SIZES

22/23 38/39 40/41

Instructions are for smallest size, with changes for larger sizes noted in different colors. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

MATERIALS

REGIA PREMIUM Merino Yak, 100 g ball
Col. 07509 (lavendel meliert) 1 ball
Double Pointed Needles 2,0 - 3,0 mm

BASICS

Basic pattern: Work each round according to the chart, working the 16-stitch repeat throughout. Repeat Rounds 1-20 throughout.

Rib pattern: Alternate k1, p1.

GAUGE

Stockinette stitch: 30 sts und 42 rows/rounds = 10 x 10 cm
Basic pattern: 32 sts und 42 rounds = 10 x 10 cm
Take time to check your gauge. If you have too many stitches and rows, switch to larger needles. If you have too few stitches and rows, switch to smaller needles.

INSTRUCTIONS


Cast on 48/64/64 st and divide them evenly over 4 needles. First work in the rib pattern for 2/3/3 cm, then work 40/60/60 rnd = approx. 9.5/14.5/14.5 cm in the basic pattern. In the following round, knit the st on Needles 1 and 4; continue working the st on Needles 2 and 3 in the basic pattern.

Now work a boomerang heel and foot following the "Socks Guide, R0333". For the foot, work the basic pattern over Needles 2 and 3; knit all st on Needles 1 and 4. To start the toe, k1 Rd, knitting 2 st together 1x each on Needles 2 and 3 / knitting 2 st together 1x each on Needles 2 and 3 = 44/60/64 st

Now work the **toe shaping** as follows:

On Needles 1 and 3, work up to 3 st before the end of the needle, k2tog, k the last st. On Needles 2 and 4, k the first st, skp, work to the end of the needle. Repeat these decreases as shown in the table until 8 st remain. Draw a double thickness of yarn through these 8 st and pull tightly, or graft together the st on the top and bottom of the toe using the Kitchener stitch.

CHART BASIC PATTERN



KEY

- = k1
- = p1
- = place 3 st on a cable needle, hold behind work; k3, then knit the st from the cable needle

ABBREVIATIONS

- k = knit
- p = purl
- rnd = round(s)
- skp = slip, knit, pass slipped stitch over - 1stitch decreased
- st = stitch(es)
