Mountain river

Abbreviations:

k = knit
p = purl
sl1k = slip a stitch knit-wise
BO = bind off
CO = cast on
pm = place marker
rm = remove marker
st(s) = stitch (es)
RS = right side
WS = wrong side
w/o = without
w&t = wrap and turn
tw = turn work
/ = next

Yarn: Malabrigo Baby Silkpaca – 225g
(50g/385m)

Colors: Yarn A (009 Polar morn) - 50g,

Yarn B: 175g - of them:

B1 (150 Azul profundo) - 25g; **B2** (412 Teal Feather) - 25g; **B3** (809 Solis) - 25g; **B4** (Bobby blue) - 25g; **B5** (856 Azules) - 25g; **B6** (068 Violetas) - 25g; **B7** (052 Paris night) - 25g

or any other yarn you like. Heavier or lighter yarn weights can also be used for this pattern, though dimensions and yardage will change. If you do not want to change the colors of the yarn for every strip then any multicolor yarn will also look beautiful.

Size: wide – 55 cm. / long - 245 cm. or optional

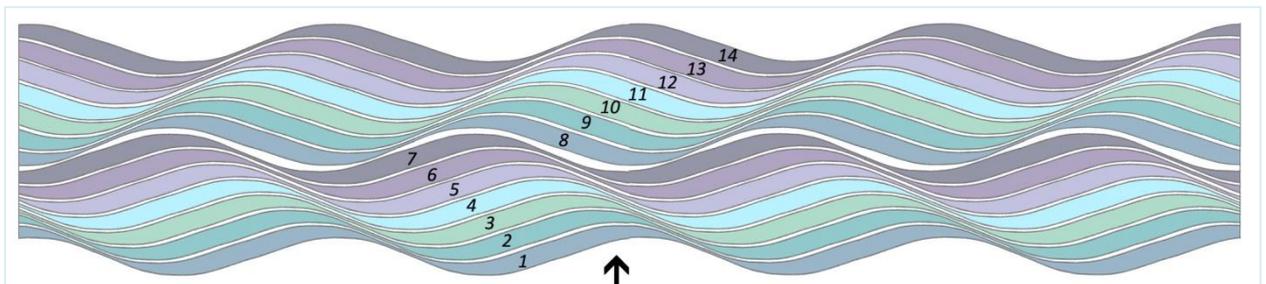
Needles: 2.5mm.

Gauge: 28sts and 32 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

Note: Attention! This project contains many work turns.

This stole is knitted seamlessly. This project seems complicated, but when you understand the knitting principle, it'll become easy and fun. The rectangular shape allows you to use this stitch pattern for a multitude of objects: scarves, wraps, jackets, sweaters, fabric bags, decorative pillows and anything else you can think of.

Selvedge stitches are already included in this stitch count. Do not add any additional selvedge stitches.



Description:

Yarn A

CO 160sts (multiply 40sts) on the needle size 2,5mm.

(Start RS) Beginning row: Sl1k, k159, tw.

Yarn A

(Start WS): P160, tw.

(Start RS): Sl1k, k159, tw.

Repeat **Strips 1-14** x 7 more times (or optional).

BO all sts.

Border

Make an I-Cord all the way around the Stole like this:

From the selv sts any side (RS) pick up and knit all sts, turn work. (WS) Purl one row and add 4sts (using the loop cast-on method). Turn work.

(RS) Next: K3, k2tog tbl, w/o turning; *slip 4sts from RN to LN, k3, k2tog tbl* - repeat between ** to the last 4sts on RN.

Repeat for the next sides but adding 4sts is no longer necessary.

BO 4sts after completing all four sides.

Attention, this is important: Block (spread your stole out on a flat surface, moisten, stretch forming waves, dry).
