Size

- **Bag and Pillow:** Width x Height: 37cm x 37cm/ 14 ½" x 14 ½"
- **Bag handles:** 20 (54, 76)cm/ 8 (21 ¼, 30)" for hand-bag (short handles shoulder-bag, medium handles shoulder-bag). Prototype features 20cm/ 8" hand-bag handles.

Bag:

Yarn1 (light): 147g (includes 140g for mosaic section and 7g for whiskers)

Yarn2 (dark) for a bag with a bottom: 155(180, 195)g (includes 25g for a bottom, 90g for the body, 10g for upper edge backing, 30(55, 70)g for 20 (54, 76)cm/ 8 (21 ¼, 30)" handles)

Yarn2 (dark) for a bag without a bottom: 130(155, 170)g (includes 90g for the body, 10g for upper edge backing, 30(55, 70)g for 20 (54, 76)cm/ 8 (21 ¼, 30)" handles)

Yarn3: 3g and 5g for a nose and eyes respectfully

Prototype (bag without a bottom):

146g/ 1 Whirl in 782 Rhubarb Bumble (136g as Yarn1 and 10g for upper edge backing)

86g/ 1 Whirlette in 863 Chocolate as Yarn2

3g/ 1 Whirlette in 881 Yummy as Yarn3 for eyes

30g/ 1 Whirlette in 853 Mango as Yarn 2 for hand-bag handles

Pillow:

Yarn1 (light): 147g

Yarn2 (dark): 90g

Yarn3: 3g and 5g for a nose and eyes respectfully

Prototype:

136g/ 1 Whirl in 782 Rhubarb Bumble as Yarn1

86g/ 1 Whirlette in 863 Chocolate as Yarn2

3g/ 1 Whirlette in 881 Yummy as Yarn3 for eyes

Other materials and tools:

- Crochet hooks 2.5mm and 2.75mm (for handles)

Bag:

- 43-45cm/ 17-18 ½" of pre-quilted fabric (bag height + ½ of the bottom width + 6cm/ 2 ¾")
- 9cm x 78cm/ 3 ½" x 30" piece of buckram or Pellon 70 Peltex Sew-In Ultra Firm Stabilizer to reinforce the upper edge (bag width x 2 + 4cm/ 1 ½")
- Optional for reinforcing the bottom: 28.5cm x 6cm/ 11 ¼" x 2 ¾" piece of plastic canvas (bag bottom measurements minus 2cm/ ¾" from each side)
- Sewing machine, sewing thread (match lining and handles)
- 1 x sew-on magnetic clasp
- Tapestry needle

Pillow:

- Pillow insert (1-2cm/ ¾ – ¾" bigger than finished size)
- Optional: 32cm/ 12 ⅝" invisible zipper (pillow width minus 5cm/ 2")

Rules for overlay mosaic crochet

- **Overlay mosaic crochet** is worked on **right side (RS) only**.
- **Each round** is made with **one color**. **Yarn1 and Yarn2 are alternated** in each round. Switch to next color at the end of rnd: make joining ss in back loop of first stitch with next rnd color, tighten both working ends.
- **Sc (colored blocks on charts):** made in stitches from prev round through back loop only.
First sc of round is made in back lp of 1st st from pr.
Abbreviation *blo* (back loop only) is skipped to simplify instructions.
- **Dc, dc- increases and decreases:** drop down stitches, made in stitches from corresponding color rnd (2nd rnd down) and through front loop only.
First dc of round is made in front lp of 1st st from 2nd rnd down/ same color rnd.
Abbreviation *flo* (front loop only) is skipped to simplify instructions.
- Use **invisible join technique** for rounds that start and end with dc: make last dc in 2 sts at the same time: in last and 1st st of 2nd rnd down (idea: Linda Toering).

yo, insert hook in directed st,
yo, draw yarn through st,

- **\dec** (modified slimmer version of edc and dc together; make in sts below prev 2sc):
yo, insert hook in directed st,

insert hook in next st, yo, draw yarn
through st,
yo, draw yarn through 3 lps on hook,
yo, draw yarn through 2 lps on hook
- **edc** (extended dc): yo, insert hook in
directed st, yo, draw yarn through st, yo,
draw yarn through 1 lp on hook, [yo, draw
yarn through 2 lps on hook]x2
- **inc**: 2dc in same st
- **/inc**: (edc, dc) in same st
- **\inc**: (dc, edc) in same st
- **leg**: part of decrease. Example: edc-dc-tog
in Rnd 10 has 2 legs: edc and dc
- **sk (skip)**: for *dc*, *inc* or *dec*, skip st from
the second rnd down, for *sc*, skip st from
prev rnd
- **Yarn1**: light for background, **Yarn2**: dark
for cat, **Yarn3**: nose or eyes

Gauge

Mosaic crochet: 29.6 sts x 29.6 rows = 10cm x 10cm/ 4" x 4".

Gauge swatch instructions

Foundation cord:

Swatch is made with one color and in turning rows to avoid breaking yarn.

Row 1 (RS): make 32sts of fnd cord, turn, ch1 (doesn't count as st throughout), 32sc, turn.

Row 2 (WS): ch1, sc in same st (in both lps; = *border sc*), 30sc flo (front lp only) in pr, sc in last st (in both lps; = *border sc*), turn.

Row 3 (RS): ch1, sc in same st (in both lps; = *border sc*), 30dc flo (front lp only) in 2nd row down, sc in last st (in both lps; = *border sc*), turn.

Rows 4-31: rep Rows 2 and 3.

Wash and dry according to *Care* section on p. 28. Measure, make sure to obtain the gauge, unravel.

Bag with a bottom

Bottom:



1) Optional bag bottom.

If you are making a pillow or a bag without a bottom, proceed to *Bag and pillow body* section on p. 9.

Approximate bottom size: 30.5cm x 8cm/ 12" x 3 ¼".

Rnd 1: with Yarn2 (dark) reserve about 80cm/ 31 ½" tail for foundation and make 59sts of foundation cord, ch1 (*doesn't count as st throughout*), 3sc (in 1st fnd cord st; =sc3inc; **pm1** flo in 1st sc; *move m up in each dc-rnd to mark 1st st of front side*), 57sc, 5sc in last st (sc5inc; **pm2** in 3rd dc and *move m up in each dc-rnd to mark 1st st of back side*), 57sc (in same fnd but from other side), 2sc in same st as beg 3sc (count tog as sc5inc), ss blo in marked 1st sc (*throughout: blo in marked 1st st*). (124sc)

Rnd 2: ch1, sc, sc3inc, 59sc, sc3inc, sc, sc3inc, 59sc, sc3inc, ss. (132sc)

Rnd 3: ch1, dc (in marked lp; *move m1 flo*), dc5inc, 59dc, dc5inc, dc (*move m2 flo*), dc5inc, 59dc, dc5inc (use invisible join for last dc of inc), ss. (140dc)

Rnd 4: ch1, 3sc, sc3inc, 63sc, sc3inc, 5sc, sc3inc, 63sc, sc3inc, 2sc, ss. (148sc)

Rnd 5: ch1, 3 dc, dc5inc, 63dc, dc5inc, 5dc, dc5inc, 63dc, dc5inc, 2dc, ss. (156dc)

Rnd 6: ch1, 5sc, sc3inc, 67sc, sc3inc, 9sc, sc3inc, 67sc, sc3inc, 4sc, ss. (164sc)

Rnd 7: ch1, 5dc, dc5inc, 67dc, dc5inc, 9dc, dc5inc, 67dc, dc5inc, 4dc, ss. (172dc)

Rnd 8: ch1, 7sc, sc3inc, 71sc, sc3inc, 13sc, sc3inc, 71sc, sc3inc, 6sc, ss. (180sc)

Rnd 9: ch1, 7dc, dc5inc, 71dc, dc5inc, 13dc, dc5inc, 71dc, dc5inc, 6dc, ss. (188dc)

Rnd 10: ch1, 9sc, sc3inc, 75sc, sc3inc, 17sc, sc3inc, 75sc, sc3inc, 8sc, ss. (196sc)

Rnd 11: ch1, 9dc, dc5inc, *6dc, [dc2inc, 12dc, dc2inc, 11dc] x2, dc2inc, 12dc, dc2inc, 5dc*, dc5inc, 17dc, dc5inc, rep bet *'s, dc5inc, 8dc, with Yarn1 (background) ss. (216dc)

Measure your work for making lining:
30.5cm x 8cm/ 12" x 3 ¼".

First 4 rnds of the bag body are also included in this section because they are slightly different from a version without a bottom. Proceed to Rnd 5 of *Bag and pillow body* section after completing the next 4 rnds.

Rnd 1: with Yarn1 ch1, 216sc, with Yarn2 ss.

Rnd 2: *front:* with Yarn2 ch1, 4sc, sk sc, inc, 97dc, inc, sk sc, 3sc,

back: 108sc, with Yarn1 ss.

Rnd 3: *front:* with Yarn1 ch1, 3dc (1st in marked sc), dec, 101sc (first 2 and last 2 in inc), dec (in first 2 of rem 4dc before m), 2dc, *back:* 108dc (use inv join for last dc), with Yarn2 ss.

Rnd 4: *front:* with Yarn2 ch1, 3sc, sk dec, /-dc (in 1st dc of inc), /dec, 4sc (first 2 behind /dec), dec (1st leg below prev sc, sk dc, 2nd leg in next), /dec, 6sc (first 2 behind /dec), dec (1st leg below prev sc), 5sc, \dec (below prev 2sc), dec,

6dc, inc, \inc, sk 2dc, 8sc, \dec (below prev 2sc), sk sc, 21sc, sk dc, /dec, 8sc (first 2 behind /dec), sk 2dc, /inc, inc, 7dc, dec, /dec, 4sc (first 2 behind /dec), \dec (below prev 2sc), dec (1st leg in next dc, sk dc, 2nd leg in next dc), 5sc (1st behind dec), \dec (below prev 2sc), dec (1st leg in next sc, sk dc, 2nd leg in next dc), 4sc (1st behind dec), \dec (below prev 2sc; 2nd leg in 1st dc of inc), \-dc (in 2nd dc of inc), sk dec, 2sc, *back:* 108sc, with Yarn1 ss.

Bag and pillow body

Charts:

To use on a digital device:

Chart 1 (front) on p. 29.

Chart 2 (back) on p. 30.

To print:

Charts 1.1-1.4 (front) and **Charts 2.1-2.4** (back) in a separate file.

Set aside yarn for optional whiskers:

If using gradient yarn, reserve 5g/ 23m/ 25yds of the lightest color for making optional whiskers.

If you would like to have a pillow opening at the bottom (to stitch in a zipper), make the alternative Rnd 1 in the box below. Otherwise, skip it and go to the regular Rnd 1 (for a bag or a pillow with an opening at the top).

Pillow with a zipper at the bottom:

Alternative Rnd 1:

with Yarn1 (light/ background) reserve 240cm/ 94" tail for fnd cord, make 202 sts of fnd cord, join in rnd with ss in first st, ch1 (*doesn't count as st throughout*), *sc (**pm1 and move up in each dc-rnd to mark 1st st of front side**), inc, [15dc, inc, 16dc,

inc]x3,
rep from * but **pm2** in 1st sc (*move up in each dc-rnd to mark 1st st of back side*), with Yarn2 ss blo in 1st sc. (216sts)
Go to Rnd 2.

(Yarn1 is a lighter color for this pattern)

Rnd 1: with Yarn1 (light/ background) reserve 120cm/ 47" tail for fnd cord, make 101sts of fnd cord, turn,
ch1 (*doesn't count as st throughout*), sc2inc (in 1st fnd st), **pm1 flo** in 1st sc (*move m up in each dc-rnd to mark 1st st of front side*),
sc, [13sc, sc2inc]x6, 14sc,
sc3inc (in last fnd st), **pm2 flo** in 2nd sc of sc3inc (= 1st st of back side; *move m up in each dc-rnd to mark 1st st of back side*),
work in same fnd but from other side:
rep bet *'s (increases will be made in the same fnd sts as for the first side), sc (in same st as beg sc2inc), with Yarn2 (dark): ss blo in marked 1st sc. (216sc)

Rnd 2: with Yarn2 (dark) ch1, 216sc (in m1-st; *all sc blo throughout*), with Yarn1 ss (*blo in first st from prev rnd throughout*).

Rnd 3: front: with Yarn1 ch1, 3dc (*1st in marked sc throughout; all dc, inc and dec flo throughout*), dec, 101sc (1st behind prev dec), dec (1st leg below prev sc), 2dc,

back: 108dc (use inv join for last dc), with Yarn2 ss.

back: 108dc (7th in sc; use inv join for last dc), with Yarn2 ss.

Bag upper edge backing:

Dec Rnd 108: *front*: with Yarn2 or upper edge backing yarn ch1, *sc (*all sc and sc2tog blo*), sc2tog, [15sc, sc2tog, 16sc, sc2tog]x3, *back*: rep *front* from *, ss blo. (216 – 14 = 202sc)

Rnds 109-117: *front*: with Yarn2 or upper edge backing yarn ch1, 101sc blo,

back: 101sc blo, ss blo. (202sts)

Fasten off after Rnd 117. Keep all markers.

Wash and dry according to *Care* section.

Optional whiskers

The prototype was made without whiskers.

Yarn usage: approximately 5g.

- Place a plastic folder or a magazine inside the bag or pillow to prevent catching the other side with a needle.
- Whiskers are made using the outline embroidery stitch. Mark the whiskers with tailor's chalk.
- To make a seam, insert the needle 2cm³/₄" from the seam starting point and emerge back to the right side (RS) at the seam beginning point. Draw the yarn through and leave a 15cm/6" tail. Make the seam following the provided video.
- Finish the seam by inserting the needle at the needle point at the end of the seam and emerging it back to the RS, 2cm³/₄" from the last needle point. Cut the yarn, leaving

a 15cm/6" tail. Repeat this process for all the whiskers in the group.

- Turn the bag inside out, draw all the tails to the wrong side (WS), tie them off, and weave them in.
- Repeat the above steps for another group of whiskers.

Finishing pillow

Option 1 (zipper):

Stitch or crochet bottom edges together from both corners inwards for about 2.5cm/ 1" (follow a video for Option 2). Sew zipper in the opening. Place a pillow insert inside the cover.

Option 2 (crochet upper edges together):

Place a pillow insert inside the cover. Remove m from last lp, insert hook from RS in next dc (1st dc of front side), PU lp and draw it through st,

[ss in next dc from front side, take lp off hook, insert hook from RS in next dc from back side, PU lp, draw it through st]x99, ss in last st. Fasten off. Leave a tail.

Thread tapestry needle with the tail. Insert needle in side of the bag 1cm/ 3/8" below the corner, make a few horizontal sts bet dc-rows (long on the inside, short on the outside). Make an extra long last st so after taking the needle out, rem tail stays inside the cover. You will be able to pick up the tail and unravel the seam in order to wash the cover. Repeat joining after washing.

Handles (x2)

Length: 20 (54, 76)cm/ 8 (21 1/4, 30)"

Make sure to have 30(55, 70)g of yarn for handles.

Gauge: 26sts = 10cm/ 4" over thermal stitch with 2.75mm hook.

Row 1 (RS): With 2.75mm hook and chosen color sc (bet m3-dc and next dc), 19sc (each bet next 2dc; last sc bet m4-dc and next dc), ch52(140, 198) or different number for desired handle length), sc (bet prev dc and m5-dc), 19sc (last bet prev dc and m6-dc), turn.

Remove m3-m6, keep m1 and m2.



4) Handles. Row 1.

Row 2 (WS): ch1 (doesn't count as st throughout), 92(180, 238)sc blo (1st in same sc; next 19 in sc, next 52(140, 198) in ch, last 20 in sc), turn.

Row 3 (RS): ch1, 20sc (each blo in 2sts: sc from pr and in lp from 2nd row down), 52(140,

198)sc (each blo in 2sts: in sc from pr and in lp of ch-fnd), 20sc (blo in 2sts: in sc from pr and in lp from 2nd row down), turn.

Rows 4-20 or to 4cm/ 1 ½": ch1, 92(180, 238)sc (blo in 2sts like in prev row, but make last row in 3 lps: in both lps of sc from prev row and in lp from 2nd row down). Fasten off.

Back side handle:

Rep *front side handle* working with markers m7-m10. After completing, **remove m7-m10**,

keep m1 and m2.

Proceed to *Lining and finishing* section on p. 31.

Handles will be stitched to the bag after completing the lining.

Care

Hand-wash in lukewarm water with a bit of mild detergent, rinse, use a towel to squeeze out excess moisture, lay flat to dry.








Lining

Bag without a bottom (Steps 1-4):

For a bag with a bottom, go to the next page and complete Steps 5-13.



1) Measure and cut pre-quilted fabric for lining.

Soften bag by stretching it gently in all directions; lay flat on an even surface.

Measure bag height and width:

Bag Height (H): from the bottom to the upper edge not backing (=37cm/ 14 1/2").

Bag width (W): (=37cm/ 14 1/2").

Calculate lining measurements:

Lining Height = bag H + 2cm/ 3/4" (for adjustments) + 2.5cm/ 1" (for SA/ seam allowance) = 37 + 2 + 2.5 = **41.5cm/ 16 1/8"**.

Lining Width (one piece) = bag W x 2 - 1cm/ 3/8" (for adjustment) + 4cm/ 1 1/2" (for SA) = 37 x 2 - 1 + 4 = **77cm/ 30 3/8"**.

Cut fabric to the measurements Height x Width: 41.5cm x 77cm/ 16 1/8" x 30 3/8".



2) Center seam. Overcast bottom edge. Fold your fabric into half width-wise RS together, stitch center seam with 2cm/ 3/4" SA. Insert lining in, stretch the bag width-wise to check if it fits, re-do the center seam if necessary. When lining fits the bag, overcast side SA's separately, press open.



3) Bottom seam. With lining folded so that center seam is in the middle of one side, stitch bottom seam with 2.5cm/ 1" SA.



4) Fold back bottom SA towards lining and hand-stitch to the lining with whip stitch. Make sure not to catch other side with your needle. Go to Step 14.

Bag with a bottom (Steps 5-13):



5) Measure and cut fabric for lining.

Soften bag by stretching it gently in all directions; lay flat on an even surface. Measure bag height and width:

Bag Height (H): from the middle of the bottom to the upper edge not backing (=41cm/ 16 1/8").

Bag width (W): (=37cm/ 14 5/8").

Calculate lining measurements:

Lining Height = bag H + 2cm/ 3/4" (for adjustments) + 2.5cm/ 1" (for SA/ seam allowance) = 41 + 2 + 2.5 = **45.5cm/ 18"**.

Lining Width: bag W x 2 - 1cm/ 3/8" (for adjustment) + 4cm/ 1 1/2" (for SA) = 37 x 2 - 1 + 4 = **77cm/ 30 3/8"**.

Cut fabric to the measurements Height x Width:

45.5cm x 77cm/ 14" x 30 3/8".



6) Center seam.

Overcast bottom edge. Fold your fabric into half width-wise RS together, stitch center seam with 2cm/ 3/4" SA. Insert lining in, stretch the bag width-wise to check if it fits, re-do the center seam if necessary.



7) When lining fits the bag, overcast center seam SA's separately, press open. Fold the lining so the center seam is located in the middle of one side.



8) Bottom seam.

With center seam in the middle of one side, stitch bottom seam with 2 cm/ 3/4" SA. Press open. Flatten the bottom corners of the lining to form triangles and pin to secure.



9) Bottom corner seams.

Seam length: bag bottom width (measured after completion) – 1.5cm = 8cm – 1.5cm = 6.5cm/ 2 1/2". Mark and stitch 6.5cm/ 2 1/2" corner seams.



10) Fold corners inwards and hand-stitch to the bottom with whip stitch.




11) Optional bottom reinforcement (Steps 11-13).

Measure lining bottom. Cut plastic canvas to the bottom size minus 1.5cm/ 5/8" each side. Example: for 8cm x 30.5cm bottom, cut plastic canvas to 8 – 1.5 x 30.5 – 1.5 = 6.5cm x 29cm/ 2 1/2" x 11 1/2". Round corners.



12) Cut a piece of quilted fabric with 1cm/ 3/8" SA on 3 sides to be folded in half and cover plastic canvas on both sides. Wrap plastic canvas in fabric, align edges, pin or baste along 3 sides.




13) With canvas inside, make a seam along 3 sides. Trim SA close to the seam (0.5cm/ 3/16"), overcast raw edges. Place reinforcement piece inside lining.

All options (bag with and without a bottom):



14) Cut lining to size.

Insert lining into the bag to check that the height of the lining matches the height of the bag WITHOUT backing. Stretch the bag height-wise slightly. Make adjustments to the lining by trimming off excess fabric from its upper edge (I had to trim 2.5cm/ 1"). The end of the center seam will come undone after trimming. Secure center seam with a few stitches.



16) Reinforce upper edge with buckram or stabilizer.

Place 9cm/ 3 1/2" buckram or stabilizer strip around the upper edge of the lining WS. Align upper edges, baste or pin together. Overlap strip edges by ~ 2cm/ 3/4", make sure overlapping line does not align with center seam.

Make a seam along upper edges first, then continue to one of the vertical overlapped edges, stitch lower edge of stabilizer strip to the lining, and proceed to the second vertical overlapped edge (Step 17).



15) The upper edge of the lining should end just under the upper edge of the bag so the backing could be effortlessly folded over the lining.



17) Hand-stitch side SA to the lining. Make sure not to catch other side with your needle.



18) Mark both sides of lining.



21) Backing seam.

Stitch backing to the lining with an invisible stitch.



19) Align marking on both sides with m1 and m2, pin together.



22) Stretch width-wise and fold attached part of the handle over the upper edge to WS. Make sure edges of the handle are at the same distance from the upper edge.



20) Upper edge seam.

Fold backing over lining, pin together in a few spots and make upper edge seam with invisible back stitch (see Step 24) bet last two double crochet rounds.

23) Handle seam (x4).



Stitch handle securely through all layers with invisible back stitch (see Step 24) and make a few extra stitches where the handle goes up.



24) Short handles whip seam.

Thread tapestry needle with a piece of handles yarn and stitch open edged of each handle together with whip stitch, leaving open about 2.5cm/ 2" between the handle seam and the whip seam.



26) Invisible upper edged back stitch (optional).

With RS of the bag facing, hand-stitch the bag to the lining with back-stitch, inserting needle through all 3 layers. Work very close to the upper edge of the lining and along the top edge of the bag.



25) Finished short handles.



27) Magnet clasp. Stitch magnet clasp parts in the middle of the backing. Make sure to stitch them to the lining through the backing.

Bag bottom:

- **Approximate size:** 30.5cm x 8cm/ 12" x 3 ¼".
- Shown on a small sample. 2 colors are alternated for better visibility.



1) Rnd 1 (RS throughout): with Yarn1 make 59sts of foundation cord, ch1 (*doesn't count as st throughout*), 3sc in same st (sc3inc; *1st st of rnd is made in 1st st throughout*),



2) 57sc,



3) 5sc in last st (sc5inc),



4) 57sc (in the same fnd sts from other side), 2sc in same st as beg 2sc, with Yarn2 ss in 1st sc (in 1st st and blo throughout). (124sc)



5) Rnd 2 (all sc and sc-increases: in prev rnd and blo throughout): with Yarn2 ch1, sc, sc3inc, 59sc, sc3inc, sc, sc3inc, 59sc, sc3inc, with Yarn1 ss. (132sc)



6) Note: in Rnd 3 and in all rounds that start and end with dc, make last dc using invisible join technique: <https://youtu.be/Rr1gLY2AiFY>
Rnd 3 (all dc in 2nd rnd down and flo throughout): with Yarn1 ch1, dc, dc5inc, 59dc, dc5inc, dc, dc5inc, 59dc, dc5inc, with Yarn2 ss. (140dc)



7) Rnd 4: with Yarn2 ch1, 3sc, sc3inc, 63sc, sc3inc, 5sc, sc3inc, 63sc, sc3inc, 2sc, with Yarn1 ss. (148sc)



8) Rnd 5: with Yarn1 ch1, 3dc, dc5inc, 63dc, dc5inc, 5dc, dc5inc, 63dc, dc5inc, 2dc, with Yarn2 ss. (156dc)
Continue with written instructions.
