## CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

CH – CHAIN

ST(S) – STITCH(ES)

SL ST – SLIP STITCH

SC – SINGLE CROCHET

INC – INCREASE (2 SC IN EACH  
STITCH)

DEC – DECREASE (SC 2 STS  
TOGETHER)

DC – DOUBLE CROCHET

BEG – BEGINNING

BLO – BACK LOOPS ONLY

(.....)\*N – REPEAT INSTRUCTIONS  
WITHIN THE BRACKETS

REQUIRED N NUMBER OF TIMES  
= 6 – NUMBER OF STITCHES

YOU SHOULD HAVE AT THE  
END OF THE ROUND

## MATERIALS

- Yarn in 3 different colors
- Crochet hook
- Polyester fiberfill
- Scissors
- Needle to weave in ends

**I used:  
for small mushroom**

- Alize “Cotton Gold”, 55% cotton/45% acrylic, 100g=329m, 4 ply/sport weight
- 2,0 mm hook
- finished size 10 cm

**for large mushroom**

- Drops “Paris”, 100% cotton, 50g=100m, 10 ply/worsted weight
- 3,5 mm crochet hook
- finished size 15 cm

## TIPS AND TRICKS

- For nice and tight stitches use crochet hook size or two smaller than indicated on yarn label.
- Work in continuous rounds, do not join or turn unless otherwise noted.
- You may use stitch marker and place it in the first stitch of each round to mark the beginning of it.
- Stuff the mushroom stem tightly as you go.
- Stuff mushroom cap very lightly while joining stem and cap.

## STEM

With first yarn

**Rnd 1:** 6 sc in magic ring =6

**Rnd 2:** [inc]\*6 =12

**Rnd 3:** [sc, inc]\*6 =18

**Rnd 4:** [2 sc, inc]\*6 =24

**Rnd 5-12:** 24 sc

**Rnd 13:** [dec, 10 sc]\*2 =22

**Rnd 14-15:** 22 sc

**Rnd 16:** [dec, 9 sc]\*2 =20

**Rnd 17-18:** 20 sc

**Rnd 19:** [dec, 8 sc]\*2 =18

**Rnd 20-24:** 18 sc

**Rnd 25:** 18 sc, sl st to next;

Fasten off and weave in the end.

Attach the second yarn to any sc of last round of stem.

Work in joined rounds.

**Rnd 1:** ch 3 (=1 dc); dc in same st (photo 1); 2 dc in each st (photo 2) all around; join to top of beg ch 3 (photo 3)=36




**Rnd 2:** ch 1 (=1 sc); 35 sc; join to beg ch 1 =36

**Rnd 3:** ch 3 (=1 dc); (2 dc in next st, dc in next st)\*17; 2 dc in last st and join with sl st to beg ch 3 =54

**Rnd 4:** work in BLO (photo 4)

ch 1 (=1 sc); sc in each st; join to beg ch 1 =54

Fasten off and weave in the end.



## CUP

With third yarn

**Rnd 1:** 6 sc in magic ring =6

**Rnd 2:** [inc]\*6 =12

**Rnd 3:** [sc, inc]\*6 =18

**Rnd 4:** [2 sc, inc]\*6 =24

**Rnd 5:** [3 sc, inc]\*6 =30

**Rnd 6:** [4 sc, inc]\*6 =36

**Rnd 7:** 36 sc

**Rnd 8:** [5 sc, inc]\*6 =42

**Rnd 9:** 42 sc

**Rnd 10:** [6 sc, inc]\*6 =48

**Rnd 11:** 48 sc



**Rnd 12:** [7 sc, inc]\*6 =54

**Rnd 13:** 54 sc

**Rnd 14:** 54 sc; sl st to next and fasten off leaving long tail for joining.

## JOINING

Place the stem inside the cap. There are 54 sts on last rounds of cap and stem. Place them next to each other (photo 5). Insert the hook through back loops of last rounds on both sides (photo 6) and pull the yarn all the way through (photo 7). Continue doing so all around (photo 8). Stuff the cap lightly once you've joined about 2/3 of mushroom and continue joining until the end. Fasten off and weave in the end.
