

MY CHEESE SHIBA

----- *By NgocLinh* -----



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Have fun crocheting time <3

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NOTE:

- This pattern does not contain crochet or knitting lesson, so it is necessary to have basic knowledge of crocheting to understand it.
- The skill level is intermediate.
- It is prohibited to sell this pattern or its translated versions. No copying, publishing or distribution.
- You are allowed to sell the finished product made this pattern.

MATERIALS:

- Yarn and crochet hook size: depends on your choice, I use Milk Cotton 125g (made in China) with main color: ochre & white and crochet hook size 2.5mm.
- One pair of black safety eyes size 10mm.
- Fiberfill
- Stitch maker
- Scissors
- Black and white embroidery thread.

ABBREVIATIONS:

- MR: magic ring
- ch: chain
- slst: slip stitch
- rnd(s): round(s)/rows
- sc: single stitch
- inc: increase (2 single crochet in indicate stitch)
- dec: decrease (single crochet 2 stitches together, use the invisible decrease)

SIZE: The size of the shiba is depend on the yarn used. If you use the same materials as me, the finished size is 15cm.

HEAD:

Use ochre and white yarn. *Note:* red words in white yarn.

Make a chain of 5 ch, start in second ch from the crochet hook.

Rnd 1: inc, 2inc, 4sc into the last stitch, work on a long the other side: 2inc, inc.
(16)

Rnd 2: (sc, inc) x8 (24)

Rnd 3: (sc, inc, sc) x8 (32)

Rnd 4: (3sc, inc) x8 (40)

Rnd 5: (2sc, inc, 2sc) x8 (48)

Rnd 6: (5sc, inc) x8 (56)

Rnd 7: (3sc, inc, 3sc) x8 (64)

Rnd 8-14: (7 rounds) 64sc (64)

Rnd 15: 10sc, (*use marker for the first eye*),
10sc, (*use marker for the second eye*), 44sc.
(64)

Rnd 16: (sc, inc) x2, sc, (*sc, inc*) x2, 12sc, (*sc, inc*) x2, (inc, sc) x2, 35sc (72)

Rnd 17: 6sc, *26sc*, 40sc (72)

Rnd 18-22: (5 rounds) 5sc, *28sc*, 39sc (72)

Rnd 23: 5sc, *2sc*, (*dec, 7sc*) x2, *dec, 6sc*, sc, (dec, 7sc) x4, dec. (64)

Rnd 24: 3sc, dec, sc, *5sc*, (*dec, 6sc*) x2, *dec, 6sc*, (dec, 6sc) x3, dec, 3sc. (56)

Rnd 25: 5sc, dec, (*5sc, dec*) x2, *2sc*, 3sc, dec, (5sc, dec) x4 (48)

Rnd 26: (2sc, dec, 2sc) x8 (40)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

MUZZLE: Use white yarn

Rnd 1: 6sc into MR (6)

Rnd 2: 6inc (12)

Rnd 3: (sc, inc, sc) x4 (16)

Rnd 4: 16sc.

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Then, make eyes and embroider the nose and mouth with black embroidery thread.

Stuff the head with fiberfill.



EARS: (make 2)

Begin with ochre yarn, red words in white yarn.

Rnd 1: 6sc into MR (6)

Rnd 2: (sc, inc) x3 (9)

Rnd 3: (sc, inc, sc) x3 (12)

Rnd 4: 5sc, **sc**, 6sc (12)

Rnd 5: 3sc, inc, **3sc**, inc, 3sc, inc (15)

Rnd 6-8: (3 rounds) 4sc, **5sc**, 6sc (15)



LEGS:

Begin with white yarn:

Rnd 1: 6sc into MR (6)

Rnd 2: 6inc (12)

Rnd 3: 12sc (12)

Change ochre color yarn:

Rnd 4-5: (2 rounds) 12sc. (12)

Fasten off and weaves in ends.

Make the second leg: repeating round 1-5 but do not cut the yarn as we join the legs together to make the body. Stuff both legs firmly.



BODY:

From second leg make a chain of 5 ch.

Rnd 6: 12 sc on next 12 stitches of first leg (start from the slst of first leg), 5 sc on the chain, 12 sc on 12 stitches of second leg, 5 sc on the other side of the chain. (34)

Continue working the body:

Rnd 7: sc, (3sc, inc) x4, sc, (inc, 3sc) x4 (42)

Rnd 8-9: (2 rounds) 42 sc. (42)

Rnd 10: (3sc, inc, 3sc) x6 (48)

Rnd 11-14: (4 rounds) 48 sc (48)

Rnd 15: (5sc, dec, 5sc) x4 (44)

Rnd 16-18: (3 rounds) 44 sc (44)

Rnd 19: (9sc, dec) x4 (40)

Rnd 20-21: (2 rounds) 40 sc (40)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Stuff with fiberfill.

ARMS: (Make 2)

Start with white color yarn:

Rnd 1: 6 sc into MR (6)

Rnd 2: 6 inc (12)

Rnd 3: 12sc

Change ochre color yarn:

Rnd 4-10: (7 rounds) 12 sc (12)

Rnd 11: (4sc, dec) x2 (10)

Do not stuff, flatten and fold the top of the arm, sew the 2 opposed stitches.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.
