

Magic Scarf is the result of a collaboration between Disneyland Paris and Spektakelstrik.

The scarf is worked from tip to tip as a tube.
The embroidery is worked after the scarf is finished.
Finally, pom-poms are created and attached to each tip.

Size

Onesize

Measurements

Approx. 150 cm

Recommended needles

Circular needle 6 mm (40-60 cm) or double pointed needles in the same size if you do not wish to use the magic loop method

Gauge

15 sts and 24 rows with needle 6 mm = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette stitch

Yarn

Main colour

KOS from Sandnes (150 m / 50 g)

62 % baby alpaca, 9 % wool and 29 % nylon

150 g Navy Blue 6079

Embroidery yarn

Peruvian Highland Wool from Filcolana

50 g of 258 Lilac

50 g of 141 Alaskan blue

Paia from Filcolana

25 g of 703 Gold Shimmer

The pom-pom is made from scraps of the embroidery yarn

Materials

1 tapestry needle

Abbreviations

k: Knit

rnd(s): Round(s)

st(s): stitch(es)

M1R: Use the left needle to pick up the bar between the stitches from the back and knit it

k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together

About the pattern

The scarf is worked from tip to tip as a tube.

The embroidery is worked after the scarf is finished. Finally, pom-poms are created and attached to each tip.

Scarf

Using needle 6 mm and the main colour, cast on 16 sts. Join in the round and place marker.

K 1 rnd.

Work increases like this:

Next rnd: *Work 4 sts, M1R; repeat from * to end.

Next rnd: *Work 5 sts, M1R; repeat from * to end.

Continue like this, i.e. with 1 more st before the increases on each rnd, until you have a total of 52 sts and have increased a total of 9 times.

Work even in stockinette stitch until the work measures 145 cm.

Now work decreases to shape the other end like this:

Next rnd: *Work 11 sts, k2tog; repeat from * to end.

Next rnd: *Work 10 sts, k2tog; repeat from * to end.

Continue like this, i.e. with 1 less st before the decreases on each rnd, until you have a total of 16 sts and have decreased a total of 9 times. Bind off.

Finishing

Weave in all ends and sew the hole at both ends of the scarf together. If this creates wrinkles, it is fine.

Embroidery

Using chain stitches, embroider Mickey Mouse, the Disney Castle and the stars onto the scarf according to the template. Each stitch should be about the same length as a knitted stitch.


Be aware that you only embroider through one layer of the scarf. Use two threads of the golden yarn or use it together with a wool yarn in the same shade.

If the scarf is worked in a light colour, you can choose to draw with a marker that dissolves in water.

Pom-pom

Create two identical pom-pom with a diameter of 7-8 cm and attach them to each end of the scarf.
