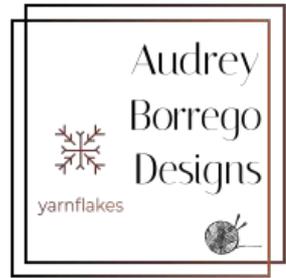


# Lueur



## Notes

This cosy shawl alternates varying textures for a fun experience. Going from twisted stitches to bicolour moss stitch, from bobbles to a garter tweed motif, it is a sampler of textures and colours.

Lueur is an asymmetrical triangle worked sideways. Started with a small tip and featuring garter edgings on both sides, it increases on one edge, 1 st every RS row, until the end. The four different motifs are worked twice, and the shawl ends with some garter stripes to match the edgings.

**Yarn :**

You will need two colours of sport weight yarn in the following amount :

MC : 555 metres – 610 yds

CC : 445 metres – 490 yds

Sample used BoucleLaine Merinos Angora (400 m – 437 yds / 100 g) in Verdier (MC) and Blanc Naturel (CC).

**Needles :**

4 mm (US 6) needles

or size required to get gauge

**Gauge :**

23 sts x 30 rows per 10 cm – 4" in texture A after blocking.

Note that a different gauge will affect size and yarn usage.

To swatch, cast-on 40 sts and work the Swatch Chart on page 4.

**Size :**

180 cm – 70 3/4" long

77 cm – 30 1/4" deep

**Notions :**

Stitch markers, scissors and tapestry needle  
row counter recommended

**Techniques used :**

Asymmetrical triangle shape shawl

Garter edges

Knit Front Back increases

Texture A : Knit, Purl, Right Twist

Texture B : Slipped stitch two colour moss stitch

Texture C : Twisted stitches, Garter, Bobbles (video tutorial included)

Texture D : Two colour garter slipped stitches

Pattern includes charted and written instructions

## Abbreviations :

- MC : main colour / CC : contrast colour
- CO : cast-on
- RS : right side / WS : wrong side
- st(s) : stitch(es)
- inc : increase / dec : decrease
- k : knit stitch / p : purl stitch
- kfb : knit the next st through the front loop then through its back loop (1 inc)
- ktbl : knit the st through its back loop
- ptbl : purl the st through its back loop
- k2tog : knit the next 2 sts together (1 dec)
- RT (see tutorial below) : right twist, k2tog without dropping the sts off the needle, then knit into the first stitch again
- sl wyif : slip the st purlwise with yarn in front
- sl wyib : slip the st purlwise with yarn in back
- MB, make MB (see tutorial below) : [(k1, yo) x3, k1] into next st, yo pass all the 7 MB strands over ; pick up the thread on the WS below the MB, knit it together with the last st on the right needle

## Reading the Chart

When knitting flat, read the Charts back and forth : RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right.

## Carrying unused colours

When skipping a colour for more than 2 rows (Chart D), carry it upwards by loosely twisting the strands of CC and MC at the beginning of a RS row.

repeat

**row 1 and all odd numbered rows (RS) :** k2, p1, RT, \*p1, k4, p1, RT\* to last 3 sts, p1, k2  
**rows 2 and 8 (WS) :** k3, \*p2, k1, p4, k1\* to last 5 sts, p2, k3  
**rows 4 and 6 :** k3, \*p2, k6\* to last 5 sts, p2, k3

## Cast-on and set-up

With MC, CO 4 sts.

**MC set-up row (WS):** knit

Work Set-up Chart.

*21 sts*

## Section 1

Work Chart A 8 times completely then work rows 1 to 10 once more.

*90 sts*

Work Chart B with both colours 7 times completely.

*104 sts*

Cut MC.

Work Chart C once completely.

*116 sts*

Work Chart D with both colours once completely then rows 1 to 10 once more.

*141 sts*

Cut CC.

## Section 2

**MC set-up row 1 (RS) :** knit

**MC set-up row 2 (WS) :** k3, \*p2, k1, p4, k1\* to last 2 sts, k2

Work Chart A 3 times completely then rows 1 to 10 once more.

*170 sts*

Work Chart B with both colours 7 times completely.

*184 sts*

Cut MC.

Work Chart C once completely.

*196 sts*

Work Chart D with both colours 2 times completely.

*236 sts*

## Finishing

Garner stripes ;

**CC row 1 (RS):** k1, kfb, knit to end (1 inc)

**CC row 2 (WS):** knit to end

Work rows 1-2 once again with MC, cut MC, then work rows 1-2 with CC once more.

*239 sts*

Using CC, loosely bind-off all sts knitwise with [stretchy bind-off method like this one](#).


Weave in all ends and block the shawl.






# CHART C

## WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS

### Set-up Chart :

Worked with MC only.

**row 1 (RS):** K1, kfb, k2 (*1 inc*)

**row 2 (WS):** Knit all sts

**row 3:** K1, kfb, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)

**row 4:** K3, p1, k2

**row 5:** K1, kfb, k1, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)

**row 6:** K3, p2, k2

**row 7:** K1, kfb, RT, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)

**row 8:** K3, p2, k3

**row 9:** K1, kfb, p1, RT, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)

**row 10:** K3, p2, k1, p1, k2

**row 11:** K1, kfb, k1, p1, RT, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)

**row 12:** K2, (k1, p2) x 2, k2

**row 13:** K1, kfb, k2, p1, RT, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)

**row 14:** K3, p2, k6

**row 15:** K1, kfb, k3, p1, RT, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)

**row 16:** K3, p2, k7

**row 17:** K1, kfb, k4, p1, RT, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)

**row 18:** K3, p2, k1, p4, k3

**row 19:** K1, kfb, p1, k4, p1, RT, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)

**row 20:** K3, p2, k1, p4, k1, p1, k2

**row 2 (WS):** K3, \*p2, k1, p4, k1\* to last 3 sts, p1, k2  
**row 3:** K1, kfb, k1, \*p1, k4, p1, RT\* to last 3 sts, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)  
**row 4:** K3, \*p2, k6\* to last 4 sts, p2, k2  
**row 5:** K1, kfb, RT, \*p1, k4, p1, RT\* to last 3 sts, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)  
**row 6:** K3, \*p2, k6\* to last 5 sts, p2, k3  
**row 7:** K1, kfb, p1, RT, \*p1, k4, p1, RT\* to last 3 sts, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)  
**row 8:** K3, \*p2, k1, p4, k1\* to last 6 sts, p2, k1, p1, k2  
**row 9:** K1, kfb, k1, p1, RT, \*p1, k4, p1, RT\* to last 3 sts, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)  
**row 10:** K3, \*p2, k1, p4, k1\* to last 7 sts, (p2, k1) x 2, k1  
**row 11:** K1, kfb, k2, p1, RT, \*p1, k4, p1, RT\* to last 3 sts, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)  
**row 12:** K3, \*p2, k6\* to end  
**row 13:** K1, kfb, k3, p1, RT, \*p1, k4, p1, RT\* to last 3 sts, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)  
**row 14:** K3, \*p2, k6\* to 1 st before end, k1  
**row 15:** K1, kfb, k4, p1, RT, \*p1, k4, p1, RT\* to last 3 sts, p1, k2 (*1 inc*)  
**row 16:** K3, \*p2, k1, p4, k1\* to last 2 sts, k2

### **Chart B :**

Worked with both colours.

**MC row 1 (RS):** K1, kfb, \*k1, sl1 wyib\* to last 2 sts, k2 (*1 inc*)  
**MC row 2 (WS):** K2, \*sl1 wyif, k1\* to last 3 sts, sl1 wyif, k2  
**CC row 3:** K1, kfb, k1, \*sl1 wyib, k1\* to last 2 sts, k2 (*1 inc*)  
**CC row 4:** K2, \*k1, sl1 wyif\* to last 2 sts, k2

### Chart C :

Worked with CC only.

- row 1 (RS) (no inc):** K2, \*k3, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2
- row 2 (WS):** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to last 2 sts, k2
- row 3:** K1, kfb, \*k3, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2 *(1 inc)*
- row 4:** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to last 3 sts, p1tbl, k2
- row 5:** K1, kfb, k1tbl, \*k3, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2 *(1 inc)*
- row 6:** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to last 4 sts, p2tbl, k2
- row 7:** K1, kfb, k2tbl, \*k3, k2tbl, k1, MB, k1, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2 *(1 inc)*
- row 8:** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to end
- row 9:** K1, kfb, k1, k2tbl, \*k3, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2 *(1 inc)*
- row 10:** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to 1 st before end, k1
- row 11:** K1, kfb, k2, k2tbl, \*k1, MB, k1, k2tbl, k3, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2 *(1 inc)*
- row 12:** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to last 2 sts, k2
- row 13:** K1, kfb, \*k3, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2 *(1 inc)*
- row 14:** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to last 3 sts, p1tbl, k2
- row 15:** K1, kfb, k1tbl, k1, MB, k1, k2tbl, \*k3, k2tbl, k1, MB, k1, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2 *(1 inc)*
- row 16:** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to last 4 sts, p2tbl, k2
- row 17:** K1, kfb, k2tbl, \*k3, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2 *(1 inc)*
- row 18:** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to end
- row 19:** K1, kfb, k1, k2tbl, k3, k2tbl, \*k1, MB, k1, k2tbl, k3, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2 *(1 inc)*
- row 20:** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to 1 st before end, k1
- row 21:** K1, kfb, k2, k2tbl, \*k3, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2 *(1 inc)*
- row 22:** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to last 2 sts, k2
- row 23:** K1, kfb, \*k3, k2tbl, k1, MB, k1, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2 *(1 inc)*
- row 24:** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to last 3 sts, p1tbl, k2
- row 25:** K1, kfb, k1tbl, \*k3, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2 *(1 inc)*
- row 26:** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to last 4 sts, p2tbl, k2
- row 27 (no inc):** K2, k2tbl, \*k3, k2tbl\* to last 2 sts, k2
- row 28:** K2, \*p2tbl, k3\* to last 4 sts, p2tbl, k2

**CC row 4:** K2, \*k3, sl1 wyif\* to last 4 sts, k4

**MC row 5:** K1, kfb, knit to end (*1 inc*)

**MC row 6:** K2, \*k1, p1, k2\* to 1 st before end, k1

**CC row 7:** K1, kfb, k1, \*sl1 wyib, k3\* to end (*1 inc*)

**CC row 8:** \*K3, sl1 wyif\* to last 4 sts, k4

**CC row 9:** K1, kfb, k2, \*sl1 wyib, k3\* to end (*1 inc*)

**CC row 10:** \*K3, sl1 wyif\* to last 5 sts, k5

**MC row 11:** K1, kfb, knit to end (*1 inc*)

**MC row 12:** K2, \*k3, p1\* to last 4 sts, k4

**CC row 13:** K1, kfb, k2, \*sl1 wyib, k3\* to last 2 sts, k2 (*1 inc*)

**CC row 14:** K2, \*k3, sl1 wyif\* to last 5 sts, k5

**MC row 15:** K1, kfb, knit to end (*1 inc*)

**MC row 16:** K2, \*k1, p1, k2\* to last 2 sts, k2

**CC row 17:** K1, kfb, k2, \*sl1 wyib, k3\* to end (*1 inc*)

**CC row 18:** \*K3, sl1 wyif\* to last 5 sts, k5

**CC row 19:** K1, kfb, k3, \*sl1 wyib, k3\* to end (*1 inc*)

**CC row 20:** \*K3, sl1 wyif\* to last 6 sts, k6

**MC row 21:** K1, kfb, knit to end (*1 inc*)

**MC row 22:** K2, \*k3, p1\* to last 5 sts, k5

**CC row 23:** K1, kfb, k3, \*sl1 wyib, k3\* to last 2 sts, k2 (*1 inc*)

**CC row 24:** K2, \*k3, sl1 wyif\* to last 6 sts, k6

**MC row 25:** K1, kfb, knit to end (*1 inc*)

**MC row 26:** K2, \*k1, p1, k2\* to last 3 sts, k3

**CC row 27:** K1, kfb, k3, \*sl1 wyib, k3\* to end (*1 inc*)

**CC row 28:** \*K3, sl1 wyif\* to last 6 sts, k6

**CC row 29:** K1, kfb, k4, \*sl1 wyib, k3\* to end (*1 inc*)

**CC row 30:** \*K3, sl1 wyif\* to last 7 sts, k7

**MC row 31:** K1, kfb, knit to end (*1 inc*)

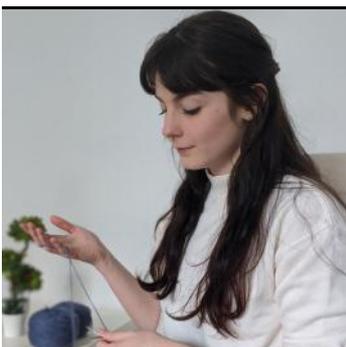
**MC row 32:** K2, \*k3, p1\* to last 2 sts, k2  
**CC row 33:** K1, kfb, \*sl1 wyib, k3\* to last 2 sts, k2 (*1 inc*)  
**CC row 34:** K2, \*k3, sl1 wyif\* to last 3 sts, k3  
**MC row 35:** K1, kfb, knit to end (*1 inc*)  
**MC row 36:** K2, \*k1, p1, k2\* to end  
**CC row 37:** K1, kfb, \*sl1 wyib, k3\* to end (*1 inc*)  
**CC row 38:** \*K3, sl1 wyif\* to last 3 sts, k3  
**CC row 39:** K1, kfb, k1, \*sl1 wyib, k3\* to end (*1 inc*)  
**CC row 40:** \*K3, sl1 wyif\* to last 4 sts, k4
