- **Yarn1 (background): 128 g** / 1 Whirl in 765 *Lemon Cassis Cream*
 - 18 g for the bottom
 - 110 g for mosaic
- **Yarn2 (contrast): 102 g** / 1 Whirlette in 888 *Acai Berry* and 16 g matching portion from 765 *Whirl Lemon Cassis Cream*
 - 90 g for mosaic
 - 12 g for upper edge backing
- **Yarn3 (white cheek): 8 g** / 1 Whirlette in 860 *Ice*
- **Yarn4 (eye): 1 g** / *same yarn as for handles*
- **Handles: 23 (50) g** / Whirlette in 853 *Mango* for hand-bag (shoulder-bag) handles
- **Beak (if different than Yarn2): 8 g** (reduce Yarn2 amount by 8 g)

- Optional for reinforcing the bottom: 26 cm x 6 cm/ 10 ¼" x 2 ¾" piece of plastic canvas (bag bottom measurements minus 2 cm/ ¾" from each side)

Rules for overlay mosaic crochet

- **Overlay mosaic crochet** is worked on **right side (RS) only**.
- **Each row or round** is made with **one color**. alternate 2 colors in each rnd. If working in rounds, finish each rnd with slip stitch (ss) blo made with next rnd color.
- **Sc (empty blocks on charts):** made in stitches from prev row through back loop only. Abbreviation *blo* (back loop only) is skipped to simplify instructions.
- **Dc, increases and decreases:** drop down stitches, made in the same color rnd (2nd rnd down) and through front loop only. Abbreviation *flo* (front loop only) is skipped to simplify instructions.
- **First sc or dc** of each rnd is made in 1st st from prev rnd or 2nd rnd down.
- **Invisible join** in rnds that start and end with dc: make last dc in 2 sts at the same time: in last and first dc of second round down.

Gauge

Mosaic crochet: 29.6 sts x 29.6 rows = 10cm x 10cm/ 4" x 4".

Gauge swatch instructions

Foundation cord:

Swatch is made with one color and in turning rows to avoid breaking yarn.

Row 1 (RS): make 32sts of fnd cord, turn, ch1 (doesn't count as st throughout), 32sc, turn.

Row 2 (WS): ch1, sc in same st (in both lps; = *border sc*), 30sc flo (front lp only) in pr, sc in

last st (in both lps; = *border sc*), turn.

Row 3 (RS): ch1, sc in same st (in both lps; = *border sc*), 30dc flo (front lp only) in 2nd row down, sc in last st (in both lps; = *border sc*), turn.

Rows 4-31: rep Rows 2 and 3.

Wash and dry according to *Care* section on p. 35. Measure, make sure to obtain the gauge, unravel.

At the End, Read How I Divided the Prototype Whirl

If you'd like to use all the colors from a gradient yarn cake as Yarn1, divide it into separate color balls and label each one with a number. To do this, cut a small tag, write the number on it, and attach it to the ball with a stitch marker to ensure you use them in the correct order.

In the Scheepjes Whirl cake, there is a visible joining point between different colors, commonly referred to as a "fuzz-buzz" by frequent users. When you encounter this fuzzy joining point, gently pull the yarn in opposite directions to break it cleanly.

The Scheepjes Whirl typically divides into **27 color balls**. The approximate weight of each

section, starting from the outside, is as follows:

- The first section: **17.8g**
- The next 25 sections: **7.8g each**
- The last section: **13.8g**

For this pattern, there are **50 Yarn1-rounds** in the mosaic section. Decide which colors to use (for instance, you may choose to exclude overly dark sections) and divide the number of Yarn1-rounds by the number of balls you'll be using. This will give you the number of rounds to work with each section. On average, one 7.8g section is enough for **4 rounds**.

If you're making a bag, account for approximately **10g of yarn** needed for the upper edge backing. This can also be made using Yarn2.

For a bag with a bottom, it's recommended to complete the bottom before dividing the Whirl.

How I Divided Whirl in 765 Lemon Cassis Cream for a Pillow and a Bag:

To prepare the Whirl for my project, I divided it as follows:

1. Dark Portion Removal:

I wound off **16.7g of the darkest portion** of the Whirl, which matched Whirllette in 888 Acai Berry (my Yarn2). This dark section was set aside to be used as Yarn2.

2. Additional Dark Sections:

I wound off **three more sections** that I considered too dark for Yarn1. When making the bag, I used this yarn for the bottom.

3. Remaining Sections:

After removing these portions, I was left with **23 color sections**.

4. Calculating Rounds per Section:

- My project required **50 rounds** in total.
- Dividing 50 rounds by 23 sections gave me approximately **2.2 rounds per section**.
- By working **2 rounds per**

section, I could complete **46 rounds**.

- This left **4 additional rounds** to reach the required 50 rounds.

5. Distributing the Extra Rounds:

To balance the additional rounds, I planned to work **3 rounds with 4 of the 23 sections**.

6. Final Round Plan for Yarn1:

- I used the **first section of Yarn1 for 3 rounds** (Rounds 1, 3, and 5).
- For the **next 19 sections**, I worked **2 rounds per section**.
- For the **last 3 sections**, I worked **3 rounds per section**.

As I worked, I gradually added the remaining portions of each color section into one ball to save for another project. I used Yarn2 to make the upper edge backing of the bag.

Rnd 1: with Yarn1 (background) reserve 80cm/ 31 1/2", make fnd cord of 52sts, ch1 (*doesn't count as st throughout*), 3sc (in 1st fnd cord st; **pm1 flo** in 1st sc; *move m up in 1st st throughout*), 50sc, sc5inc in last st (5sc in same st; **pm2 flo** in 3rd sc; *move m up in 1st st of back throughout*), 50sc (in other side of fnd), 2sc in same st as beg 3sc (count tog as sc5inc), ss blo in 1st sc (*blo in 1st st throughout*). (110sc)

Rnd 2: ch1, sc (in m1-sc; *sc blo in prev row throughout*), sc3inc, 52sc, sc3inc, sc (in m2-sc), sc3inc, 52sc, sc3inc, ss. (118sc)

Rnd 3: ch1, dc (in m1-sc; *all dc flo in 2nd row down throughout*), dc5inc, 52dc, dc5inc, dc (*move m2 flo*), dc5inc, 52dc, dc5inc (*use inv join for last dc in all rnds that start and end with dc*), ss. (126dc)

Rnd 4: ch1, 3sc, sc3inc, 56sc, sc3inc, 5sc, sc3inc, 56sc, sc3inc, 2sc, ss. (134sc)

Rnd 5: ch1, 3dc, dc5inc, 56dc, dc5inc, 5dc, dc5inc, 56dc, dc5inc, 2dc, ss. (142dc)

Rnd 6: ch1, 5sc, sc3inc, 60sc, sc3inc, 9sc, sc3inc, 60sc, sc3inc, 4sc, ss. (150sc)

Rnd 7: ch1, 5dc, dc5inc, 60dc, dc5inc, 9dc, dc5inc, 60dc, dc5inc, 4dc, ss. (158dc)

Rnd 8: ch1, 7sc, sc3inc, 64sc, sc3inc, 13sc, sc3inc, 64sc, sc3inc, 6sc, ss. (166sc)

Rnd 9: ch1, 7dc, dc5inc, 64dc, dc5inc, 13dc, dc5inc, 64dc, dc5inc, 6dc, ss. (174dc)

Rnd 10: ch1, 9sc, sc3inc, 68sc, sc3inc, 17sc, sc3inc, 68sc, sc3inc, 8sc, ss. (182sc)

Inc Rnd 11: ch1, 9dc, dc5inc, *6dc, [dc2inc, 13dc]x4, dc2inc, 5dc*, dc5inc, 17dc, dc5inc, rep bet *'s, dc5inc, 8dc, with Yarn2 (dark) ss. (200dc)

Straighten, measure, and keep this note for making lining: 28cm x 8cm/ 11" x 3 1/4".

Do not fasten off. Sk Rnd 1, go to Rnd 2 of Bag, pillow section.




Chart 1. Bag bottom.

There are two options for making a pillow: you can make the opening at the bottom, which is convenient if you plan to add a zipper, or at the top if you intend to join all sides and avoid having an open side with a fastening.

Pillow with opening at the bottom:

Rnd 1: with Yarn1 (background) reserve 50cm/ 20" to make a corner seam in preparation for stitching in a zipper, reserve 240cm/ 94" (or bag/pillow width x6) for fnd cord, with 2.5mm hook (regular size) make fnd cord of 200 sts (**pm1** in 1st st, **pm2** in 101st st), untwist, ss in 1st st to join in rnd, ch1 (*doesn't count as st throughout*), *200sc (1st in same st; **move m1 and m2** up throughout; **pm3** in m2 -fnd st for bottom seam), with Yarn2 ss blo in 1st sc. (200sc) Go to Rnd 2.

Bag without bottom or pillow with opening at the top:

• Rnds 1, 2:

Rnd 1: with Yarn1 (background) reserve 120cm/ 47", loosely or with 0.5mm bigger hook make fnd cord of 93sts, turn, with 2.5mm (smaller) hook ch1 (*doesn't count as st throughout*), sc2inc (in 1st fnd st), **pm1 flo** in 1st sc (*move m up in 1st st of front throughout*),

5sc, [sc2inc, 15sc]x5, sc2inc, 5sc, sc3inc (in last fnd st), **pm2 flo** in 2nd sc of sc3inc (= 1st st of back side; *move m up in 1st st of back throughout*),

in other side of fnd:

rep bet *'s, sc (in same st as beg sc2inc), with Yarn2 ss blo in 1st sc. (200sc)

Rnd 2: with Yarn2 ch1, 200sc (*sc blo in prev row throughout*), with Yarn1 ss (*blo in 1st st throughout*).

Rnd 3: *front:* with Yarn1 ch1, 11sc (1st in m1-st), 7dc (*dc flo in 2nd row down throughout*), 6sc, dec (1st leg below prev sc; *see Special stitches* on p. 6), 6dc, 3sc, 6dc, dec, 7sc (1st behind dec), dec (1st leg below prev sc), dc, dec, 4sc (1st behind dec), dec (1st leg below prev sc), 3dc, dec, 3sc (1st behind dec), sk sc, inc (*2dc in same st throughout*), 4dc, sc, 5dc, dec, 6sc (1st behind dec), sk sc, /2dc (*right-slanted dc: make in next or indicated st*), 10sc (1st behind dc), sk sc, /2dc, 4sc (1st behind dc),


Note about Yarn3:

- Yarn3 is an optional color used in *Rounds 37–77* for the cheek and light reflection. If preferred, all Yarn3-sts can be made with Yarn1.

Using more than one color in the same round:

Videos included in the instructions demonstrate how to work with multiple colors in the same round.

- **Finish previous st with a different color before switching:** When switching to a different color for the next stitch, finish the previous stitch using the new color. Specifically, make the last yarn over (yo) with the next color and draw it through the loops on the hook.



- **Enclosing non-working yarn in sc:** Always enclose non-working yarn in all sc. When incorporating Yarn3, carry Yarn1 through Yarn3-sc stitches (enclosed within the stitch), and vice versa—carry Yarn3 through Yarn1-sc stitches.



- **Before first Yarn3-section:** Enclose Yarn3 tail in 15sc before section when possible or leave tail to enclose in next round, finish last st with Yarn3.

- **Handling loose strands behind dc:** For **4 or fewer dc:** Leave a strand of the unused yarn on WS, ensuring it doesn't contract fabric.

For **more than 4 dc:**

Use one of 3 methods:

1) Leave a strand of the unused yarn on WS (slightly longer than the natural float to lift it to the next round level), enclosing it within sc of the following round.

2) Enclose unused yarn in dc (**Rnd 39:** <https://youtu.be/6Fq31YdvnNk>).

3) After finishing dc-section, remove lp from the hook, pick up unused yarn, and make ss in sts from prev rnd behind dc-section. Draw lp from last ss to RS through lp after last dc, then continue.

- **After last Yarn3 section:**

Finish last st of Yarn3-section with Yarn1, enclose Yarn3 tail in first 15sc or leave to enclose in next round if making dc. Alternatively, you can enclose Yarn3 backwards in the next row to the beginning of the next Yarn3-section.

- **Yarn3 tail reminders:** After finishing Yarn1-rnd, insert hook from RS 15 sts before first Yarn3-section and 15sts after last Yarn3 section, pick up Yarn3 tail and draw it to RS leaving a 15sts-strand on WS- it will remind you about the tail on WS.

- **Yarn2 rounds:** Enclose all loose strands from previous round when working sc.

Enclose beginning and ending Yarn3 tails if not enclosed in previous round.

- Stitch or crochet the bottom edges of the pillow cover together from both corners (from beg tail and m3) inward for approximately 2.5 cm (1").

Measure the Zipper Length

- Align the bottom and upper sides to ensure they are the same length. If the pillow insert is significantly larger than the cover, measure the side length with the insert inside to see how much it stretches. Add the difference to the zipper length.
- Measure the zipper length between the corner seams.
- Mark the same length on the zipper from the runner.
- Mark the ends of corner seams with pins for reference.

Shorten the Zipper (if needed)

- If the zipper is too long, stitch the teeth together on both sides, 0.5 cm (1/8") from the mark towards the end.

Pin the Zipper

- Start by pinning both ends, then the middle, and finally the rest.

Baste the Zipper

- Remove pins as you go.
- Baste 0.7 cm (1/4") from the zipper midline.
- Align the cover edge with the zipper midline.

Stitch the Zipper In

- Open the zipper and sew it in using an invisible hem stitch.
- Ensure your stitches are even and close to the zipper teeth for a neat finish. Take care not to catch the folded part of the invisible zipper, as this could prevent the runner from moving freely.
- Periodically check if the runner moves smoothly along the zipper.

7. Final Touches

- Remove the basting stitches.
- Trim excess zipper length. Overcast raw edges.

PU last Yarn2-lp, with lp on hook insert hook from RS in next st (1st st of front side), PU lp and draw it through st, [ss in next st from front side, take lp off hook, insert hook from RS in next st from back side, PU lp, draw it through st] rep for 28sts (to last dec of the second leaf on the front side), then cut Yarn2, switch to Yarn1 (weave in Yarn1 and Yarn2 tails if you don't have an opening at the bottom) and continue with yarn1 to last 7sts for which switch again to Yarn1 (weave tails if you don't have an opening at the bottom), with Yarn2 ss in m2-st (last). Fasten off.

Care

Hand-wash in lukewarm water with a bit of mild detergent, rinse, use a towel to squeeze out excess moisture, lay flat to dry.






Chart 3. Parrot eye.

Parrot eye.




Chart 4. Back.

Lining



- 1) Measure and cut fabric for lining.**
Soften bag by stretching it gently in all directions; lay flat on an even surface.
 Measure bag height and width:
 Bag Height (H): from the middle of the bottom to the upper edge not backing: 38cm/ 15".
 Bag width (W): (=34cm/ 13 3/8 ").

Calculate lining measurements:

Lining Height = bag H + 2cm/ 3/4" (for adjustments) + 2.5cm/ 1" (for SA/ seam allowance) =

$$38\text{cm} + 2\text{cm} + 2.5\text{cm} = \mathbf{42.5\text{cm}/ 16\ 3/4''}.$$

Lining Width: bag W x 2 – 1cm/ 3/8" (for adjustment) + 4cm/ 1 1/2" (for SA) =


$$34\text{cm} \times 2 - 1\text{cm} + 4\text{cm} = \mathbf{71\text{cm}/ 27\ 7/8''}.$$

Cut fabric to the measurements:


$$\mathbf{42.5\text{cm} \times 71\text{cm}/ 16\ 3/4'' \times 27\ 7/8''}.$$



- 2) Center seam.** Overcast bottom edge. Fold your fabric into half width-wise RS together, stitch center seam with 2cm/ 3/4" SA. Insert lining in, stretch the bag width-wise to check if it fits, re-do the center seam if necessary. When lining fits the bag, overcast SA's separately, press open.




- 3) Bottom seam.** With lining folded so that center seam is in the middle of one side, stitch bottom seam with 2.5cm/ 1" SA.



4) Bottom corner seams.

Seam length: bag bottom width (measured after completion) – 1.5cm = 8cm – 1.5cm = 6.5cm / $3 \frac{1}{8}'' - \frac{5}{8}'' = 2 \frac{1}{2}''$. Distance between the bag bottom corners and corner seams is half of the corner seam length ($6.5\text{cm} / 2 = 3.25\text{cm} (1 \frac{1}{4}'')$). Stitch two 6.5cm / $2 \frac{1}{2}''$ corner seams.



5) Fold corners inwards and sew with a whip stitch to the bottom. Sew the bottom seam allowances to the bag.



6) Optional bottom reinforcement.

Measure lining bottom. Cut plastic canvas to the bottom size minus 1.5cm / $\frac{5}{8}''$ each side. Trim corners.



7) Cut a piece of quilted fabric with 1cm / $\frac{3}{8}''$ SA on 3 sides to be folded in half and cover plastic canvas on both sides. Wrap plastic canvas in fabric, align edges, pin or baste along 3 sides. With canvas inside, make a seam along 3 sides. Trim SA close to the seam (0.5cm / $\frac{3}{16}''$), overcast raw edges. Place bottom reinforcement piece inside lining.




8) Cutting lining to size.

Insert the lining into the bag to check that its height matches the bag's height **without the backing**.

Before cutting, fold the lining at the desired cutting level, pin it in place, and fold the upper edge of the backing over the lining to ensure it fits properly. The lining should end just under the bag's upper edge so the backing can easily fold over it.

When you're 100% sure, trim the excess fabric from the lining's upper edge (usually 1cm/ $\frac{3}{8}$ "). The center seam comes undone after trimming; secure it with a few stitches.



9) Reinforce upper edge with buckram/ stabilizer.

Place 9cm/ 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " buckram (stiff but thin backing) or stabilizer (2mm thick very stiff backing) strip around the upper edge of the lining WS. Align upper edges, baste or pin together. Overlap strip edges by $\sim 2\text{cm}/ \frac{3}{4}$ " , make sure overlapping line does not align with center seam.

Overcast upper edge of the lining and buckram together. Start from beg of the buckram stripe. After finishing upper edge, turn and continue overcasting seam to join buckram short edges, turn and continue the seam along other side of the buckram stripe.




10) Finish lining.

Hand-stitch side SA to the lining. Make sure not to catch other side with your needle.



11) Snap Installation.


Align bag's sides (m1 and m2) with the lining sides at the upper edge and pin. Fold the upper edge backing inside the bag. Find the midpoints of the backing on the front and back (between handle ends), ensuring they align when folded at the side marks. Stitch magnet snap parts to the backing only (not the lining) at these midpoints with a couple of stitches per base. Fold the bag again at the side marks to confirm snap parts and handles align.



12) Pin the backing to the lining on both sides from the front snap. Unpin the sides of the bag from the lining and remove the lining. Stitch the front snap securely through both the backing and lining (not the bag exterior).



13) Place the lining inside the bag again, align and pin the sides together, and securely stitch the back snap through the backing, lining, and bag exterior.



14) Upper edge seam.

With RS of the bag facing, hand-stitch the bag to the lining with back-stitch, inserting needle through all 3 layers. Make smaller stitches along 4 handle bases to make sure they are stitched securely.



15) Backing seam.

Hand-stitch backing to the lining with whip stitch.

Bag bottom:

- **Approximate size:** 28cm x 8cm/ 11" x 3 ¼"
- Shown on a small sample. 2 colors are alternated for better visibility.



1) Rnd 1 (RS throughout): with Yarn1 make 52sts of foundation cord, ch1 (*doesn't count as st throughout*), 3sc in same st (sc3inc; *1st st of rnd is made in 1st st throughout*),



2) 50sc,



3) 5sc in last st (sc5inc),



4) 50sc (in the same fnd sts from other side), 2sc in same st as beg 2sc, with Yarn2 ss in 1st sc (*in 1st st and blo throughout*). (110sc)



5) Rnd 2 (all sc and sc-increases: in prev rnd and blo throughout): with Yarn2 ch1, sc, sc3inc, 52sc, sc3inc, sc, sc3inc, 52sc, sc3inc, with Yarn1 ss. (118sc)



6) Note: in Rnd 3 and in all rounds that start and end with dc, make last dc using invisible join technique: <https://youtu.be/Rr1gLY2AiFY>
Rnd 3 (all dc in 2nd rnd down and flo throughout): with Yarn1 ch1, dc, dc5inc, 52dc, dc5inc, dc, dc5inc, 52dc, dc5inc, with Yarn2 ss. (126dc)



7) Rnd 4: with Yarn2 ch1, 3sc, sc3inc, 56sc, sc3inc, 5sc, sc3inc, 56sc, sc3inc, 2sc, with Yarn1 ss. (134sc)



8) Rnd 5: with Yarn1 ch1, 3dc, dc5inc, 56dc, dc5inc, 5dc, dc5inc, 56dc, dc5inc, 2dc, with Yarn2 ss. (142dc)
Continue with written instructions.
