Scarf with Hood in Sandnes Kashmir Alpakka



Sizes:

One size.

Finished measurements:

Finished length: 126 cm.

Required yarn:

Kashmir Alpakka

Colour 1042: 500 g.

Knitting needles:

Circular needle 5½ mm.

Tension:

17 sts st st on needles 5.5 mm = 10 cm.

Knit the first and last st on the row as these are edge sts.

Right hand side:

Cast on 56 sts on needle 5½ mm and knit 1 row (= WS).

Work pattern according to diagram **A** (edge sts are not included in the diagram).

On the last row of the diagram **A** adjust no of sts to 42 sts.

Continue to work pattern according to diagram **B** until work measures 80 cm.

Work to within 3 sts of the edge and inc 1 st from the RS a total of 40 times. The new sts are worked into the pattern.

Work approx 4 cm without inc.

Put work aside and work another part in same manner but mirror the inc.

Finishing:

Place RS on RS and knit alternating between the needles and at the same time cast off.

Sew the hood at the neck, start approx 8 cm after the 1st inc.

Translations for diagrams:

Slutt her = Finish here.

Gjenta = Repeat.

Beg her = Start here.

Rett på rettsiden, vrang på vrangside = Knit on the RS, purl on the WS.

Vrang på rettsiden, rett på vrangside = Purl on the RS, knit on the WS.

Kast = Yarn round needle.

2 r sm = k2tog.



2m vridd r sm = k2tog tbl.

3 m r sm = k3tog.

Strikk 2 m i 1 m = Work 2 sts into 1 st (= 1 st inc).

Strikk 2. m r foran 1. m, strikk 1. m r, la m gli av p = Knit the 2nd st in front of the 1st st, knit the 1st st, slip st.

- = Rett på rettsiden, vrang på vrangside
- = Vrang på rettsiden, rett på vrangside
- = Kast
- = 2 r sm
- = 2 m vridd r sm
- = 3 m r sm
- = Strikk 2 m i 1 m
- = Strikk 2. m r foran 1. m, strikk 1. m r, la m gli av p
