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The sample shown on this page is a small summer scarf, measuring approximately 17in/43cm wide by 45in/114cm long. It was knit on 3.25mm/US3 needles with a half set of colorshift yarn in the Peacock Blue to Hot Pink color bridge colorway.

Yardage: approximately 320yds/300m.

A project worked with full set of the yarn and a 138st CO will measure approximately 26in/66cm wide by 57in/145cm long.

Notes

The stitches that will be dropped are highlighted in grey in the chart as a visual aid to the structure of the lace patterning. They are worked as normal knit stitches on the RS, and purl stitches on the WS.

The stitches can be dropped at any point in the project: as you work a RS row drop the pairs of stitches and replace them with double yarn overs. On the next row purl the second of each pair of yarn overs through the back loop.

ktbl means knit through the back loop.

ptbl means purl through the back loop.

Kfb means knit into the front and the back of the stitch.

Instructions:

CO 88 sts

For a wider version CO 138sts (or 38 + a multiple of 50)

Work 3 rows of garter stitch.

RS rows of the chart are worked from right to left.

WS rows are worked from left to right.

Work rows 1 & 2 once. Row 1 reduces the stitch count to 74/114 (or 34 + multiple of 40), and creates the yarn overs which will be the beginning of the waves of dropped stitches.

Repeat rows 3 - 22 to desired length.

The sample has 11 repeats of rows 3 - 22.

Work row 23 once. This row increases the stitch count back to 88/138 (or 38 + a multiple of 50).

Work 3 rows of garter st. On the first of these rows knit the second yarn over of all the double yarn overs through the back loop.

BO loosely & block.
