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# Bell the Gnome

## PART 1

### ABBREVIATIONS

MR - magic ring;  
ch - chain;  
st - stitch;  
sc - single crochet;  
hdc - half double crochet;  
dc - double crochet;  
dec - decrease;

slst - slip stitch;  
FLO - front loops only;

[n] - number of stitches in round.



# BODY

Start in off-white.

1: 6 sc in a MR [6]

2: inc in all 6 st [12]

3: (sc, inc) x 6 [18]

4: sc, (inc, 2 sc) x 5, inc, sc [24]

5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 [30]

6: 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x 5, inc, 2 sc [36]

7: (5 sc, inc) x 6 [42]

8-12: (5 rounds) sc in all 42 st [42]

Change to beige, cut the off-white yarn.

13: BLO, sc in all 42 st [42]

14-16: (3 rounds) sc in all 42 st [42]

Stuff the body with fiberfill and continue stuffing as you go.

17: (5 sc, dec) x 6 [36]

18: 2 sc, (dec, 4 sc) x 5, dec, 2 sc [30]

19: (3 sc, dec) x 6 [24]

20: BLO, sc, (dec, 2 sc) x 5, dec, sc [18]

21: (sc, dec) x 6 [12]

22: BLO, 6 dec [6]



Fasten off leaving a tail about 10 cm long and cut the yarn. Using a tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loops of the six stitches and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end (picture 1).

# COAT

Go back to round 19 of the body. Pull up a loop of jeans yarn in the first leftover front loop.

1: FLO, (3 sc, inc) x 6 [30] (pictures 2-3)

- 2: 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x 5, inc, 2 sc [36]  
 3: (5 sc, inc) x 6 [42]  
 4: 3 sc, (inc, 6 sc) x 5, inc, 3 sc [48]  
 5: (7 sc, inc) x 6 [54]  
 6: 4 sc, (inc, 8 sc) x 5, inc, 4 sc [60] (picture 4)  
 7-12: (6 rounds) sc in all 60 st [60]  
 13: (9 sc, inc) x 6 [66]  
 14: sc in all 66 st [66]  
 15: (10 sc, inc) x 6 [72]  
 16-20: (5 rounds) sc in all 72 st [72]  
 21: (10 sc, dec) x 6 [66]  
 22: sc in all 66 st [66]  
 23: (9 sc, dec) x 6 [60]  
 24-25: (2 rounds) sc in all 60 st [60]  
 Change to off-white, cut the jeans yarn.  
 26: sc in all 60 st [60] (picture 5),  
 turn your work (picture 6)  
 and start to crochet the fur part.  
 27: BLO, sc in all 60 st [60]  
 28-29: (2 rounds) sc in all 60 st [60]



Slst in next st. Fasten off and weave in the yarn. Turn up the off-white part on the coat and rolled up (pictures 7-8).

## HEAD

In beige.

1: 6 sc in a MR [6]

2: inc in all 6 st [12]

3: (sc, inc) x 6 [18]

4: sc, (inc, 2 sc) x 5, inc, sc [24]

5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 [30]

6: 2 sc, (inc, 4 sc) x 5, inc, 2 sc [36]

7: (5 sc, inc) x 6 [42]

8-13: (6 rounds) sc in all 42 st [42]

I recommend embroidering or glue the eyes on the face when assembling and making the finishing touches. If you want to use safety eyes instead, you can insert them between rounds 8 and 9, with an interspace of approximately 7 stitches. Stuff the head with fiberfill and continue stuffing as you go.

14: (5 sc, dec) x 6 [36]

15: sc in all 36 st [36]

16: 2 sc, (dec, 4 sc) x 5, dec, 2 sc [30]


17: (3 sc, dec) x 6 [24]

18: sc, (dec, 2 sc) x 5, dec, sc [18]

19: (sc, dec) x 6 [12]

20: BLO, 6 dec [6]

Fasten off leaving a tail about 10 cm long and cut the yarn.



Using a tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loops of the six stitches and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end. Sew the head to the body with beige yarn, using the leftover front loops of round 21 of the body and the front loops of round 19 of the head (pictures 9-11).



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## HAT

In jeans.

1: 6 sc in a MR [6]

2-3: (2 rounds) sc in all 6 st [6]

4: (sc, inc) x 3 [9]

5: sc in all 9 st [9]

6: (2 sc, inc) x 3 [12]

7: sc in all 12 st [12]

8: (3 sc, inc) x 3 [15]

9: sc in all 15 st [15]

10: (4 sc, inc) x 3 [18]

11: sc in all 18 st [18]

12: (2 sc, inc) x 6 [24]

13: sc in all 24 st [24]

14: (3 sc, inc) x 6 [30]

15: sc in all 30 st [30]

16: (4 sc, inc) x 6 [36]

17: sc in all 36 st [36]

18: (5 sc, inc) x 6 [42]

19: sc in all 42 st [42]

20: (6 sc, inc) x 6 [48]

21-28: (8 rounds) sc in all 48 st [48]

Slst in next st. Fasten off and weave in the yarn. The hat doesn't need to be stuffed, sew it on top of the head.

# POMPON

In off-white.

**1:** 6 sc in a MR [6]

**2:** inc in all 6 st [12]

**3:** (sc, inc) x 6 [18]

**4-5:** (2 rounds) sc in all 18 st [18]

Stuff the pompon with fiberfill and continue stuffing as you go.

**6:** (sc, dec) x 6 [12]

**7:** 6 dec [6]

Fasten off leaving a tail about 10 cm long and cut the yarn.

Using a tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loops of the six stitches and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end.

## ARM (make 2)

Start in jeans.

**1:** 6 sc in a MR [6]

**2:** inc in all 6 st [12]

**3-5:** (3 rounds) sc in all 12 st [12]

**6:** 1 bobble st, sc, dec, (2 sc, dec) x 2 [9]

**7:** sc in all 9 st [9]

Stuff rounds 1-6 with fiberfill. Don't stuff the rest of your work.

Change to beige, cut the jeans yarn.

**8:** BLO, (1 sc, dec) x 3 [6]

**9-16:** (8 rounds) sc in all 6 st [6]

Don't fasten off, but take a break here.

Go back to round 7 of the arm. Pull up a loop of jeans e yarn in the first leftover back loop (picture 12).

**1:** FLO, sc in all 9 st [9], cut the jeans yarn.

Go back to round 16 of the arm.  
Change to jeans, cut the beige yarn.

**17:** sc in all 6 st [6] (picture 13)

Turn your work and start to crochet the sleeve.



Sleeve

**1:** BLO, inc in all 6 st [12] (picture 14)

**2-5:** (4 rounds) sc in all 12 st [12] (pictures 15-16)

Slst in next st. Fasten off and weave in the yarn (picture 17).

Flatten and pin the arms symmetrically to both sides of the coat and sew between round 2 and 6 of the coat



# LEGS

## Leg 1

Start in pink.

**1:** 6 sc in a MR [6]

**2:** inc in all 6 st [12]

**3:** BLO, sc in all 12 st [12]

**4:** sc in all 12 st [12]

**5:** (2 sc, dec) x 3 [9]

Stuff rounds 1-5 with fiberfill. Don't stuff the rest of your work.

Change to off-white, cut the pink yarn.

**6:** BLO, (1 sc, dec) x 3 [6]

**7-10:** (4 rounds) sc in all 6 st [6]

Change to beige, cut the off-white yarn.

**11-20:** (10 rounds) sc in all 6 st [6]

Slst in next st. Fasten off, leaving a yarn tail.

Go back to round 5 of the leg. Pull up a loop of pink yarn in the first leftover back loop.

**1:** FLO, sc in all 9 st [9], cut the pink yarn.

## Leg 2

**1-6:** repeat the instructions for the Leg 1.

**7-8:** (2 rounds) sc in all 6 st [6]

Change to beige, cut the off-white yarn.

**9-20:** (12 rounds) sc in all 6 st [6]

Slst in next st. Fasten off, leaving a yarn tail.

Go back to round 5 of the leg. Pull up a loop of pink yarn in the first leftover back loop.

**1:** FLO, sc in all 9 st [9], cut the pink yarn.

Sew the legs to the bottom of the body between round 3 and 6 of the body.

## BEARD

In off-white

- 1: 6 sc in a MR [6]
- 2: inc in all 6 st [12]
- 3: (sc, inc) x 6 [18]
- 4: (sc, inc) x 9 [27]
- 5: sc in all 27 st [27]
- 6: (sc, inc) x 13, sc [40]
- 7: sc in all 40 st [40]
- 8: (sc, inc) x 20 [60]
- 9: sc in all 60 st [60]
- 10: (1 sc, inc) x 30 [90]
- 11: sc in all 90 st [90]

The beard doesn't need to be stuffed. Fold the piece in half and work the next round through both layers to close.

- 12: sc in all 45 st [45]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Position the beard between rounds 11 and 12, in the center of the face, and sew it on. The bottom edge doesn't need to be sewn on

## MUSTACHE

In off-white

Ch 25. Crochet in rows.

- 1: start in second ch from hook, sc in all 24 st [24], ch 1, turn

## NOSE

In beige.

- 1: 6 sc in a MR [6]
  - 2-6: (5 rounds) sc in all 6 st [6]
- Slst in next st. Fasten off, leaving a yarn tail. The nose doesn't need to be stuffed. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew the nose in the center of the face (right above the mustache)

## EAR (make 2)

In beige.


- 1: 6 sc in a MR [6]
- Fasten off, leaving a yarn tail. Pin the ears symmetrically to the sides of the mustache and sew them on.

**2:** (skip 1 st, 5 dc in next st, skip 1 st, 2 slst) x 4, skip 1 st, 5 dc in next st, skip 1 st, slst [34]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Position the mustache above the beard, the wider side is the bottom side, and sew it between rounds 11 and 12, in the center of the face.

# FINISHING TOUCHES

- Embroider individual strands of hair on the beard using silver yarn.
- Decorate the gnome with embroidery, beads and small buttons in different colors.

## BIRD

### HEAD AND BODY

In pink.

**1:** 7 sc in a MR [7]

**2:** inc in all 7 st [14]

**3-5:** (3 rounds) sc in all 14 st [14]

**6:** 3 sc in next st, 13 sc [16]

**7:** sc, 3 sc in next st, 14 sc [18]

**8:** 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, 15 sc [20]

**9:** 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, sc, 3 sc in next st, 15 sc [24]

**10:** sc in all 24 st [24]

I recommend embroidering or glue the eyes on the face when assembling and making the finishing touches. If you want to use safety eyes instead, you can insert them between rounds 4 and 5, with an interspace of approximately 3 stitches.

Stuff the head and body with fiberfill and continue stuffing as you go.

**11:** sc, (dec, 2 sc) x 5, dec, sc [18]

**12:** (sc, dec) x 6 [12]

**13:** 6 dec [6]

Fasten off leaving a tail about 10 cm long and cut the yarn.

Using a tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loops of the six stitches and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end.

## WING (make 2)

In off-white. The wing doesn't need to be stuffed.

**1:** 6 sc in a MR [6]

**2:** inc in all 6 st [12]

**3-4:** (2 rounds) sc in all 12 st [12]

**5:** (2 sc, dec) x 3 [9]

**6:** sc in all 9 st [9]

**7:** (1 sc, dec) x 3 [6]

Fasten off leaving a tail about 10 cm long and cut the yarn. Using a tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loops of the six stitches and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end.

Sew the wings to the sides of the body using a single strand of off-white yarn.

## TAIL

In off-white.

**1:** (ch 5, start in second ch from hook, 2 dc, sc, slst) x 2 [8]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew the tail between rounds 9 and 10 of the body

## FOOT

In off-white.

**1:** (ch 4, start in second ch from hook, dc, sc, slst) x 2 [6]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew the foot to the bottom of the body.

## BEAK

In off-white.

**1:** ch 3, start in second ch from hook, sc, slst [2]

Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing. Sew the beak between the eyes.
