



# M A U V E L O U S

A large, symmetrical triangle shawl with stripes of color and geometric patterns, knit using a combination of garter stitch medallions and two-color brioche zig zags.



## SIZING AND DIMENSIONS:

One size: 73" / 185 cm wingspan x 32" / 81 cm depth, measured after blocking; see Construction notes and Schematic on Page 2.

## MATERIALS:

**Yarn:** 1135 yds / 1037 m Fingering weight yarn

**Color A:** 310 yds / 283 m

**Color B:** 405 yds / 370 m

**Color C:** 420 yds / 384 m

## Shown in:

**A:** 1 skein **Aya Fibers** Silk Singles in Saffron Crocus (*light mauve*; 70% Superwash Merino wool, 30% Silk; 437 yds / 400 m per 100g)

**B:** 1 skein **Aya Fibers** Silk Singles in Yummy Tits (*hot pink*; from *Tits Out Collective*)

**C:** 1 skein **Aya Fibers** Silk Singles in Secret Wish (*dark mauve*)

**Needles:** 32" / 81 cm or longer US 4 / 3.5mm circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge. Circular needles are used to accommodate large number of stitches and for brioche knitting.

**Tools:** tapestry needle, row counter, 4 stitch markers for noting shawl increases

**Gauge:** 20 sts x 48 rows = 4" / 10 cm; measured in garter stitch (taken after blocking).

## NOTES:

- Choose 3 colors of fingering or light fingering weight yarn for the textural shawl of your dreams! I chose 3 colors in the pink and mauve family for a nice blending, but feel free to use any 3 colors you love! For the best effect, I recommend choosing 3 colors in different tones: light, medium, and dark. Speckled and variegated yarns work wonderfully with these textures and stitch patterns!

- This pattern has both written instructions and charts for every section. If you are planning to print this pattern and want to work with written instructions ONLY, print to Page 9. Charts are on Pages 10 - 13. If you are planning to knit from the charts, I recommend reading through each Section of the written instructions to make sure you don't miss any important notes.

- Please note that the yarn used for this sample is a lighter single ply fingering weight. A standard fingering weight yarn will work for this shawl, but if you substitute yarns, the size of your shawl may vary.

- In brioche, all slipped stitches are slipped purl-wise, except when decreasing.

- Remember, when knitting brioche, each slipped st with its yarn over is counted as one st. When counting rows in brioche, just count the knit sts (looks like a "V") on the Main Side of shawl.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

**BO** :: Bind off

**brk** :: Brioche knit (bark); knit st together w/ its yarn over

**brkyobrk** :: 2-st inc; brk1, leaving st on LH needle, yo, then brk1 into the same st.

**brLsl dec** :: 2-st dec slanting left, involving 3 sts; sl first st knit-wise w/ its yo, brk next 2 sts together, pass slipped st over w/ its yo.

**brp** :: Brioche purl (burp); purl st together w/ its yarn over

**brRsl dec** :: 2-st dec slanting right, involving 3 sts; sl first st knit-wise w/ its yo, knit next st, pass slipped st over, place st on LH needle and pass the following st over w/ its yo. Place st on RH needle.

**CC** :: Contrast color

**CO** :: Cast on

**CS** :: Contrast side

**dec** :: Decrease(s/d)

**inc** :: Increase(s/d)

**K** :: Knit

**k2tog** :: 1-st dec; Knit 2 sts together

**LH** :: Left hand

**M** :: Stitch marker

**MC** :: Main color

**MS** :: Main side

**P** :: Purl

**PM** :: Place st marker

**RH** :: Right hand

**rep** :: Repeat

**SM** :: Slip st markers as encountered

**sl** :: Slip st/s purl-wise [unless otherwise instructed]

**Slide** :: Do not turn work, slide work to other end of needle

**sl1yof** :: Leaving the working yarn in front, slip stitch purl-wise, then bring yarn over and across the stitch, then back to the front (creating a little shawl), ready for next stitch or brp

**sk2p** :: 2-st center dec, involving 3 sts; Sl 1 st knit-wise, k2tog, pass first slipped st over the last worked st

**ssk** :: 1-st dec; sl 2 sts separately knit-wise onto RH needle. Place slipped sts back onto LH needle, and k2tog tbl.

**st/s** :: Stitch/es

**tbl** :: Through back loop of st

**Turn** :: Turn work

**wyib** :: With working yarn in back of work

**wyif** :: With working yarn in front of work

**yf** :: Yarn forward


**yf sl1yo** :: Bring yarn under right needle to front of work, slip next stitch purl-wise, then bring yarn over needle and across slipped stitch to back of needle, ready for next stitch or brk

**yo** :: Yarn forward and over needle to the back

## CONSTRUCTION NOTES:

This symmetrical triangle shawl is knit from the top down, with increases in the center as well as along the edges. See arrows on schematic showing direction of knitting. Within the garter stitch Diamond Medallion sections, 4 stitches are increased on every MS row, while in the Brioche Zig Zag and Border sections, 8 stitches are increased every MS MC row, 2 at each edge, and 4 in the center. The shawl begins with a simple garter stitch setup using Color A, then Diamond Medallions are created using garter stitch lace. To bring in Color B, a two-color brioche zig zag section begins to really blend your colors well. These are alternated again continuing with Color B, and then bringing in Color C for a bold finish. See Page 5 for blocking notes and photos. I wear this shawl with the top edge wrapped warmly around my neck or shoulders, and the bottom point of the triangle facing down.

## PATTERN:

Using Color A yarn and the Long Tail Cast On method, CO 6 sts. [Video tutorial: <https://bit.ly/2nSEJdY>]. Turn to work CS row.

**Begin shawl setup:** In this small section, the shawl shaping inc sts have been bolded for ease of reading. Stitch markers will be placed to help you remember where the inc sts will be on all consecutive rows. Stitch counts for each repeat have been noted in parentheses following Row 5.

**Setup Row (CS):** K to last st, sl 1 wyif.

**[INC ROW] Row 1 (MS):** K2, (**yo**, k1) 3 times, sl 1 wyif. [3 sts inc, 9 sts total]

**Row 2 (CS):** K to last st, sl 1 wyif.

**[INC ROW] Row 3 (MS):** K2, PM, **yo**, k2, **yo**, PM, k1, PM, **yo**, k2, **yo**, PM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc, 13 sts total]

**Row 4 (CS):** K to last st, sl 1 wyif.

**[INC ROW] Row 5 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k to next M, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k to next M, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 17 (21, 25, 29, 33, 37, 41, 45, 49, 53, 57) sts total]

**Row 6 (CS):** K to last st, sl 1 wyif.

Repeat [Rows 5 & 6] 10 *more* times, ending with Row 6 CS. [4 sts inc every rep; 57 sts total]

**Begin Diamond Medallion One:** If you prefer charted instructions, see Charts A1 & A2 on Page 11 for Rows 1 - 28 ONLY. Otherwise continue with written instructions below. **[Note:** In the following section, the shawl shaping inc sts have been bolded for ease of reading. ]

**[INC ROW] Row 1 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k14, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k14, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 61 sts total]

**Row 2 and all CS rows:** K to last st, sl 1 wyif.

**[INC ROW] Row 3 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k12, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k12, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 65 sts total]

**[INC ROW] Row 5 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1, (yo, ssk) twice, k10, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1, (yo, ssk) twice, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1, (yo, ssk) twice, k10, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1, (yo, ssk) twice, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 69 sts total]

**[INC ROW] Row 7 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k3, (yo, ssk) twice, k8, (k2tog, yo) twice, k3, (yo, ssk) twice, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k3, (yo, ssk) twice, k8, (k2tog, yo) twice, k3, (yo, ssk) twice, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 73 sts total]

**[INC ROW] Row 9 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k1, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k1, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k6, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k1, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k1, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k1, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k6, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k1, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 77 sts total]

**[INC ROW] Row 11 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k1, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k3, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k4, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k3, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k1, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k3, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k4, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k3, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 81 sts total]

**[INC ROW] Row 13 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k1, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k5, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k2, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k5, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k1, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k5, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k2, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k5, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k1, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 85 sts total]

**[INC ROW] Row 15 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k3, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k3, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k4, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k3, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k3, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k3, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k3, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k4, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k3, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k3, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 89 sts total]

**[INC ROW] Row 17 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k5, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k1, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k6, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k1, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k5, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k5, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k1, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k6, (yo, ssk) 3 times, k1, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k5, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 93 sts total]

**[INC ROW] Row 19 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k7, (yo, ssk) twice, yo, sk2p, yo, (k2tog, yo) twice, k8, (yo, ssk) twice, yo, sk2p, yo, (k2tog, yo) twice, k7, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k7, (yo, ssk) twice, yo, sk2p, yo, (k2tog, yo) twice, k8, (yo, ssk) twice, yo, sk2p, yo, (k2tog, yo) twice, k7, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 97 sts total]

**[INC ROW] Row 21 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k9, (yo, ssk) twice, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k10, (yo, ssk) twice, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k9, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k9, (yo, ssk) twice, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k10, (yo, ssk) twice, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k9, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 101 sts total]

**[INC ROW] Row 23 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k11, yo, ssk, yo, sk2p, yo, k2tog, yo, k12, yo, ssk, yo, sk2p, yo, k2tog, yo, k11, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k11, yo, ssk, yo, sk2p, yo, k2tog, yo, k12, yo, ssk, yo, sk2p, yo, k2tog, yo, k11, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 105 sts total]

**[INC ROW] Row 25 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k13, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k14, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k13, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k13, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k14, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k13, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 109 sts total]

**[INC ROW] Row 27 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k15, yo, sk2p, yo, k16, yo, sk2p, yo, k15, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k15, yo, sk2p, yo, k16, yo, sk2p, yo, k15, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 113 sts total: 56 sts Right and Left Side, 1 center st]

**[INC ROW] Row 29 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k to next M, **yo**, SM, k1, SM, **yo**, k to next M, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyif. [4 sts inc; 117 (121, 125, 129, 133, 137) sts total]

**Row 30 (CS):** K to last st, sl 1 wyif.

**Rows 31 - 40:** Repeat [Rows 29 & 30] 5 more times, ending with Row 30 CS. [4 sts inc every rep; 137 sts total]

**[INC ROW] Row 41 (MS):** K2, SM, **yo**, k to last M, **yo**, SM, k1, sl 1 wyib. [2 sts inc; 139 sts total]

Turn work, Row 41 is your last garter stitch row!  
**Remember to make sure that last stitch was slipped with your working yarn in back, ready to purl the next row!**

**Begin Brioche Zig Zag One:** If you prefer charted instructions, see Charts B1 & B2 on Page 12, beginning after the Setup Rows. Otherwise continue with written instructions below.

**[Notes:** In the following section, the pattern repeats and inc sts have been bolded for ease of reading. This section is worked twice. Please note the numbers in parentheses following stitch pattern repeats are for the second repeat. Stitch counts for each repeat have been noted in parentheses following each INC ROW.

**- IMPORTANT:** On all MS CC rows from this point forward where increases are made in ALL Brioche Zig Zag sections, process the yo sts as a “p1” rather than a “brp1”.]

Use Color A as MC yarn.

**Setup Row CS MC:** (P1, sl1yof) rep to last st, p1. Slide.

**Setup Row CS CC:** Join Color B as CC yarn: Sl1 wyib, (brk1, yf sl1yo) rep to last 2 sts, brk1, sl1 wyib. Turn.

**[INC ROW] Row 1 MS MC:** K1, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobr**, yf sl1yo, (**brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, **brkyobr**, SM, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobr**, yf sl1yo, (**brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, **brkyobr**, SM, yf sl1yo, k1. Slide. [8 sts inc; 147 (211) sts total]

**Row 1 MS CC:** Sl1 wyif, (brp1, sl1yof) rep to last 2 sts, brp1, sl1 wyif. Turn.

**Row 2 and all CS MC rows:** P1, sl1yof, (brp1, sl1yof) rep to last st, p1. Slide.

**Row 2 and all CS CC rows:** Sl1 wyib, (brk1, yf sl1yo) rep to last 2 sts, brk1, sl1 wyib. Turn.

**[INC ROW] Row 3 MS MC:** K1, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobr**, yf sl1yo, (**brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) twice, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, **brkyobr**, SM, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobr**, yf sl1yo, (**brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) twice, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, **brkyobr**, SM, yf sl1yo, k1. Slide. [8 sts inc; 155 (219) sts total]

**Row 3 MS CC:** Sl1 wyif, (brp1, sl1yof) rep to last 2 sts, brp1, sl1 wyif. Turn.

**[INC ROW] Row 5 MS MC:** K1, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobr**, yf sl1yo, (**brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 4 times, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, **brkyobr**, SM, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobr**, yf sl1yo, (**brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 4 times, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, **brkyobr**, SM, yf sl1yo, k1. **Row 5 MS CC:** Sl1 wyif, (brp1, sl1yof) rep to last 2 sts, brp1, sl1 wyif. Turn.

**[INC ROW] Row 7 MS MC:** K1, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobr**, yf sl1yo, (**brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 6 times, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, **brkyobr**, SM, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobr**, yf sl1yo, (**brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 6 times, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, **brkyobr**, SM, yf sl1yo, k1. Slide. [8 sts inc; 171 (235) sts total]

**Row 7 MS CC:** Sl1 wyif, (brp1, sl1yof) rep to last 2 sts, brp1, sl1 wyif. Turn.

**INC ROW] Row 9 MS MC:** K1, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobrk**, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo, (**brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 6 times, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, brk1, yf sl1yo, **brkyobrk**, SM, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobrk**, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo, (**brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 6 times, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, brk1, yf sl1yo, **brkyobrk**, SM, yf sl1yo, k1. Slide. [8 sts inc; 179 (243) sts total]

**Row 9 MS CC:** Sl1 wyif, (brp1, sl1yof) rep to last 2 sts, brp1, sl1 wyif. Turn.

**INC ROW] Row 11 MS MC:** K1, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobrk**, yf sl1yo, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 3 times, (**brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 4 times, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 3 times, **brkyobrk**, SM, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobrk**, yf sl1yo, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 3 times, (**brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 4 times, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 3 times, **brkyobrk**, SM, yf sl1yo, k1. **INC ROW] Row 13 MS MC:** K1, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobrk**, yf sl1yo, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 5 times, (**brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) twice, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 5 times, **brkyobrk**, SM, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobrk**, yf sl1yo, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 5 times, (**brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) twice, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo**) 4 (6) times, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 5 times, **brkyobrk**, SM, yf sl1yo, k1. **Row 13 MS CC:** Sl1 wyif, (brp1, sl1yof) rep to last 2 sts, brp1, sl1 wyif. Turn.

**Row 3 MS CC:** Sl1 wyif, (brp1, sl1yof) rep to last 2 sts, brp1, sl1 wyif. Turn.

**[INC ROW] Row 5 MS MC:** K1, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobr**, yf sl1yo, **(brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, {brk1, yf sl1yo} 4 times, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, {brk1, yf sl1yo} 5 times)** 7 times, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 4 times, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, **brkyobr**, SM, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobr**, yf sl1yo, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 4 times, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, **({brk1, yf sl1yo} 5 times, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, {brk1, yf sl1yo} 4 times, brkyobr, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo)** 7 times, **brkyobr**, SM, yf sl1yo, k1. **Row 5 MS CC:** Sl1 wyif, (brp1, sl1yof) rep to last 2 sts, brp1, sl1 wyif. Turn.

**[INC ROW] Row 7 MS MC:** K1, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobrk**, yf sl1yo, (**brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, {brk1, yf sl1yo} 6 times, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, {brk1, yf sl1yo} 3 times**) 7 times, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 6 times, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, **brkyobrk**, SM, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobrk**, yf sl1yo, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 6 times, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, (**{brk1, yf sl1yo} 3 times, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, {brk1, yf sl1yo} 6 times, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo**) 7 times, **brkyobrk**, SM, yf sl1yo, k1. **Row 7 MS CC:** Sl1 wyif, (brp1, sl1yof) rep to last 2 sts, brp1, sl1 wyif. Turn.

**[INC ROW] Row 9 MS MC:** K1, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobrk**, yf sl1yo, (**brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, {brk1, yf sl1yo} 8 times, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, brk1, yf sl1yo**) 7 times, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 8 times, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, **brkyobrk**, SM, yf sl1yo, SM, **brkyobrk**, yf sl1yo, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, (brk1, yf sl1yo) 8 times, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo, (**brk1, yf sl1yo, brRsl dec, yf sl1yo, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, {brk1, yf sl1yo} 8 times, brkyobrk, yf sl1yo, brLsl dec, yf sl1yo**) 7 times, **brkyobrk**, SM, yf sl1yo, k1. Slide. [8 sts inc; 495 sts total]

**Row 9 MS CC:** Sl1 wyif, (brp1, sl1yof) rep to last 2 sts, brp1, sl1 wyif. Turn.

**Row 10 CS MC:** P1, sl1yof, (brp1, sl1yof) rep to last st, p1. Slide.

**Row 10 CS CC:** Sl1 wyib, (brk1, yf sl1yo) rep to last 2 sts, brk1, sl1 wyib. Turn.

**[Designer Tip:** If you find that you have very little Color C yarn left, feel free to break Color C and bind off using Color A.]

### Begin binding off shawl:

Break CC yarn. Using MC yarn, BO all sts using the Elastic Bind Off method as follows: K2, (sl 2 sts purl-wise back to LH needle, k2tog tbl, brk1, sl 2 sts purl-wise back to LH needle, k2tog tbl, k1) rep until 3 sts remain, sl 2 sts purl-wise back to LH needle, k2tog tbl, k1, sl 2 sts purl-wise back to LH needle, k2tog tbl. Break yarn and pull end through last loop, pulling tight to close.

### FINISHING:

Weave in all ends and block as desired to size on schematic. **Note about blocking brioche:** It can tend to open up quite a bit when wet blocked, but with a shawl, this is a good thing! I highly recommend wet blocking this shawl and gently pressing it into a towel to absorb most of the water. Lay flat on blocking mats or plastic trash bags [do not place on a towel because it may prolong drying time]. Let the shawl remain in the natural triangle shape, and pin out to desired dimensions. See Page 9, Photo 1 for a photo of my shawl sample blocking.

After top of shawl is dry, you may need to flip it over to dry the other side. The brioche stitch creates a double-sided fabric, so each side may need extra time to dry.

Enjoy your new Mauvelous shawl!!

### Notes for following charts:

- Be sure to read through the written instructions thoroughly.
- Read the charts as to work the shawl flat: all odd numbered rows (MS rows) will be read from right to left; all even numbered rows (CS rows) will be read from left to right. Arrows indicating direction of chart reading are provided.
- In the Brioche Zig Zag charts, the MC rows are white, and the CC rows are gray.
- The hot pink outline shows the repeat of the stitch pattern in all charts.
- All Setup Rows between garter stitch and brioche sections are in the written instructions ONLY. I've included page numbers on the charts so you can easily refer back before beginning the next section.
- Please note the stitch marker locations in the written instructions, on either side of the center stitch, and at the edge stitches.




## Charts A1 & A2 Notes:

- These charts show the lace portion only. Please refer to the written instructions on the pages noted below for all Setup Rows, and the increase rows following the lace.
- Diamond Medallion One (Page 3): Work Rows 1 - 28 with no stitch pattern repeats.
- Diamond Medallion Two (Page 5): Work Rows 1 - 14 ONLY; Repeat stitch pattern 7 times.
- Diamond Medallion Three (Page 7): Work Rows 15 - 27 ONLY; Repeat stitch pattern 10 times.



#### Diamond Medallion :: Left Side


