MANOS DEL URUGUAY

## SIZES

Brim Circumference: 17½ (20, 22½)"

Hat shown measures 20".

## MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay WOOL CLASICA (100% wool;

approx. 100g/138 yds), 1 sk

Shown in #52 Cameo

US 8/5mm ndls, 16" circular; or size to obtain gauge.

US 9/5.5mm ndls, 16" circular needle and set of double-

pointed needles, or 1 size larger than gauge needle

stitch marker

cable needle

tapestry needle

## GAUGE

16 stitches and 28 rounds = 4" over Twisted Rib Pattern  
on smaller needle, slightly stretched.

## ABBREVIATIONS

beg: begin(ning)

C2B: slip 1 stitch to cn and hold in back, k1, k1 from cn

C4B: slip 2 stitches to cn and hold in back, k2, k2 from cn

C4Bdec: slip 2 stitches to cn and hold in back, k2tog, ssk  
from cn

C4F: slip 2 stitches to cn and hold in front, k2, k2 from cn

cn: cable needle

CO: cast on

k: knit

k1tbl: knit one stitch through the back loop

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

m1: insert left ndl under horizontal strand between st just  
worked and next st from the front to the back, knit through  
the back loop

ndl(s): needle(s)

p: purl

p1tbl: purl one stitch through the back loop

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

pm: place marker

rnd(s): round(s)

ssk: slip 2 stitches, 1 at a time, knitwise to the right needle.

Return stitches to the left needle in turned position then  
knit them together through the back loops

st(s): stitch(es)

T3B: slip 1 stitch to cn and hold in back, k2, p1 from cn

T3F: slip 2 stitches to cn and hold in front, p1, k2 from cn

T4B: slip 2 stitches to cn and hold in back, k2, p2 from cn

T4Bdec: slip 2 stitches to cn and hold in back, k2, p2tog  
from cn

T4F: slip 2 stitches to cn and hold in front, p2, k2 from cn



## STITCH GUIDE

### *Twisted Rib Pattern* (multiple of 2 sts)

Rnd 1: \*K1tbl, p1tbl; repeat from \* around.

Repeat this round for pattern.

### *Cable Pattern* (multiple of 10 sts)

Rnd 1: \*K2, p3; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 2: \*K2, m1, p3, m1; repeat from \* around. [98 (112, 126) stitches]

Rnd 3: \*K3, p4; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 4: \*M1, k3, p4; repeat from \* around. [112 (128, 144) stitches]

Rnd 5: \*K4, p4; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 6: \*C4B, p4; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 7: \*K4, p4; repeat from \* to last 8 stitches, k4, p2, leave remaining 2 stitches unworked, shifting beg of round 2 stitches to the right.

Rnd 8: \*T4B, T4F; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 9: \*K2, p4, k2; repeat from \* to end, k2 from beg of round shifting beg of round 2 stitches to the left.

Rnd 10: \*P4, C4F; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 11: \*P4, k4; repeat from \* to last 8 stitches, p4, k2, leave remaining 2 stitches unworked, shifting beg of round 2 stitches to the right.

Rnd 12: \*T4F, T4B; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 13: \*P2, k4, p2; repeat from \* to end, p2 from beg of round shifting beg of round 2 stitches to the left.

Rnd 14: \*C4B, p4; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 15: \*K4, p4; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 16: \*K4, p2, T4B, T4F, p2; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 17: \*K4, p2, k2, p4, k2, p2; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 18: \*C4B, p2, k2, p4, k2, p2; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 19: Repeat Round 17.

Rnd 20: \*K4, p2, T4F, T4B, p2; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 21: Repeat Round 15.

Rnd 22: \*C4B, p2tog, p2; repeat from \* around. [98 (112, 126) stitches remain]

Rnd 23: \*K4, p3; repeat from \* to last 7 stitches, k4, p1, leave remaining 2 stitches unworked shifting beg of round 2 stitches to the right.

Rnd 24: \*T4Bdec, T3F; repeat from \* around. [84 (96, 108) stitches remain]

Rnd 25: \*K2, p2, k2; repeat from \* to end, k2 from beg of round shifting beg of round 2 stitches to the left.

Rnd 26: \*P2, C4F; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 27: \*P2, k4; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, p2, k2, leave remaining 2 stitches unworked shifting beg of round 2 stitches to the right.

Rnd 28: \*T3F, T3B; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 29: \*P1, k4, p1; repeat from \* to end, p1 from beg of round shifting beg of round 1 stitch to the left.

Rnd 30: \*C4Bdec, p2; repeat from \* around. [56 (64, 72) stitches remain]

Rnd 31: \*K2, p2; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 32: \*K2, p2tog; repeat from \* around. [42 (48, 54) stitches remain]

Rnd 33: \*C2B, p1; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 34: \*K2, k2tog, k1, p1; repeat from \* around. [35 (40, 45) stitches remain]

Rnd 35: \*C4B, p1; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 36: \*[K2tog] 2 times, p1; repeat from \* around. [21 (24, 27) stitches remain]

Rnd 37: \*K2tog, p1; repeat from \* to last 3 stitches, k2tog, leave remaining 1 stitch unworked shifting beg of round 1 stitch to the right. [14 (16, 18) stitches remain]

Rnd 38: \*K2tog; repeat from \* around. [7 (8, 9) stitches remain]



*INSTRUCTIONS*

*BODY*

With smaller needle, CO 70 (80, 90) stitches. Join to work in the round, being careful not to twist stitches. Pm to show beg of round.


Work Twisted Rib Pattern for 1".  
Change to larger circular needle.

Work Rounds 1–38 of Cable Pattern, changing to dpn when necessary. [7 (8, 9) stitches remain]  
Cut yarn, leaving at least a 5" tail. Thread tail onto tapestry ndl and draw tail through remaining stitches.

*FINISHING*

Weave in ends and block. For the beret, block around a dinner plate.
