**KNITTING NEEDLES**

5.0 mm (US8) 32 ~ 40" circular needle, 16 ~ 24" circular needle or double pointed needles

4.0 mm (US6) 16 ~ 24" circular needle or double pointed needles

4.0 mm crochet hook

**YARN** 2 strands of yarn held together

Fingering weighted, *Mominoki Sock Fine 4ply, Rose Granite* : 630 (800, 950, 1,100) m

Lace weighted, *Knitting for Olive Soft Silk Mohair, Pearl Grey* : 630 (800, 950, 1,100) m

**SIZE DIRECTION** XS (S, M, L)

**GAUGE** 16 stitches x 23 rows in Stockinette stitch (10 x 10 cm)


**NOTIONS** 5 (6, 7, 8) markers, tapestry needle

# Maple Vest

## BACK

5.0 mm (US8) 32 ~ 40" circular needle ; Work flat

CO 31 (35, 39, 39) sts

R1(WS) p to EOR

R2(RS) k4 tbl, M1L, k to the last 4 sts, M1R, k4 tbl

R3(WS) p4 tbl, M1Rp, p to the last 4 sts, M1Lp, p4 tbl

Rep. R2(RS) - R3(WS), 6 (8, 10, 12) more times. [59 (71, 83, 91) sts in total]

Stockinette stitch for 28 (32, 32, 32) rows.

## BACK : Armholes

R1(RS) k4 tbl, M1L, k to the last 4 sts, M1R, k4 tbl

R2(WS) p4 tbl, p to the last 4 sts, p4 tbl

Rep. R1(RS) - R2(WS), 5 (5, 7, 9) more times. [71 (83, 99, 111) sts in total]

## SIZE S (M, L) only

Next R(RS) k4 tbl, M1L, k to the last 4 sts, M1R, k4 tbl

Next R(WS) p4 tbl, M1Rp, p to the last 4 sts, M1Lp, p4 tbl

Rep. these 2 rows, 0 (0, 1) more time. [87 (103, 119) sts in total]

Cut yarn. Place back stitches on the stitch holder or extra needle.

[71 (87, 103, 119) sts in total]

## Front Right

5.0 mm (US8) 16 ~ 24" circular needle ; Work flat

Facing RS, from the armhole (the last increased row) to the neck, pick up 15 (19, 23, 27) sts along the right shoulder.

R1(WS) p to EOR

Stockinette stitch for 6 (8, 8, 8) rows, ending in WS.



# Maple Vest

## FRONT Right neckline

R1(RS) k to the last 4 sts, M1R, k4

R2(WS) p to EOR

R3(RS) k to EOR

R4(WS) p to EOR

Rep. R1(RS) - R4(WS), 0 (1, 1, 1) more time. [16 (21, 25, 29) sts in total]

Next R(RS) k to the last 4 sts, M1R, k4

Next R(WS) p to EOR

Rep. these 2 rows, 4 (4, 5, 5) more times. [21 (26, 31, 35) sts in total]

Next R(RS) k to the last 4 sts, M1R, k4 [22 (27, 32, 36) sts in total]

Next R(WS) p4, M1Rp, p to EOR [23 (28, 33, 37) sts in total]

Next R(RS) k to the last 4 sts, M1R, k4 [24 (29, 34, 38) sts in total]

Cut yarn. Place stitches on the stitch holder or extra needle.

## Front Left

5.0 mm (US8) 16 ~ 24" circular needle ; Work flat

Facing RS, from the neck to the armhole (the last increased row),  
pick up 15 (19, 23, 27) sts along the left shoulder.

R1(WS) p to EOR

Stockinette stitch for 6 (8, 8, 8) rows, ending in WS.

## FRONT Left neckline

R1(RS) k4, M1L, k to EOR

R2(WS) p to EOR

R3(RS) k to EOR

R4(WS) p to EOR

Rep. R1(RS) - R4(WS), 0 (1, 1, 1) more time. [16 (21, 25, 29) sts in total]

# Maple Vest

Next R(RS) k4, M1L, k to EOR

Next R(WS) p to EOR

Rep. these 2 rows, 4 (4, 5, 5) more times. [21 (26, 31, 35) sts in total]

Next R(RS) k4, M1L, k to EOR [22 (27, 32, 36) sts in total]

Next R(WS) p to the last 4 sts, M1Lp, p4 [23 (28, 33, 37) sts in total]

Next R(RS) k4, M1L, k to EOR [24 (29, 34, 38) sts in total]

Do not cut yarn. It is the working yarn from now.

## JOIN FRONT Right & Left

R1(WS) p to the last 4sts, M1Rp, p4, CO 9 (11, 13, 13) using a cable method, join to the Right,  
p4, M1Lp, p to EOR [59 (71, 83, 91) sts in total]

Stockinette stitch for next 16 (18, 18, 18) rows, ending in WS.

[17 (19, 19, 19) rows in total]

## FRONT : Armholes

R1(RS) k4 tbl, M1L, k to the last 4 sts, M1R, k4 tbl

R2(WS) p4 tbl, p to the last 4 sts, p4 tbl

Rep. R1(RS) - R2(WS), 5 (5, 7, 9) more times. [71 (83, 99, 111) sts in total]

## SIZE S (M, L) only

next R(RS) k4 tbl, M1L, k to the last 4 sts, M1R, k4 tbl

next R(WS) p4 tbl, M1Rp, p to the last 4 sts, M1Lp, p4 tbl

Rep. these 2 rows, 0 (0, 1) more time. [87 (103, 119) sts in total]

Do not cut yarn. It is the working yarn from now.

[71 (87, 103, 119) sts in total]

## JOIN FRONT & BACK

set-up R(RS) k4 tbl, PM(1), M1L, k to the last 4 sts, M1R, PM(2), k4 tbl,

CO 8 (8, 8, 8) using a cable method, join to the back,

k4 tbl, PM(3), M1L, k to the last 4 sts, M1R, PM(4), k4 tbl,

CO 8 (8, 8, 8) using a cable method, k4 tbl [162 (194, 226, 258) sts in total]

M(1) is the MM, BOR

# Maple Vest

Join and work in round.

R1 k to M, (k1 tbl, p1) x 7, k2 tbl, k to M, k2 tbl, (p1, k1 tbl) x 7

SIZE S (M, L) only

R2 - R3 Rep. R1

ALL SIZES

<b>Pattern A</b>	Place <b>1</b> stitch on cable needle (CN), hold to <b>front</b> , k1 tbl, p1 ; k1 tbl from CN
<b>Pattern B</b>	Place <b>2</b> stitches on cable needle (CN), hold to <b>back</b> , k1 tbl ; p1, k1 tbl from CN

R4 k to M, **A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 4, p1, **B**, k1 tbl, k to M, k1 tbl, **A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 4, p1, **B**

R5 k to M, (k1 tbl, p1) x 7, k2 tbl, k to M, k2 tbl, (p1, k1 tbl) x 7

R6 k to M, k1 tbl, p1, **A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 2, p1, **B**, p1, k2 tbl,  
k to M, k2 tbl, p1, **A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 2, p1, **B**, p1, k1 tbl

R7 Rep. R5

R8 k to M, **A**, p1, **A**, p1, **B**, p1, **B**, k1 tbl, k to M, k1 tbl, **A**, p1, **A**, p1, **B**, p1, **B**

R9 Rep. R5

R10 Rep. R6



# Maple Vest

## SPLIT FRONT & BACK

R1(RS) k to M, (k1 tbl, p1) x 7, k2 tbl, RM, turn work

Using a contrasting colour thread or yarn, thread through the last 16 sts as shown in the photo.



R2(WS) p2 tbl, (k1, p1 tbl) x 7, p to M,  
(p1 tbl, k1) x 7 p2 tbl, RM, turn work

Using a contrasting colour thread or yarn, [97 (113, 129, 145) sts in total] thread through the last 16 sts as shown in the photo.

This thread or yarn will stay while you are working on the front body.

While working the front of the vest, place the back stitches on the stitch holder.

### SET 1

R3(RS) k2 tbl, (p1, k1 tbl) x 7, k to M, (k1 tbl, p1) x 7, k2 tbl Always slip markers.

R4(WS) p2 tbl, (k1, p1 tbl) x 7, p to M, (p1 tbl, k1) x 7, p2 tbl

<b>Pattern A</b>	Place <b>1</b> stitch on cable needle (CN), hold to <b>front</b> , k1 tbl, p1 ; k1 tbl from CN
<b>Pattern B</b>	Place <b>2</b> stitches on cable needle (CN), hold to <b>back</b> , k1 tbl ; p1, k1 tbl from CN

R5(RS) k1 tbl, **A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 4, p1, **B**, k to M, **A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 4, p1, **B**, k1 tbl

R6(WS) Rep. R4(WS)

R7(RS) k2 tbl, p1, **A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 2, p1, **B**, p1, k1 tbl, k to M, k1 tbl, p1, **A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 2, p1, **B**, p1, k2 tbl

R8(WS) Rep. R4(WS)

R9(RS) k1 tbl, **A**, p1, **A**, p1, **B**, p1, **B**, k to M, **A**, p1, **A**, p1, **B**, p1, **B**, k1 tbl

R10(WS) Rep. R4(WS)

R11(RS) Rep. R7(RS)

R12(WS) Rep. R4(WS)

R13(RS) Rep. R9(RS)

Rep. R3(RS) - R4(WS), 2 times.

Rep. R5(RS) - R17(RS) once.

R18(WS) p2 tbl, (k1, p1 tbl) x 7, [(k1, p1 tbl) x 8, pm] x 3 (4, 5, 6), (k1, p1 tbl) x 8, k1, (p1 tbl, k1) x 7, p2 tbl

R19(RS) k2 tbl, (p1, k1 tbl) x 7, p1, [(k1 tbl, p1) x 8] x 4 (5, 6, 7), (k1 tbl, p1) x 7, k2 tbl

R20(WS) Rep. R18(WS) Always slip markers.

## SIZE S (M, L) only

R21(RS) Rep. R19(RS)

R22(WS) Rep. R18(WS)

## RIB BAND

Always slip markers.

R1(RS) k2 tbl, (p1, k1 tbl) x 7, p1, [(k1 tbl, p1) x 8] x 4 (5, 6, 7), (k1 tbl, p1) x 7, k2 tbl

R2(WS) p2 tbl, (k1, p1 tbl) x 7, [(k1, p1 tbl) x 8] x 4 (5, 6, 7), k1, (p1 tbl, k1) x 7, p2 tbl

R3 - R4 Rep. R1(RS) - R2(WS)

R5(RS) k1 tbl, **A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 4, p1, **B**, p1, [**A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 4, p1, **B**, p1] x 4 (5, 6, 7),  
**A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 4, p1, **B**, k1 tbl

R6(WS) p2 tbl, (k1, p1 tbl) x 7, [(k1, p1 tbl) x 8] x 4 (5, 6, 7), k1, (p1 tbl, k1) x 7, p2 tbl

R7(RS) k2 tbl, p1, **A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 2, p1, **B**, p1, k1 tbl, p1,  
[k1 tbl, p1, **A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 2, p1, **B**, p1, k1 tbl, p1] x 4 (5, 6, 7),  
k1 tbl, p1, **A**, (p1, k1 tbl) x 2, p1, **B**, p1, k2 tbl

R8(WS) Rep. R6(WS)

R9(RS) k1 tbl, **A**, p1, **A**, p1, **B**, p1, **B**, p1, [**A**, p1, **A**, p1, **B**, p1, **B**, p1] x 4 (5, 6, 7), **A**, p1, **A**, p1, **B**, p1, **B**, k1 tbl

R10(WS) Rep. R6(WS)

R11(RS) Rep. R7(RS)

R12(WS) Rep. R6(WS)

R18(WS) Rep. R2(WS)  
R19(RS) Rep. R1(RS)  
R20(WS) Rep. R2(WS)  
R21(RS) Rep. R1(RS)  
R22(WS) Rep. R2(WS)  
BO in pattern.

## BACK BOTTOM

5.0 mm (US8) 32 ~ 40" circular needle ; Work flat

Facing WS, pick up 16 sts from the row with thread in (left side),  
p to EOR (Back), pick up 16 sts from the row with thread in (right side).  
After picking up stitches, remove threads. [97 (113, 129, 145) sts in total]



Work the same as

**SET 1** on page 7

**SET 2** on page 8

**RIB BAND** on page 8

R1 - R20

R5 - R22

BO in pattern.

## ARM BANDS

4.0 mm (US6) 16 ~ 24" circular needle ; Work in round

Facing RS, from the center of the underarm CO edge, pick up 4 sts,  
pick up 84 (94, 104, 114) sts (approx. pick up 4sts, skip 1 st) along the armhole,  
pick up 4 sts from the rest of the underarm CO edge. [92 (102, 112, 122) sts in total]

R1 - R7 (k1 tbl, p1)\*, rep\* to BOR

R8 k2tog tbl, (k1 tbl, p1)\*, rep\* to the last 2sts, SSK tbl

BO in pattern.

Make both sides the same.

# Maple Vest

## NECK BAND

4.0 mm (US6) 16 ~ 24" circular needle ; Work in round

Facing back side, from right neck beside shoulder line to the left, pick up as below.

23 (27, 31, 31) sts from the back, 3 sts from the left shoulder line,

24 (25, 26, 26) sts from the left neckline, 9 (11, 13, 13) sts from CO edge in front,

24 (25, 26, 26) sts from the right neckline, 3 sts from the right shoulder line.

[86 (94, 102, 102) sts in total]

R1 - R18 (k1 tbl, p1)\*, rep\* to BOR

Fold in half inside, onto the picked-up seam Crocheted BO in loose tension.
