About Love&peace Cardigan

The Love&peace Cardigan is worked from the top down with a special patchwork mood. It features a lovely and casual design, incorporating adorable heart patterns, various cable patterns, and lace stitches on a collar cardigan. Begin with the yoke, working raglan increases and increases along the front side. The sleeves are worked in the round on needles, following the provided chart. Front plackets are worked separately with buttonholes, and then complete the cardigan with a vertical placket by attaching it using a tapestry needle and lastly, knit a cute collar. Please refer to the written instructions and charts. Please read the written instructions and the charts. Happy knitting with the Love&peace Cardigan. 🙌❤️




Size Selection Tips

Love&peace Cardigan is designed with a relaxed fit and slightly cropped length. Although it is worked top-down, it might not be easy to adjust total length due to the pattern. There are variations in the pattern placement depending on size. Please note the pattern placement for each size on below. I recommend checking the final length when selecting a size based on your preference for the pattern.



Gauge swatch for Love&peace pattern

Dimension may vary depending on where you measure the 10 cm x 10 cm gauge. For your reference, when arranging the pattern as shown below, the swatch size is measured at 12 cm x 7 cm excluding 2-garter stitch on both sides. (after water washing and flat drying)



Abbreviation and chart symbols

RS: Right Side	 : Knit on RS / Purl on WS

 (2 rows = 1 RS and 1 WS) RS: Knit WS: slip purlwise with yarn in front	 : 2/1 LPC, two over one left purl cross (Slip 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold at front of work. Purl 1 st from left needle, then knit 2 sts from cable needle.
 : German Short Rows – turn the work so the wrong side is facing	 : 2/1 RPC Two Over One Right Purl Cross (Slip 1 st onto a cable needle and hold at back of work. Knit 2 sts from left needle, then purl 1 st from cable needle)
 : Double stitches (no stitch): slip the st from the left needle to the right needle purlwise with yarn in front. You can see that the yarn is in the front of the work. Insert your needle as if you were going to purl, then slip the stitch from the left needle to the right without working it. Pull the yarn to the back of the work OVER TOP of the right needle. This will distort the stitch, making it look as if there are 2 sts instead of 1.	



Before 3/3 left cross, 3/3 right cross, please make sure to refer to the instructional video through QR code

: 3/3 left cross, Slip 3 sts onto a cable needle and hold at front of work. Knit 3 sts from left needle, then knit 3 sts from cable needle

: 3/3 right cross, Slip 3 sts onto a cable needle and hold at back of work. Knit 3 sts from left needle, then knit 3 sts from cable needle

Cast On

Cast on 84 (84) 92 (92) sts on 4.5 mm circular needles, using long-tail cast on method or your preferred cast-on method. After cast-on, the next row is a WS row. Purl across one row by placing markers at “/” position.

Yoke

Turn above WS row with purl, placing marker. Now it is a RS row. Please follow the instructions on **Yoke Chart**. Start the raglan increases from row 1 marked on **Yoke Chart**. ‘1’ on **Yoke Chart** is RS row.

Progress sequence on RS is as follows: [Front Left – Sleeve Left – Back – Sleeve Right – Front Right]

⚠ Before 3/3 left cross, 3/3 right cross, please make sure to refer to the instructional video through QR code in **abbreviations and symbols**.

Work pattern according to **Yoke Chart** until all increases are completed, end on a WS row. Once completed, there are total 290 (306) 330 (346) sts, distributed as follows:

40 (42) 45 (47) / 2 (2) 2 (2) / 61 (65) 71 (75) / 2 (2) 2 (2) / 80 (84) 90 (94) / 2 (2) 2 (2) / 61 (65) 71 (75) / 2 (2) 2 (2) / 40 (42) 45 (47)

Body

Turn and now it is a RS row of the 1st row on **Body Chart**. On the 1st RS row, divide stitches for sleeves and remove all markers while dividing sleeve stitches. Work as follows:

Body separation: Row 1 (RS) on **Body Charts**

Work pattern in **Body Chart** to marker, K1 from 2 raglan sts, cast on 7 (7) 7 (9) sts for the underarm using the backward loop method, [place 1 st from 2 raglan sts, the left sleeve stitches and 1 st from next 2 raglan sts on a stitch holder], K1 sts from 2 raglan sts, work pattern in **Body Chart** across back to marker, K1 from next 2 raglan stitches, cast on 7 (7) 7 (9) sts for the underarm using the backward loop method, [place 1 st from 2 raglan sts, the right sleeve stitches and 1 st from next 2 raglan sts on a stitch holder], K1 from 2 raglan sts, Work pattern in **Body Chart** to end.

There are now total 178 (186) 198 (210) sts. The next row is a WS Row of 2nd row on **Body Chart**. Continue working back and forth in pattern on **Body Chart** until pattern ends.

Before working the rib, please note to change a 4.0 mm circular needle. And work decreases, working in 1 x 1 rib. Please check and see **Body Chart**.

Repeat 1 x 1 rib as **Body Chart** until ribbing measures 5 (6) 6 (7) cm or to the desired length. Bind off by using Italian bind-off technique or desired bind-off method.

Sleeve

Place the stitches that are on hold for one sleeve on a 4.5 mm circular needle. Pick up and knit 7 (7) 7 (9) sts in the cast on stitches from the body. Mark the beginning of the round in the middle of the underarm sts. (Refer to **Sleeve Chart** for placing marker.) Then, there are now total 70 (74) 80 (84) sts. Work pattern according to **Sleeve Chart**, decreasing every 8 (8) 6 (6)th round, until pattern ends or to the desired length.

Before working the ribbing, please note to change a 4.0 mm circular needle and work decreases according to **Sleeve Chart**. Work in the round in 1 x 1 rib (k1, p1) as **Sleeve Chart** until ribbing measures 4 cm or to the desired length. Bind off using Italian bind-off technique.

Work the other sleeve identically.

Front Placket

Before knitting the collar, it is essential to first connect the front placket. The left front placket and the right front placket are knitted following the instructions provided below and referencing the accompanying video.

Left front placket: is without buttonholes to be connected to the left front panel.



Please scan the QR code to see instructional video. Prepare two sets of 4.25 mm circular needles. (or, 4.0 mm circular needle and 4.5 circular needles) Use one circular needles (4.2 mm circular needles or 4.0 mm circular needles) and cast on 8 sts by using Judy’s magic cast on technique. Then, with an extra circular needles (4.2 mm circular needles or 4.5 mm circular needles), work [K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1]. From now on, use only the circular needle with stitches (Or, knit using one set of 4.0 mm needles and one set of 4.5 mm needles alternately.) Turn the work and knit as follows.

slip1(knit-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1

Repeat above RS row and WS row until the front placket reaches the similar length as the cardigan's left front edge. Before moving on the next step for attaching the front placket, please note to keep the stitches live and not bind them off.

Prepare a tapestry needle. Before binding off the front placket, facing RS, start at the upper part (neck) of left front of the cardigan and first row of the front placket. The first and last knit stitch of the cardigan and the last purl stitch of the front placket become the seam stitches.

Connect the cardigan and the front placket with the tapestry needle. Join 1 row for the cardigan and 1 row for the front placket. Work every row.

While continuing to attach the front placket to the end of the cardigan, align the length of the front placket with the end of the cardigan. If there is excess or insufficient length, knit up the front placket to match the length of the end of the cardigan, and then bind off with a RS row facing using the Italian bind-off technique.



Right front placket: with buttonholes to be connected to the right front panel.

After casting on 8 stitches using the Judy's magic cast on method as you did during the left front placket, work the setup row, and proceed as follows.

Row 1 (WS): slip1(knit-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1

[Row 2 (RS): slip1(knit-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1

Row 3 (WS): slip1(knit-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1]

Repeat [Row 2 and Row 3] the button placket (right front placket) as above, ending on a WS. Next row is a RS row.

To make buttonholes, knit one set { RS, WS } as follows, then repeat the [Row 2, Row 3]. Buttonholes are worked every 22 (22) 24 (24)th row or at desired intervals. Total 4 buttonholes have been worked.

{ RS: slip1(knit-wise), P1, K1, yarn over, **K2tog**, P1, K1, P1

WS: slip1(knit-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1 }

Repeat above rows including buttonholes until the front placket reaches the similar length as the cardigan's right front edge. Before moving on the next step for attaching the front placket, please note to keep the stitches live and not bind them off.

Prepare a tapestry needle. Before binding off the front placket, facing RS, start at the bottom part (rib) of right front of the cardigan and first row of the front placket. The first and last knit stitch of the cardigan and the last purl stitch of the front placket become the seam stitches.

Connect the cardigan and the front placket with the tapestry needle. Join 1 row for the cardigan and 1 row for the front placket. Work every row.

While continuing to attach the front placket to the end of the cardigan, align the length of the front placket with the end of the cardigan. If there is excess or insufficient length, knit up the front placket to match the length of the end of the cardigan, and then bind off with a RS row facing using the Italian bind-off technique.

Sew 4 buttons on along left front edge across from the buttonholes. (18 mm buttons x 5 pcs)

Collar

After knitting the front placket, work the collar. Facing WS, pick up stitches along the cardigan, using 4.0 mm needles in the following order: Left Front, Left Sleeve, Back, Right Sleeve, Right Front. Please refer to the number of sts as follows. the total number of sts can be adjusted, but it must be odd. As the collar folds over, RS of the cardigan becomes WS of the collar.

Front placket - 3 (3) 3 (3) sts,

Left front - 16 (16) 17 (17) sts,

Raglan - 2 (2) 2 (2) sts,

Left sleeve - 9 (9) 11 (11) sts,

Raglan - 2 (2) 2 (2) sts,

Back - 25 (25) 27 (27) sts,

Raglan - 2 (2) 2 (2) sts,

Right sleeve - 9 (9) 11 (11) sts,

Raglan - 2 (2) 2 (2) sts,

Right front - 16 (16) 17 (17) sts,
Front placket - 3 (3) 3 (3) sts

A total of 89 (89) 97 (97) sts are on the needle. Starting from the sts picked up along the back, work the collar according to the chart until it measures 10 cm or the desired length, increasing every 3 rows. Please note to switch to 4.5 mm needles at row 10.

Row 1 (WS): slip1(purl-wise), K1, P1, K1, P1, place a marker, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 6 sts before the marker, K1, place a marker, P1, K1, P1, K2

Row 2 (RS): slip1(purl-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, slip marker, P1, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to the marker, slip marker, K1, P1, K1, P2

Row 3 (WS) **increase row**: slip1(knit-wise), K1, P1, K1, P1, slip marker, **M1RP**, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 1 st before the marker, K1, **M1LP**, slip marker, P1, K1, P1, K2

Row 4 (RS): slip1(purl-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, slip marker, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 1 st before the marker, K1, slip marker, K1, P1, K1, P2

Row 5 (WS): slip1(knit-wise), K1, P1, K1, P1, slip marker, P1, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to the marker, slip marker, P1, K1, P1, K2

Row 6 (RS) **increase row**: slip1(purl-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, slip marker, **M1RP**, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 1 st before the marker, K1, **M1LP**, slip marker, K1, P1, K1, P2

Row 7 (WS): slip1(knit-wise), K1, P1, K1, P1, slip marker, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 1 st before the marker, K1, slip marker, P1, K1, P1, K2

Row 8 (RS): slip1(purl-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, slip marker, P1, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to the marker, slip marker, K1, P1, K1, P2

Row 9 (WS) **increase row**: slip1(knit-wise), K1, P1, K1, P1, slip marker, **M1RP**, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 1 st before the marker, K1, **M1LP**, slip marker, P1, K1, P1, K2

Change to 4.5 mm circular needles and work as follows.

Row 10 (RS): slip1(purl-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, slip marker, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 1 st before the marker, K1, slip marker, K1, P1, K1, P2

Row 11 (WS): slip1(knit-wise), K1, P1, K1, P1, slip marker, P1, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to the marker, slip marker, P1, K1, P1, K2

Row 12 (RS) **increase row**: slip1(purl-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, slip marker, **M1RP**, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 1 st before the marker, K1, **M1LP**, slip marker, K1, P1, K1, P2

Row 13 (WS): slip1(knit-wise), K1, P1, K1, P1, slip marker, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 1 st before the marker, K1, slip marker, P1, K1, P1, K2

Row 14 (RS): slip1(purl-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, slip marker, P1, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to the marker, slip marker, K1, P1, K1, P2

Row 15 (WS) **increase row**: slip1(knit-wise), K1, P1, K1, P1, slip marker, **M1RP**, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 1 st before the marker, K1, **M1LP**, slip marker, P1, K1, P1, K2

Row 16 (RS): slip1(purl-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, slip marker, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 1 st before the marker, K1, slip marker, K1, P1, K1, P2

Row 17 (WS): slip1(knit-wise), K1, P1, K1, P1, slip marker, P1, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to the marker, slip marker, P1, K1, P1, K2

Row 18 (RS) **increase row**: slip1(purl-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, slip marker, **M1RP**, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 1 st before the marker, K1, **M1LP**, slip marker, K1, P1, K1, P2

Row 19 (WS): slip1(knit-wise), K1, P1, K1, P1, slip marker, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 1 st before the marker, K1, slip marker, P1, K1, P1, K2

Row 20 (RS): slip1(purl-wise), P1, K1, P1, K1, slip marker, P1, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to the marker, slip marker, K1, P1, K1, P2

Row 21 (WS): slip1(knit-wise), K1, P1, K1, P1, slip marker, [K1, P1], Repeat [K1, P1] to 1 st before the marker, K1, slip marker, P1, K1, P1, K2

Work until Row 21 (WS) or to desired length. Bind off by using Italian bind-off technique, facing RS.

Weave in all tails.
