

# Peter Rabbit™

## FLOPSY, MOPSY & COTTON-TAIL

*The Tale of Peter Rabbit* was first published by Frederick Warne in 1902 and endures as Beatrix Potter's most popular and well-loved tale. It introduces the mischievous Peter Rabbit and his sisters Flopsy, Mopsy and Cotton-tail. Peter's narrow escape from Mr. McGregor's garden after snacking on delicious lettuces and radishes is made all the more memorable by the illustrations of him in his blue jacket and his sisters in their bright red capes as they pick blackberries.

A mixture of colourwork and stitch pattern, this layette for mischievous little bunnies includes a textured patchwork sweater and cot blanket. Snacks are provided for them with radishes and turnips, plus the adorable dress-up items include a bunny-ears beanie, radish-trimmed booties, and a sweet red capelet.



# Patchwork Sweater

## MEASUREMENTS

### TO FIT AGES

0-3    3-6    6-9    9-12 months

### FINISHED SIZES

Chest

52    55    62    65 cm

20½    21¾    24½    25½ in

Length to shoulder

24    24    30    30 cm

9½    9½    11¾    11¾ in

Sleeve length

13    15    17    19 cm

5    6    6¾    7½ in

## MATERIALS

Yarn quantities are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

- 50g/1¾oz balls of Debbie Bliss Baby Cashmerino:
  - 4(4:4:5) balls in Ecru (A)
  - 1 ball in Teddy (B)
  - 1 ball in Mist (C)
  - 1 ball in Ruby (D)
  - 1 ball in Wasabi (E)
- Pair of 3mm (US 2-3) knitting needles
- Pair of 3.25mm (US 3) knitting needles
- 4 small buttons
- Stitch markers
- Stitch holders
- Dark brown embroidery thread (floss) for details
- Small amount of Mink for details
- Cable needle

## TENSION

25 sts and 34 rows to 10cm/4in square over st st using 3.25mm (US 3) needles.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**tw2R - twist 2 right:** K into front of 2nd st, k into front of first st, slip sts off needle together.

**C4B - cable 4 back:** Slip 2 sts onto cable needle and hold to back of work, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

**bobble st:** K in front, back, front and back of next st, turn, p4, turn, k4, turn, p4, turn, [k2tog] twice, then pass first k2tog over 2nd.

## CHART NOTES

Read charts from right to left when working right side rows and left to right when working wrong side rows.

Note that charts three and four begin on a wrong side row.

If preferred colourwork can be worked using Swiss darning/duplicate stitch on completion.


### Tip

*Having a button shoulder fastening on a baby sweater means it can be easily and comfortably placed over and off the baby's head*



## SWEATER BACK

With 3mm (US 2-3) needles and A, cast on 62(66:74:78) sts.

**1st rib row:** K2, [p2, k2] to end.

**2nd rib row:** P2, [k2, p2] to end.

These 2 rows **set** rib.

Work 7 more rows in rib.

**Inc row:** P1, m1, p30(32:36:38), m1, p30(32:36:38), m1, p1.

65(69:77:81) sts.

Change to 3.25mm (US 3) needles.

**1st row:** [P1, k1] 1(1:2:2) times, tw2R, work 1st row of chart one, tw2R, [p1, k1] 1(2:3:4) times, work 1st row of chart six, [k1, p1] 1(2:3:4) times, tw2R, work 1st row of chart one, tw2R, [k1, p1] 1(1:2:2) times.

**2nd row:** [P1, k1] 1(1:2:2) times, p2, work 2nd row of chart one, p2, [p1, k1] 1(2:3:4) times, work 2nd row of chart six, [k1, p1] 1(2:3:4) times, p2, work 2nd row of chart one, p2, [k1, p1] 1(1:2:2) times.

Work 19 rows in patt.

**22nd row:** [P1, k1] 1(1:2:2) times, p2, work 1st row of chart three, p2, [p1, k1] 1(2:3:4) times, work 22nd row of chart six, [k1, p1] 1(2:3:4) times, p2, work 1st row of chart four, p2, [k1, p1] 1(1:2:2) times.

**23rd row:** [P1, k1] 1(1:2:2) times, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart four, tw2R, [p1, k1] 1(2:3:4) times, work 23rd row of chart six, [k1, p1] 1(2:3:4) times, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart three, tw2R, [k1, p1] 1(1:2:2) times.

These 2 rows **set** patt and chart placement.

Work 15 rows in patt.

**39th row:** [P1, k1] 1(1:2:2) times, tw2R, work 1st row of chart one, tw2R, [p1, k1] 1(2:3:4) times, work 39th row of chart six, [k1, p1] 1(2:3:4) times, tw2R, work 1st row of chart one, tw2R, [k1, p1] 1(1:2:2) times.

**40th row:** [P1, k1] 1(1:2:2) times, p2, work 2nd row of chart one, p2, [p1, k1] 1(2:3:4) times, work 40th row of chart six, [k1, p1] 1(2:3:4) times, p2, work 2nd row of chart one, p2, [k1, p1] 1(1:2:2) times.

These 2 rows **set** patt and chart placement.

Work 19 rows in patt.

**60th row:** [P1, k1] 1(1:2:2) times, p2, work 1st row of chart four, p2, [p1, k1] 1(2:3:4) times, p2, [k1, p1] 1(2:3:4) times, p2, work 1st row of chart three, p2, [k1, p1] 1(1:2:2) times.

**61st row:** [P1, k1] 1(1:2:2) times, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart three, tw2R, [p1, k1] 1(2:3:4) times, k2, [k1, p1] 1(2:3:4) times, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart four, tw2R, [k1, p1] 1(1:2:2) times.

These 2 rows **set** patt and chart placement.

Work 15 rows in patt.

### 3RD AND 4TH SIZES ONLY

**77th row:** [P1, k1] 1(1:2:2) times, tw2R, work 1st row of chart one, tw2R, [p1, k1] 1(2:3:4) times, k2, [k1, p1] 1(2:3:4) times, tw2R, work 1st row of chart one, tw2R, [k1, p1] 1(1:2:2) times.

**78th row:** [P1, k1] 1(1:2:2) times, p2, work 2nd row of chart one, p2, [p1, k1] 1(2:3:4) times, p2, [k1, p1] 1(2:3:4) times, p2, work 2nd row of chart one, p2, [k1, p1] 1(1:2:2) times.

These 2 rows **set** patt and chart placement.

Work 18 rows in patt.

### ALL SIZES

**Cast (bind) off row:** Using A, cast (bind) off 20(20:23:24) sts purlwise, patt 25(29:31:33) including st left from cast (bind) off, cast (bind) off rem 20(20:23:24) sts knitwise.

25(29:31:33) sts.

Slip rem sts onto a holder.



## SWEATER FRONT

Work as given for back until 20(20:24:24) rows fewer have been worked than on back, ending with a wrong side row.

### SHAPE NECK

**Next row (right side):** Patt 25(25:29:30), turn and leave rem sts on a spare needle.

Work on first set of sts as follows:

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge on every row to 22(22:26:27) sts, then on every foll alt row until 20(20:23:24) sts rem, ending with a wrong side row.

Work 8(8:10:10) rows straight.

K 2 rows.

**Buttonhole row (right side):**

K2(2:4:4), [yf, k2tog, k5] twice, yf, k2tog, k2(2:3:4).

K 1 row.

Cast (bind) off purlwise.

Return to sts on spare needle.

With right side facing, place centre 15(19:19:21) sts on a holder, rejoin yarn and patt to end.

25(25:29:30) sts.


Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge on every row to 22(22:26:27) sts, then on every foll alt row until 20(20:23:24) sts rem, ending with a wrong side row.

Work 12(12:14:14) rows straight.

Cast (bind) off.







## SLEEVES (MAKE 2)

With 3mm (US 2-3) needles and A, cast on 38(42:46:50) sts.

Work in rib as set on back, beg with 1st row, for 6 rows.

Change to 3.25mm (US 3) needles.

Work 4 rows in st st, beginning with a k row.

**Inc row:** K3, m1, k to last 3 sts, m1, k3.

Work 5 rows in st st, beginning with a p row.

Rep the last 6 rows 3(4:5:6) times and the inc row again.

48(54:60:66) sts.

Cont straight in st st until sleeve measures 13(15:17:19) cm/5(6:6¾:7½)in from cast-on edge, ending with a p row.

Cast (bind) off.

## NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam.

With right side facing and using 3mm (US 2-3) needles and A, pick up and knit 16(16:17:17) sts evenly down left front neck, k15(19:19:21) sts from front neck holder, pick up and knit 16(16:17:17) sts evenly up right front neck, then k25(29:31:33) from back neck holder.

72(80:84:88) sts.

**1st row:** K3, [p2, k2] to last st, k1.

**2nd row:** K1, [p2, k2] to last 3 sts, p2, k1.

These 2 rows **set** rib.

Work 2 more rows in rib.

**Buttonhole row:** Rib to last 3 sts, yf, k2tog, k1.

Work 3 rows in rib.


Cast (bind) off loosely in rib.

## MAKING UP

Using Mink and chart for placement, work outline embroidery on chart six.

Using embroidery thread and chart for placement, work face embroidery on chart six.

Measure 9(10.5:12:13) cm/3½(4¼:4¾:5)in down from shoulder seams on front and back and place a marker for armholes. Sew sleeves to armholes between markers, sewing through all three thicknesses at left shoulder. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons, matching buttonholes.





# Patchwork Blanket

## MEASUREMENTS

### FINISHED SIZE

Length 59cm/23¼in

Width 50cm/19¾in

## MATERIALS

Yarn quantities are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

- 50g/1¾oz balls of Debbie Bliss Baby Cashmerino:
  - 5 balls in Ecru (A)
  - 1 ball in Teddy (B)
  - 1 ball in Mist (C)
  - 1 ball in Ruby (D)
  - 1 ball in Wasabi (E)
- Pair of 3.25mm (US 3) knitting needles
- Dark brown embroidery thread (floss) for details
- Small amount of Mink for details
- Cable needle
- Optional 3cm/1¼in pom-pom maker

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**tw2R – twist 2 right:** K into front of 2nd st, k into front of first st, slip sts off needle together.

**C4B – cable 4 back:** Slip 2 sts onto cable needle and hold to back of work, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

**bobble st:** K in front, back, front and back of next st, turn, p4, turn, k4, turn, p4, turn, [k2tog] twice, then pass first k2tog over 2nd.

## TENSION

25 sts and 34 rows to 10cm/4in square over st st using 3.25mm (US 3) needles.

## CHART NOTES

Read charts from right to left when working right side rows and left to right when working wrong side rows.

Note that charts two, three, four, and eight begin on a wrong side row.

If preferred colourwork can be worked using Swiss darning/duplicate stitch on completion.

## BLANKET

With 3.25mm (US 3) needles and A, cast on 126 sts.

**1st moss st row:** [P1, k1] to end.

**2nd moss st row:** [K1, p1] to end.

These 2 rows **set** moss st.

Work 6 rows in moss st.

\*\*

**1st row:** [P1, k1] twice, p1, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice, work 1st row of chart seven, [k1, p1] twice, p1, tw2R, work 1st row of chart one, tw2R, work 1st row of chart five, tw2R, work 1st row of chart one, tw2R, p1, [k1, p1] twice, work 1st row of chart six, [p1, k1] twice, p1, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice.

**2nd row:** [K1, p1] twice, k1, p2, k1, [k1, p1] twice, work 2nd row of chart six, [p1, k1] twice, k1, p2, work 2nd row of chart one, p2, work 2nd row of chart five, p2, work 2nd row of chart one, p2, k1, [p1, k1] twice, work 2nd row of chart seven, [k1, p1] twice, k1, p2, k1, [k1, p1] twice.

These 2 rows **set** patt and chart placement.

Work 19 rows in patt.

**22nd row:** [K1, p1] twice, k1, p2, k1, [k1, p1] twice, work 22nd row of chart six, [p1, k1] twice, k1, p2, work 1st row of chart three, p2, work 1st row of chart two, p2, work 1st row of chart four, p2, k1, [p1, k1] twice, work 22nd row of chart seven, [k1, p1] twice, k1, p2, k1, [k1, p1] twice.

**23rd row:** [P1, k1] twice, p1, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice, work 23rd row of chart seven, [k1, p1] twice, p1, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart four, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart two, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart three, tw2R, p1, [k1, p1] twice, work 23rd row of chart six, [p1, k1] twice, p1, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice.

These 2 rows **set** patt and chart placement.

Work 15 rows in patt.



**39th row:** [P1, k1] twice, p1, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice, work 39th row of chart seven, [k1, p1] twice, p1, tw2R, work 1st row of chart one, tw2R, work 1st row of chart five, tw2R, work 1st row of chart one, tw2R, p1, [k1, p1] twice, work 39th row of chart six, [p1, k1] twice, p1, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice.

**40th row:** [K1, p1] twice, k1, p2, k1, [k1, p1] twice, work 40th row of chart six, [p1, k1] twice, k1, p2, work 2nd row of chart one, p2, work 2nd row of chart five, p2, work 2nd row of chart one, p2, k1, [p1, k1] twice, work 40th row of chart seven, [k1, p1] twice, k1, p2, k1, [k1, p1] twice.

These 2 rows **set** patt and chart placement.

Work 19 rows in patt.

\*\*\*

**60th row:** [K1, p1] twice, k1, p2, k1, [k1, p1] 14 times, k2, p2, k1, m1 purlwise, [k1, p1] 22 times, k1, p2, k1, [p1, k1] 15 times, p2, k1, [k1, p1] twice. 127 sts.

**61st row:** [P1, k1] twice, p1, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] 14 times, p2, tw2R, p2, [k1, p1] 22 times, p1, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] 15 times, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice.

**62nd row:** [K1, p1] twice, k1, p2, k1, [k1, p1] 14 times, k2, p2, k1, p1, [k1, p1] 22 times, k1, p2, k1, [p1, k1] 15 times, p2, k1, [k1, p1] twice.

Rep last 2 rows once more.


**65th row:** [P1, k1] twice, p1, tw2R, p1, skpo, [p1, k1] 13 times, p2, tw2R, p2, [k1, p1] 22 times, p1, tw2R, p1, [k1, p1] 13 times, k1, p2tog, p1, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice.

125 sts.

**66th row:** [K1, p1] twice, k1, p2, work 1st row of chart three, p2, work 1st row of chart two, p2, k1, [p1, k1] twice, work 1st row of chart eight, [k1, p1] twice, k1, p2, work 1st row of chart two, p2, work 1st row of chart four, p2, k1, [k1, p1] twice.

**67th row:** [P1, k1] twice, p1, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart four, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart two, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice, work 2nd row of chart eight, [k1, p1] twice, p1, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart two, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart three, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice.

Work 15 rows in patt.

**83rd row:** [P1, k1] twice, p1, tw2R, work 1st row of chart one, tw2R, work 1st row of chart five, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice, work 18th row of chart eight, [k1, p1] twice, p1, tw2R, work 1st row of chart five, tw2R, work 1st row of chart one, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice.

**84th row:** [K1, p1] twice, k1, p2, work 2nd row of chart one, p2, work 2nd row of chart five, p2, k1, [p1, k1] twice, work 19th row of chart eight, [k1, p1] twice, k1, p2, work 2nd row of chart five, p2, work 2nd row of chart one, p2, k1, [k1, p1] twice.

These 2 rows **set** patt and chart placement.

Work 19 rows in patt.

**104th row:** [K1, p1] twice, k1, p2, work 1st row of chart three, p2, work 1st row of chart two, p2, k1, [p1, k1] twice, work 39th row of chart eight, [k1, p1] twice, k1, p2, work 1st row of chart two, p2, work 1st row of chart four, p2, k1, [k1, p1] twice.

**105th row:** [P1, k1] twice, p1, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart four, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart two, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice, work 40th row of chart eight, [k1, p1] twice, p1, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart two, tw2R, work 2nd row of chart three, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice.

These 2 rows **set** patt and chart placement.

Work 15 rows in patt.

**121st row:** [P1, k1] twice, p1, tw2R, p1, m1, [p1, k1] 14 times, p1, tw2R, p2, [k1, p1] 22 times, p1, tw2R, p1, [k1, p1] 14 times, m1, p1, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice.

127 sts.

**122nd row:** [K1, p1] twice, k1, p2, k1, [k1, p1] 14 times, k2, p2, [k1, p1] 23 times, k1, p2, k1, [k1, p1] 14 times, k2, p2, k1, [k1, p1] twice.

**123rd row:** [P1, k1] twice, p1, tw2R, [p1, k1] 15 times, p1, tw2R, p2, [k1, p1] 22 times, p1, tw2R, p1, [k1, p1] 15 times, tw2R, p1, [p1, k1] twice.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

**126th row:** [K1, p1] twice, k1, p2, k1, [k1, p1] 14 times, k2, p2, k1, k2tog, [p1, k1] 22 times, p2, k2, [p1, k1] 14 times, k1, p2, k1, [k1, p1] twice.

126 sts.

Rep from \*\* to \*\*\* once.

Work 8 rows in moss st.

Cast (bind) off.

## TO FINISH

Using Mink and chart for placement, work outline embroidery on charts six, seven and eight.


Using embroidery thread and chart for placement, work face embroidery on charts six, seven, and eight.

Using B and chart for placement, work outline embroidery on chart five.

Using A, make four pom-poms and attach to each corner of the blanket.



# Bunny Ears Beanie

## MEASUREMENTS

### TO FIT AGES

0-3    3-6    6-12 months

## TENSION

24 sts and 48 rounds to  
10cm/4in square over g st  
using 3.25mm (US 3) needles.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**kfbf:** Knit into the front, back  
and front of next stitch to  
increase two stitches.

## MATERIALS

Yarn quantities are based on  
average requirements and are  
therefore approximate.

- 50g/1¾oz balls of Debbie Bliss Baby Cashmerino:
  - 2 balls in Teddy (A)
  - 1 ball in Mist (B)
- Pair of 3mm (US 2-3) knitting needles
- 3.25mm (US 3) circular needle, 30cm/12in long
- A set of 3.25mm (US 3) double-pointed needles (DPNs)
- Stitch marker

### Tip

*Make sure to attach  
the ears very  
firmly to the hat*



## HAT

With 3.25mm (US 3) circular needle and B, cast on 83(91:99) sts.

Join to work in the round, being careful not to twist stitches, place marker for beg of round.

Work 14 rounds in st st (k every round).

Break off B.

Join A.

**1st round:** K to end.

**2nd round:** P to end.

These 2 rounds **set** g st.

Cont in g st for a further 28(38:48) rounds, hat should measure 6(8:10) cm/2¼(3¼:4)in from beg of g st, ending with a p round.

## SHAPE CROWN

Change to 3.25mm (US 3) DPNs when stitch count becomes too small for your circular needle.

**1st round:** K10(11:12), [s2kpo, k17(19:21)] 3 times, s2kpo, k10(11:12).

75(83:91) sts.

Work 3 rounds in g st.

**5th round:** K9(10:11), [s2kpo, k15(17:19)] 3 times, s2kpo, k9(10:11).

67(75:83) sts.

Work 3 rounds in g st.

**9th round:** K8(9:10), [s2kpo, k13(15:17)] 3 times, s2kpo, k8(9:10).

59(67:75) sts.

Work 3 rounds in g st.

**13th round:** K7(8:9), [s2kpo, k11(13:15)] 3 times, s2kpo, k7(8:9).

51(59:67) sts.

P 1 round.

**15th round:** K6(7:8), [s2kpo, k9(11:13)] 3 times, s2kpo, k6(7:8).

43(51:59) sts.

P 1 round.

**17th round:** K5(6:7), [s2kpo, k7(9:11)] 3 times, s2kpo, k5(6:7).

35(43:51) sts.

P 1 round.

**19th round:** K4(5:6), [s2kpo, k5(7:9)] 3 times, s2kpo, k4(5:6).

P 1 round.

27(35:43) sts.

## 2ND AND 3RD SIZES ONLY

**21st round:** K-(4:5), [s2kpo, k-(5:7)] 3 times, s2kpo, k-(4:5).

-(27:35) sts.

P 1 round.

## 3RD SIZE ONLY

**23rd round:** K-(-:4), [s2kpo, k-(-:5)] 3 times, s2kpo, k-(-:4).

-( -:27) sts.

P 1 round.

## ALL SIZES

**Next round:** K1, k2tog, [s2kpo] to last 3 sts, skpo, k1.

11 sts.

**Next round:** K2, [k2tog] 4 times, k1.

7 sts.

Leaving a long end, break yarn and thread through rem sts, pull up and secure.

## EARS (MAKE 2)

With 3mm (US 2-3) needles and A, cast on 1 st.

**1st row:** Kfbf.

3 sts.

**2nd row and every even row:** K to end.

**3rd row:** K1, kfbf, k1.

5 sts.

**5th row:** K2, kfbf, k2.

7 sts.

**7th row:** K3, kfbf, k3.

9 sts.

**9th row:** K4, kfbf, k4.

11 sts.

**11th row:** K5, kfbf, k5.

13 sts.

**13th row:** K6, kfbf, k6.

15 sts.

K 75 rows.

**89th row:** [Sl1, k2tog, pss0] 5 times.

5 sts.

Leaving a long end, break yarn and thread through rem sts, pull up and secure.

## TO FINISH

Join ears to either side of hat, approximately 12 rounds below brim.



# Radish Booties

## MEASUREMENTS

### TO FIT AGES

0-3    3-6 months

## MATERIALS

Yarn quantities are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

- 50g/1¾oz balls of Debbie Bliss Baby Cashmerino:
  - 1 ball in Mist (A)
  - 1 ball in Teddy (B)
  - 1 ball in Ecru (C)
- Small amount of Ruby (D) and Wasabi (E) for radishes

### 0-3 MONTHS

- 2 x 2.75mm (US 2) double-pointed needles (DPNs)

### 3-6 MONTHS

- 2 x 3mm (US 2-3) double-pointed needles (DPNs)

### BOTH SIZES

- Pair of 2.75mm (US 2) knitting needles for radishes
- 3mm (US D-3) crochet hook
- Stitch holder

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**k1B:** Knit 1 st (or number indicated) in yarn B (or other colour indicated).

## PATTERN NOTE

A larger needle size is used for the larger booties but instructions remain the same for both sizes.

## TENSION

28 sts and 50 rows to 10cm/4in over g st using 2.75mm (US 2) needles.

26 sts and 48 rows to 10cm/4in over g st using 3mm (US 2-3) needles.



## BOOTIES (MAKE 2)

\*With 2.75mm (US 2) or 3mm (US 2-3) DPNs and A, cast on 18 sts (for first half of cuff) and k 16 rows\*.

Break yarn and leave sts on a holder.

Rep from \* to \* for second half of cuff.

### JOIN CUFF HALVES

Change to B.

**Next row:** [K1, p1] 9 times across second half of cuff, then [k1, p1] 9 times across first half of cuff.

36 sts.

**Next row:** [K1, p1] to end.

Rep the last row 6 times more.

### SHAPE INSTEP

**Next row (right side):** K13B, join C but do not break off B, k10C, turn.

Using C, work as follows.

**Next row:** K10, turn.

Work 24 rows on centre 10 sts.

**Next row:** K1, skpo, k4, k2tog, k1.

8 sts.

K 1 row.

Break yarn.

With right side facing and B, using yarn left at base of instep, pick up and knit 13 sts evenly along side of instep, k across centre 8 sts, then pick up and knit 13 sts evenly along other side of instep, k rem 13 sts.

60 sts.

K 11 rows.

Work 7 rows in st st, beginning with a k row.

**Next row:** [P next st tog with corresponding st 7 rows below] to end.

Break yarn.

### SHAPE SOLE

**Next row:** Slip first 25 sts onto right hand needle, rejoin B and k10 sts, turn.

**Next row:** K9, k2tog, turn.

Rep last row until 20 sts rem, then k to end.

Cast (bind) off.

## MAKING UP

Join back seam. With back seam to centre of cast (bind) off, join heel seam.

## RADISHES (MAKE 4)

With 2.75mm (US 2) needles and D, cast on 5 sts.

**1st row:** [Kfb] 5 times.

10 sts.

Work 5 rows in st st, beginning with a p row.

**7th row:** [K2tog] 5 times.

5 sts.

**8th row:** P to end.

**9th row:** K2tog, k1, k2tog.

3 sts.

Leaving a long end, break yarn and thread through rem sts, pull up and secure. Join side seam.

### Tip

*Always make sure that the cords do not become detached from the booties*

With a small amount of E and tapestry (darning) needle, make 3 chain leaves at top of radish as follows:

Join yarn and make a loop, thread yarn through loop. Working into loop just made cont in the same way until chain measures 2cm/ $\frac{3}{4}$ in, fasten off.

## TO FINISH

With crochet hook and B, make two 30cm/ $11\frac{3}{4}$ in crochet chains for cords. Thread through the rib starting and ending either side of the centre stitch. Sew a radish to each end of crochet cords.

## MEASUREMENTS

## MATERIALS

Yarn quantities are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

- 50g/1¾oz balls of Debbie Bliss Cashmerino DK:
  - 1(2:2) balls in Ruby
- Pair of 4mm (US 6) knitting needles
- 1 button

## TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm/4in square over st st using 4mm (US 6) needles.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**wrap 1:** On a k side row yarn to front, slip next st onto right hand needle, yarn to back, slip st back onto left hand needle, when working across the wrapped st on the next row, work the wrapped st and the wrapping loop tog as one st.

## CAPELET

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 114(132:150) sts.

K 6 rows.

**1st row:** K to end.

**2nd row:** K4, p to last 4 sts, k4.

These 2 rows **set** st st with g st edging and are repeated throughout.

Work 10 rows straight in patt.

**13th row:** K8(10:12), [skpo, k5(6:7)] 6 times, skpo, k10(12:14), [k2tog, k5(6:7)] 6 times, k2tog, k8(10:12).

100(118:136) sts.

Work 7 rows straight in patt.

**21st row:** K8(10:12), [skpo, k4(5:6)] 6 times, skpo, k8(10:12), [k2tog, k4(5:6)] 6 times, k2tog, k8(10:12).

86(104:122) sts.

Work 9 rows straight in patt.

**31st row:** K8(10:12), [skpo, k3(4:5)] 6 times, skpo, k6(8:10), [k2tog, k3(4:5)] 6 times, k2tog, k8(10:12).

72(90:108) sts.

Work 9 rows straight in patt.

## 2ND AND 3RD SIZES ONLY

**41st row:** K-(10:12), [skpo, k-(3:4)] 6 times, skpo, k-(6:8), [k2tog, k-(3:4)] 6 times, k2tog, k-(10:12).

-(76:94) sts.

Work 7 rows straight in patt.

## 3RD SIZE ONLY

**49st row:** K-(-:12), [skpo, k-(-:3)] 6 times, skpo, k-(-:6), [k2tog, k-(-:3)] 6 times, k2tog, k-(-:12).

-(-:80) sts.

Work 7 rows straight in patt.

## ALL SIZES

## NECKBAND

K 2 rows.

**Next 2 rows:** K to last 15 sts, wrap 1, turn.

**Next 2 rows:** K to last 14 sts, wrap 1, turn.

**Next 2 rows:** K to last 13 sts, wrap 1, turn.

**Next 2 rows:** K to last 12 sts, wrap 1, turn.

**Next 2 rows:** K to last 11 sts, wrap 1, turn.

**Next row:** K to end.

**Next row:** K to last 4 sts, yf, k2tog, k2.

K 3 rows.

Cast (bind) off loosely knitwise.

## TO FINISH

Sew on button, matching buttonhole.
