



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Inc = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop

P = Purl

P2tog = Purl next 2 stitches together

Pss0 = Pass slipped stitch over

Rep = Repeat

Rem = Remaining


RS = Right side

Sl1 = Slip next stitch knitwise

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side



MATERIALS

Patons® Classic Wool Worsted™ (3.5 oz/100 g, 194 yds/177 m)

Contrast A Navy Blue (77773) **1 ball or 160 yds/146 m**

Contrast B Winter White (00201) **1 ball or 160 yds/146 m**

Note: 1 ball each of Contrast A and B will make 2 Sweaters, 4 Toques and 4 pairs of Mittens (see Notes on page 2 for color placement).

Sizes U.S. 5 (3.75 mm) and U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) Susan Bates® knitting needles **or sizes needed to obtain gauge.** Size U.S. G/6 (4 mm) Susan Bates® crochet hook for Mittens. Susan Bates® yarn needle. Safety pins. Optional: Matching Coats & Clark® Cotton Embroidery Floss for hanging loops.

MEASUREMENTS

Sweater: 3½" [9 cm] wide.

Mittens: 2½" [6 cm] long, excluding string.

Toque: 3" [7.5 cm] tall, including pompom.

GAUGE

20 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Make 1 of each Version throughout with A as Color 1 and B as Color 2.
- Make 1 of each Version throughout with B as Color 1 and A as Color 2.

SWEATER



Back: With Color 2 and smaller needles, cast on 19 sts. Break Color 2.

****1st row:** (RS). With Color 1, K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.
2nd row: P1. *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.
 Rep these 2 rows of (K1. P1) ribbing once more.**

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st for 12 rows, ending on a purl row.

Shape raglans: Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Next row: K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.


Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. 7 sts. Leave these sts on a safety pin.

Front: Work as given for Back.

Optional: Work duplicate st motif on Front, placing 1st row of Chart 7 rows up from ribbing as shown.

Duplicate St Chart



KEY

- = Color 1
- = Color 2 Duplicate st

Sleeves: With A and smaller needles cast on 11 sts. Break A. Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st, inc 1 st each end of needle on 3rd and following 6th row. 15 sts.

Work 1 row even.

Shape raglans: Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Next row: K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 2 times more. 5 sts.

Next row: K1. Sl1. K2tog. pss0. K1. 3 sts.


Next row: Purl.

Leave these sts on a safety pin.

Neckband: Sew raglan seams, leaving left back raglan open. With RS of work facing and smaller needles, K3 from left sleeve safety pin, K7 from front safety pin, K3 from right sleeve safety pin and K7 from back safety pin. 20 sts. Work 9 rows in (K1. P1) ribbing. Cast off in ribbing.

Sew left back raglan and collar seam with mattress st.

Sew side and sleeve seams with mattress st.



MATTRESS ST

TOQUE

Contrast Edge Version



With Color 2 and smaller needles, cast on 21 sts. Break Color 2.

1st row: (RS). With Color 1, K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: P1. *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.
 Rep these 2 rows of (K1. P1) ribbing once more.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st for 8 rows, ending on a purl row.

*****Next row:** *K2. K2tog. Rep from * to last st. K1. 16 sts.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: (K2tog) 8 times. 8 sts.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: (K2tog) 4 times. 4 sts. Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Fasten off.

Sew seam. Fold cuff to RS.

Pompom: Wind Color 2 around 3 fingers approx 40 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to a smooth round shape approx 1" [2.5 cm] in diameter. Sew to top of Toque.***



Stripe Version



With Color 1 and smaller needles, cast on 21 sts.

1st row: (RS). K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: P1. *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows of (K1. P1) ribbing once more.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st as follows:
With Color 2, work 2 rows.
With Color 1, work 2 rows.
Rep these 4 rows once more.

Work from *** to *** as given for Contrast Edge Version.

MITTENS Contrast Edge Version



With Color 2 and smaller needles, cast on 15 sts. Break Color 2.

******1st row:** (RS). With Color 1, K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: P1. *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows of (K1. P1) ribbing once more.

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows:

Next row: (RS). K7. M1. K1. M1. K7. 17 sts.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: K7. Slip next 3 sts onto a safety pin. M1. K7.****

Beg with a purl row, work 8 rows in stocking st.

*******Next row:** (WS). (P2tog) 7 times. P1. 8 sts.

Next row: Knit.

Next row: (P2tog) 4 times. 4 sts.

Break yarn, leaving a 10" [25.5 cm] end. Thread end through rem sts and sew side seam.

Thumb: With RS of work facing, Color 1 and larger needles, knit across 3 sts from safety pin. Pick up and knit 1 st on opposite side of thumb hole. 4 sts. Slip these 4 sts onto left-hand needle.

Next row: Knit. Slip sts onto left-hand needle.

Rep last row twice more.

Next row: (K2tog) twice.

Break yarn leaving a long end. Thread end through rem sts. Fasten off.

Crochet String: With crochet hook make a chain 6" [15 cm] long.

Fasten off.

Sew 1 Mitten to each end of Crochet String.*****

Stripe Version



With Color 1 and smaller needles, cast on 15 sts.

Work from **** to **** as given for Contrast Edge Version.

Next row: Purl.

Proceed in stocking st as follows:
With Color 2, work 2 rows.

With Color 1, work 2 rows.

With Color 2, work 2 rows.

Next row: With Color 1, knit.

Work from ***** to ***** as given for Contrast Edge Version.

FINISHING

Cut embroidery floss to desired length and thread onto yarn needle. Secure to ornament top and tie ends together with bow or overhand knot to form hanging loop.
