


# Karelia

Circular yoke sweater with flower motif

*size S worn with 11 cm positive ease*

This pattern is my second collaboration with Kokon Yarn.

The flower motif is worked not as embroidering but as weaving between the stitches while knitting. It is traditional Estonian technique and called „Roosimine“, which means Rose in Estonian language. The pattern made with this technique is called „Roositud“. Traditional Estonian Roositud patterns have quite geometrical form and are worked in a set of bright primary colors. I have designed my own flower Roositud. Normally it's used for very tight gauge knitting like mittens, gloves or socks. Intentionally I have worked it in very loose tension with chunky mohair. It gave the motif a 3-dimensional look.

I was looking for the name associated with forest for this project and named it after the place of beautiful forest and lakes.

The pattern is worked seamlessly from the top down.

## Sizes

2XS (XS, S, M1)(M2, L, XL, 2XL) (3XL, 4XL, 5XL, 6XL).

Designed to fit with 10–15cm / 4–6" of positive ease.

Model has a 87 cm / 34" bust & is 172 cm / 5' 7¾".

## Yarn

**MC:** 3 (3, 3, 4) (4, 4, 5, 5)(5, 6, 6, 7) skeins of Kokon Yarn Fingering Weight Merino (100% merino wool; 320 meters / 100g), shown in color Madder.

874 (909, 960, 1022)(1083, 1160, 1321, 1426) (1577, 1694, 1883, 2061) meters / 956 (994, 1050, 1118)(1184, 1268, 1445, 1560)(1724, 1853, 2059, 2254) yards of fingering or sport weight wool yarn.

**CC1 (Leaf):** 2 mini skeins of Kokon Yarn Chunky Mohair (78% mohair, 13% wool, 9% nylon; 100 meters / 50g), shown in color Cork.

15 meters / 17 yards of thick mohair yarn (150 cm / 59" for each). You can also use 3 to 4 strands of lace weight mohair yarn held together. Making crochet chain from mohair lace could also be a lovely alternative. (See video ["knit with 3 strands from 1 ball"](#))

**CC2 (Flower):** 1 mini skeins of Kokon Yarn DK Weight Merino (100% merino wool; 184 meters / 100g), shown in color Gold.

6 meters / 7 yards of DK or Worsted weight wool yarn (60 cm / 24" for each). You can

also use 2 strands of fingering weight yarn held together.

*You can change the color for each flower plant! One flower plant needs 150 cm / 59" of CC1 and 60 cm / 24" of CC2.*

## Needles

4.5 mm / US 7 needle as main needle, 3.5 mm / US 4 for neck, hem and cuff. Adjust needle size if necessary to get gauge.

## Gauge

20 sts x 28 rows = 10 cm / 4", with main needle in stockinette stitch after wet blocking.

## Notions

11 stitch markers, tapestry needle, waste yarn, 10 small hair ties

**CC** = contrast color

**CC at left** = round with CC at left end. See *Roosimine on Page 4*

**CC-to-f** = CC to front, *Roosimine on Page 4*



**inc** = increase


**k** = knit

**k2tog** = knit 2 stitches together (dec 1 st)

**LHN** = left hand needle


**MC** = main color

**m1L** = make one left. With LHN pick up bar between stitches from front to back and knit through the back loop. (inc 1 st)



**m1p** = make one purl. With LHN pick up bar between stitches from front to back and purl through the back loop. (inc 1 st)

**m1R** = make one right. With LHN pick up bar between stitches from back to front and knit through the front loop. (inc 1 st)



**odd** = odd numbered Roosimine round

**p** = purl

**PM** = place marker

**ptbl** = purl through the back loop

**RHN** = right hand needle

**RM** = remove marker

**RS** = right side

**SM** = slip marker

**st; sts** = Stitch; Stitches

**WS** = wrong side

## German short rows

You can find [video list](#) on Ravelry pattern page.

**sl-gsr** = slip 1 stitch purlwise with yarn in front. Bring yarn up, over, and back to pull on the slipped st until it slides around to show two legs. It will look like a double st, but count this as a single st. Work following sts as usual while keeping the tension on the slipped st.

**k-gsr** = knit slipped gsr. K through both legs (through the center of the entire bundle) as if the gsr were a normal single stitch. Work following sts as usual.

**p-gsr** = purl slipped gsr. P through both legs (through the center of the entire bundle) as if the gsr were a normal single stitch. Work following sts as usual.

## Roosimine – Estonian inlay technique

For each flower plant motif, you need:

- 150 cm of CC1 (Chunky Mohair for Leaf)
- 60 cm of CC2 (DK Merion for Flower)


Size 2XS–L have 9 flowers, size XL–4XL has 10 flowers.

You can tie each mohair yarn end loosely with small hair tie, so that they will not get tangled up.

If your CC is not long enough, you can join CC on wrong side (see video [„Roosimine – join CC“](#))

## My Abbreviations for Roosimine:

Each waving stich is shown „CC1-to-f, k x sts, CC1-to-b” in written pattern.

**CC-to-f** = CC to front

**CC-to-b** = CC to back

Written patterns for both rounds with CC at right end & CC at left end are shown as same way, but **Roosimine** is worked differently.

**Roosimine rounds with CC at right end** (see [video “Roosimine rounds with CC at right end”](#)):

*The waving yarn is at the right end of the pattern.*

1. With MC knit to Rooseimine.
2. **CC-to-f** = Bring CC from back to front between needles and let it hang there.
3. **k x sts** = With MC knit x sts. CC yarn is hanging at front of work.
4. **CC-to-b** = Bring CC from front to back between needles and let it hang.
5. With MC knit to next Roosimine. CC yarn is hanging at back of work.

Repeat from 2. to 4.

After you finish all Roosimine for each motif, knit some more sts with MC, then adjust tension of waving yarn (*do not pull too tight!*).

**Roosimine rounds with CC at left end:** (see [video “Roosimine rounds with CC wr left end”](#))


*The waving yarn is at the left end of the pattern.*

1. With MC knit to Rooseimine. Lift CC from back to front over top of LHN (*not between needles!*).
2. **The 1st CC-to-f** = Bring CC from front to back between needles and leave a U-shaped loose loop of CC at front of work.
3. **k x sts** = With MC knit x sts. t of work.
4. **CC-to-b** = Bring U from front to back between needles and let it hang.
5. With MC knit to next Roosimine. U is hanging at back of work.
6. **Next CC-to-f** = Bring U from back to front between needles and let it hang.
7. & 8. Repeat 3. & 4.

After you finish all Roosimine for each motif, knit some more sts with MC, then adjust tension of waving yarn until U-shaped loose loop will disappear (*do not pull too tight!*).

f: sleeve length



j: cuff circumference



## SECTION 1: Neckline Ribbing



With smaller needle, using Long Tail CO, CO 90(90, 90, 90)(90, 90, 94, 94)(94, 98, 98, 98) sts, PM and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist your sts

**Round 1:** (k1, p1) repeat to end, SM.

**Round 2:** (k1, ptbl) repeat to end, SM.

Repeat Round 2 until rib measures 5 cm / 2"

Switch to main needle.

**Next Round:** K to end, SM.

## SECTION 2: Short rows for back



### ✓ Size 2XS-L

**Row 1 (RS):** K10, turn.

**Row 2 (WS):** Sl-gsr, p9, SM, p10, turn.

**Row 3:** Sl-gsr, k9, SM, k9, k-gsr, k4, turn.

**Row 4:** Sl-gsr, p13, SM, p9, p-gsr, p4, turn.

**Row 5:** Sl-gsr, k13, SM, k13, k-gsr, k4, turn.

**Row 6:** Sl-gsr, p17, SM, p13, p-gsr, p4, turn.

**Row 7:** Sl-gsr, k17, SM, k17, k-gsr, k4, turn.

**Row 8:** Sl-gsr, p21, SM, p17, p-gsr, p4, turn.

**Row 9:** Sl-gsr, k21, SM, do not turn.

### ✓ Size XL-3XL

**Row 1 (RS, inc):** K3, m1L, k6, m1L, k1, turn. = 2 sts inc, 96 sts

**Row 2 (WS, inc):** Sl-gsr, p11, SM, p3, m1p, p6, m1p, p1, turn. = 2 sts inc, 98 sts

**Row 3:** Sl-gsr, k11, SM, k11, k-gsr, k4, turn.

**Row 4:** Sl-gsr, p15, SM, p11, p-gsr, p4, turn.

**Row 5 (inc):** Sl-gsr, k15, SM, k15, k-gsr, k1, m1L, k2, turn. = 1 st inc, 99 sts

**Row 6 (inc):** Sl-gsr, p19, SM, p15, p-gsr, p1, m1p, p2, turn. = 1 st inc, 100 sts

**Row 7:** Sl-gsr, k19, SM, k19, k-gsr, k4, turn.

**Row 8:** Sl-gsr, p23, SM, p19, p-gsr, p4, turn.

**Row 9:** Sl-gsr, k23, SM, do not turn.

### ✓ Size 4XL-6XL

**Row 1 (RS, inc):** K4, m1L, k7, turn. = 1 st inc, 99 sts

**Row 2 (WS, inc):** Sl-gsr, p11, SM, p4, m1p, p7, turn. = 1 st inc, 100 sts

**Row 3:** Sl-gsr, k11, SM, k11, k-gsr, k4, turn.

**Row 4:** Sl-gsr, p15, SM, p11, p-gsr, p4, turn.

**Row 5:** Sl-gsr, k15, SM, k15, k-gsr, k4, turn.

**Row 6:** Sl-gsr, p19, SM, p15, p-gsr, p4, turn.


**Row 7:** Sl-gsr, k19, SM, k19, k-gsr, k4, turn.

**Row 8:** Sl-gsr, p23, SM, p19, p-gsr, p4, turn.

**Row 9:** Sl-gsr, k23, SM, do not turn.

## SECTION 3: Increase rounds



### ✓ Size 2XS-L

**Round 1 (RS, inc):** (M1L, k5) 4 times, m1L, k1, k-gsr, k3, (m1L, k5) 8 times, m1L, k3, k-gsr, k1, (m1L, k5) 4 times, SM. = 18 sts inc, 108 sts

**Round 2-4:** K to end, SM.

**Round 5 (inc):** (K3, m1L, k3) repeat to end, SM. = 18 sts inc, 126 sts

**Round 6-8:** K to end, SM.

**Round 9 (inc):** (K7, m1L) repeat to end, SM. = 18 sts inc, 144 sts

**Round 10-12:** K to end, SM.

**Round 13 (inc):** (K4, m1L, k4) repeat to end, SM. = 18 sts inc, 162 sts

**Round 14-16:** K to end, SM.

**Round 17 (inc):** (m1L, k9) repeat to end, SM. = 18 sts inc, 180 sts

**Round 18 (place markers):** (K20, PM) repeat 8 times, k20, SM.

In the next section, you will have one flower in each room between the markers.

**Round 1 (RS, inc):** (M1L, k5) 4 times, m1L, k3, k-gsr, k1, (m1L, k5) 10 times, m1L, k1, k-gsr, k3, (m1L, k5) 4 times, SM. = 20 sts inc, 120 sts

**Round 2-5:** K to end, SM.

**Round 6 (inc):** (K3, m1L, k3) repeat to end, SM. = 20 sts inc, 140 sts

**Round 7-10:** K to end, SM.

**Round 11 (inc):** (K7, m1L) repeat to end, SM. = 20 sts inc, 160 sts

**Round 12-15:** K to end, SM.

**Round 16 (inc):** (K4, m1L, k4) repeat to end, SM. = 20 sts inc, 180 sts

**Round 17-20:** K to end, SM.

**Round 21 (inc):** (m1L, k9) repeat to end, SM. = 20 sts inc, 200 sts

**Round 22:** K to end, SM



**Round 2–6:** K to end, SM.

**Round 7 (inc):** (K3, m1L, k3) repeat to end, SM. = 20 sts inc, 140 sts

**Round 8–12:** K to end, SM.

**Round 13 (inc):** (K7, m1L) repeat to end, SM. = 20 sts inc, 160 sts

**Round 14–18:** K to end, SM.

**Round 19 (inc):** (K4, m1L, k4) repeat to end, SM. = 20 sts inc, 180 sts

**Round 20–24:** K to end, SM.

**Round 25 (inc):** (m1L, k9) repeat to end, SM. = 20 sts inc, 200 sts

**Round 26–27:** K to end, SM

**Round 28 (place markers & reposition EOR):** K10, PM, (k20, PM) 9 times, k10, RM( = previous EOR), k10, SM (= new EOR).



= 22 sts between markers, 2 sts inc

**Round 5:** [K6, (CC1-to-f, k3, CC1-to-b, k3) twice, k4, SM] repeat to end.

**Round 6 (CC at left):** [K5, (CC1-to-f, k3, CC1-to-b, k3) twice, k5, SM] repeat to end.

**Round 7:** [K4, (CC1-to-f, k3, CC1-to-b, k3) twice, (CC2-to-f, k1, CC2-to-b, k1) twice, k2, SM] repeat to end.

**Round 8 (CC at left, inc):** [k3, (CC1-to-f, k3, CC1-to-b, k3) twice, (CC2-to-f, k1, CC2-to-b, k1) 3 times, k1, m1L, SM] repeat to end.  
= 23 sts between markers, 1 st inc

**Round 9:** [K2, (CC1-to-f, k2, CC1-to-b, k4) twice, (CC2-to-f, k1, CC2-to-b, k1) 4 times, k1, SM] repeat to end.

**Round 10 (CC at left):** [(CC1-to-f, k3, CC1-to-b, k3) twice, k3, (CC2-to-f, k1, CC2-to-b, k1) 3 times, k2, SM] repeat to end.

**Round 11:** Repeat Round 9.

**Round 12 (CC at left):** [K3, (CC1-to-f, k3, CC1-to-b, k3) twice, (CC2-to-f, k1, CC2-to-b, k1) 3 times, k2, SM] repeat to end.

**Round 13:** [K4, (CC1-to-f, k3, CC1-to-b, k3) twice, (CC2-to-f, k1, CC2-to-b, k1) twice, k3, SM] repeat to end.

**Round 14 (CC at left):** [K5, (CC1-to-f, k3, CC1-to-b, k3) twice, k6, SM] repeat to end.

**Round 15:** [K6, (CC1-to-f, k3, CC1-to-b, k3) twice, k5, SM] repeat to end.

**Round 16 (CC at left):** Repeat Round 15.

**Round 17:** [K7, (CC1-to-f, k2, CC1-to-b, k4) twice, k4, SM] repeat to end.

**Round 18 (CC at left):** Repeat Round 17.

**Round 19:** [K7, (CC1-to-f, k1, CC1-to-b, k5) twice, k4, SM] repeat to end.

**Round 20 (inc):** [K11, m1L, k12, SM] repeat to end. = 24 sts between markers, 1 st inc

**Round 21–24:** K to end, SM. = 4 rows RM between flowers except EOR.





**Set-Up Round** (*Place markers*): k34(35, 36, 37)(38, 39, 30, 31)(32, 32, 33, 33), PM, k1, PM, k38(36, 34, 32)(30, 28, 34, 32)(30, 30, 36, 36), PM, k1, PM, k68(70, 72, 74)(76, 78, 84, 86)(88, 88, 92, 92), PM, k1, PM, k38(36, 34, 32)(30, 28, 34, 32)(30, 30, 36, 36), PM, k1, PM, k34(35, 36, 37)(38, 39, 54, 55)(56, 56, 59, 59), SM (= EOR).

**Round 1 (inc):** (K to marker, m1R, SM, k1, SM, m1L) 4 times, k to marker, SM.  
= 8 sts inc, 224(224, 224, 224)(224, 224, 248, 248)(248, 248, 268, 268) sts

**Round 2:** K to end, SM.

Repeat Rounds 1–2, 4(6, 8, 10)(12, 14, 15, 17)(20, 24, 26, 29) more times. = 256(272, 288, 304)(320, 336, 368, 384)(408, 440, 476, 500) sts


Repeat Round 1, once more. = 264(280, 296, 312)(328, 344, 376, 392)(416, 448, 484, 508) sts



## SECTION 6: Separate body and sleeves

K to marker, \*RM, bring the yarn to front of work, slip the next stitch purlwise, then return the yarn to the back, slip the stitch on RHN back to LHN, place 52(54, 56, 58)(60, 62, 70, 72)(76, 84, 94, 100) sts from LHN on waste yarn and remove 3 markers, turn work, CO 3(3, 3, 3)(3, 3, 3, 4)(4, 4, 4, 5) sts using Cable CO method, PM for new EOR, CO 4(4, 4, 4)(4, 4, 4, 5)(5, 5, 5, 6) sts, turn work, sl 1 st from LHN to RHN, pass the last CO st over slipped st to close the hole, pull the working yarn (= 6(6, 6, 6)(6, 6, 6, 8)(8, 8, 8, 10) CO sts remain), k to marker\*, repeat from \* to \* except PM between CO sts, RM (= previous EOR), k to marker (= new EOR). = 172(184, 196, 208)(220, 232, 248, 264)(280, 296, 312, 328) sts

## SECTION 7: Lower body



Knit in rounds in Stockinette stitch until piece measures 21(19, 19, 19)(18, 19, 20, 22)(23, 22, 24, 25) cm / 8¼ (7½, 7½, 7¼)(7, 7¼, 8, 8½)(9, 8¾, 9¼, 10)“ from dividing round,

or 9 cm / 3½” shorter than your favorite body length.

## 1x1 Hem Ribbing:

Switch to smaller needle.

Round 1–2: Knit to end, SM.

**Round 3:** (K1, ptbl) repeat to end, SM.

Repeat Round 3 until rib measures 8 cm.

With traditional method (or stretchy bind off method), BO all sts loosely (*knitted sts knitwise, purled sts purlwise*).

## SECTION 8: Sleeves




With larger needle and Magic Loop Method or set of DPNs, Move held sleeve sts onto main needle.

Beginning at center of underarm, pick up 4(4, 4, 4)(4, 4, 4, 5)(5, 5, 5, 6) sts from half of underarm CO, k52(54, 56, 58)(60, 62, 70, 72)(76, 84, 94, 100) sleeve stitches, then pick up 4(4, 4, 4)(4, 4, 4, 5)(5, 5, 5, 6) sts from remaining underarm, PM (EOR), join for working in the round. = 60(62, 64, 66)(68, 70, 78, 82)(86, 94, 104, 112) sts

Knit in rounds in Stockinette stitch until sleeve measures 28(27, 27, 26)(26, 26, 25, 23)(21, 19, 20, 20) cm / 11(10½, 10½, 10¼)(10¼, 10¼, 9¾, 9)(8¼, 7½, 8, 8)“ from underarm CO,

or 15 cm / 6” shorter than your favorite sleeve length.

## 1 x 1 Cuff Ribbing:

*Switch to smaller needle.*

**Round 1–2:** Knit to end, SM.

**Round 3 (dec):** K8(7, 6, 7)(8, 9, 7, 7)(7, 5, 2, 0), (k2tog) repeat 22(24, 26, 26)(26, 26, 32, 34)(36, 42, 50, 56) times, k8(7, 6, 7)(8, 9, 7, 7)(7, 5, 2, 0), SM. = 38(38, 38, 40)(42, 44, 46, 48)(50, 52, 54, 56) sts

**Round 4:** (K1, ptbl) repeat to end, SM.

Repeat Round 4 until rib measures 15 cm / 6”.

With traditional method (or stretchy BO method), BO all sts loosely (*knitted sts knitwise, purled sts purlwise*).

## FINISHING:

Weave in all ends and block fabric.
