st(s) // stitch(es)

r // row

rnd(s) // round(s)

BOR // beginning of round

k // knit

p // purl

k tbl // knit through back loop

p tbl // purl through back loop

sl st // slip st

s1wyif // slip 1 st with yarn held in front

pssso // pass the slipped st over

k2tog // knit 2 sts together

k2tog tbl // knit 2 sts together through the back loop

p2tog // purl 2 sts together

p2tog tbl // purl 2 sts together through the back loop

dec // decrease

inc // increase

yo // yarn over

m1L // make 1 left inc, knitwise

m1R // make 1 right inc, knitwise

m1P // make 1 left inc, purlwise

M // marker

cM // chart marker

Mini Augustins no. 5

Size: 110 cm in diameter.

Gauge: 18 sts x 22 rows = 10 x 10 cm in Stockinette Stitch at needle size 5 mm.

Needle size: Double pointed needles 5 mm + circular needles 5 mm,
(the lengths 40, 60 og 80 cm are recommended).

Yarn: 2 strands of “Cashmere Classic”, Cardiff Cashmere (112 m per 25 g).

Yarn alternative: 1 strand of “Heavy merino”, Knitting for Olive (125 m per 50g).

Amount: A total of 400g of “Cashmere Classic”, *or* 350g of “Heavy merino”.

Process: The blanket is knitted in the round, center-out, using charts and written instructions to create the laced pattern. To finish its edge, a laced border is knitted orthogonally onto the blanket.

Pattern

Before you begin

- Please read the entire pattern before casting on.
- Be sure to make a swatch before beginning, to ensure the right gauge.

Blanket

At double pointed needles, cast on 9 sts.
Place an M between the first and last st = BOR.

Section 1

- K 1 rnd.
- Knit *yo, k 1*. Repeat *-* throughout the rnd (= 18 sts).

Section 2

- Knit 3 rnds of twisted ribbing, *p 1, k 1 tbl*.
- Knit *yo, p 1, yo, k 1 tbl*. Repeat *-* throughout the rnd (= 36 m).

Section 3

- K 1 rnd.
- P 1 rnd.
- Knit *yo, k2tog*. Repeat *-* throughout the rnd.
- P 1 rnd.
- K 2 rnds.
- Knit *yo, k 1*. Repeat *-* throughout the rnd (= 72 m).

Section 4

- Knit the 2 following rnds in a total of 5 times (= 10 rnds) :
 - Rnd 1: *p 1, k 1 tbl, k 1, k 1 tbl, k 1, k 1 tbl*. Repeat *-* throughout the rnd.
 - Rnd 2: *p 1, k2tog, yo, k 1 tbl, yo, k2tog tbl*. Repeat *-* throughout the rnd.
- Knit *p 1, k 1 tbl, k 1, k 1 tbl, k 1, k 1 tbl*. Repeat *-* throughout the rnd.
- Knit *p 1, yo, k 1, yo*. Repeat *-* throughout the rnd (= 144 m).

Section 5

- Knit *p 1, k 11*. Repeat *-* throughout the rnd.
- Knit 'Chart 1'.
- Knit *yo, k 1*. Repeat *-* throughout the rnd (= 288 m).

Section 6

- K 1 rnd.
- P 1 rnd.
- Knit *k2tog tbl, yo*. Repeat *-* throughout the rnd.
- Knit 3 rnds of twisted ribbing, *k 1 tbl, p 1*.
- Knit 'Chart 2'.

Break the yarn and keep the sts on the needle.

Laced border

The laced border is knitted back and forth orthogonally onto the blanket - this is done by knitting 1 st from the blanket + 1 st from the border together on every RS row.

First the border sts must be established - this is done in the following way:

At the right side needle from the RS of the blanket, cast on 23 sts.

Knit the 23 sts in the following way (WS): p 1, k 1, p 3, k 1, p 9, k 8.

The 23 sts are now at the left side needle and lay in continuation of the blanket sts.

Knit the next row (RS) in the following way: p 1 (edge st), k 6, p 1, k 9, p 1, k 3, p 1, k2tog (1 st from the border + 1 st from the blanket).

The laced border is now established and the following 8 rows must be repeated until there are none of the 288 blanket sts left. Finish after the 7th row and bind off all remaining sts.

Border

- 1. p (WS): s1wyif, k 1, p 3, k 1, p 9, k 2, *yo, k2tog* - repeat *-* 2 times in total, yo, k 2.
- 2. p (RS): p 1, k 7, p 1, k3tog, *yo, k 1* - repeat *-* 3 times in total, yo, k3tog tbl, p 1, slip the 3rd st from the left over the 2 sts to the right from it, k 1, yo, k 1, p 1, k 2 tbl (1 border st + 1 blanket st).
- 3. p (WS): s1wyif, k 1, p 3, k 1, p 9, k 3, *yo, k2tog* - repeat *-* 2 times in total, yo, k 2.
- 4. p (RS): p 1, k 8, p 1, k 9, p 1, k 3, p 1, k 2 tbl (1 border st + 1 blanket st).
- 5. p (WS): s1wyif, k 1, p 3, k 1, p 9, k 4, *yo, k2tog* - repeat *-* 2 times in total, yo, k 2.
- 6. p (RS): p 1, k 9, p 1, k3tog, *yo, k 1* - repeat *-* 3 times in total, yo, k3tog tbl, p 1, slip the 3rd st from the left over the 2 sts to the right from it, k 1, yo, k 1, p 1, k 2 tbl (1 border st + 1 blanket st).
- 7. p (WS): s1wyif, k 1, p 3, k 1, p 9, k 5, *yo, k2tog* - repeat *-* 2 times in total, yo, k 2.
- 8. p (RS): bind off 4 sts, k 6, p 1, k 9, p 1, k 3, p 1, k 2 tbl (1 border st + 1 blanket st).

Finishing

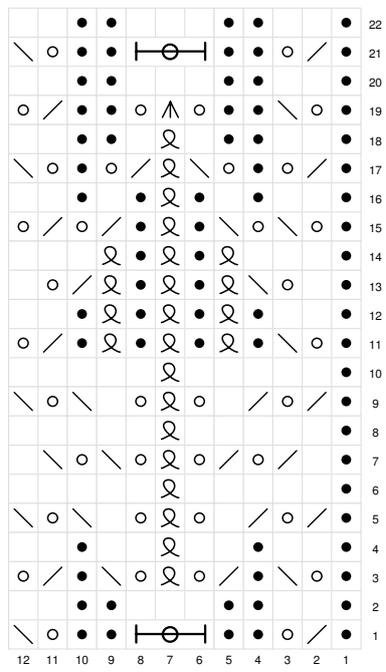
Weave in all ends and sew the 2 ends of the laced border together from the WS.

Rinse the blanket by hand in luke warm water and let it dry laying flat.

Symbols

	k.
	p.
	k2tog tbl.
	k 2 tog.
	slip 1 st knitwise, k2tog, pass the slipped st over.
	yo.
	k tbl.
	Slip the 3rd st over the 2 sts to the right from it, k 1, yo, k 1.
	Slip the 3rd st over the 2 sts to the right from it, k 1, yo, slip 1 st knitwise, place the slipped st back onto the left-side needle, k2tog, tbl, k 1.
	k 1, slip 1 st purlwise, slip the 4th st over the 2 sts to the right from it, place the slipped st back onto the left-side needle, k2tog, yo, k 1.
