Sandnes Garn Kos - 150m/50g (62% baby alpaca, 9% merino, 29% polyamide) in 1 thread,
Infinity Design Air - 150m/50g (65% baby alpaca, 7% merino, 28% polyamide) in 1 thread,
Drops Air - 150m/50g (65% baby alpaca, 7% merino, 28% polyamide) in 1 thread. Casagrande
Angora 80 - 112m/25g (80% angora, 20% polyamide) in 2 threads,
Piu Bella - Angora Spike Regina – 125m/25g (80% angora, 20% merino) in 2 threads, Piu Bella -
Angora Spike Regina Plus – 125m/25g (80% angora, 20% polyamide) in 2 threads, Casa del Filato
– Angorino – 125m/25g (80% angora, 20% polyamide) in 2 threads,
Chinese mink – 350m/50g (90% mink down, 10% polyamide) in 2 threads + 1(2) additional thread (a
spool of additional thread is included with the mink skein yarn).

Materials:

- Circular knitting needles No. 3.5, with a line length of 40 cm
- Circular knitting needles No. 4 with a line length of 40 cm
- Circular knitting needles No. 4.5 with a line length of 40 cm (for a snood)

Additional materials:

- Stitch markers (5 pcs)
- Hook
- Wide eye needle
- Measuring tape
- Scissors

Knitting density:

For the hat:

In the pattern(top of the hat): Sample after

WTO with 4 mm knitting needles: 18-18.5 sts

* 26 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm.

In stockinette stitch(inner part of the product - lining): Sample

after WTO with 4 mm knitting needles: 19-19.5 sts * 27 rows = 10 cm

x 10 cm.

For the snood:

In the pattern:

Sample after WTO with 4.5 mm knitting needles:

17.5-18 sts * 25 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm.

You can also make your own calculations for knitting a snood based on your individual density.

Important! Maintain the specified density. If you don't get my density, then try with by selecting a larger or smaller size of knitting needles.

2 persons together. pr.-2 stitches together knitwise with a tilt **to the right**;



Patterns:

The pattern on the top of the product is a pearl pattern.

In circular knitting:

1 row.1 knit stitch, 1 purl stitch. **Row 2.**1 knit stitch, 1 purl stitch. **Row 3.**1 purl, 1 knit **Row 4.**1 purl, 1 knit



In rotary knitting left from the Mongolian People's Republic:

Row 1 (RS):1 knit stitch, 1 purl stitch. **Row 2 (RS):**1 knit stitch, 1 purl stitch. **Row 3 (RS):**1 purl, 1 knit **Row 4 (RS):**1 purl, 1 knit



In rotary knitting on the right from the Mongolian People's Republic:

Row 1 (RS):1 knit stitch, 1 purl stitch. **Row 2 (RS):**1 knit stitch, 1 purl stitch. **Row 3 (RS):**1 purl, 1 knit **Row 4 (RS):**1 purl, 1 knit

Note:The diagrams above are for the pattern itself, not the 'ears.' To make it easier to understand, remember this tip:

- in turning knitting to the left of the MNR, the pattern changes in each front row;
 - in rotary knitting to the right of the MNR, the pattern changes in each purl row.

The pattern on the inside of the product (lining) is front stitch.

When knitting in a rotary pattern: in the front row, all stitches are front loops, in the back row, all stitches are back loops.

When knitting in the round, all stitches are knit.

We kindly ask you to carefully read the technical instructions for some elements before starting the work!

Design:

The hat is knitted in one piece, seamlessly. First, the top part of the hat is knitted, then the inner part—the lining—is knitted.



Size 40-42

With waste thread (any contrasting thread of similar thickness) using a circular hook knitting needles 3.5 (or 0.5 size smaller than the needles you used to get the density in the pattern) cast on **68 loops** (as shown in the video below) and close the knitting in a circle.

We hang it up **Mongolian People's Republic** and knit:

1 row. All loops are knit.

Row 2. We knit all the stitches as front loops and simultaneously place markers:

Mongolian People's Republic, 8 loops, **M1**, 13 loops, **M2**, 27 loops, **M3**, 13 loops, **M4**, 7 loops.

Next we will knit our "ears" using shortened rows using wrapped loops and rotary knitting.

Switch to needles 4 (or the size of needles that you used to get the density in the pattern).

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting left from the Mongolian People's Republic.*

Row 3. (LS): **Mongolian People's Republic**, 8 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with the front loop), **M1**, 9 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, we start with the front loop), wrap the next loop and turn the work to the front;

Row 4. (IS): 5 loops according to the pattern (row 2 of the pattern, start with the purl st), wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 5. (LS): 5 loops according to the pattern (row 3 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the front loop together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 6. (IS): 6 loops according to the pattern (row 4 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the purl stitch together with the wrap with a purl stitch, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 7. (LS): 7 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the front loop together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 8. (IS): 8 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit purl.

p. together with the wrapping of the purl, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 9.(LS):9 loops according to the pattern (row 3 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the front loop together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 10.(IS):10 loops according to the pattern (row 4 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the purl stitch together with the wrap with a purl stitch, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 11.(LS):11 stitches according to the pattern (row 1 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the front stitch together with the wrap, **M2**, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 12.(IS):**M2**, 12 loops according to the pattern (row 2 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the purl stitch together with the wrap, **M1**, 8 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with the front loop), **Mongolian People's Republic**,

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting on the right from the Mongolian People's Republic*.

7 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with the front loop), **M4**, 9 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with the purl st.), wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 13.(LS):5 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with the front loop), wrap the next loop and turn the work to the front loop;

Row 14.(IS):5 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, start with the front loop), lift the wrap and knit the purl loop together with the wrap with the back loop, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the front loop;

Row 15.(LS):6 loops according to the pattern (row 4 of the pattern, start with a front loop), lift the wrap and knit the front loop together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the back loop;

Row 16.(IS):7 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with the front loop), lift the wrap and knit the purl loop together with the wrap with the back loop, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the front loop;

Row 17.(LS):8 loops according to the pattern (row 2 of the pattern, start with a front loop), lift the wrap and knit the front loop together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the back loop;

Row 18.(IS):9 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, start with the front loop), lift the wrap and knit the purl loop together with the wrap with the back loop, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the front loop;

Row 19.(LS):10 loops according to the pattern (row 4 of the pattern, start with a front loop), lift the wrap and knit the front loop together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the back loop;

Row 20.(IS):11 stitches according to the pattern (row 1 of the pattern, start with the front stitch), lift the wrap and knit the purl stitch together with the wrap, **M3**, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 21.(LS):**M3**, 12 loops according to the pattern (row 2 of the pattern, start with the front loop), lift the wrap and knit the front loop together with the wrap, **M4**, 7 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.), **Mongolian People's Republic**,

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting left from the Mongolian People's Republic*.

8 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.), **M1**, 13 loops according to the pattern (row 3 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the front loop together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

We remove markers M2, M3, leaving only the marker **M1, M4 and Mongolia**.

Row 22.(IS):14 loops according to the pattern (row 4 of the pattern, start with the purl st.), **M1**, 8 loops according to the pattern (4th row of the pattern, start with the purl st.), **Mongolian People's Republic**,

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting on the right* from the Mongolian People's Republic.

7 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.), **M4**, 13 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, we start with the front loop), lift the wrap and knit the purl loop together with the wrap with the back loop, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the front loop;

Row 23.(LS):14 stitches according to the pattern (row 4 of the pattern, start with knit stitches), **M4**, 7 loops according to the pattern (4th row of the pattern, start with the front loop), **Mongolian People's Republic**,

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting left* from the Mongolian People's Republic.

8 stitches according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with knit stitches), **M1**, 14 loops according to the pattern (row 1 of the pattern, start with a knit stitch), lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 24.(IS):15 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.), **M1**, 8 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with the front loop), **Mongolian People's Republic**,

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting on the right* from the Mongolian People's Republic.

7 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with the front loop), **M4**, 14 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the purl stitch together with the wrap with a purl stitch, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 25.(LS):15 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with the front loop), **M4**, 7 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.), **Mongolian People's Republic**,

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting left* from the Mongolian People's Republic.

8 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.), **M1**, 15 loops according to the pattern (row 3 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), pick up the wrap and knit together with the wrap from the front, 21 loops according to the pattern (row 3 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), pick up the wrap and knit together with the wrap from the front from the previous row,

15 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.), **M4**, 7 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, start with the front loop).

Next we move on to circular knitting and use *pearl pattern in circular knitting*. We remove markers M1 and M4, leaving only the marker **Mongolian People's Republic**.

Row 26. 68 loops according to the pattern (4th row of the pattern).

Row 27. 68 stitches in pattern (1 row of pattern).

Row 28. 68 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern).

Row 29. 68 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern).

Row 30. 68 loops according to the pattern (4th row of the pattern).

Repeat rows 27-30 again **4.5 times** (total 18 rows) or a total of 24 rows in front of the pattern.

The height of the front of the hat from the beginning of the pattern should be ~ 9.5 cm.

Formation of the crown

Let's start shaping the crown.

The crown closure will consist of 4 wedges.

To do this, we need to place markers as follows (without knitting loops):

Mongolian People's Republic, 9 loops, **M1**, 16 loops, **M2**, 18 loops, **M3**, 16 loops, **M4**, 9 loops.

We will form the crown of the upper part of the hat lining using decreases:

For convenience, we reset the row numbers to zero.

1 row. (1 row of pattern): 68 loops according to pattern;

Row 2. (2nd row of pattern): **Mongolian People's Republic**, 7 loops according to the pattern, 2 together knit stitches, **M1**, 2 together purl, 12 loops according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M2**, 2 together purl, 14 stitches according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M3**, 2 together purl, 12 loops according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M4**, 2 together purl pr, 7 loops according to pattern;

Row 3. (3rd row of pattern): 60 loops according to pattern;

Row 4. (4th row of the pattern): **Mongolian People's Republic**, 6 loops according to the pattern, 2 together knit stitches,

M1, 2 together purl, 10 loops according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M2**, 2 together purl, 12 loops according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M3**, 2 together purl, 10 loops according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M4**, 2 together purl pr, 6 loops according to pattern;

Row 5.(1 row of pattern): 52 loops according to pattern;

Row 6.(2nd row of pattern):**Mongolian People's Republic**, 5 loops according to the pattern, 2 together. persons. l., **M1**, 2 together purl, 8 loops according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M2**, 2 together purl, 10 loops according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M3**, 2 together purl, 8 loops according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M4**, 2 together purl pr, 5 loops according to pattern;

Row 7.(3rd row of pattern): 44 loops according to pattern;

Row 8.(4th row of the pattern):**Mongolian People's Republic**, 4 loops according to the pattern, 2 together. knit., **M1**, 2 together purl, 6 loops according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M2**, 2 together purl, 8 loops according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M3**, 2 together purl, 6 loops according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M4**, 2 together purl pr, 4 loops according to pattern;

Row 9.(1 row of pattern): 36 loops according to pattern;

Row 10.(2nd row of pattern):**Mongolian People's Republic**, 3 loops according to the pattern, 2 together. knit., **M1**, 2 together purl, 4 stitches according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M2**, 2 together purl, 6 loops according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M3**, 2 together purl, 4 stitches according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M4**, 2 together purl pr, 3 loops according to pattern;

Row 11.(3rd row of the pattern): 28 loops according to the pattern;

Row 12.(4th row of the pattern):**Mongolian People's Republic**, 2 loops according to the pattern, 2 together knit stitches, **M1**, 2 together purl, 2 stitches according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M2**, 2 together purl, 4 stitches according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M3**, 2 together purl, 2 stitches according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M4**, 2 together purl pr, 2 loops according to pattern;

Row 13.(1 row of pattern): 20 loops according to pattern;

Row 14.(2nd row of pattern):**Mongolian People's Republic**, 1 loop according to pattern, 2 together knit stitches,

M1, 2 together purl right, 2 together front left,

M2, 2 together purl, 2 stitches according to pattern, 2 together knit, **M3**, 2 together purl right, 2 together front left, **M4**, 2 together purl 1 loop according to pattern;

Row 15.(4th row of the pattern):**Mongolian People's Republic**, 2

together persons. l., **M1**, 1 front st, 1 purl st, **M2**, 2 together purl right, 2 together front left, **M3**, 1 front st, 1 purl st,

M4, 2 together out. pr.

We cut the thread and thread it into a needle with a wide eye.

We slip the remaining stitches onto the needle, simultaneously removing the markers and tightening the remaining stitches. Bring the yarn to the back and secure the tail with a few knots, hiding it.

Knitting the lining

Let's start knitting the inner part of the hat - the lining.

To do this, we need to unravel the waste (contrast thread) and pick it up with 3.5 knitting needles (or 0.5 size smaller than the needles with which you got the density in the front surface) - **68 loops** as shown in the video

We attach the lining thread and knit 1 row with face stitches, simultaneously placing markers:

Mongolian People's Republic, 7 persons. p., **M1**, 13 persons. p., **M2**, 27 persons. p., **M3**, 13 persons. p., **M4**, 8 persons. p.

Next, we will knit our "ears" using shortened rows using wrapped loops using rotary knitting (see the "Techniques" section).

Next, we will knit the lining with 4 knitting needles (or the size of knitting needles that you used to get the density in the front surface) in the front surface.

Row 2.(LS): **Mongolian People's Republic**, 7 persons. p., **M1**, 9 persons. p., wrap the next loop and turn the work to the WS;

Row 3.(IS): 5 purl sts, wrap next loop and turn work onto RS;

Row 4.(LS): 5 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 5.(IS): 6 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 6.(LS):7 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 7.(IS):8 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl sts together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 8.(LS):9 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 9.(IS):10 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 10.(LS):11 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitches together with the wrapping stitch,**M2**, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 11.(IS):12 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl sts together with the wrapping purl st,**M1**, 7 out. p., **Mongolian People's Republic**, 8 out. p.,**M4**, 9 purl sts, wrap next loop and turn work onto RS;

Row 12.(LS):5 knit stitches, wrap next stitch and turn work onto WS;

Row 13.(IS):5 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 14.(LS):6 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 15.(IS):7 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 16.(LS):8 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 17.(IS):9 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 18.(LS):10 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 19.(IS):11 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl sts together with the wrapping purl st,**M3**, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 20.(LS):12 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap,**M4**, 8 persons. p., **Mongolian People's Republic**, 7 persons. p.,**M1**, 13 persons. st., lift the wrap and knit persons. st. together with the wrap with a face, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

We remove markers M2, M3, leaving only the marker**M1, M4 and Mongolia**.

Row 21.(IS):14 purl sts,**M1**, 7 out. p.,**Mongolian People's Republic**, 8 out. p.,**M4**, 13 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 22.(LS):14 persons. p.,**M4**, 8 persons. p.,**Mongolian People's Republic**, 7 persons. p.,**M1**, 14 persons. st., lift the wrap and knit persons. st. together with the wrap with a face, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 23.(IS):15 purl sts,**M1**, 7 out. p.,**Mongolian People's Republic**, 8 out. p.,**M4**, 14 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 24.(LS):15 persons. p.,**M4**, 8 persons. p.,**Mongolian People's Republic**, 7 persons. p.,**M1**, 15 persons. p., lift the wrap and knit persons. p. together with the wrapping face, 21 persons. p., lift the wrap and knit persons. p. together with the wrapping face,

15 persons. p.,**M4**, 8 persons. p.

Next we move on to circular knitting and knit with the front surface.

We remove markers M1 and M4, leaving only the marker**Mongolian People's Republic**.

Knit with the garter stitch to a height of 9-9.5 cm, measured from the beginning of the front part of the hat.

Note: don't forget to secure the ends of the thread inside out at the base of the hat, which was left of the top layer of the hat and the lining.

Formation of the crown

Let's start shaping the crown.

Ties

To do this, find the center of our "ears" and pick up 4 loops with a crochet hook (as shown in the video). Transfer these loops to 4-mm needles and knit a hollow cord 60-65 rows long (or any desired length).

With waste thread (any contrasting thread of similar thickness) using a circular hook knitting needles 3.5 (or 0.5 size smaller than the needles you used to get the density in the pattern) cast on **72 loops** (as shown in the video below) and close the knitting in a circle.

Row 27.(IS):13 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl sts together with the wrapping purl st,**M3**, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 28.(LS):14 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap,**M4**, 6 persons. p., **Mongolian People's Republic**, 7 persons. p.,**M1**, 15 persons. p.,**M2**, lift the wrap and knit the front st together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the front st;

We remove markers M2, M3, leaving only the marker**M1, M4 and Mongolia**.

Row 29.(IS):16 purl sts,**M1**, 7 out. p.,**Mongolian People's Republic**, 6 out. p.,**M4**, 15 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

To do this, find the center of our "ears" and pick up 4 loops with a crochet hook (as shown in the video). Transfer these loops to 4-mm needles and knit a hollow cord 60-65 rows long (or any desired length).

Size 46-48

With waste thread(any contrasting thread of similar thickness) using a circular hook knitting needles 3.5 (or 0.5 size smaller than the needles you used to get the density in the pattern) cast on **76 loops**(as shown in the video below) and close the knitting in a circle.

Next, we will knit the lining with 4 knitting needles (or the size of knitting needles that you used to get the
density in the front surface) in the front surface.

Row 2.(LS):**Mongolian People's Republic**, 7 persons. p.,**M1**, 9 persons. p., wrap the next loop and turn the work to the WS;

Row 3.(IS):3 purl sts, wrap next loop and turn work onto RS;

Row 4.(LS):3 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 5.(IS):4 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 6.(LS):5 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 7.(IS):6 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 8.(LS):7 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 9.(IS):8 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap purl st, 1 purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 10.(LS):9 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 11.(IS):10 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 12.(LS):11 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 13.(IS):12 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 14.(LS):13 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap,**M2**, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 15.(IS):14 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl sts together with the wrapping purl st,**M1**, 7 out. p., **Mongolian People's Republic**, 8 out. p.,**M4**, 9 purl sts, wrap next loop and turn work onto RS;

Row 16.(LS):3 knit stitches, wrap next stitch and turn work onto WS;

Row 17.(IS):3 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 18.(LS):4 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 19.(IS):5 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 20.(LS):6 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 21.(IS):7 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 22.(LS):8 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 23.(IS):9 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 24.(LS):10 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 25.(IS):11 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 26.(LS):12 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next stitch and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 27.(IS):13 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl sts together with the wrapping purl st,**M3**, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 28.(LS):14 knit stitches, lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap,**M4**, 8 persons. p., **Mongolian People's Republic**, 7 persons. p.,**M1**, 15 persons. st., lift the wrap and knit persons. st. together with the wrap with a face, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

We remove markers M2, M3, leaving only the marker**M1, M4 and Mongolia.**

Row 29.(IS):16 purl sts,**M1**, 7 out. p.,**Mongolian People's Republic**, 8 out. p.,**M4**, 15 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 30.(LS):16 persons. p.,**M4**, 8 persons. p.,**Mongolian People's Republic**, 7 persons. p.,**M1**, 16 persons. st., lift the wrap and knit persons. st. together with the wrap with a face, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 31.(IS):17 purl sts,**M1**, 7 out. p.,**Mongolian People's Republic**, 8 out. p.,**M4**, 16 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 32.(LS):17 persons. p.,**M4**, 8 persons. p.,**Mongolian People's Republic**, 7 persons. p.,**M1**, 17 persons. st., lift the wrap and knit persons. st. together with the wrap with a face, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 33.(IS):18 purl sts,**M1**, 7 out. p.,**Mongolian People's Republic**, 8 out. p.,**M4**, 17 purl sts, lift the wrap and knit the purl st together with the wrap with the purl st, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 34.(LS):18 persons. p.,**M4**, 8 persons. p.,**Mongolian People's Republic**, 7 persons. p.,**M1**, 18 persons. p., lift the wrap and knit persons. p. together with the wrapping face, 23 persons. p., lift the wrap and knit persons. p. together with the wrapping face,

Next, we switch to circular knitting and knit with the stockinette stitch. Remove markers M1 and M4, leaving only the marker. **Mongolian People's Republic**.

Knit with the front stitch to a height of 11 cm, measured from the beginning of the front part of the hat.

Note: don't forget to secure the ends of the thread inside out at the base of the hat, which was left of the top layer of the hat and the lining.

Formation of the crown

Let's start shaping the crown.

The crown closure will consist of 4 wedges.

We will form the top of the lining using decreases:

We cut the thread and thread it into a needle with a wide eye.

We slip the remaining stitches onto the needle, simultaneously removing the markers and tightening the remaining stitches. Carefully secure the tail with a few knots and hide it.

Ties

We will make the ties with a hollow cord.

To do this, find the center of our "ears" and pick up 4 loops with a crochet hook (as shown in the video). Transfer these loops to 4-mm needles and knit a hollow cord 60-65 rows long (or any desired length).

We cut off the end of the thread and, using a needle, tighten the loops and hide the tail inside the hollow cord.

We knit the second tie in the same way as the first.

Congratulations, your hat is ready!

Size 49-51

With waste thread (any contrasting thread of similar thickness) using a circular hook knitting needles 3.5 (or 0.5 size smaller than the needles you used to get the density in the pattern) cast on **80 loops** (as shown in the video below) and close the knitting in a circle.

We hang it up **Mongolian People's Republic** and knit:

1 row. All loops are knit.

Row 2. We knit all the stitches as front loops and simultaneously place markers:

Mongolian People's Republic, 8 loops, **M1**, 17 loops, **M2**, 31 loops, **M3**, 17 loops, **M4**, 7 loops.

Next we will knit our "ears" using shortened rows using wrapped loops and rotary knitting.

Switch to needles 4 (or the size of needles that you used to get the density in the pattern).

Row 4. (IS): 5 loops according to the pattern (row 2 of the pattern, start with the purl st), wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 5. (LS): 5 loops according to the pattern (row 3 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the front loop together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 6. (IS): 6 loops according to the pattern (row 4 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the purl stitch together with the wrap with a purl stitch, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 7. (LS): 7 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the front loop together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 8.(IS):8 loops according to the pattern (row 2 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the purl stitch together with the wrap with a purl stitch, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 17.(LS):5 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with the front loop), wrap the next loop and turn the work to the front loop;

Row 18.(IS):5 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, start with the front loop), lift the wrap and knit the purl loop together with the wrap with the back loop, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the front loop;

Row 19.(LS):6 loops according to the pattern (row 4 of the pattern, start with a front loop), lift the wrap and knit the front loop together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the back loop;

Row 20.(IS):7 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with the front loop), lift the wrap and knit the purl loop together with the wrap with the back loop, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the front loop;

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting* **left** from the **Mongolian People's Republic**.

8 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.),**M1**, 17 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the front loop together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

We remove markers M2, M3, leaving only the marker **M1, M4 and Mongolia**.

Row 30.(IS):18 stitches according to the pattern (row 4 of the pattern, start with the purl stitch),**M1**, 8 loops according to the pattern (4th row of the pattern, start with the purl st.),**Mongolian People's Republic**,

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting* **on the right** from the **Mongolian People's Republic**.

7 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.),**M4**, 17 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, we start with the front loop), lift the wrap and knit the purl loop together with the wrap with the back loop, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the front loop;

Row 31.(LS):18 stitches according to the pattern (4th row of the pattern, start with knit stitches),**M4**, 7 loops according to the pattern (4th row of the pattern, start with the front loop),**Mongolian People's Republic**,

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting* **left** from the **Mongolian People's Republic**.

8 stitches according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with knit stitches),**M1**, 18 loops according to the pattern (row 1 of the pattern, start with a knit stitch), lift the wrap and knit the knit stitch together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the WS;

Row 32.(IS):19 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.),**M1**, 8 loops according to the pattern (2nd row

Row 34.(IS):20 loops according to the pattern (4th row of the pattern, start with the purl st.),**M1**, 8 loops according to the pattern (4th row of the pattern, start with the purl st.),**Mongolian People's Republic**,

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting on the right* from the **Mongolian People's Republic.**

7 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.),**M4**, 19 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, we start with the front loop), lift the wrap and knit the purl loop together with the wrap with the back loop, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the front loop;

Row 35.(LS):20 stitches according to the pattern (row 4 of the pattern, start with knit stitches),**M4**, 7 loops according to the pattern (4th row of the pattern, start with the front loop),**Mongolian People's Republic**,

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting left* from the **Mongolian People's Republic.**

8 stitches according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with knit stitches),**M1**, 20 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with the front loop), lift the wrap and knit the front loop together with the wrap, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the back loop;

Row 36.(IS):21 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.),**M1**, 8 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with the front loop),**Mongolian People's Republic**,

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting on the right* from the **Mongolian People's Republic.**

7 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with the front loop),**M4**, 20 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), lift the wrap and knit the purl stitch together with the wrap with a purl stitch, wrap the next loop and turn the work onto the RS;

Row 37.(LS):21 stitches according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with knit stitches),**M4**, 7 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.),**Mongolian People's Republic**,

!Next we knit *pearl pattern in rotary knitting left* from the **Mongolian People's Republic.**

8 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern, start with the purl st.), **M1**, 21 loops according to the pattern (row 3 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), pick up the wrap and knit together with the wrap from the front, 21 loops according to the pattern (row 3 of the pattern, start with a purl stitch), pick up the wrap and knit together with the wrap from the front from the previous row,

Row 38. 80 loops according to the pattern (4th row of the pattern).

Row 39. 80 loops according to the pattern (1 row of the pattern).

Row 40. 80 loops according to the pattern (2nd row of the pattern).

Row 41. 80 loops according to the pattern (3rd row of the pattern).

Row 42. 80 loops according to the pattern (4th row of the pattern).

Repeat rows 39-42 again **6 times** (total 24 rows) or a total of 30 rows in front of the pattern.

The height of the front of the hat from the beginning of the pattern should be ~ 11.5 cm.

We cut the thread and thread it into a needle with a wide eye.

We slip the remaining stitches onto the needle, simultaneously removing the markers and tightening the remaining stitches. Bring the yarn to the back and secure the tail with a few knots, hiding it.

Knitting the lining

Let's start knitting the inner part of the hat - the lining.

To do this, we need to unravel the waste (contrast thread) and pick it up with 3.5 knitting needles (or 0.5 size smaller than the needles with which you got the density in the front surface) - **80 loops** as shown in the video

We attach the lining thread and knit 1 row with face stitches, simultaneously placing markers:

Formation of the crown

The crown closure will consist of 4 wedges.

Ties

We will make the ties with a hollow cord.

To do this, find the center of our "ears" and pick up 4 loops with a crochet hook (as shown in the video). Transfer these loops to 4-mm needles and knit a hollow cord 60-65 rows long (or any desired length).

We cut off the end of the thread and, using a needle, tighten the loops and hide the tail inside the hollow cord.

The height of the front of the hat from the beginning of the pattern should be ~ 13 cm.

Ties

To do this, find the center of our "ears" and pick up 4 loops with a crochet hook (as shown in the video). Transfer these loops to 4-mm needles and knit a hollow cord 60-65 rows long (or any desired length).

Snood



You can knit a snood using these calculations or calculate it yourself based on your individual density.

The snood can also be knitted with either a pattern or a garter stitch, your choice.

Ready calculations are given for 3 snood sizes: XS

(40-45 oz)

S (age 46-51)

M (age 52-54)

Parameters of the finished snood:

Height:

XS ~ 17-18 cm

S ~ 19-20 cm

M ~ 20-21 cm

Width (in the middle of the snood):

XS ~ 22-23 cm

S ~ 24-25 cm

M ~ 25-26 cm

Description of the work sequence:

With waste thread (any contrasting thread of similar thickness) using a circular hook knitting needles 4 (or 0.5 size smaller than the needles you used to get the density in the pattern) cast on **70 /74/78 loops** (as shown in the video below) and close the knitting in a circle.



Next, after the MNR, you need to knit half the loops of the snood – 35/37/39 loops. And then finish knitting.

Next, we transfer the loops from the waste yarn to an additional knitting needle.

Next, we need to sew the snood as shown in the video. You can sew the snood with the same thread you used to knit the snood itself or a different color.

An example of calculating a snood based on individual density

Let's say your density is: In a 10 * 10 cm square: 19 p * 27 r

In a 1 x 1 cm square: 1.9 p * 2.7 r

You need to knit a snood size - S.

The height of the finished snood in this size is ~19-20 cm (parameters of the finished snood),

!BUT since we knit the snood horizontally, then in the working process this will be the width and our the number of loops we need to cast on.

$(1.9 \text{ sts} * 20 \text{ cm} * 2) + 1-2 \text{ cm} = 78 \text{ stitches}$ (there must be an even number of stitches),

Where

1.9 p – density in 1 cm;

20 cm is the height of the finished snood; 2 –

since the snood is double;

1-2 cm – to round the snood when moving from the inner to the outer part.

Total:

We need to cast on 78 stitches using waste yarn.

and knit a snood to a height of ~49-50 cm (the snood height for size S). After the MNR, knit half the snood stitches and finish knitting.

Height for other sizes: XS ~ 46-47

cm

M~51-52 cm

After the snood has been knitted to the required height, we transfer the loops from the waste yarn to additional knitting needles.

Our snood is ready!

Wet-heat treatment of the product

Hand wash in cool water (around 30 degrees Celsius) with a liquid detergent for delicate items. Do not rub! Gently squeeze and remove excess water with a towel. Do not wring! Lay flat on a towel to dry, turning the item occasionally until completely dry.

Advice: If your pearl pattern is crooked, then during the WTO you need to straighten it with your hands in the desired direction. Also, the pattern should be straightened while drying.
