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows. Bind off 1 st at beg of every other RS row 18 (17, 16) times, then every foll RS row 8 (13, 18) times; **at same time**, while working shaping at right edge, work shaping at left edge as foll: Bind off 1 st at beg of every other WS row 19 (18, 17) times, then every foll WS row 3 (8, 13) times. Bind off 9 sts at beg of next WS row, 8 sts at beg of next WS row, remaining 9 sts on next WS row.

**Right sleeve:** Work same as for left sleeve, reversing raglan cap shaping.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew raglan seams. With size 3.5 mm circular needle and RS facing, pick up and knit 84 sts along right front, back and left front neck edge. Next WS row: Knit. Next RS row: Bind off all sts.



## DESIGN 15

### Jacket Solo Lino Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

**Materials:** 450 (500, 550) g of Lana Grossa Solo Lino (80% recycled linen (viscose), 20% linen; 120 m/50 g) in Soft Blue (col 4). Size 3.5 mm needles; size 3.5 mm circular needle, 60 cm long.

**Slip stitch selvage:** Knit the first st of every row and sl the last st of every row as if to purl with yarn in front of work.

**Slip garter selvage:** Slip first st of every row as if to knit and knit last st of every row.

**Garter st:** K every row.

**Stockinette:** K on RS, p on WS.



**Reverse stockinette:** P on RS, k on WS.

**Ridge pattern:** Work \* 3 rows in stockinette, 3 rows in reverse stockinette; rep from \* throughout.

**Left front:** With size 3.5 mm needles, cast on 64 (69, 74) sts. Working a slip garter selvage at right

**Slip garter selvage:** Slip first st of every row as if to knit and knit last st of every row. Work a slip garter selvage throughout.

**Garter st:** K every row.

**Stockinette:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Pattern mix:** Work according to chart on page 32.





slip garter selvage at beg and end of rows, work in garter st for 3 rows = approx. 1.5 cm. Change to size 9 mm needles. Maintaining slip garter selvage, work in stockinette for 34 cm, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeves: Cast on 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows, 13 sts at beg of next 4 rows = 124 (130, 136) sts. Change to size 9 mm circular needle. Working a slip st selvage at beg and end of rows, cont until sleeves measure 13 (14, 15) cm from last sleeve cast-on row, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 18 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge once, 2 sts twice. Sl remaining 46 (49, 52) sts for each shoulder/overarm to holders.

**Front:** With size 8 mm needles, cast on 64 (70, 76) sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working a slip garter selvage at beg and end of rows, work in garter st for 3 rows = approx. 1.5 cm. Change to size 9 mm needles. Maintaining slip garter selvage, work palm tree motif according to chart, working sts between arrow a and b (c and d / e and f) once. Work through chart row 86, then work remainder of front in stockinette. At same time, when front measures same length as back to sleeves, shape sleeves same as for back. Cont until sleeves measure 9 (10, 11) from last sleeve cast-on row, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 16 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge once, 1 st 5 times and when front measures same length as back to shoulders/overarms, sl remaining 46 (49, 52) sts for each shoulder/overarm to holders.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Graft shoulder/overarms or join with 3-needle bind-off. With size 8 mm crochet hook, work 1 rnd single crochet, then 1 rnd crab st [work single crochet from left to right] around neck edge. Sew side and sleeve seams.

## HOW TO WORK WITH VARIEGATED YARNS

Variiegated yarns are yarns dyed with more than one color.

Organico Print and Wakame Print are examples of variegated yarns. The frequency of the colors can be long and spaced out, producing a self-striping pattern or colors can appear as shorter flecks. The effects vary depending on the technique of the crafter, the pattern used and the frequency of the color change.

These effects include "flashing" (lightning-bolt effects) and "pooling" (large splotches of color).

While these effects can be integrated as a design element, they can sometimes be unwanted. To avoid color pooling, alternate 2 balls, using each ball for 2 rows, then switching. You may also want to start different balls at different color repeats.

**Materials:** 200 (250) g each of Lana Grossa **Il Puro** (100% silk; 100 m/50 g) in Grey-Brown (col 21) and Ivory (col 22). Size 5 and 6 mm needles; size 5 mm circular needle, 60 cm long; size 5.5 mm crochet hook.

**Slip garter selvage:** Slip first st of every row as if to knit and knit last st of every row.

**Slip stitch selvage:** Knit the first st of every row

and sl the last st of every row as if to purl with yarn in front of work.

**Rib pattern:** K1, p1.


**Stockinette:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Stripe sequence:** Work \* 8 rows with Ivory, 8 rows with Grey-Brown; rep from \* throughout.

**Chevron pattern:** Work according to chart on page 35. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows, numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows. Position sts as given in instructions. Work rows 1 – 4 once, then repeat rows 3 and 4 throughout.

**Gauge:** On size 6 mm needles, 15 sts and 22.5 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette; 16.5 sts and 19.5 rows = 10 x 10 cm in chevron pat.

**Back:** With size 5 mm needles and Grey-Brown, cast on 71 (79) sts. Working a slip garter selvage at beg and end of rows, work in rib pat for 4.5 cm, ending with a WS row. Change to size 6 mm needles. Next RS row: Work first 2 sts of chevron



Work in pat as established for 80 rows and back measures approx. 46 cm from cast-on, measured along center of work. Next RS row: Work in pat to 1 st before center st, k2tog, work to end. Next WS row: Divide back at center = 35 (39) sts each side. Working each side separately, work in stockinette without working decs and incs, cont to follow stripe sequence and work a slip stitch selvage at each neck edge for 16 rows = approx. 7 cm. Shape sleeves: Cast on 21 sts at left and right sleeve edge = 56 (60) sts each side. Working a slip st selvage at each sleeve edge, cont in pat as established until sleeves measure approx. 17 cm and 40 rows have been worked from sleeve cast-on row. Loosely bind off all sts.

**Front:** Work same as for back.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Beg at neck edge, sew shoulder/overarm seams over 4 cm, leave next 17 (19) cm unsewn, sew remaining 13 cm. With size 5 mm circular needle and Grey-Brown, pick up and knit 62 sts along left sleeve edge and work in rib pat for 1.5 cm. Bind off all sts in rib. Repeat for right sleeve edge. Sew side and sleeve seams. With size 5.5 mm crochet hook, join Grey-Brown to right back neck edge. Crochet a 40 cm long chain, then work 1 row of slip st over the chain. Repeat at left back neck edge. Tie chains at center of back.

**Pullover Solo Lino Mélange**  
**Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46)**

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to

all sizes.

**Materials:** 400 (450, 500) g of Lana Grossa **Solo Lino Mélange** (80% recycled linen (viscose), 20% linen; 105 m/50 g) in Beige Melange (col 103) and 100 (150, 150) g in White (col 101). Size 5 mm needles; size 5 mm circular needles, 60 and 100 cm long.

**Slip garter selvage:** Slip first st of every row as if to knit and knit last st of every row.

**Slip stitch selvage:** Knit the first st of every row and sl the last st of every row as if to purl with yarn in front of work.

**Rib pattern A:** Work according to chart A. Numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows, number at right edge of chart indicates RS row. Beg chart pat with sts before first arrow, work 3 sts between arrows for pat repeat, end with sts after 2nd arrow. Work rows 1 – 3 once.

**Rib pattern B in rows:** Work according to chart B. Number at right edge of chart indicates RS row, number at left edge of chart indicates WS row. Beg chart pat with sts before first arrow, work 2 sts between arrows for pat repeat, end with sts after 2nd arrow. Repeat rows 1 and 2 throughout.

**Rib pattern B in rnds:** Rnd 1: Work the 2-st pat rep of row 1 of chart B around. Rnd 2: Knit all sts. Repeat rnds 1 and 2 throughout.

**Stockinette:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Full-fashion increases:** On RS rows, work M1R inc, 3 sts in from each edge.

**Full-fashion decreases:** At beg of RS row, SKP (slip 1 st as if to knit, k1, pass slipped st over knitted st), 3 sts in from edge; at end of RS row, k2tog, 3 sts in from edge.


**Gauge:** 21 sts and 27 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette and rib pat B on size 5 mm needles.

**Back:** With size 5 mm needles and Beige Melange, cast on 89 (98, 107) sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working a slip garter selvage at beg and end of rows, work the 3 rows of rib pat A according to chart A = approx. 1 cm. Next, maintaining slip garter selvage, work in stockinette for 32 (33, 34) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at beg and end of next RS rows, then every other RS row 9 times = 109 (118, 127) sts. Cont until armhole measures 16 (17, 18) cm from first inc row, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: Bind off 5 (6, 7) sts at each shoulder edge once, then 5 sts 5 times (then 6 sts 3 times, 5 sts twice / then 7 sts twice, 6 sts 3 times). At same time, when back measures 1.5 cm from beg of shoulder shaping, shape neck on next RS row as foll: Bind off center 37 (38, 37)

sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge once, 2 sts once, 1 st once. No sts remain after shoulder and neck shaping is complete.

**Front:** Work same as for back until armhole measures 9.5 (10.5, 11.5) cm from first inc row, ending with a WS row. Shape neck and shoulders: Bind off center 29 (30, 29) sts. Working each side separately and working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each neck edge every RS row 10 times and when front measures same length as back to shoulders, shape shoulders same as for back. No sts remain after shoulder and neck shaping is complete.


**Sleeves:** With size 5 mm needles and White, cast on 49 (53, 57) sts. Beg with a WS row [= chart row 2] and working a slip garter selvage at beg and end of rows, work in rib pat B according to chart B for 9 cm, ending with a WS row. 





### DOUBLE STRANDED LONG-TAIL CAST-ON

Wrap the yarn from the ball around your forefinger, then wrap around left thumb, double-stranding yarn (length should be at least twice the width of the cast-on), then wrap around left thumb again. The tail end of the yarn is looped around left thumb. Insert needle upwards through double loop on your left thumb, wrap yarn on your forefinger over needle and pull through loop on your thumb to form a stitch. Take your thumb out of the loop and tighten the loop on the needle. Wrap doubled yarn around left thumb again and hold first stitch with right hand. The yarn from the ball wraps around your forefinger and leads to the needle. Continue forming stitches until the required number of stitches has been cast on.

rnds = 10 x 10 cm in slip st pat; 16 sts and 20 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette.

**Body:** Body is worked in one piece to underarms, then separated for back and front. With size 5 mm circular needle, Natural/Sand and double stranded long-tail cast-on, cast on 148 sts. Join for working in rnds, place beg of rnd marker and 2nd marker after 74 sts to indicate "side seams". Change to size 6 mm circular needle, work in stockinette and shape sides as foll: Work M1R inc 1 st after and 1 st before each marker (= 4 sts increased) on rnd 2, 5 and 8 = 160 sts. Cont until body measures 6 cm from cast-on, then work in slip st pat according to chart, working the 10-st pat rep 16 times around = 8 pat reps each for back and front. When body measures approx. 34 cm from beg of slip st pat and a total of 75 rnds has been worked in slip st pat, divide for back and

front at markers. Sl 80 back sts to a holder and work in stockinette with Natural/Sand across remaining 80 front sts back and forth in rows as foll: Next RS row: Bind off 4 sts for left armhole, work to center 2 sts, skip next st on left needle, knit next st, knit skipped st then sl both sts to right needle, work to end. Next WS row: Bind off 4 sts for right armhole, divide work at center for V-neck and cont as foll: Working each side separately, working full-fashion dec and working 3 selvage sts at each neck edge and at each armhole edge, dec 1 st at each neck edge every RS row 9 times. At same time, working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each armhole edge every other RS row 3 times = 24 sts each side. Cont until armhole measures 20 cm, then shape shoulders as foll: Bind off 6 sts at each shoulder edge 3 times = 6 sts remain for neckband extensions. Cast on 1 selvage st at right edge of left neckband extension (left edge of right

neckband extension) = 7 sts and cont in pat as established on these 7 sts for 9 cm more. Sl sts to a holder. Next, with Natural/Sand, k80 back sts from holder. Working decs and 3 selvage sts at each armhole edge same as for front, cont in stockinette until back measures same length as front to shoulders. Shape shoulders same as for front. Bind off remaining 30 sts.

**Finishing:** Pin piece to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Graft left and right neckband extensions tog, then sew side edges of neckband extensions to back neck edge.

Next RS row: Work center 75 sts in purl garter st, remaining sts as established for 12 cm, ending with a WS row. Next RS row: Work center 87 sts in stockinette, remaining sts as established for 4 cm, ending with a WS row. Next RS row: Work center 75 sts in chart pat (= rep rows 4 and 5), remaining sts as established for 6 cm. Sl sts to a holder; mark center 75 sts for V-neck.

**Slip stitch selvage:** Knit the first st of every row and sl the last st of every row as if to purl with yarn in front of work.

**Chart pattern:** Numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows, numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows. Position sts and work rows as given in instructions. Note: 1 st and 1 yo are treated as 1 st.

**Seed stitch:** K1, p1; on foll rows, purl the knit sts and knit the purl sts.

**Purl garter st:** P every row.

**Stockinette:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Gauges:** On size 5.5 mm needles, 15.5 sts and 21 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette; 15.5 sts and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm in seed st.

**Note:** Pullover is worked as one piece which is later folded and seamed to create the garment.

**Back:** With size 5 mm circular needle, cast on 101 sts and work rows 1 - 3 of chart pat = approx. 1 cm. Cont in chart pat, repeating rows 4



**Gauge:** 17.5 sts and 21 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette and reverse stockinette on size 6 mm needles.

**Back:** With size 4.5 mm needles, cast on 99 (105, 113) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in rib pat for 5 rows = approx. 1.5 cm. Change to size 6 mm needles. Next RS row: Work in stockinette and dec 11 sts evenly across row = 88 (94, 102) sts. Cont in stockinette until back measures 36.5 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Cont until armhole measures 17 (18, 19) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 18 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 5 sts at each neck edge twice. Bind off remaining 12 (15, 19) sts for each shoulder.

**Front:** Work same as for back until armhole measures 14 (15, 16) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 18 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge once, 2 sts twice, 1 st twice and when front measures same length as back to shoulders, bind off remaining 12 (15, 19) sts for each shoulder.

**Front overlay:** With size 4.5 mm needles, cast on 74 (77, 81) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in rib pat for 5 rows = approx. 1.5 cm. Change to size 6 mm needles. Next RS row: Work in reverse stockinette and dec 8 sts evenly across row = 66 (69, 73) sts. Cont in reverse stockinette until piece measures 36.5 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armhole: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next RS row, 2 sts at beg of next 2 RS rows, 1 st at beg of next 3 RS rows, then 1 st at beg of every other RS row twice = 53 (56, 60) sts. Cont until armhole measures 14 (15, 16) cm, ending with a RS row. Shape neck: Work first 13 sts, bind off next 18 sts, work to end. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge once, 2 sts twice, 1 st twice. Bind off remaining 3 right shoulder sts and remaining 12 (15, 19) left shoulder sts.

**Sleeves:** With size 4.5 mm needles, cast on 52 (55, 59) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in rib pat for 5 rows = approx. 1.5 cm. Change to size 6 mm needles. Next RS row: Work in stockinette and dec 6 sts evenly across row = 46 (49, 53) sts. Cont in stockinette and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at beg and end of 11th row worked in stockinette, then every foll 10th row 4 times = 56 (59, 63) sts. Cont until sleeve measures 30 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows, 1 st at beg of next 22 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 6 rows. Bind off remaining 14 (17, 21) sts.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. With stockinette side of front and reverse stockinette side of front overlay facing up, baste front overlay to front along left side edge, shoulders and neck edge. Sew shoulder and side seams, working through all thicknesses. With size 5 mm crochet hook, work 1 rnd single crochet around neck edge, working through both thicknesses along front neck edge. Sew in sleeves, working through both thicknesses along left front armhole. Sew sleeve seams.







(14, 15) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 18 (19, 18) sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge twice, 2 sts 3 times, 1 st twice. Bind off remaining 13 (17, 22) sts for each shoulder.

**Front:** Work same as for back until armhole measures 3 (4, 5) cm, ending with a WS row.

**Shape neck:** Bind off center 18 (19, 18) sts. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge once, 2 sts twice, 1 st every other row 3 times, then 1 st every foll 4th row 3 times and when front measures same length as back to shoulders, bind off remaining 13 (17, 22) sts for each shoulder.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder and side seams. With size 4 mm

crochet hook, work 1 rnd single crochet, then 1 rnd crab st [work single crochet from left to right] around neck edge and around each armhole edge.

### TIP

Even though you may want to start your project right away, it is important that you first make a gauge swatch using the original yarn in the pattern. In that way, you can be assured that your project will be a success.

**Size 36 – 40 (42 – 46)**

Instructions are given for first size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given,

it applies to both sizes.

**Materials:** 200 g of Lana Grossa **Organico** (100% organic cotton; 90 m/50 g) in Sand (col 83), 150 g in Ecru (col 6) and 50 (100) g in Brown/Grey (col 94); 300 g of Lana Grossa **Wakame** (75% cotton, 25% viscose; 125 m/50 g) in Natural (col 2) and 300 g of Lana Grossa **Wakame Print** (75% cotton, 25% viscose; 125 m/50 g) in Natural/Beige/Greige/Sand/Grey (col 105). Size 5 and 5.5 mm needles; size 5 mm crochet hook; one 25 mm snap button in camel [by Union Knopf, item 19630, col 16].

**Note:** Work with single strand of Organico, but 1 strand of Wakame and 1 strand of Wakame Print held tog throughout.

**Slip garter selvage:** Slip first st of every row as if to knit and knit last st of every row. Work a slip garter selvage throughout.

**Rib pattern:** K1, p1.

**Stockinette:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Reverse stockinette:** P on RS, k on WS.

**Fisherman's rib:** Work according to chart on page 41. Numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows, number at right edge of chart indicates RS row. Beg chart pat with sts before first arrow, work 2 sts between arrows for pat repeat, end with sts after 2nd arrow. Work rows 1 – 3 once, then repeat rows 2 and 3 throughout. Note: 1 st and 1 yo are treated as 1 st.

**Stripe sequence A [back and fronts]:** Purl 1 RS row with Sand, then work 8 rows in reverse stockinette with Brown/Grey, 22 rows in reverse stock-

inette with Sand, 8 rows in reverse stockinette with Brown/Grey, 40 rows in reverse stockinette with 1 strand Wakame and 1 strand Wakame Print held tog, 12 rows in stockinette with 1 strand Wakame and 1 strand Wakame Print held tog, 12 rows in stockinette with Ecru = 103 rows and approx. 43 cm, 41 rows in Fisherman's rib with 1 strand Wakame and 1 strand Wakame Print held tog, 10 rows in stockinette with Ecru.


**Stripe sequence B [sleeves]:** Purl 1 RS row with Sand, then work 24 rows in reverse stockinette with 1 strand Wakame and 1 strand Wakame Print held tog, 10 rows in stockinette with Ecru, 43 rows in Fisherman's rib with 1 strand Wakame and 1 strand Wakame Print held tog, 10 rows in stockinette with Sand, 12 rows in stockinette with Ecru = 110 rows = approx. 43 cm.

**Full-fashion decreases A [worked on a RS = knit row when working in stockinette]:** At beg of RS row, selvage st, k1, SKP (slip 1 st as if to knit, k1, pass slipped st over knitted st); at end of RS row, work to last 4 sts, k2tog, k1, selvage st = 1 st decreased at each edge.

**Full-fashion decreases B [worked on a RS row when working in Fisherman's rib]:** At beg of RS row, selvage st, make a yo, then sl next st as if to purl, SK2P (slip 1 st as if to knit, k2tog, pass slipped st over knitted st); at end of RS row, work to last 5 sts, k3tog, make a yo, then sl next st as if to purl, selvage st = 2 sts decreased at each edge.

**Gauges:** On size 5.5 mm needles, 16 sts and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette and reverse stockinette with 1 strand Organico and/or 1 strand Wakame and 1 strand Wakame Print held tog; 16 sts and 27 rows = 10 x 10 cm in Fisherman's rib with 1 strand Wakame and 1 strand Wakame Print held tog.

**Back:** With size 5 mm needles and Sand, cast on



89 (95) sts and work in rib pat for 5 cm, ending with a WS row. Change to size 5.5 mm needles and work in stripe sequence A, ending with 16 rows in Fisherman's rib. Place marker at beg and end of last row to indicate beg of armholes.

Cont until back measures 17 (18) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: Bind off 7 (10) sts at each shoulder edge once, 8 sts 3 times. At same time, on 3rd row of shoulder shaping, shape neck: Bind off center 23 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge once. No sts remain after shoulder and neck shaping is complete.

**Left front:** With size 5 mm needles and Sand, cast on 49 (53) sts and work in rib pat for 5 cm, ending with a WS row. Change to size 5.5 mm needles and work in stripe sequence A for 84 (86) rows = approx. 35 (36) cm. Shape front edge: Working full-fashion dec A, dec 1 st at end of next RS row, then every other RS row twice. Working full-fashion dec B, dec 2 sts at end of 2nd row worked in Fisherman's rib, then every foll 8th row 3 times, then every foll 6th row twice. Work 5 (3) rows even.

Working full-fashion dec A, dec 1 st at end of next RS row, then every foll 6th (4th) row 2 (3) times. At same time, when left front measures same length as back to armhole, place armhole marker at right edge and when left front measures same length as back to shoulder, shape shoulder at right edge same as for back. No sts remain after shoulder and neck shaping is complete.

**Right front:** Work same as for left front, reversing all shaping.

**Sleeves:** With size 5 mm and Sand, cast on 41 (43) sts and work in rib pat for 6 cm, ending with a WS row. Change to size 5.5 mm needles, work in stripe sequence B and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at beg and end of 12th row, then every foll 12th row 7 times = 57 (59) sts. Work increased sts into pattern. Work to end of stripe sequence B = 110 rows and sleeve measures approx. 49 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

**Pockets:** Make 2 alike. With size 5.5 mm needles and Sand, cast on 21 sts and work in reverse stockinette for 18 rows. Change to Brown/Grey and cont in reverse stockinette for 8 rows; change to Ecru and cont in reverse stockinette for 10 rows. Bind off all sts. Pocket measures approx. 15 cm from beg.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew on pockets, matching stripes. Sew shoulder seams. With size 5 mm crochet hook and Sand, work 1 row single crochet, then 1 row half double crochet along right front, back neck and left front edge. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew snap button to fronts at beg of front edge shaping.



**Gauge:** 18.5 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in main pat on size 5.5 mm needles.




**Left front:** With size 5 mm circular needle, cast on 69 sts. Next 2 rows: Work in main pat according to chart, working the 12-st pat rep between arrows 4 times. Change to size 5.5 mm circular needle and cont in main pat until left front measures 36 (34) cm from cast-on. Place marker at right edge to indicate beg of armhole. Cont until left front measures 16 (18) cm from marker, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulder/overarm at right edge same as for back = 11 sts remain for front band extension. Cont in pat as established on these 11 sts for 7 cm more, then bind off all sts.

**Right front:** Work same as for left front, reversing all shaping.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder/overarm seams. Sew left and right front band extensions tog, then sew side edges of front band extensions to back neck edge. With size 4.5 mm circular needle, pick up and knit 59 (67) sts between armhole markers at fronts and back. Beg with a WS row [= chart row 2], work in main pat according to chart for 3.5 cm, then bind off all sts in pat. Sew side seams.



**Slip garter selvage:** Slip first st of every row as if to knit and knit last st of every row. Work a slip garter selvage throughout.

**Rib pattern:** K1, p1.

**Stockinette:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Reverse stockinette:** P on RS, k on WS.



**Front:** With size 3.5 mm needles and Nougat, cast on 122 (132) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in rib pat for 3 rows = approx. 1 cm. Change to size 4 mm needles. Next RS row:

Working a slip garter selvage at beg and end of row, work first 61 (66) sts in reverse stockinette with Nougat, work remaining 61 (66) sts in stockinette with Cognac. Work in pat as established and work A-line shaping as foll: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at beg and end of 21st row, then every foll 16th row 6 times = 108 (118) sts. At same time, when front measures approx. 26 cm from cast-on and a total of 80 rows has been worked in Intarsia pattern, switch colors and stitch patterns on next RS row as foll: Work first 61 (66) sts in stockinette with Red, work remaining 61 (66) sts in reverse stockinette with Reed. Work in pat as established for 42 (46) rows = approx. 13 (14) cm. Shape neck and armholes: Bind off center 16 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 5 sts at each neck edge once, 3 sts once, 2 sts 3 times, 1 st every other row 3 times, 1 st every foll 4th row

3 times, 1 st every foll 6th row twice, 1 st every foll 12th row once.

At same time, when front measures approx. 16 cm and 52 rows have been worked from last color and stitch pattern change, shape armholes as foll: Bind off 4 sts at each armhole edge once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once, 1 st once. When armhole measures 18 (19) cm and 58 (62) rows have been worked from beg of armhole shaping, bind off remaining 13 (18) sts for each shoulder.

**Back:** Work same as for front, reversing colors and stitch patterns until armhole measures 16 (17) cm and 52 (56) rows have been worked from last color and stitch pattern change. Shape neck: Bind off center 56 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge once, 1 st once and when back measures same length as front to shoulders, bind off remaining 13 (18) sts for each shoulder.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder and side seams. With size 3.5 mm crochet hook, work 1 rnd single crochet, then 1 rnd crab st [work single crochet from left to right] around neck edge, using appropriate color yarn. When changing colors, work st up to second to last step so that 2 loops remain on the hook, then use the new color to complete the st. Bobble trim: With size 3.5 mm crochet hook and appropriate color yarn, work 1 rnd single crochet around left armhole edge, then work bobbles across 23 sts on either side of shoulder line = 46 sts total. Work bobble trim according to chart, working the pat rep between arrows 12 times = 16 bobbles. Work 1 row crab st [work single crochet from left to right] along remaining armhole edge, then cut yarn and fasten off. Repeat around right armhole edge.

**Materials:** 500 (550) g of Lana Grossa **Cashsilk** (40% polyamide, 30% bamboo, 15% cashmere, 15% silk; 75 m/ 50 g) in Burgundy (col 51), 200 g in Dark Grey (col 12) and 150 g in Natural (col 8). Size 7.5 and 8 mm needles; size 8 mm crochet hook.

**Slip garter selvage:** Slip first st of every row as if to knit and knit last st of every row.

**Rib pattern:** K1, p1.

**Stockinette:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Purl garter st:** P every row.

**Intarsia pattern:** Work each block of color over 17 (19) sts, working each block of color with separate ball of yarn or bobbin. Twist yarns around each other at each color change to prevent holes. For each block, work 26 rows in stockinette, then 2 rows in purl garter st = 28 rows per block. Numbers on schematic indicate colors used (refer to color numbers under Materials).


**Chart patterns A and B on page 43:** Numbers at right edge of charts indicate RS rows, numbers at left edge of charts indicate WS rows. Position sts as given in instructions.

**Gauge:** 14 sts and 22 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette and purl garter st on size 8 mm needles.

**Back:** With size 7.5 needles and Burgundy, cast on 70 (78) sts and work in rib pat for 4 rows = approx. 2 cm. Change to size 8 mm needles. Working a slip garter selvage at beg and end of rows, work in Intarsia pat, using colors according to schematic. Work for 120 (118) rows and back measures approx. 56.5 (55.5) from cast-on. Shape armholes: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 1 st at beg of next 4 rows = 56 (64) sts. Cont until armhole measures 19 (20) cm and 42 (44) rows have been worked from beg of armhole shaping. Shape

shoulders and neck: Bind off 6 sts at each shoulder edge once, 5 (7) sts twice. At same time, on 3rd row of shoulder shaping, shape neck: Bind off center 16 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge once. No sts remain after shoulder and neck shaping is complete.

**Left front:** With size 7.5 mm needles and Burgundy, cast on 41 (45) sts and work rows 1 – 4 of chart pat A. Change to size 8 mm needles. Next RS row: Slip garter selvage, work in Intarsia pat to last 6 sts, work last 6 sts as established [= last 6 sts of chart A], always working last 6 sts in appropriate color yarn as well. Work in pat as established for 86 rows and left front measures approx. 41 cm from cast-on. Shape front edge: Work to last 9 sts on next RS row, k2tog, work to end. Repeat dec row every foll 6th row 11 times. At same time, when left front measures same length as back to armhole, shape armhole at right edge same as for back and when left front measures same length as back to shoulder, shape shoulder at right edge same as for back = 6 sts remain for front band extension. Cast on 1 selvage st at right edge of front band extension = 7 sts and cont in pat as established for 9 cm more, working the newly cast-on selvage st at right edge as foll: On RS rows, k1tbl; on WS rows, sl 1 st as if to purl with yarn in front of work. Bind off all sts.



**Right front:** Work same as for left front, reversing all shaping and following chart pat B. Work decreases for front edge shaping on RS rows as foll: Work first 7 sts as established, SKP (slip 1 st as if to knit, k1, pass slipped st over knitted st), work to end. Work newly cast-on selvage st at left edge of front band extension as foll: On RS rows, p1; on WS rows, sl 1 st as if to knit with yarn in back of work.


**Sleeves:** With size 7.5 mm needles and Burgundy, cast on 34 (38) sts and work in rib pat for 4 rows = approx. 2 cm. **Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Sew left and right front band extensions tog, then sew side edges of front band extensions to back neck edge. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.

**Belt:** With size 8 mm needles and Burgundy, cast on 7 sts. Next RS row: Work first 6 sts of row 1 of chart pat B, p1. Next WS row: Sl 1 st as if to knit with yarn in back of work, work last 6 sts of row 2 of chart pat B. Repeat last 2 rows until belt measures 165 cm from cast-on, then bind off all sts in pat. Belt loops: Make 2 alike. With size 8 mm crochet hook and Burgundy, crochet a 6 cm long chain. Sew belt loops waist-high to left and right side edge.





Work increased sts into slip st pat. Next, work in stockinette and cont to shape sides as foll: Inc 1 st at beg and end of 7th row, then every foll 8th row 5 times = 77 (83) sts. Cont

until back measures 36 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 1 st at beg of next 4 rows = 69 (75) sts. Cont until armhole measures 10 (11) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 29 sts. Working each side separately and working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each neck edge 6 times. Bind off remaining 14 (17) sts for each shoulder.

**Front:** Work same as for back until armhole measures 5 (6) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 19 sts. Working each side separately and working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each neck edge 11 times and when front measures same length as back to shoulders, bind off remaining 14 (17) sts for each shoulder.

**Sleeves:** With size 8 mm needles, cast on 41 (45) sts. Purl 1 WS row, then work rows 1 – 28 of slip st pat A according to chart A. Next, work in stockinette and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at beg and

end of 3rd row, then every foll 24th row twice = 47 (51) sts. Cont until sleeve measures 42 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 1 st at beg of next 4 rows. Bind off remaining 39 (43) sts.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Neckband: With size 8 mm needles, cast on 7 sts and work in slip st pat B according to chart B for 70 cm, then bind off all sts in pat. Sew cast-on edge to bound-off edge. With seam of neckband centered over back neck edge, sew neckband to back and front neck edge, sewing 12 cm of neckband to left back neck edge, leaving next 12 cm unsewn, then sewing 22 cm of neckband to front neck edge, leaving next 12 cm unsewn, sewing remaining 12 cm to right back neck edge. With size 7 mm crochet hook, work 1 rnd slip stitch around inside edge of neckband and along left and right open neck edge.





**Motifs:** Make 8 alike. For each motif, work rnds 1 – 6 of chart A once. Numbers on chart indicate rnds. Beg motif with ch4, sl st to first ch to form ring. Beg rnd 1 with ch3 (count as 1 dc). On rnd 2, work first dc of each group in dc on rnd below, work remaining 3 dc of group into ch-sp on rnd below. On rnd 6, work sts into ch-sp on rnd below. Chart shows rnds 1 – 6 in their



entirety. Cut yarn and fasten off after having worked to end of rnd 6.

**Double crochet mesh pattern:** Worked back and forth in rows according to chart B. Beg each row with the number of chains shown on chart. Numbers at right and left edge of chart indicate rows. Beg chart pat with sts before first arrow, work 2 sts between arrows for pat repeat, end with sts after 2nd arrow. Work rows 1 – 6 once, then work rows [5 and 6] 3 times = 12 rows total, then work rows 13 – 16 once, then work rows [15 and 16] 3 times = 22 rows total, then work rows [23 and 24] 5 times = 32 rows total, then work rows 33 – 42 once, then work rows 41 and 42 once, then work row 41 once more = 45 rows total.




**Gauges:** With size 5.5 mm crochet hook, 20 sts and 7 rows = 10 x 10 cm in double crochet mesh pat; one motif = 18 x 18 cm.

**Back:** With size 5.5 mm crochet hook, crochet 4 motifs. With right sides tog, join motifs with rows of sl st. Next, work 1 row sc along outer edges of top motifs, work 2 rows dc along outer edges of bottom motifs. Cut yarn and fasten off.

**Left front:** With size 5.5 mm crochet hook, crochet 2 motifs. With right sides tog, join motifs with a row of sl st. Next, work 1 row sc along right outer edge of top motif, work 2 rows dc along right outer edge of bottom motif. Cut yarn and fasten off.

**Right front:** Work same as for left front.

**Sleeves:** With size 5.5 mm crochet hook, ch65 + ch1. Working first sc on first row in 2nd ch

from hook, work in double crochet mesh pat according to chart B = 65 sc after row 1. Dec 1 st at beg and end of rows 13 and 23 as shown on chart = 61 sts. Dec 4 sts at beg and end of next 2 rows, 1 st at beg and end of next 5 rows, 2 sts at beg and end of next 4 rows = 19 sts. Cut yarn and fasten off.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams over 9.5 cm. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Work 1 row dc along bottom edge and along left and right front edge, working 3 dc in each corner at bottom edge. Work 1 row sc along right front, back and right front neck edge.


**Shawl  
Il Puro**

**Size:** Approx. 56 x 112 cm

**Materials:** 200 g of Lana Grossa **Il Puro** (100% silk; 100 m/50 g) in Grey/Brown (**col 21**) and 100 g each in Bordeaux

(**col 16**), Caramel (**col 23**) and Patina (**col 20**). Size 6 mm circular needle, 80 cm long.

block. Make 13 tassels, each approx. 10 cm long and using approx. 5 g of yarn. Make 1 tassel with Grey/Brown and 2 tassels each with remaining colors. Sew tassels to shaped side edges and tip of shawl, following colors as given on schematic.



**Slip stitch selvage:** Knit the first st of every row and sl the last st of every row as if to purl with yarn in front of work. Work a slip st selvage throughout.

**Garter st:** K every row.

**Gauge:** 16 sts and 32 rows = 10 x 10 cm in garter st on size 6 mm needles.

**Instructions:** With size 6 mm needles and Grey/Brown, cast on 181 sts. Next 2 rows: Slip st selvage, work in garter st to last st, slip st selvage. Next [dec] row: Slip st selvage, k1, SKP (slip 1 st as if to knit, k1, pass slipped st over knitted st), work to last 4 sts, k2tog, k1, selvage st. Maintaining slip st selvage and working in garter st throughout, rep dec row every other row 86 times = 7 sts. Work 1 row even. Next row: Slip st selvage, k1, SK2P [slip 1 st as if to knit, k1, pass slipped st over knitted st], k1, slip st selvage = 5 sts. Work 1 row even. Next row: Slip st selvage, SK2P, slip st selvage = 3 sts. Work 1 row even. Next row: SK2P. Cut yarn and pull through last st on needle.

**Finishing:** Pin shawl to measurements and

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
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
