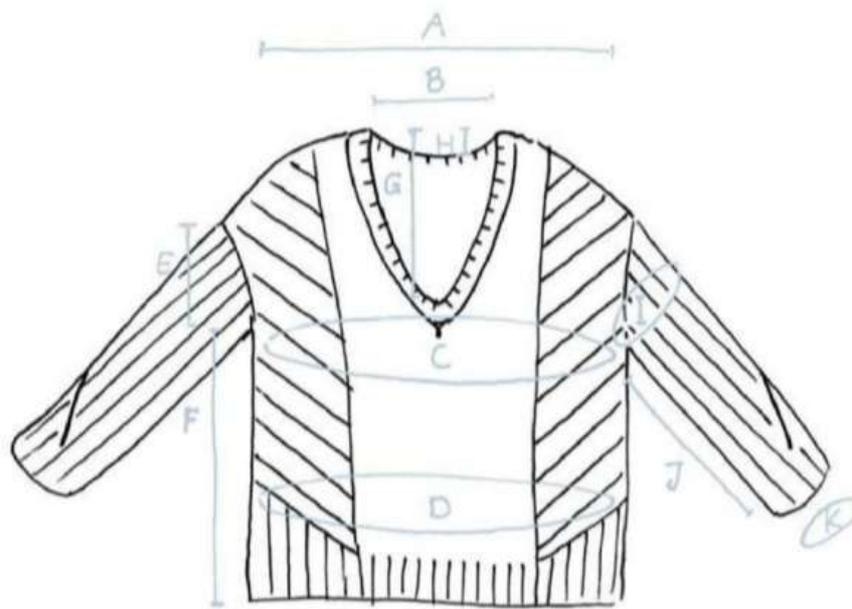

A Shoulder width: 66.5 (70.5, 74, 78, 82, 86) cm / 26.25 (27.75, 29.25, 30.75, 32.25, 33.75)"

B Back neck width: 22 (22, 22.5, 23.5, 23.5, 24.5) cm / 8.5 (8.5, 9, 9.25, 9.25, 9.75)"

C Bust circumference: 113 (123, 133, 144, 154, 164) cm / 44.5 (48.5, 52.5, 56.5, 60.5, 64.5)"

D Hip circumference: 113 (123, 133, 144, 154, 164) cm / 44.5 (48.5, 52.5, 56.5, 60.5, 64.5)"

E Armhole depth: 14 (16, 16.5, 18.5, 20.5, 21.5) cm / 5.5 (6.25, 6.5, 7.25, 8, 8.5)"

Pattern Info

Sizes

1 (2, 3, 4, 5, 6)

Finished bust circumference: 113 (123, 133, 144, 154, 164) cm / 44.5 (48.5, 52.5, 56.5, 60.5, 64.5)" - recommended to be worn with 25.5 cm / 10" of positive ease at the bust.

Yarn

Cambrian Mountains Wool Double Knitting (100% wool; 100 metres / 109 yards per 50g)

1147 (1248, 1366, 1469, 1587, 1671) metres / 1255 (1365, 1494, 1606, 1736, 1827) yards

Sample shown is knit in colourway Cegin. Caro wears a size 2 with 26 cm / 10" of positive ease.

Needles

3.5 mm / US 4 circular needle with a cable length of at least 100 cm / 40" (or needle size to obtain gauge)

3.25 mm / US 3 circular needle with a cable length of at least 100 cm / 40" (or needle one size smaller than size to obtain gauge)

Gauge

21 sts x 32 rows = 10 x 10 cm / 4" x 4" (knit flat, in stockinette st, on 3.5 mm / US 4 needle, after blocking)

25 sts x 32 rows = 10 x 10 cm / 4" x 4" (knit flat, in k2, p2 ribbing, on 3.5 mm / US 4 needle, after blocking)

24 sts x 32 rows = 10 x 10 cm / 4" x 4" (knit flat, in Chart A lace pattern, on 3.5 mm / US 4 needle, after blocking)

31 st Chart A lace panel measures 13 cm / 5.125" wide, after blocking

Directions

BACK

For best results, use the Tubular Cast-On. If you wish to work a Longtail Cast-On, with the larger needle, CO 142 (154, 166, 178, 190, 202) sts and begin ribbing as instructed for Row 1 in Hem Ribbing section. Do not join in the round.

If working Tubular Cast-On: With smaller needle, CO 142 (154, 166, 178, 190, 202) sts using your preferred Tubular Cast-On. Do not join in the round.

Work 4 tubular rows as for 1x1 ribbing.

Before working the next row, rearrange your sts for hem ribbing as follows: Sl1, *sl1 to CN and hold in back, sl1 from left needle, sl1 from CN, sl2* to last st, sl1

Next Row (RS): *K2, sl2 wyif* to last 2 sts, k2

Next Row (WS): *Sl2 wyif, k2* to last 2 sts, sl2 wyif

Hem

Switch to larger needle. Note that from this point, the first and last st of each row are selvedge sts that will be worked in garter st for the rest of the body (k every row).

Row 1 (RS): *K2, p2* to last 2 sts, k2

Row 2 (WS): K1, p1, *k2, p2* to last 4 sts, k2, p1, k1

Work even as est until hem meas 6.5 cm / 2.5" from the cast-on edge.

Begin Chart A

Size 1 only

Row 1 (RS): K1, pm, work Row 1 of Chart A-Right over next 31 sts, pm, (k3, k2tog) x 15, k3, pm, work Row 1 of Chart A-Left over next 31 sts, pm, k1 [127 sts]

Size 2 only

Row 1 (RS): K1, pm, work Row 1 of Chart A-Right over next 31 sts, pm, k4, k2tog, (k3, k2tog) x 16, k4, pm, work Row 1 of Chart A-Left over next 31 sts, pm, k1 [137 sts]

Size 3 only

Row 1 (RS): K1, pm, work Row 1 of Chart A-Right over next 31 sts, pm, k5, k2tog, (k3, k2tog) x 18, k5, pm, work Row 1 of Chart A-Left over next 31 sts, pm, k1 [147 sts]

Size 4 only

Row 1 (RS): K1, pm, work Row 1 of Chart A-Right over next 31 sts, pm, k6, k2tog, (k3, k2tog, k4, k2tog) x 9, k7, pm, work Row 1 of Chart A-Left over next 31 sts, pm, k1 [159 sts]

Size 5 only

Row 1 (RS): K1, pm, work Row 1 of Chart A-Right over next 31 sts, pm, k7, k2tog, (k3, k2tog, k4, k2tog) x 10, k7, pm, work Row 1 of Chart A-Left over next 31 sts, pm, k1 [169 sts]

Size 6 only

Row 1 (RS): K1, pm, work Row 1 of Chart A-Right over next 31 sts, pm, k7, k2tog, (k3, k2tog, k4, k2tog) x 11, k8, pm, work Row 1 of Chart A-Left over next 31 sts, pm, k1 [179 sts]

All sizes

You now have 127 (137, 147, 159, 169, 179) sts on your needle.

Row 2 (WS): K1, sm, work Row 2 of Chart A-Left to marker, sm, p to marker, sm, work Row 2 of Chart A-Right to marker, sm, k1

Row 3 (RS): K1, sm, work Row 3 of Chart A-Right to marker, sm, k to marker, sm, work Row 3 of Chart A-Left to marker, sm, k1

Work even as est through Row 54 of Chart A-Right and Chart A-Left, ending after a WS row.

Begin Chart B

Row 1 (RS): K1, sm, work Row 1 of Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k to marker, sm, work Row 1 of Chart B-Left to marker, sm, k1

Row 2 (WS): K1, sm, work Row 2 of Chart B-Left to marker, sm, p to marker, sm, work Row 2 of Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k1

Work even as est, rep Rows 1-6 of Chart B-Right and Chart B-Left, until back meas 42 (40.5, 40, 38.5, 38, 37) cm / 16.5 (16, 15.75, 15.25, 15, 14.5)" from hem, ending after a WS row.

Back yoke shaping

Yoke Increase Row (RS): K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, Inv-L, k to last st before marker, Inv-R, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, sm, k1 [129 (139, 149, 161, 171, 181) sts]

Next Row (WS): K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, sm, p to marker, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k1

Cont in patt as est, rep Yoke Increase Row every 14th row another 0 (0, 0, 0, 0, 3) times, then every 12th row another 0 (0, 0, 0, 4, 0) times, then every 10th row another 0 (0, 0, 2, 0, 0) times, then every 8th row another 0 (0, 0, 3, 0, 0) times, then every 6th row another 0 (3, 6, 0, 0, 0) times, then every 4th row another 9 (5, 1, 0, 0, 0) times.

Upon completion of this section, you will have worked the Yoke Increase Row a total of 10 (9, 8, 6, 5, 4) times. [147 (155, 163, 171, 179, 187) sts]

Work even as est until back meas 55 (56, 56.5, 57, 58.5, 58.5) cm / 21.75 (22, 22.25, 22.5, 23, 23)" from hem, ending after a WS row.

Back shoulder & neckline shaping

Note that shoulder and neckline shaping are worked AT THE SAME TIME; shoulder shaping begins first, and continues through neckline shaping. For best results, use the Sloped Bind-Off method. Remove markers as needed to work bind offs. Bind off sts in patt; where sts to be bound off occur in lace panels, bind off as for knit sts. Take care when working across charted lace panels during bind-offs that you do not work more yarn-overs than there are decreases in the remaining charted sts - on some rows, you may need to omit the first yo of Chart B-Right and the last yo of Chart B-Left in order to maintain the correct stitch count.

Row 1 (RS): BO 7 (7, 8, 8, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1 [140 (148, 155, 163, 171, 178) sts]

Row 2 (WS): BO 7 (7, 8, 8, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to end [133 (141, 147, 155, 163, 169) sts]

Row 3: BO 6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to end [127 (134, 140, 147, 155, 160) sts]

Row 4: BO 6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to end [121 (127, 133, 139, 147, 151) sts]

Row 5: BO 7 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to end [114 (120, 126, 131, 139, 142) sts]

Row 6: BO 7 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to end [107 (113, 119, 123, 131, 133) sts]

Row 7: BO 6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 8) sts, work in patt as est to end [101 (106, 112, 115, 123, 125) sts]

Row 8: BO 6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 8) sts, work in patt as est to end [95 (99, 105, 107, 115, 117) sts]

Using a removable marker, locate and mark the centre st of your work.

Row 9 (RS): BO 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 9) sts, work in patt as est to 7 (7, 8, 8, 8, 8) sts before marked centre stitch, BO centre 15 (15, 17, 17, 17, 17) sts, work in patt as est to end [73 (77, 80, 82, 89, 91) sts]

From this point forward, the left and right shoulders are worked separately. With RS facing, slip the first 33 (35, 36, 37, 40, 41) sts from your needle onto a stitch holder or waste yarn; these sts will be worked later for the back right shoulder shaping section. [40 (42, 44, 45, 49, 50) sts]

Back left shoulder shaping

Row 10 (WS): BO 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 9) sts, work in patt as est to end [33 (35, 36, 37, 40, 41) sts]

Row 11 (RS): BO 7 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to end [26 (28, 29, 29, 32, 32) sts]

Row 12: BO 6 (7, 7, 7, 8, 8) sts, work in patt as est to end [20 (21, 22, 22, 24, 24) sts]

Row 13: BO 5 sts, work in patt as est to end [15 (16, 17, 17, 19, 19) sts]

Row 14: BO 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 9) sts, work in patt as est to end [8 (9, 9, 9, 10, 10) sts]

Row 15: BO 2 sts, work in patt as est to end [6 (7, 7, 7, 8, 8) sts]

Row 16: BO all rem sts

Back right shoulder shaping

Slip 33 (35, 36, 37, 40, 41) held sts back onto needles and rejoin working yarn, ready to work a WS row.

Row 10 (WS): BO 7 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to end [26 (28, 29, 29, 32, 32) sts]

Row 11 (RS): BO 6 (7, 7, 7, 8, 8) sts, work in patt as est to end [20 (21, 22, 22, 24, 24) sts]

Row 12: BO 5 sts, work in patt as est to end [15 (16, 17, 17, 19, 19) sts]

Row 13: BO 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 9) sts, work in patt as est to end [8 (9, 9, 9, 10, 10) sts]

Row 14: BO 2 sts, work in patt as est to end [6 (7, 7, 7, 8, 8) sts]

Row 15: BO all rem sts

FRONT

Work as for back, until front measures 32.5 (33, 32.5, 33, 33, 32.5) cm / 12.75 (13, 12.75, 13, 13, 12.75)" from hem, ending after a WS row.

Front neckline & yoke shaping

Note that neckline and yoke shaping are worked AT THE SAME TIME; neckline shaping begins first, and continues through yoke shaping. Please read the following section through to the end before proceeding.

Row 1 (RS): K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k30 (35, 40, 46, 51, 56), k2tog, pm, yo, k to next marker, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, sm, k1

Row 2 (WS): K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, sm, p to marker, sm, p to marker, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k1

Row 3: K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, yo, sm, k1, yo, ssk, k to next marker, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, sm, k1

Row 4: Rep Row 2

Row 5: K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k to 3 sts before marker, k2tog, yo, k1, sm, k2, yo, ssk, k to next marker, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, sm, k1

Row 6: Rep Row 2

Row 7: K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k to 4 sts before marker, k2tog, yo, k2, remove marker, Inv-R, placing new marker between the new st and the slipped st, k2, yo, ssk, k to next marker, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, sm, k1 [128 (138, 148, 160, 170, 180) sts]

Row 8: Rep Row 2

From this point on, work cont concurrently on right and left shoulders, working from two balls of yarn simultaneously.

Neckline Dec Row (RS): K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k to 6 sts before marker, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k2. Remove marker, and place a locking stitch marker in the row below between the stitch just worked and the next st on your left needle. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, k2, ssk, yo, ssk, k to next marker, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, sm, k1 [126 (136, 146, 158, 168, 178) sts]

Next Row (WS): K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, sm, p to last st before centre of work, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, k1, p to marker, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k1

Cont as est, repeating Neckline Decrease Row every RS row another 12 (16, 16, 17, 18) times.

Neckline Eyelet Row (RS): K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k to 4 sts before marker, yo, k2tog, k2. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, k2, ssk, yo, k to next marker, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, sm, k1

Next Row (WS): K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, sm, p to last st before centre of work, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, k1, p to marker, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k1

Next Row: Rep Neckline Decrease Row

Next Row: K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, sm, p to last st before centre of work, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, k1, p to marker, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k1

Cont, alternating the Neckline Eyelet Row with the Neckline Decrease Row every other RS row, another 8 (4, 5, 6, 5, 5) times, then work the Neckline Eyelet Row every RS row for the remainder of the front.

AT THE SAME TIME, begin yoke shaping when front meas 42 (40.5, 40, 38.5, 38, 37) cm / 16.5 (16, 15.75, 15.25, 15, 14.5)" from hem, ending after a WS row.

Front yoke shaping

Yoke Increase Row (RS): K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, Inv-L, work as est for neck line. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work as est for neckline to last st before first marker, Inv-R, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, k1 [2 sts incl]

Next Row (WS): K1, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Left to marker, sm, p to last st before centre of work, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, k1, p to marker, sm, work in patt as est using Chart B-Right to marker, sm, k1

Cont in patt as est, repeating Yoke Increase Row every 14th row another 0 (0, 0, 0, 0, 3) times, then every 12th row another 0 (0, 0, 0, 4, 0) times, then every 10th row another 0 (0, 0, 2, 0, 0) times, then every 8th row another 0 (0, 0, 3, 0, 0) times, then every 6th row another 0 (3, 6, 0, 0, 0) times, then every 4th row another 9 (5, 1, 0, 0, 0) times.

Upon completion of this section, you will have worked the Neckline Decrease Row a total of 22 (22, 23, 24, 24, 25) times, and the Yoke Increase Row a total of 10 (9, 8, 6, 5, 4) times. [104 (112, 118, 124, 132, 138) sts]

Work even as est until front meas 55 (56, 56.5, 57, 58.5, 58.5) cm / 21.75 (22, 22.25, 22.5, 23, 23)" from hem, ending after a WS row.

Front shoulder shaping

For best results, use the Sloped Bind-Off method. Remove markers as needed to work bind offs. Bind off sts in pattern; where sts to be bound off occur in lace panels, bind off as for knit sts. Take care when working across charted lace panels during bind-offs that you do not work more yarn-overs than there are decreases in the remaining charted sts - on some rows, you may need to omit the first yo of Chart B-Right and the last yo of Chart B-Left in order to maintain the correct stitch count.

Row 1 (RS): BO 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 9) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [97 (105, 110, 116, 123, 129) sts]

Row 2 (WS): BO 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 9) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [90 (98, 102, 108, 114, 120) sts]

Row 3: BO 6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [84 (91, 95, 100, 106, 111) sts]

Row 4: BO 6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [78 (84, 88, 92, 98, 102) sts]

Row 5: BO 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 8) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [71 (77, 80, 84, 89, 94) sts]

- Row 6: BO 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 8) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [64 (70, 72, 76, 80, 86) sts]
- Row 7: BO 6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [58 (63, 65, 68, 72, 77) sts]
- Row 8: BO 6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [52 (56, 58, 60, 64, 68) sts]
- Row 9: BO 7 (7, 8, 8, 8, 8) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [45 (49, 50, 52, 56, 60) sts]
- Row 10: BO 7 (7, 8, 8, 8, 8) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [38 (42, 44, 48, 52) sts]
- Row 11: BO 6 (7, 7, 7, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [32 (35, 35, 37, 40, 43) sts]
- Row 12: BO 6 (7, 7, 7, 8, 9) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [26 (28, 28, 30, 32, 34) sts]
- Row 13: BO 7 (7, 7, 8, 8, 8) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [19 (21, 21, 22, 24, 26) sts]
- Row 14: BO 7 (7, 7, 8, 8, 8) sts, work in patt as est to last st, k1. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [12 (14, 14, 14, 16, 18) sts]
- Row 15: BO all rem sts on first side. On second side, with separate ball of yarn, work in patt as est to end [6 (7, 7, 7, 8, 9) sts]
- Row 16: BO all rem sts

LEFT SLEEVE

Cuff

For best results, use the Tubular Cast-On. If you wish to work a Longtail Cast-On, with the larger needle, CO 46 (50, 50, 54, 58, 62) sts and begin ribbing as instructed for Row 1. Do not join in the round.

If working Tubular Cast-On: With smaller needle, CO 46 (50, 50, 54, 58, 62) sts using your preferred Tubular Cast-On. Do not join in the round.

Work 4 tubular rows as for 1x1 ribbing.

Before working the next row, rearrange your sts for cuff ribbing as follows: sl1, *sl1 to CN and hold in back, sl1 from left needle, sl1 from CN, sl2* to last st, sl1

Next Row (RS): *K2, sl2 wyif* to last 2 sts, k2

Next Row (WS): *Sl2 wyif, k2* to last 2 sts, sl2 wyif

Switch to larger needle. Note that from this point, the first and last st of each row are selvedge sts that will be worked in garter st for the rest of the sleeve (k every row).

Row 1 (RS): *K2, p2* to last 2 sts, k2

Row 2 (WS): K1, p1, *k2, p2* to last 4 sts, k2, p1, k1

Work even as est until sleeve measures 6.5 cm / 2.5" from the cast on edge.

Begin Chart C pattern & sleeve shaping

Note that chart pattern and sleeve shaping are worked AT THE SAME TIME; chart pattern begins first, and cont through sleeve shaping.

Row 1 (RS): (K2, p2) x 3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5), pm, work Row 1 of Chart C-Right over next 22 sts, pm, (p2, k2) x 3 (4, 4, 4, 5, 5)

Row 2 (WS): K1, p1, (k2, p2) x 2 (3, 3, 3, 4, 4), k2, sm, work Row 2 of Chart-C Right to marker, sm, (k2, p2) x 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 4), k2, p1, k1

Work even as est for another 2 rows.

Sleeve Increase Row (RS): K1, Inv-L, cont in patt as est to last 2 sts, Inv-R, k1 [48 (52, 52, 56, 60, 64) sts]

Note: Work sleeve increases in patt; if new sts should be purl sts to cont ribbing, use Inv-LP/Inv-RP increases instead of Inv-L/Inv-R.

Cont in patt as est, repeating Sleeve Increase Row every 6th row another 11 (6, 3, 0, 0, 0) times, then every 4th row another 0 (7, 14, 19, 17, 16) times, then every RS row another 0 (0, 0, 0, 4, 5) times.

Upon completion of this section, you will have worked the Sleeve Increase Row a total of 12 (14, 18, 20, 22, 22) times. [70 (78, 86, 94, 102, 106) sts]

Work even as est ending after row 54 of the chart and cont in k2,p2 ribbing until sleeve meas 39.5 (40, 40.5, 40.5, 40.5, 40) cm / 15.5 (15.75, 16, 16, 16, 15.75)" from cast-on edge, ending after a WS row.

Bind off all sts in patt.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Work as for left sleeve to end of cuff section.

Begin Chart C pattern & sleeve shaping

Note that chart pattern and sleeve shaping are worked AT THE SAME TIME; chart pattern begins first, and cont through sleeve shaping.

Row 1 (RS): (K2, p2) x 3 (4, 4, 4, 5, 5), pm, work Row 1 of Chart C-Left over next 22 sts, pm, (p2, k2) x 3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5)

Row 2 (WS): K1, p1, (k2, p2) x 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 4), k2, sm, work Row 2 of Chart-C Left to marker, sm, (k2, p2) x 2 (3, 3, 3, 4, 4), k2, p1, k1

Work even as est for another 2 rows.

Work sleeve shaping as instructed for left sleeve. [70 (78, 86, 94, 102, 106) sts]

Work even as est ending after row 54 of the chart and cont in k2,p2 ribbing until sleeve meas 39.5 (40, 40.5, 40.5, 40.5, 40) cm / 15.5 (15.75, 16, 16, 16, 15.75)" from cast-on edge, ending after a WS row.

Bind off all sts in patt.

FINISHING

Gently soak and block all pieces of your pullover to schematic measurements using T-pins and blocking wires, if desired. Weave in all ends.

SEAMING

Mark the base of the armhole using locking stitch markers at each side of both front and back pieces, measuring 14 (16, 16.5, 18.5, 20.5, 21.5) cm / 5.5 (6.25, 6.5, 7.25, 8, 8.5)" down from the beginning of the shoulder bind-offs. Sew front to back at shoulder seams using mattress stitch, taking care to match up edges of front and back neckline and lace panels. Sew sleeves to body, matching up outer edges of sleeve cap (excluding selvedge stitches) to armhole markers, and taking care to place left and right sleeves to their respective sides of the body. Sew sleeves and side seams using mattress stitch. Weave in all ends.

NECKLINE

Beginning at right shoulder seam, with RS facing and using smaller needle pick up and k 54 (54, 58, 58, 62, 62) sts across back neckline, pick up and k 68 (70, 72, 74, 76, 78) sts along left front neckline, pick up one stitch into centre stitch at base of V-neck, pick up and k 68 (70, 72, 74, 76, 78) sts along right front neckline, place marker to indicate BOR and join for working in the round. [191 (195, 203, 207, 215, 219) sts]

Sizes 1, 3 & 5 only

Round 1: (K2, p2) x 30 (-, 32, -, 34, -), pm, k5, pm, (p2, k2) x 16 (-, 17, -, 18, -), p2

Round 2: *K2, p2* to marker, sm, k1, s2kp, k1, sm, *p2, k2* to last 2 sts, p2 [189 (-, 201, -, 213, -) sts]

Round 3: *K2, p2* to marker, sm, k3, sm, *p2, k2* to last 2 sts, p2

Round 4: *K2, p2* to marker, sm, s2kp, sm, *p2, k2* to last 2 sts, p2 [187 (-, 199, -, 211, -) sts]

Sizes 2, 4 & 6 only

Round 1: (P2, k2) x - (30, -, 32, -, 34), p2, pm, k5, pm, *p2, k2* to end of round

Round 2: *P2, k2* to 2 sts before marker, p2, sm, k1, s2kp, k1, sm, *p2, k2* to end of round [- (193, -, 205, -, 217) sts]

Round 3: *P2, k2* to 2 sts before marker, p2, sm, k3, sm, *p2, k2* to end of round

Round 4: *P2, k2* to 2 sts before marker, p2, sm, s2kp, sm, *p2, k2* to end of round [- (191, -, 203, -, 215) sts]

All sizes

Round 5: BO all sts loosely in patt, removing markers as they are encountered

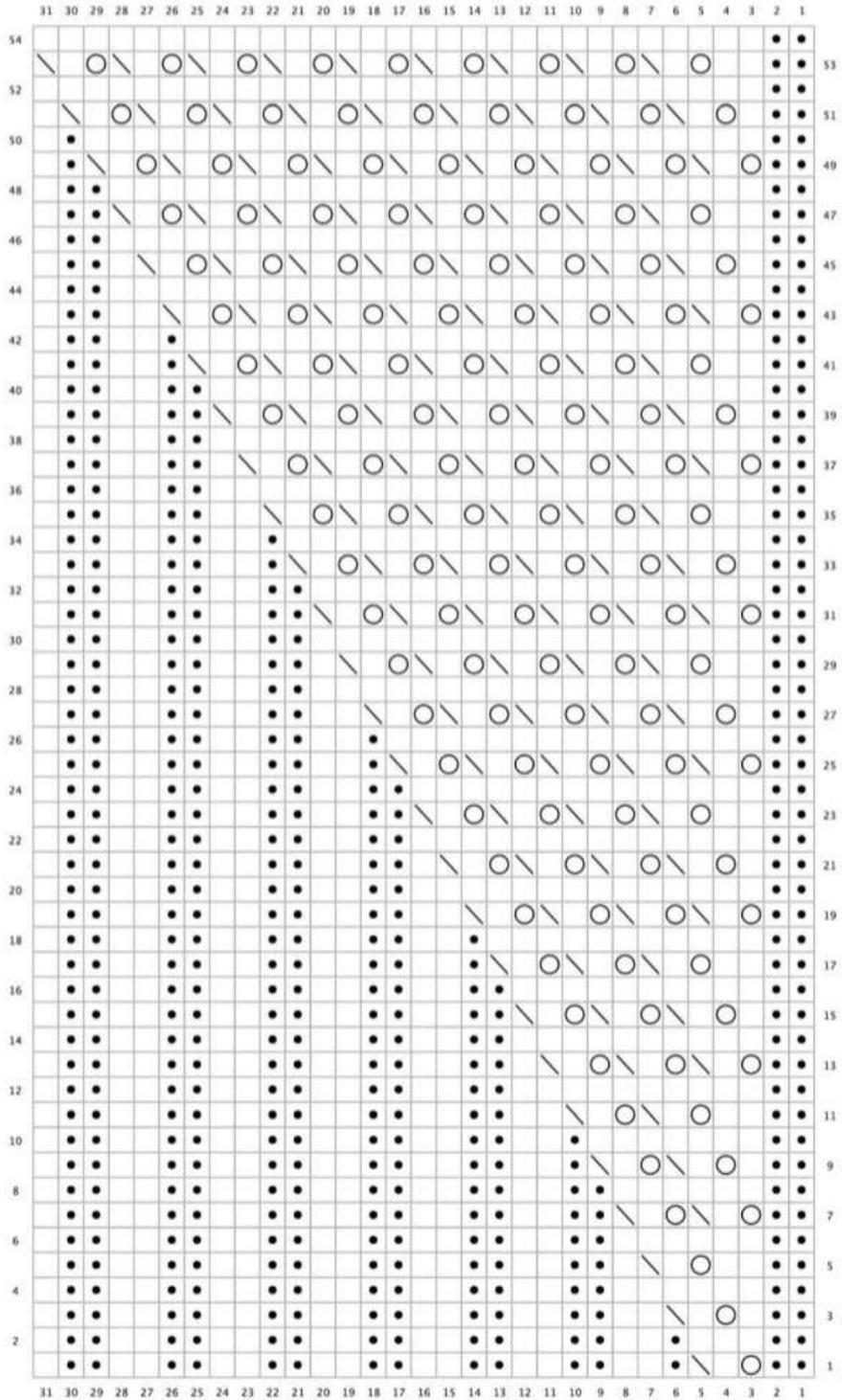
After working neckband, weave in all ends and gently steam or wet block entire garment again.
