

# MY TINY OTTER

*My Tiny Otter pattern is published in April 2020 – Ngoc Linh*

### **NOTE:**

- This pattern does not contain crochet or knitting lesson, so it is necessary to have basic knowledge of crocheting to understand it.
- The skill level is intermediate.

### **SIZE:**

The size of Tiny Otter depends on the yarn used. If you use the same material as me, the finished size is 22cm.

### **MATERIALS:**

- Yarn and crochet hook size: depends on your choice, I use Jeans (Yarn Art) with 2 main color: color 87 for head & color 40 for body, crochet hook size 2.0mm.
- One pair of black safety eyes size 8mm.
- Fiberfill
- Stitch maker
- Scissors
- Yarn needle
- Black embroidery thread to make the mouth & the nose.

### **ABBREVIATIONS:**

- MR: magic ring
- ch: chain
- slst(s): slip stitch(s)
- rnd(s): round(s)/rows
- sc: single stitch
- inc: increase ( 2 single crochet in indicate stitch)
- dec: decrease ( single crochet 2 stitches together, use the invisible decrease)

**HEAD:** (start with color 87)

Make a chain of 6 ch, start in second ch from the crochet hook.

Rnd 1: inc, 3sc, 3sc into the last stitch, work on a long the other side: 3sc, sc (12)

Rnd 2: 2inc, 3sc, 3inc, 3sc, inc (18)

Rnd 3: (sc, inc) x2, 3sc, (sc, inc) x3, 3sc, sc, inc (24)

Rnd 4: (sc, inc, sc) x2, 3sc, (sc, inc, sc) x3, 3sc, sc, inc, sc (30)

Rnd 5: (3sc, inc) x2, 3sc, (3sc, inc) x3, 3sc, 3sc, inc (36)

Rnd 6: (2sc, inc, 2sc) x2, 3sc, (2sc, inc, 2sc) x3, 3sc, 2sc, inc, 2sc (42)

Rnd 7: (5sc, inc) x2, 3sc, (5sc, inc) x3, 3sc, 5sc, inc (48)

Rnd 8: (3sc, inc, 3sc) x2, 3sc, (3sc, inc, 3sc) x3, 3sc, 3sc, inc, 3sc (54)

Rnd 9: (7sc, inc) x2, 3sc, (7sc, inc) x3, 3sc, 7sc, inc (60)

Rnd 10: (4sc, inc, 4sc) x2, 3sc, (4sc, inc, 4sc) x3, 3sc, 4sc, inc, 4sc (66)

Rnd 11-15: (5 rounds) 66sc

*Note:* At rnd 12: 14sc, use marker for the first eye, 13sc, use marker for the second eye, 39sc

Rnd 16: 5sc, (3sc, inc) x3, 7sc, (inc, 3sc) x3, 30sc (72)

Rnd 17-22: (6 rounds) 72sc

**Change color 40:**

Rnd 23: (7sc, dec) x8 (64)

Rnd 24: (3sc, dec, 3sc) x8 (56)

Rnd 25: (5sc, dec) x8 (48)

Rnd 26: (2sc, dec, 2sc) x8 (40)

Rnd 27: (4sc, dec, 4sc) x4 (36)

*Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff the head with fiberfill.*

*Then, make eyes and embroider the mouth and the nose with black embroidery thread.*



**EARS** (make 2)

Rnd 1: 6sc into MR (6)

Rnd 2: 6inc (12)

*Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew the ear into Rnd 12-13 from top of the head.*



**LEGS:**

Starting the first leg with yarn color 74:

Rnd 1: 6sc into MR (6)

Rnd 2: 6inc (12)

Rnd 3: BLO 12sc

Rnd 4-6: 12sc

*Make the second leg: repeating round 1-5 but do not cut the yarn as we join the legs together to make the body. Stuff both legs firmly.*

**BODY:** (use yarn color 40)

From second leg make a chain of 3 ch.

Rnd 7: (sc, inc) x6 on next 12 stitches of first leg (start from the slst of first leg), 3inc on the chain, (sc, inc) x6 on 12 stitches of second leg, 3inc on the other side of the chain. (48)

*Continue working the body:*

Rnd 8: 48sc

Rnd 9: (7sc, inc) x6 (54)

Rnd 10-11: (2 rounds) 54sc

Rnd 12: (7sc, dec) x6 (48)

Rnd 13-15: 48sc

Rnd 16: (5sc, dec, 5sc) x4 (44)

Rnd 17-19: BLO 44sc

Rnd 20: (9sc, dec) x4 (40)

Rnd 21-22: 40sc

Rnd 23: (4sc, dec, 4sc) x4 (36)

Rnd 24-25: 36sc

*Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff firmly.*

**TAIL** (use yarn color 40)

Rnd1: 6sc into MR (6)

Rnd 2: (sc, inc) x3 (9)

Rnd 3: 9sc

Rnd 4: (sc, inc, sc) x3 (12)

Rnd 5: 12sc

Rnd 6: (sc, inc) x6 (18)

Rnd 7-8: (2 rounds) 18sc

Rnd 9: (sc, inc, sc) x6 (24)

Rnd 10-12: (3 rounds) 24sc  
Rnd 13: (2sc, dec, 2sc) x4 (20)  
Rnd 14-16: (3 rounds) 20sc  
Rnd 17: (3sc, dec) x4 (16)  
Rnd 18-20: (3 rounds) 16sc  
Rnd 21: (sc, dec, sc) x4 (12)  
Rnd 22-23: (2 rounds) 12sc

*Stuff firmly.*

*Fasten off. Fold the top of the ear, sew the 2 opposed stitches.*



**ARMS:** (Make 2)

Rnd 1: 5 sc into MR (5)  
Rnd 2: 5inc (10)  
Rnd 3-9: (7 rounds) 10sc

*Do not stuff, flatten and fold the top of the arm, sew the 2 opposed stitches. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.*
