

PINERY SOCKS

Knitting pattern by Masha Zyablikova

Notes

Both socks are worked alike top down in the round with a magic loop technique on the circular needles or ordinary way on the double-pointed needles.

Charts and keys for them are attached at the end of the pattern.

Yarn

Any sock yarn (80% wool, 20% nylon/polyamide; 400-420 m (437-450 y)/100 g)
~ 70 (75) 85 (95) 105 (115) g.

Needles and Notions

- 2,5 mm (US 1½) circular needles 80 cm (32") length cable or double-pointed needles.
- Stitch markers; scissors; tapestry needle.

Gauge (after blocking)

32 sts x 41 r = 10 cm (4") – the Main Pattern (Chart 1) on the needles 2,5 mm (US 1½).

Stitch Glossary and Abbreviations:

St/s – stitch/es

M – marker/s

K/p – knit/purl

R – row/round

ER – end of row/round

BORM – beginning of round marker

ktbl – knit st through the back of the loop (twisted knit st)

ptbl – purl st through the back of the loop (twisted purl st)

ssp ([video](#)) – slip slip purl, left decrease

p2tog ([video](#)) – purl 2 together, right decrease

k2tog – knit 2 together, right decrease

sl – slip

wyib – with yarn in the back

wyif – with yarn in the front

1/1 LCp ([video](#)) – Slip 1 stitch and hold it in the front, p1, then ktbl slipped stitch.

RS/WS – Right Side/Wrong Side

ES – Edge stitch/es

~ – around, approximately

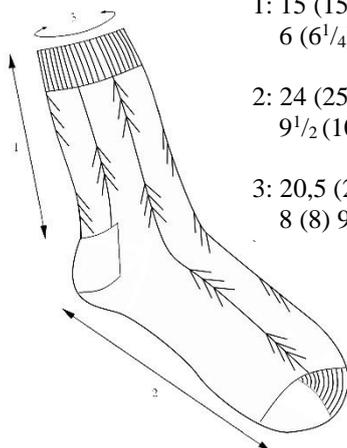
[] – part to repeat

{..} – a total number of stitches

Finished Measurements



1: 15 (15,5) 16,5 (17) 18,5 (19,5) cm
6 (6¼) 6½ (6¾) 7¼ (7¾)"

2: 24 (25,5) 27 (28) 29,5 (31) cm
9½ (10) 10¾ (11) 11¾ (12¼)"

3: 20,5 (20,5) 22,5 (22,5) 24 (24) cm
8 (8) 9 (9) 9½ (9½)"

Leg

Cast on 66 (66) 72 (72) 78 (78) sts using German method or any other stretchy cast on plus 1 st to join in the round. Join for working in the round, be careful not to twist the sts.

{66 (66) 72 (72) 78 (78)} sts

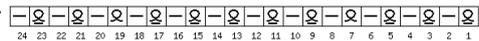
Place BORM and work cuff in Twisted Rib pattern until the cuff measures ~ 4 cm (1½''):

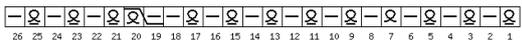
R 1-17: [k1tbl, p 1] – repeat to ER.

If you are working with the double-pointed needles, divide sts between the 3 needles of 22 (22) 24 (24) 26 (26) for each needle to make it convenient to work the pattern.

R 18: Place M every 22 (22) 24 (24) 26 (26) sts and work 3 horizontal pattern repeats as follow:

S, M: 

L, XL: 

2XL, 3XL: 

☉ – k1tbl ☉ – p1tbl ([video](#))

— – p ☉ – 1/1 LCp ([video](#))

R 19:

S, M: [p 5, k1tbl, p 5] – repeat to ER.

L, XL: [p 6, k1tbl, p 5] – repeat to ER.

2XL, 3XL: [p 6, k1tbl, p 6] – repeat to ER.

Remove markers except BORM and place markers every 11 (11) 12 (12) 13 (13) sts. Work the Main Pattern as follow:

1st Vertical Pattern Repeat; 15 (16) 17 (18) 15 (15) rounds:

S, M: [Chart 1; p 5, k1tbl, p 5] – repeat to ER.

L, XL: [Chart 1; p 6, k1tbl, p 5] – repeat to ER.

2XL, 3XL: [p 6, k1tbl, p 6; Chart 1] – repeat to ER.

2nd Vertical Pattern Repeat; 15 (16) 17 (18) 15 (15) rounds:

S, M: [p 5, k1tbl, p 5; Chart 1] – repeat to ER.

L, XL: [p 6, k1tbl, p 5; Chart 1] – repeat to ER.

2XL, 3XL: [Chart 1; p 6, k1tbl, p 6] – repeat to ER.

3rd Vertical Pattern Repeat is worked like 1st Vertical Pattern Repeat.

4th Vertical Pattern Repeat **only for sizes 2XL and 3XL** is worked like 2nd Vertical Pattern Repeat

A total 45 (48) 51 (54) 60 (64) rounds.

Heel flap

In this part, you will work back and forth over the last 33 (33) 35 (35) 39 (39) sts before BORM.

Turn your work to the wrong side.

How to work rows 1-3 of the heel: [VIDEO](#)

R 1 (WS): Sl ES knitwise wyib, [k 1, sl 1 purlwise wyib] – 15 (15) 16 (16) 18 (18) times, until there is only 2 sts left on the needle. K1. ES work ktbl.

R 2 (RS): Sl ES purlwise wyif. P 31 (31) 33 (33) 37 (37). Sl ES purlwise wyif.

R 3 (WS): ES work k. [K 1, sl 1 purlwise wyib] – 15 (15) 16 (16) 18 (18) times, until there is only 2 sts left on the needle. K 1. ES work ktbl.

R 4 (RS): Sl ES purlwise wyif. P 31 (31) 33 (33) 37 (37). Sl ES purlwise wyif.

Repeat rows 3-4 13 (13) 14 (14) 16 (16) more times.

A total 30 (30) 32 (32) 36 (36) rows.

Heel Turn

R 1 (WS): ES work k, k 17 (17) 19 (19) 21 (21), k2tog, k 1.

R 2 (RS): Sl ES purlwise wyif, p 4 (4) 6 (6) 6 (6), ssp, p 1, turn.

R 3 (WS): Sl ES knitwise wyib, k to 1 st before gap, k2tog, k 1.

R 4 (RS): Sl ES purlwise wyif, p to 1 st before gap, ssp, p 1.

Repeat rows 3-4 until all sts of the heel are worked.

! In sizes 2XL and 3XL you have to omit the final K1/P1 in the last 2 rows.

A total 14 (14) 14 (14) 15 (15) rows.

{19 (19) 21 (21) 23 (23)} sts.

Foot (Shape Gusset)

Begin working in the round again.

From Heel to Toe you have to work total 60 (64) 68 (72) rounds (4 Vertical Pattern Repeats of Chart 1) for sizes S (M) L (XL) and 75 (80) rounds (5 Vertical Pattern Repeats of Chart 1) for sizes 2XL (3XL).

How to pick up sts from ES: [VIDEO](#)

R 1 (RS): Place **BORM** on the right hand needle.

Pick up 15 (15) 16 (16) 18 (18) sts along the side of the heel from edge sts +1 st at corner from row below to prevent a hole. Place **M1**. Work 33 (33) 37 (37) 39 (39) instep sts according to the Main Pattern: *Chart 1 interchangeable with [p 5(5)6(6)6(6), k1tbl, p 5(5)5(5)6(6)] as the pattern requires.* Place **M2**. Pick up 1 st at the corner from the row below + 15 (15) 16 (16) 18 (18) sts along the side of the heel from edge sts. P to ER.

{84 (84) 92 (92) 100 (100)} sts.

R 2: BORM, p 16 (16) 17 (17) 19 (19) tbl, **M1**, 33 (33) 37 (37) 39 (39) sts according to the Main Pattern, **M2**, p 16 (16) 17 (17) 19 (19) tbl, p to ER.

R 3: BORM, p 14 (14) 15 (15) 17 (17), p2tog, **M1**, 33 (33) 37 (37) 39 (39) sts according to the Main Pattern, **M2**, ssp, p to ER.

R 4: BORM, p 15 (15) 16 (16) 18 (18), **M1**, 33 (33) 37 (37) 39 (39) sts according to the Main Pattern, **M2**, p to ER.

R 5: BORM, p to 2 sts before **M1**, p2tog, **M1**, 33 (33) 37 (37) 39 (39) sts according to the Main Pattern, **M2**, ssp, p to ER.

R 6: BORM, p to **M1**, 33 (33) 37 (37) 39 (39) sts according to the Main Pattern, **M2**, p to ER.

Repeat rounds 5-6 7 (7) 8 (8) 9 (9) more times.

A total 20 (20) 22 (22) 24 (24) rounds.

Decreased 9 (9) 10 (10) 11 (11) sts on each side.

{66 (66) 72 (72) 78 (78)} sts.

Foot (remaining part to Toe)

Remaining 40 (44) 46 (50) rounds for sizes S (M) L (XL) and 51 (56) rounds for sizes 2XL (3XL) are worked as follow:

BORM, p to **M1**, **M1**, 33 (33) 37 (37) 39 (39) sts according the Main Pattern, **M2**, p to ER.

Toe

Work 1 (2) 2 (3) 3 (4) round(s) in pattern:

Purl sts work as P, twisted knit sts as Ktbl.

Remove **M1** and **M2** and place markers as follow:

BORM, 6 (6) 6 (6) 7 (7) sts, **M1**, 2 (2) 3 (3) 2 (2) sts, **M2**, 31 (31) 33 (33) 37 (37) sts, **M3**, 2 (2) 3 (3) 2 (2) sts, **M4**, 25 (25) 27 (27) 30 (30) sts.

Total number of sts between **M2** and **M3**, **M4** and **M1**:

31 (31) 33 (33) 37 (37).

Work toe according to the Decreases Chart.

After 13 (13) 14 (14) 16 (16) r remove **BORM** to make it convenient to work next rounds.

After the last round of Decreases Chart, work 1 short row: p 3.

{18 (18) 20 (20) 22 (22)} sts.

Remove markers, cut the thread ~ 15 cm (6"), divide sts between two needles equally, and sew the open sts with a Kitchener Stitch.

Key for Charts

	Ktbl - knit stitch through the back of the loop (twisted knit stitch)
	Ptbl (video) – purl stitch through the back of the loop (twisted purl stitch)
	purl
	1/1 LC (video) – Slip 1 stitch and hold it in the front, k1tbl, then ktbl slipped stitch.
	1/1 RC (video) – Slip 1 stitch and hold it in the back, k1tbl, then ktbl slipped stitch.
	1/1 LCp (video) – Slip 1 stitch and hold it in the front, p1, then ktbl slipped stitch.
	1/1 pRC (video) – Slip 1 stitch and hold it in the back , ktbl, then purl slipped stitch.
	Ssp (video) – slip 1 knitwise, slip 1 knitwise, purl 2 together through the back of loop
	Purl 2 together (video)

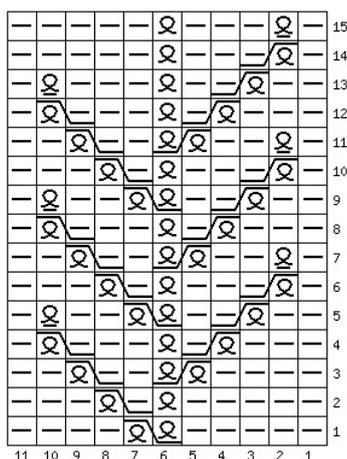


Chart 1 S

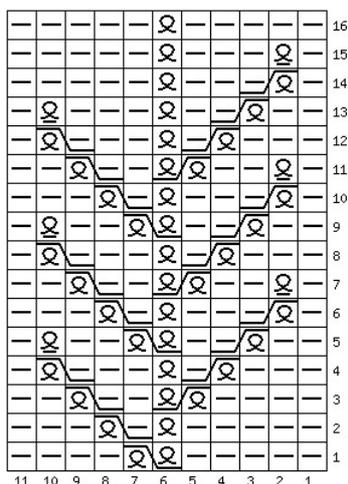


Chart 1 M

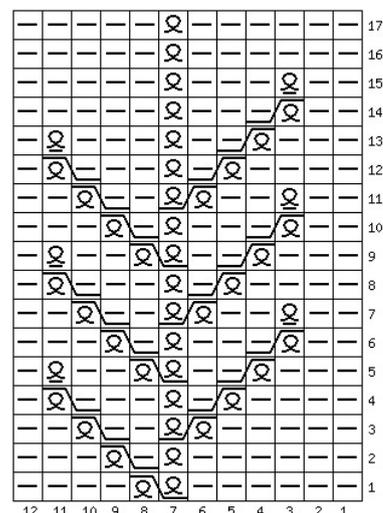


Chart 1 L

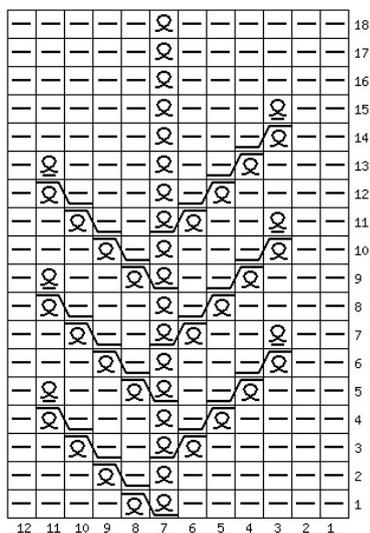


Chart 1 XL

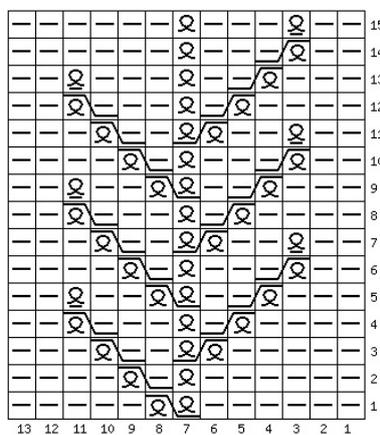


Chart 1 2XL

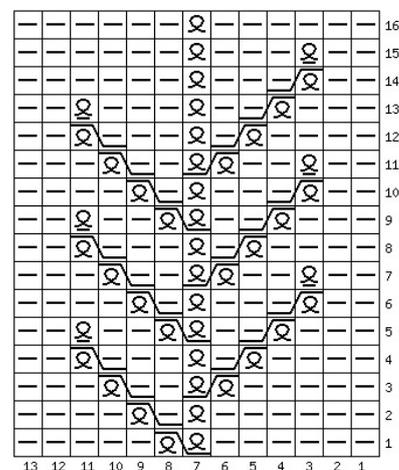
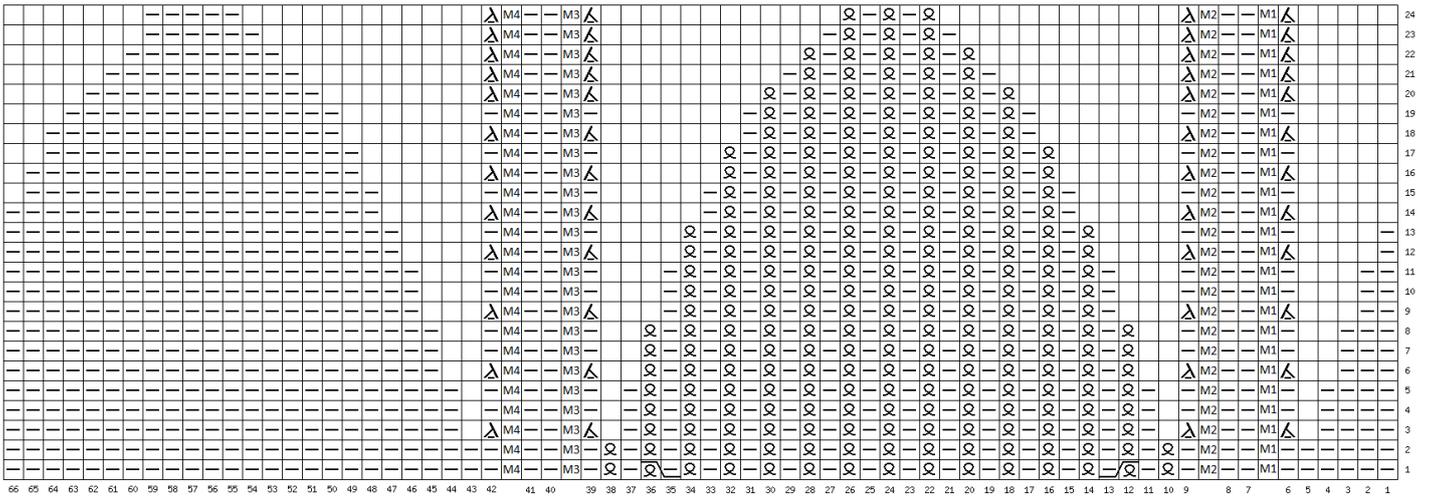
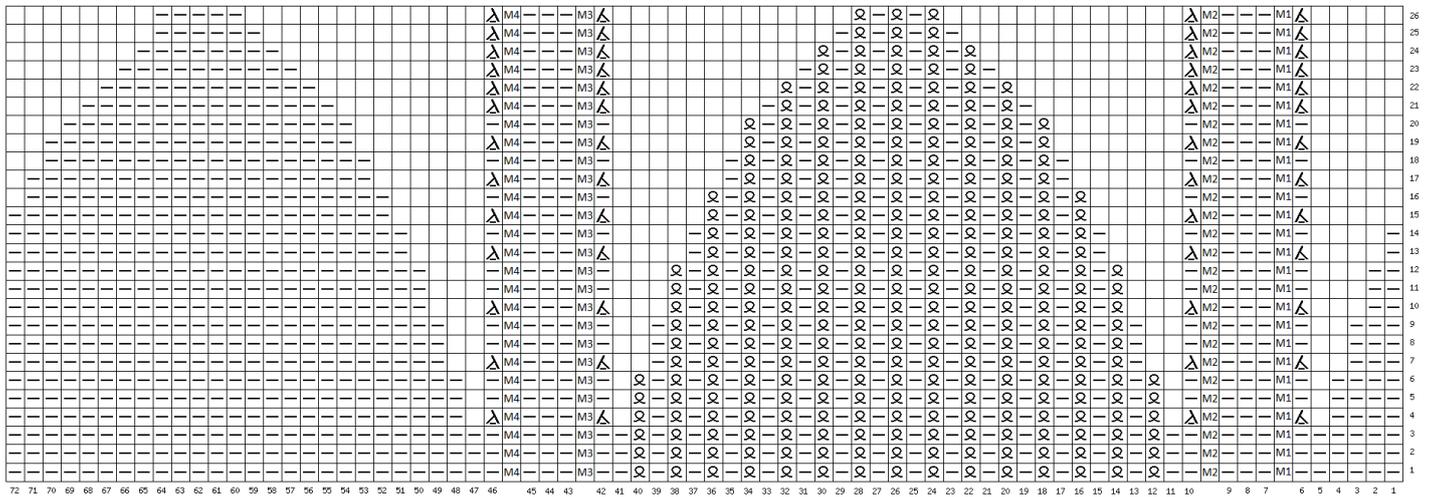


Chart 1 3XL

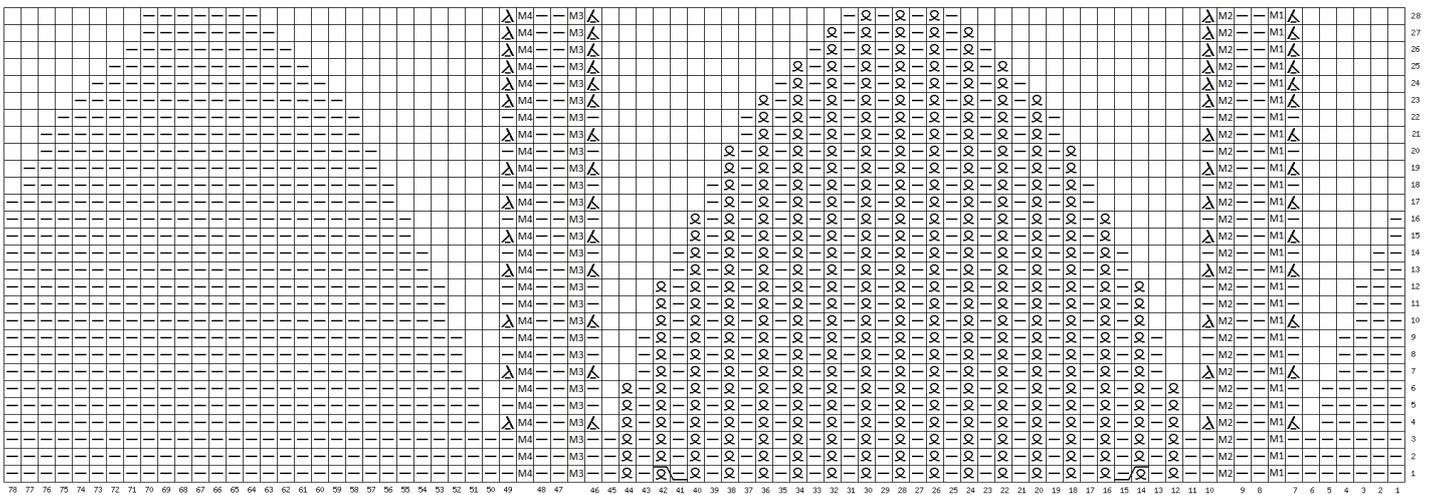
