MATERIALS

REGIA PREMIUM Merino Yak, 100 g ball

Col. 07518 (mineral blue meliert) 5, 6, 6, 7, 7 balls

Make sure to purchase enough of the same dye lot in order to complete your project. The color names refer to the German names on the sleeves. The amount of yarn needed approx. vary from person to person.

Size 2.5 and 3 mm (US size 1/2 and 2/3) circ. needle, 80 cm long

1 cable needle or stitch holder

1 crochet hook 3 mm (US size 2/3)

2 stitch markers

1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

GAUGE

Using needle size 3 mm, cable pattern:

32 st and 42 rows = 10 x 10 cm

If your gauge differs from the given gauge, use needles of a larger or smaller size accordingly.

THE BASICS

Ribbed pattern, using needle size 2.5 mm:

RS: alternate k2, p2.

WS: work the st as they appear.

Cable pattern, using needle size 3 mm:

Work according to the chart. All RS rows are shown. In the non pictured WS rows work the st as they appear. Work R 1 to 14 throughout.

Stockinette stitch: RS: knit, WS: purl.

Rev stockinette stitch: RS: purl, WS: knit.

INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions are for smallest size, with changes for larger sizes noted in different colors. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Back

Using needle size 2.5 mm, cast on 168/180/194/206/220 st and work 6 cm in ribbed pattern, work as follows in the first WS row: selvage st, p1, then alternate k2, p2, end with k2, p1, selvage st. Using needle size 3 mm, work as follows, increase 1 st in the first R: selvage st, 7/13/5/11/3 st in stockinette stitch, work the 30-st pattern repeat 5/5/6/6/7x, 3 st in rev stockinette stitch, 7/13/5/11/3 st in stockinette stitch, selvage st = 169/181/195/207/221 st.

For armhole shaping, when the piece measures 30 cm from the cast-on edge, place a stitch marker at each edge. For shoulder shaping, when the piece measures 52/53/54/55/56 cm from the cast-on edge, bind off at each edge every other R 9x 4 st and 4x 5 st/3x 4 st and 10x 5 st/9x 5 st and 4x 6 st/3x 5 st and 10x 6 st/9x 6 st and 4x 7 st.

At the same time, when the piece measures 56/57/58/59/60 cm from the cast-on edge, for neck shaping, bind off the 47 center st and work both sides separately, bind off at the neck edge every other R 1x 3 st and 1x 2 st.

Total length = 58/59/60/61/62 cm.

Front

Work as for the back, but with a lower neck edge. When the piece measures 49/50/51/52/53 cm from the cast-on edge, for neck shaping, bind off the 27 center st and work both sides separately, bind off at the neck edge every other R 2x 3 st, 2x 2 st and 5x 1 st. For shoulder shaping, when the piece measures 52/53/54/55/56 cm from the cast-on edge, work as for the back.

Total length = 58/59/60/61/62 cm.

Sleeves

Using needle size 2.5 mm, cast on 78 st and work 6 cm in ribbed pattern, in the first WS row work as follows: selvage st, p1, alternate k2, p2 and end with k2, p1, selvage st. Using needle size 3 mm, work as follows, in the first R increase 17 st evenly spaced: selvage st, work the 30-st pattern repeat 3x, 3 st in rev stockinette stitch, selvage st = 95 st.



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For side shaping, from the border work increases at each edge in every 14th R 3x 1 st and in every 12th R 10x 1 st/
 in every 10th R 10x 1 st and in every 8th R 7x 1 st/in every 8th R 20x 1 st/in every 6th R 24x 1 st/in every 6th R 14x 1 st and in every 4th R 13x 1 st = 121/129/135/143/149 st. When the piece measures 49/47/45/43/41 cm from the cast-on edge, bind off the st. Work the second sleeve the same way.

Hood

Using needle size 3 mm, cast on 161 st and work as follows: selvage st, 3 st in stockinette stitch, work the 30-st pattern repeat 5x, 3 st in rev stockinette stitch, 3 st in stockinette stitch, selvage st. When the piece measures 24 cm from the cast-on edge divide the work in 3 sections: 54 st = right section, 53 st = center section, 54 st = left section. Now decrease the st of the right and left section as follows: work to the last st of the center section, slip the last st of the center section, work the first st of the last section, pass the slipped st over the knitted st, turnover. Slip the first st purlwise and work tot the last st of the center section, purl the last st of the center section and the first st of the last section together, turnover. Repeat these 2 rows until there are no st left of the right and left section. Now pick up 76 st at the front edge at each edge of the center section = total 205 st. Using needle size 2.5 mm, work in ribbed pattern. When the border measures 2 cm, bind off the st as they appear.


FINISHING

Dampen and block the pieces according the measurements; allow to dry. Sew the shoulder seams. Sew on the sleeves lightly stretched between the stitch markers. Sew the side and sleeve seams. Work 1 round single crochet around the neck edge. Sew the hood to the neck edge, the border edges should overlap 1 cm in front, see foto. Weave in all ends.

- p = purl
- R = row(s)
- Rd = round(s)
- RS = right side
- st = stitch(es)
- tog = together
- WS = wrong side

- = slip 3 st on a cable needle in front of the work, k3, then knit the st from the cable needle
