Sizes:

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9) 10, 11

Sizes 1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9) 10, 11 are intended to fit an approximate actual bust circumference of 75 (80, 85, 90, 95) (100, 110, 120, 130) 140, 150 cm.

Bust circumference of finished garment:

99 (104, 109, 114, 119) (124, 134, 144, 154) 164, 174 cm

Upper arm circumference of finished garment:

39.5 (40.5, 42, 43, 44.5) (45.5, 48, 51.5, 55) 59, 62.5 cm

Recommended length of finished garment:

50 (50, 51.5, 51.5, 53.5) (53.5, 55, 56.5, 57) 58.5, 60 cm (measured from mid-back excluding neck edge)

Recommended length of finished sleeve:

44.5 (44.5, 44.5, 44.5, 44.5) (44.5, 44, 45, 44.5) (45.5, 44.5) cm

Yoke depth:

20 (20, 20, 20, 21.5) (21.5, 22, 22.5, 23.5) 24, 24.5 cm (measured from mid-back excluding neck edge)

Gauge:

20 sts x 30 rows in PATTERN on 4.5mm needles = 10 x 10 cm after blocking.

Needles:

Circular needles: 3.5mm (25-120 cm), 4.5mm (40-120 cm)

Materials:

550 (600, 650, 650, 650) (700, 750, 800, 850) 950, 1000g DK Pure Merino Wool by Unikt Yarn (100 g = 200m) *held together with* 145 (150, 160, 165, 170) (180, 190, 210, 220) 240, 255g Silk Mohair by Unikt Yarn (50g = 420m) PLUS 55 (55, 55, 55, 55) (60, 60, 60, 65) 70, 70g Merino Singles by Sysleriget (100g = 366m) **held double** (the quantity provided is the total amount of yarn required) *held together with* 10 (10, 10, 10, 10) (15, 15, 15, 15) 15, 15g Silk Mohair by Isager (25g = 212m) for the 'colour change' sleeve.

If knitting the sweater all in one colour you will require:

250 (300, 300, 300, 300) (300, 350, 350, 400) 400, 450g Alpaca 2 by Isager (50g = 250m) *held together with* 200 (250, 300, 300, 300) (300, 350, 350, 350) 400, 450g Tvinni by Isager (50g = 260m) *held together with* 150 (175, 175, 175, 175) (200, 200, 225, 225) 250, 250g Silk Mohair by Isager (25g = 212m).

OR

600 (650, 700, 700, 700) (750, 800, 850, 900) 1000, 1050g DK Pure Merino Wool by Unikt Yarn (100g = 200m) *held together with* 150 (175, 175, 175, 175) (175, 200, 200, 225) 250, 250g Silk Mohair by Unikt Yarn (50g = 420m)

OR

700 (700, 800, 800, 800) (850, 950, 950, 1000) 1100, 1150g Merino Singles by Sysleriget (100g = 366m) **held double** (the quantity provided is the total amount of yarn required) *held together with* 150 (175, 175, 175, 175) (175, 200, 200, 225) 250, 250g Silk Mohair by Isager (25g = 212m).

If you choose to lengthen the sweater you may require more yarn.

** Yarns used in pictures are:*

Version 1: Alpaca 2 by Isager in shade E0 held together with Tvinni by Isager in shade 2s held together with Silk Mohair by Isager in shade E0.

Version 2: DK Pure Merino Wool by Unikt Yarn in shade Hubba Bubba held together with Silk Mohair by Unikt Yarn in shade Natural AND for the 'colour change' sleeve Merino Singles by Sysleriget in shade Lollipop held together with Merino Singles by Sysleriget in shade Natural and Silk Mohair by Unikt Yarn in shade Natural.

Size guide:

Montrose Sweater is designed to have approximately 24 cm of positive ease, meaning it is designed to be approximately 24 cm larger in circumference than your bust measurement.

Montrose Sweater has a classic raglan structure with a striped texture worked throughout. The oversized fit provides a modern look that looks great with anything. The sweater is worked from the top down. First the neck edge is worked and folded over, then short rows are worked to create shape to the neck as part of the yoke. The remainder of the yoke is worked in the round with raglan increases. The sweater is then divided for the body and sleeves, and new stitches are cast on for the underarms. The body and sleeves are finished separately and worked in the round, and the edges are bound off using your preferred bind-off technique.

Abbreviations

BOR = beginning of round

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

k = knit

p = purl

k2tog = knit two stitches together

p2tog = purl two stitches together

sl = slip stitch purlwise

sk = slip 1 stitch knitwise, return stitch back to the left needle

st(s) = stitch(es)

tbl = through the back loop

wyf = with yarn held in front

wyb = with yarn held behind

M = marker

M1L = Make 1 Left; work an increase by inserting the left needle under the strand between the stitches from front to back and knitting it through the back loop.

M1R = Make 1 Right; work an increase by inserting the left needle under the strand between the stitches from back to front and knitting it through the front loop.

M1Lp = Make 1 Left purl; work an increase by inserting the left needle under the strand between the stitches from front to back and purling it through the back loop.

M1Rp = Make 1 Right purl; work an increase by inserting the left needle under the strand between the stitches from back to front and purling it through the front loop.

German short rows

Work to turning point. Turn the work, bring the working yarn in front of the work and slip the first stitch purlwise, bring the working yarn up and over the needle, pulling it tightly so that it pulls both “legs” of the slipped stitch over the needle.

Continue as the pattern describes. When working across the turning stitch, work both “legs” of the stitch as one stitch.

PATTERN for swatch (working back and forth):

Row 1 (RS): Purl across row.

Row 2 (WS): Knit across row.

Row 3 (RS): Purl across row.

Row 4 (WS): Purl across row.

Row 5 (RS): Knit across row.

Row 6 (WS): Knit across row

Row 7 (RS): Purl across row.

Row 8 (WS): Knit across row.

Row 9 (RS): Knit across row.

Row 10 (WS): Purl across row.

PATTERN (working in the round):

Round 1: Purl across round.

Round 2: Purl across round.

Round 3: Purl across round.

Round 4: Knit across round.

Round 5: Knit across round.



Pattern

Neck

Cast on 96 (102, 102, 108, 108) (114, 108, 114, 120) 120, 126 sts on a 3.5mm 40 cm circular needle with one strand of each yarn held together, using your preferred method.

Join to work in the round and place a marker for the beginning of the round.

Work a total of 25 rounds in *k2, p1* rib.

Change to a 4.5mm 40 cm circular needle.

Fold the neck edge towards the WS so the sts on the needle are held parallel to the sts of the cast-on round.

Round 1: Knit each stitch on the needle together with the parallel stitch from the cast-on round. Repeat until the end of round. You have finished knitting the neckband.

Slip sts from the left to the right needle and place markers as follows:

Slip 2 sts (*raglan*), **place marker 1**, slip 32 (35, 34, 37, 37) (39, 36, 38, 40) 40, 43 sts (*back*), **place marker 2**, slip 2 sts (*raglan*), **place marker 3**, slip 12 (12, 13, 13, 13) (14, 14, 15, 16) 16, 16 sts (*right sleeve*), **place marker 4**, slip 2 sts (*raglan*), **place marker 5**, slip 32 (35, 34, 37, 37) (39, 36, 38, 40) 40, 43 sts (*front*), **place marker 6**, slip 2 sts (*raglan*), **place marker 7**, slip 12 (12, 13, 13, 13) (14, 14, 15, 16) 16, 16 sts (*left sleeve*), **BOR**. You are now at the marker for the beginning of the round.

Yoke

You will now work back and forth in PATTERN, while working raglan increases every other row and German short rows to shape the neckline as follows:

Row 1 (RS): M1Rp, **slip BOR**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2 (*back*), M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M3**, M1Lp, purl to M4 (*right sleeve*), M1Rp, **slip M4**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M5**, M1Lp, p2 (*front*), turn work. (6 sts increased)

Row 2 (WS): Knit to M5 (*front*), **slip M5**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip M4**, knit to M3 (*right sleeve*), **slip M3**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip M2**, knit to M1 (*back*), **slip M1**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip BOR**, knit to M7 (*left sleeve*), M1L, **slip M7**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip M6**, M1R, k2 (*front*), turn work. (2 sts increased)

Row 3 (RS): Purl to M6 (*front*), **slip M6**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M7**, purl to BOR (*left sleeve*), M1Rp, **slip BOR**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2 (*back*), M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M3**, M1Lp, purl to M4 (*right sleeve*), M1Rp, **slip M4**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M5**, M1Lp, p2 past last turn (*front*), turn work. (6 sts increased)

Row 4 (WS): Purl to BOR slipping markers as you go, **slip BOR**, knit to M7 (*left sleeve*), M1L, **slip M7**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip M6**, M1R, k2 past last turn (*front*), turn work. (2 sts increased)

Row 5 (RS): Knit to BOR slipping markers as you go, M1R, **slip BOR**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M1**, M1L, knit to M2 (*back*), M1R, **slip M2**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M3**, M1L, knit to M4 (*right sleeve*), M1R, **slip M4**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M5**, M1L, k2 past last turn (*front*), turn work. (6 sts increased)

Row 6 (WS): Knit to M5 (*front*), **slip M5**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip M4**, knit to M3 (*right sleeve*), **slip M3**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip M2**, knit to M1 (*back*), **slip M1**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip BOR**, purl to M7 (*left sleeve*), M1Lp, **slip M7**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip M6**, M1Rp, p2 past last turn (*front*), turn work. (2 sts increased)

Row 7 (RS): Purl to M6 (*front*), **slip M6**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M7**, purl to BOR (*left sleeve*), M1Rp, **slip BOR**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2 (*back*), M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M3**, M1Lp, purl to M4 (*right sleeve*), M1Rp, **slip M4**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M5**, M1Lp, p1 (2, 2, 2, 2) (2, 2, 2, 2) 2, 2 past last turn (*front*), turn work. (6 sts increased)

Row 8 (WS): Knit to M5 (*front*), **slip M5**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip M4**, knit to M3 (*right sleeve*), **slip M3**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip M2**, knit to M1 (*back*), **slip M1**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip BOR**, knit to M7 (*left sleeve*), M1L, **slip M7**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip M6**, M1R, k1 (2, 2, 2, 2) (2, 2, 2, 2) 2, 2 past last turn (*front*), turn work. (2 sts increased)

Row 9 (RS): Purl to M6 (*front*), **slip M6**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M7**, purl to BOR, M1Rp, **slip BOR**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M1**, M1L, knit to M2 (*back*), M1R, **slip M2**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M3**, M1L, knit to M4 (*right sleeve*), M1R, **slip M4**, k2 (*raglan*), **slip M5**, M1L, k1 (1, 1, 1, 1) (2, 1, 2, 2) 2, 2 past last turn (*front*), turn work. (6 sts increased)

Row 10 (WS): Purl to BOR slipping markers as you go, **slip BOR**, purl to M7 (*left sleeve*), M1Lp, **slip M7**, p2 (*raglan*), **slip M6**, M1Rp, p1 (1, 1, 1, 1) (2, 1, 2, 2) 2, 2 past last turn (*front*), turn work. (2 sts increased)

Row 11 (RS): Knit to BOR.

The German Short Rows are now finished. A total of 40 stitches have been increased.

There are a total of 136 (142, 142, 148, 148) (154, 148, 154, 160) 160, 166 stitches on the needles. 2 sts (*raglan*), 42 (45, 44, 47, 47) (49, 46, 48, 50) 50, 53 sts (*back*), 2 sts (*raglan*), 22 (22, 23, 23, 23) (24, 24, 25, 26) 26, 26 sts (*right sleeve*), 2 sts (*raglan*), 42 (45, 44, 47, 47) (49, 46, 48, 50) 50, 53 sts (*front*), 2 sts (*raglan*), 22 (22, 23, 23, 23) (24, 24, 25, 26) 26, 26 sts (*left sleeve*).

You will now work in the round whilst continuing to work increases on both the body and the sleeves either side of the raglan stitches every other round as follows:

Round 1 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2, M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, M1Lp, purl to M4, M1Rp, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1Lp, purl to M6, M1Rp, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, M1Lp, purl to BOR, M1Rp, **BOR**. (8 sts increased)

(NB) Remember to work both 'legs' of turning stitch as one.

Round 2: K2, **slip M1**, purl to M2, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, purl to M4, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, purl to M6, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, purl to BOR, **BOR**.

Round 3 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2, M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, M1Lp, purl to M4, M1Rp, **slip**

M4, k2, **slip M5**, M1Lp, purl to M6, M1Rp, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, M1Lp, purl to BOR, M1Rp, **BOR**. (8 sts increased)

Round 4: Knit across round.

Round 5 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1L, knit to M2, M1R, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, M1L, knit to M4, M1R, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1L, knit to M6, M1R, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, M1L, knit to BOR, M1Rp, **BOR**. (8 sts increased)

Round 6: K2, **slip M1**, purl to M2, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, purl to M4, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, purl to M6, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, purl to BOR, **BOR**.

Round 7 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2, M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, M1Lp, purl to M4, M1Rp, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1Lp, purl to M6, M1Rp, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, M1Lp, purl to BOR, M1Rp, **BOR**. (8 sts increased)

Round 8: K2, **slip M1**, purl to M2, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, purl to M4, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, purl to M6, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, purl to BOR, **BOR**.

Round 9 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1L, knit to M2, M1R, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, M1L, knit to M4, M1R, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1L, knit to M6, M1R, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, M1L, knit to BOR, M1R, **BOR**. (8 sts increased)

Round 10: Knit across round.

Work rounds 1 to 10, 4 (4, 5, 5, 5) (5, 4, 4, 3) 3, 3 times in total, changing to a longer 4.5mm circular needle when required to accommodate the growing number of stitches.

Sizes 1 and 2: Work rounds 1 to 6 once more.

Sizes 5, 6, and 10: Work rounds 1 to 2 once more.

Size 7: Work rounds 1 to 4 once more.

Size 9: Work rounds 1 to 8 once more.

Sizes 3, 4, 8 and 11 do not need to work any extra rounds.

There are a total of 320 (326, 342, 348, 356) (362, 324, 314, 312) 288, 286 stitches on the needles. 2 sts (*raglan*), 88 (91, 94, 97, 99) (101, 90, 88, 88) 82, 83 sts (*back*), 2 sts (*raglan*), 68 (68, 73, 73, 75) (76, 68, 65, 64) 58, 56 sts (*right sleeve*), 2 sts (*raglan*), 88 (91, 94, 97, 99) (101, 90, 88, 88) 82, 83 sts (*front*), 2 sts (*raglan*), 68 (68, 73, 73, 75) (76, 68, 65, 64) 58, 56 sts (*left sleeve*).

Sizes 3 and 4 can now proceed to **Body**. All other sizes will need to continue to make increases as described below.

Sizes 1 and 2:

These sizes will need to work two more sleeve increases, without increasing further on the front or the back, as follows:

Round 11 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, purl to M2, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, M1Lp, purl to M4, M1Rp, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, purl to M6, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, M1Lp, purl to BOR, M1Rp, **BOR**. (4 sts increased)

Round 12: K2, **slip M1**, purl to M2, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, purl to M4, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, purl to M6, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, purl to BOR, **BOR**.

Round 13 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, knit to M2, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, M1L, knit to M4, M1R, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, knit to M6, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, M1L, knit to BOR, M1R, **BOR**. (4 sts increased)

Round 14: Knit across round.

There are a total of 328 (334, x, x, x) (x, x, x, x) x, x stitches on the needles. 2 sts (*raglan*), 88 (91, x, x, x) (x, x, x, x) x, x sts (*back*), 2 sts (*raglan*), 72 (72, x, x, x) (x, x, x, x) x, x sts (*right sleeve*), 2 sts (*raglan*), 88 (91, x, x, x) (x, x, x, x) x, x sts (*front*), 2 sts (*raglan*), 72 (72, x, x, x) (x, x, x, x) x, x sts (*left sleeve*).

Proceed to **Body**.

Size 5:

This size needs to work an additional increase to the front and back only, as follows:

Round 15 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2, M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, purl to M4, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1Lp, purl to M6, M1Rp, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, purl to BOR, **BOR**. (4 sts increased)

Round 16: Knit across round.

There are a total of x (x, x, x, 360) (x, x, x, x) x, x stitches on the needles. 2 sts (*raglan*), x (x, x, x, 101) (x, x, x, x) x, x sts (*back*), 2 sts (*raglan*), x (x, x, x, 75) (x, x, x, x) x, x sts (*right sleeve*), 2 sts (*raglan*), x (x, x, x, 101) (x, x, x, x) x, x sts (*front*), 2 sts (*raglan*), x (x, x, x, 75) (x, x, x, x) x, x sts (*left sleeve*).

Proceed to **Body**.

Size 6:

This size needs to make two additional increases to the front and back only, as follows:

Round 17 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2, M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, purl to M4, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1Lp, purl to M6, M1Rp, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, purl to BOR, **BOR**. (4 sts increased)

Round 18 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1L, knit to M2, M1R, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, knit to M4, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1L, knit to M6, M1R, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, knit to BOR, **BOR**. (4 sts increased)

There are a total of x (x, x, x, x) (370, x, x, x) x, x stitches on the needles. 2 sts (*raglan*), x (x, x, x, x) (105, x, x, x) x, x sts (*back*), 2 sts (*raglan*), x (x, x, x, x) (76, x, x, x) x, x sts (*right sleeve*), 2 sts (*raglan*), x (x, x, x, x) (105, x, x, x) x, x sts (*front*), 2 sts (*raglan*), x (x, x, x, x) (76, x, x, x) x, x sts (*left sleeve*).

Proceed to **Body**.

Size 7:

This size will need to make additional increases every round as follows:

Round 19 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1L, knit to M2, M1R, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, M1L, knit to M4, M1R, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1L, knit to M6, M1R, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, M1L, knit to BOR, M1Rp, **BOR**. (8 sts increased)

Round 20 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2, M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, purl to M4, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1Lp, purl to M6, M1Rp, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, purl to BOR, **BOR**. (4 sts increased)

Round 21 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2, M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, M1Lp, purl to M4, M1Rp, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1Lp, purl to M6, M1Rp, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, M1Lp, purl to BOR, M1Rp, **BOR**. (8 sts increased)

Round 22 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2, M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, purl to M4, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1Lp, purl to M6, M1Rp, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, purl to BOR, **BOR**. (4 sts increased)

Round 23 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1L, knit to M2, M1R, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, M1L, knit to M4, M1R, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1L, knit to M6, M1R, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, M1L, knit to BOR, M1Rp, **BOR**. (8 sts increased)

Round 24 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1L, knit to M2, M1R, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, knit to M4, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1L, knit to M6, M1R, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, knit to BOR, **BOR**. (4 sts increased)

Round 25 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2, M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, M1Lp, purl to M4, M1Rp, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1Lp, purl to M6, M1Rp, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, M1Lp, purl to BOR, M1Rp, **BOR**. (8 sts increased)

Round 26 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2, M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, purl to M4, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1Lp, purl to M6, M1Rp, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, purl to BOR, **BOR**. (4 sts increased)

Round 27 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1Lp, purl to M2, M1Rp, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, M1Lp, purl to M4, M1Rp, **slip**

M4, k2, **slip M5**, M1Lp, purl to M6, M1Rp, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, M1Lp, purl to BOR, M1Rp, **BOR**. (8 sts increased)

Round 28 (increase round): K2, **slip M1**, M1L, knit to M2, M1R, **slip M2**, k2, **slip M3**, knit to M4, **slip M4**, k2, **slip M5**, M1L, knit to M6, M1R, **slip M6**, k2, **slip M7**, knit to BOR, **BOR**. (4 sts increased)

Size 7 should work Rounds 19 to 28 once, then work rounds 19 to 20 once more (12 rounds total).

Sizes 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 9, and 10:

Joining round: K2 (*raglan*), purl 88 (91, 94, 97, x) (x, 114, x, 132) 142, x sts (*back*), k2 (*raglan*), place the next 72 (72, 73, 73, x) (x, 80, x, 92) 100, x sts on hold (*right sleeve*), cast on 7 (9, 11, 13, x) (x, 16, x, 18) 18, x new sts in extension of the sts on the needle using the backwards-loop technique, k2 (*raglan*), purl 88 (91, 94, 97, x) (x, 114, x, 132) 142, x (*front*), k2 (*raglan*), place the next 72 (72, 73, 73, x) (x, 80, x, 92) 100, x sts on hold (*left sleeve*), cast on 7 (9, 11, 13, x) (x, 16, x, 18) 18, x new sts in extension of the sts on the needle using the backwards-loop technique.

Break the yarn and place a new BOR marker towards the center of the newly cast on sts. Remove all other markers.

Slip sts from the right needle to the left needle so you can begin the next round from the new BOR marker.

Sizes 5, 6, 8, and 11:

Joining round: K2 (*raglan*), knit x (x, x, x, 101) (105, x, 124, x) x, 151 sts *back*, k2 (*raglan*), place the next x (x, x, x, 75) (76, x, 87, x) x, 106sts on hold (*right sleeve*), cast on x (x, x, x, 14) (15, x, 16, x) x, 19 new sts in extension of the sts on the needle using the backwards-loop technique, k2 (*raglan*), knit x (x, x, x, 101) (105, x, 124, x) x, 151 sts *front*, k2 (*raglan*), place the next x (x, x, x, 75) (76, x, 87, x) x, 106 sts on hold (*left sleeve*), cast on x (x, x, x, 14) (15, x, 16, x) x, 19 new sts in extension of the sts on the needle using the backwards-loop technique.

Break the yarn and place a new BOR marker towards the center of the newly cast on sts. Remove all other markers.

Slip sts from the right needle to the left needle so you can begin the next round from the new BOR marker.

All sizes.

There are a total of 198 (208, 218, 228, 238) (248, 268, 288, 308) 328, 348 stitches on the needles.

You now resume working in the 5-round stitch pattern. Which round you start depends upon which size you are knitting and will ensure you maintain the stitch pattern:

Sizes 1, 2, 3, 4, and 9: Start with round 1.

Sizes 5, 6 and 11: Start with round 5.

Size 7: Start with round 2.

Size 8: Start with round 4.

Size 10: Start with round 3.

Round 1: Purl across round.

Round 2: Purl across round.

Round 3: Knit across round.

Round 4: Knit across round.

Round 5: Purl across round.

After you have worked the 0 (0, 0, 0, 1) (1, 4, 2, 0) 3, 1 round(s) of the initial partial repeat of the stitch pattern, work rounds 1 to 5 a total of 13 (13, 14, 14, 14) (14, 14, 15, 15) 15, 16 times. The body should measure approximately 41.5 (41.5, 43, 43, 45) (45, 46.5, 48, 48.5) 50, 51.5 cm measured from the mid-back excluding the neck edge.

Work rounds 1 and 2, 1 more time. The body should measure approximately 42 (42, 43.5, 43.5, 45.5) (45.5, 47, 48.5, 49) 50.5, 52 cm measured from the mid-back excluding the neck edge.

When looking at the sweater from the RS your last 3 rounds should be seen as 3 purl rounds.

Change to 3.5mm circular needle and knit one round as follows:

Sizes 1, 4, 8 and 11:

Knit across round.

Sizes 2, 5, 7 and 10:

Knit x (104, x, x, 119) (x, 134, x, x) 164, x sts, **k2tog**, knit across the remainder of the round.

Sizes 3, 6 and 9:

Knit x (x, 72, x, x) (82, x, x, 102) x, x sts, **k2tog**, knit next x (x, 72, x, x) (82, x, x, 102) x, x sts, **k2tog**, knit across the remainder of the round.

There are now a total of 198 (207, 216, 228, 237) (246, 267, 288, 306) 327, 348 stitches on the needles.

Continue using 3.5mm needles and work 8 cm of *k2, p1* rib.

Bind off using your preferred bind-off technique.

NB) Binding off in pattern, with knit over knit and purl over purl, has been used in the pattern pictures.

Sleeves

Place the stitches for one sleeve on a 4.5mm 40 cm circular needle. You will be picking up a total of 7 (9, 11, 13, 14) (15, 16, 18) 18, 19 sts along the underarm cast-on edge, which equates to 1 st for each st cast on at the underarm, as follows:

Sizes 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 9, and 10:

Joining round: Pick up and knit 4 (5, 6, 7, x) (x, 8, x, 9) 9, x sts from the left side of the underarm cast-on edge, purl across the 72 (72, 73, 73, x) (x, 80, x, 92) 100, x sts that were on hold, pick up and knit the remaining 3 (4, 5, 6, x) (x, 8, x, 9) 9, x sts from the underarm cast-on edge. Place a BOR marker.

Sizes 5, 6, 8, and 11:

Joining round: Pick up and knit x (x, x, x, 7) (8, x, 8, x) x, 10 sts from the left side of the underarm cast-on edge, knit across the x (x, x, x, 75) (76, x, 87, x) x, 106 sts that were on hold, pick up and knit the remaining x (x, x, x, 7) (7, x, 8, x) x, 9 sts from the underarm cast-on edge. Place a BOR marker.

All sizes.

There are now a total of 79 (81, 84, 86, 89) (91, 96, 103, 110) 118, 125 sts on the needle.

You now resume working in the 5-round stitch pattern. Which round you start depends upon which size you are knitting and will ensure you maintain the stitch pattern:

Sizes 1, 2, 3, 4, and 9: Start with round 1.

Sizes 5, 6 and 11: Start with round 5.

Size 7: Start with round 2.

Size 8: Start with round 4.

Size 10: Start with round 3.

Round 1: Purl across round.

Round 2: Purl across round.

Round 3: Knit across round.

Round 4: Knit across round.

Round 5: Purl across round.

After you have worked the 0 (0, 0, 0, 1) (1, 4, 2, 0) 3, 1 round(s) of the initial partial repeat of the stitch pattern, work rounds 1 to 5 a total of 21 (21, 21, 21, 22) (22, 21, 22, 21) 22, 22 times **while at the same time working decreases** every 13th (11th, 11th, 10th, 9th) (10th, 8th, 7th, 6th) 5th, 5th round a total of 1 (9, 9, 10, 6) (2, 3, 9, 14) 20, 10 time(s) and every 12th (10th, 10th, 9th, 8th) (9th, 7th, 6th, 5th) 4th, 4th round a total of 8 (1, 1, 1, 7) (10, 12, 8, 5) 3, 15 time(s). The sleeve should measure approximately 36.5cm measured from the underarm cast on edge.

If you are working the 'colour change' sleeve variation of the pattern - when working the left sleeve change your yarn colour on the 12th repeat of 'round 4'. You will continue the rest of the sleeve as per the pattern in your new colour yarn.

Decrease rounds are worked differently depending on whether they take place on a knit round or a purl round as follows:

When the decreases take place on a knit row:

K2tog, knit until 2 stitches before marker, **sk k2tog tbl**.

When the decreases take place on a purl row:

P2tog, purl until 2 stitches before marker, **sk p2tog tbl**.

There are now a total of 61 (61, 64, 64, 63) (67, 66, 69, 72) 72, 75 sts on the needle.

Work rounds 1 and 2, 1 more time.

When looking at the sweater from the RS your last 3 rounds should be seen as 3 purl rounds.

Change to 3.5mm circular needle.

Sizes 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6:

Round 6: K2tog, knit across round.

Sizes 5, 7-11:

Round 6: Knit across round.

All sizes.

There are now a total of 60 (60, 63, 63, 63) (66, 66, 69, 72) 72, 75 sts on the needle.

Continue using 3.5mm needles and work 7 cm of *k2, p1* rib.

Bind off using your preferred bind-off technique.

NB) Binding off in pattern, with knit over knit and purl over purl, has been used in the pattern pictures.

Repeat for second sleeve.

Finishing

Weave in all ends.
