SIZE

One size: 162cm (64in) wide x 60cm (24in) deep

YARN

Eden Cottage Yarns Hayton 4ply (4ply/fingering weight; 80% merino wool, 10% cashmere, 10% nylon; 350m/380yds per 100g skein)

Shades: **MC:** Marigold; 2 skeins, **CC:** Red Kite; 1 skein

NEEDLES & NOTIONS

3.5mm (US 4) circular needle, 100cm (40in) length

2 stitch markers

Tapestry needle

TENSION

22 sts and 32 rows to 10cm (4in) over stocking stitch (stockinette) after blocking.

Take time to check your tension and adjust the needle size as necessary to ensure an accurate finish.

ABBREVIATIONS

PATTERN TECHNIQUES

Cable Cast-On: *Insert right-hand needle **between** first two stitches on left-hand needle, yarn over needle (as for a regular knit stitch) and bring the loop through. Without twisting it, transfer the newly created stitch onto the left-hand needle; rep from * until you have cast on the specified number of stitches

PATTERN NOTES

Piccadilly begins at the top centre and is worked downwards to border. There are two yarn-over increases in every row to create an elongated crescent shape. The shawl is worked in stocking stitch with picot garter stripes before a lace border is worked sideways and joined to the body with simple decreases and slipped stitches.

At the end of each Picot Stripe the stitch count will have increased by 12 stitches with the exception of Picot Stripes 6 and 13 which include additional M1R increases – stitch counts are given at the end of each row for these sections.

Stitches created by each M7 are decreased away in subsequent rows and have no net effect on total stitch counts.

All slip stitches should be slipped purlwise with the yarn held as indicated by the stitch.

PATTERN BEGINS

Take time to read the Pattern Notes before starting.

GARTER TAB CAST ON & SET-UP

Using MC, cast on 3 sts.

Knit 6 rows but do not turn on the last row.

Rotate work 90 degrees clockwise, pick up and knit 1 st in each of the 3 garter ridges. Rotate work another 90 degrees, pick up and knit 3 sts along the cast-on edge, turn. 9 sts

Set-up row: K3, PM, k3, PM, k3.

Row 1 (RS): K3, SM, yo, [kfb] 3 times, yo, SM, k3. 14 sts

Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 16 sts

Row 3: K3, SM, yo, [k1, kfb] 5 times, yo, SM, k3. 23 sts

Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 25 sts

PICOT STRIPE 1

Join CC and commence working stripes of 2 rows in CC and 4 rows in MC. **Loosely** carry the unused yarn up the side of the shawl – no need to break it after each stripe. If desired, begin each RS row with a yarn over and drop it at the end of the following WS row to keep the edge loose.

Row 1 (RS): Using CC, K3, SM, yo, k9, M7, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.

Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k10, ssk, k5, k2tog, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.

Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p11, p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p to marker, yo, SM, k3.

Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k12, ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.

Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 37 sts

PICOT STRIPE 2

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k10, M7, k9, M7, k10, yo, SM, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.
Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k11, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k7] twice, k4, yo, SM, k3.
Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p12, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p7] twice, p5, yo, SM, k3.
Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k13, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k7] twice, k6, yo, SM, k3.
Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 49 sts

PICOT STRIPE 3

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k11, [M7, k9] to last 15 sts, M7, k11, yo, SM, k3.
Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.
Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k12, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k7] to last 8 sts, k5, yo, SM, k3.
Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p13, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p7] to last 9 sts, p6, yo, SM, k3.
Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k14, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k7] to last 10 sts, k7, yo, SM, k3.
Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 61 sts

PICOT STRIPE 4

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k2, [M7, k9] to last 6 sts, M7, k2, yo, SM, k3.
Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.
Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k3, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k7] to last 15 sts, ssk, k5, k2tog, k3, yo, SM, k3.
Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p4, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p7] to last 14 sts, p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p4, yo, SM, k3.
Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k5, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k7] to last 13 sts, ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k5, yo, SM, k3.
Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 73 sts

PICOT STRIPE 5

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k3, [M7, k9] to last 7 sts, M7, k3, yo, SM, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.
Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k4, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k7] to last 16 sts, ssk, k5, k2tog, k4, yo, SM, k3.
Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p5, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p7] to last 15 sts, p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p5, yo, SM, k3.
Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k6, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k7] to last 14 sts, ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k6, yo, SM, k3.
Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 85 sts

PICOT STRIPE 6

Note: Additional increases are made in this section and stitch counts are provided for each row.
Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k4, [M7, k2, M1R, k5, M1R, k2] to last 8 sts, M7, k4, yo, SM, k3. 149 sts
Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3. 151 sts
Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k5, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k9] to last 17 sts, ssk, k5, k2tog, k5, yo, SM, k3. 137 sts
Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p6, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p9] to last 16 sts, p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p6, yo, SM, k3. 123 sts
Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k7, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k9] to last 15 sts, ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k7, yo, SM, k3. 109 sts
Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 111 sts

PICOT STRIPES 7-12

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k4, [M7, k11] to last 8 sts, M7, k4, yo, SM, k3.
Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.
Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k5, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k9] to last 17 sts, ssk, k5, k2tog, k5, yo, SM, k3.
Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p6, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p9] to last 16 sts, p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p6, yo, SM, k3.
Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k7, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k9] to last 15 sts, ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k7, yo, SM, k3.
Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 12 sts inc per 6-row repeat
 Rep last 6 rows a further 5 times. 183 sts

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k4, [M7, k2, M1R, k7, M1R, k2] to last 8 sts, M7, k4, yo, SM, k3. 303 sts

Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3. 305 sts

Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k5, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k11] to last 17 sts, ssk, k5, k2tog, k5, yo, SM, k3. 277 sts

Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p6, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p11] to last 16 sts, p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p6, yo, SM, k3. 249 sts

Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k7, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k11] to last 15 sts, ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k7, yo, SM, k3. 221 sts

Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 223 sts

PICOT STRIPE 14

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k3, [M7, k13] to last 7 sts, M7, k3, yo, SM, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.

Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k4, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k11] to last 16 sts, ssk, k5, k2tog, k4, yo, SM, k3.

Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p5, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p11] to last 15 sts, p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p5, yo, SM, k3.

Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k6, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k11] to last 14 sts, ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k6, yo, SM, k3.

Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 235 sts

PICOT STRIPE 15

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k2, [M7, k13] to last 6 sts, M7, k2, yo, SM, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.

Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k3, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k11] to last 15 sts, ssk, k5, k2tog, k3, yo, SM, k3.

Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p4, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p11] to last 14 sts, p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p4, yo, SM, k3.

Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k5, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k11] to last 13 sts, ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k5, yo, SM, k3.

Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 247 sts

PICOT STRIPE 16

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k15, [M7, k13] to last 5 sts, k2, yo, SM, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.

Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k16, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k11] to last 8 sts, k5, yo, SM, k3.

Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p17, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p11] to last 9 sts, p6, yo, SM, k3.

Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k18, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k11] to last 10 sts, k7, yo, SM, k3.

Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 259 sts

PICOT STRIPE 17

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k14, [M7, k13] to last 4 sts, k1, yo, SM, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.

Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k15, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k11] to last 7 sts, k4, yo, SM, k3.

Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p16, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p11] to last 8 sts, p5, yo, SM, k3.

Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k17, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k11] to last 9 sts, k6, yo, SM, k3.

Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 271 sts

PICOT STRIPE 18

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k13, [M7, k13] to last 3 sts, yo, SM, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.

Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k14, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k11] to last 6 sts, k3, yo, SM, k3.

Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p15, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p11] to last 7 sts, p4, yo, SM, k3.



Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k16, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k11] to last 8 sts, k5, yo, SM, k3.

Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 283 sts

PICOT STRIPE 19

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k12, [M7, k13] to last 16 sts, M7, k12, yo, SM, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.

Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k13, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k11] to last 5 sts, k2, yo, SM, k3.

Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p14, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p11] to last 6 sts, p3, yo, SM, k3.

Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k15, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k11] to last 7 sts, k4, yo, SM, k3.

Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 295 sts

PICOT STRIPE 20

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k11, [M7, k13] to last 15 sts, M7, k11, yo, SM, k3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3.

Row 3: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k12, [ssk, k5, k2tog, k11] to last 4 sts, k1, yo, SM, k3.

Row 4: K3, SM, yo, p13, [p2tog, p1, sl1 wyif, p1, p2tog tbl, p11] to last 5 sts, p2, yo, SM, k3.

Row 5: K3, SM, yo, k14, [ssk, sl1 wyib, k2tog, k11] to last 6 sts, k3, yo, SM, k3.

Row 6: K3, SM, yo, p to marker, yo, SM, k3. 307 sts

FLOWER BAND

Note: Stitch count increases dramatically on Row 6 before decreasing away on Row 7.

Row 1 (RS): Change to CC. K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3. 2 sts inc

Row 2 (WS): K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3. 2 sts inc

Rows 3-4: Rep Rows 1-2. 315 sts

Row 5: Change to MC. K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3. 317 sts

Row 6: K3, SM, yo, k2, *k1, [k1 wrapping yarn around the needle 3 times] 5 times; rep from * to last 6 sts, k3, yo, SM, k3.

Row 7: K3, SM, yo, k3, *p1, sl 5 sts wyib from LH to RH needle dropping the yo's, wrap the yarn around all 5 sts from back to front twice; rep from * to last 7 sts, p1, k3, yo, SM, k3. 321 sts

Row 8: K3, SM, yo, k to marker, yo, SM, k3. 323 sts

Rows 9-12: Rep Rows 1-2 twice. 331 sts

Break CC and continue in MC only.

Row 13: Rep Row 5.

Rows 14: Rep Row 8. 335 sts

BORDER

Notes: The border includes two pattern stitches worked simultaneously: Chart A in MC and Chart B in CC. As you work the border, the last stitch of each RS row is joined to the main body of the shawl by working an ssk (1 st from border with 1 st from body), then turn and work the next WS row to the end.

When changing colours between Chart A and Chart B, twist the yarn strands in the back of work on RS rows, and in front on WS rows.

Stitch counts fluctuate so when checking stitch counts do so after working either Row 1, 2 or 4 of Chart B.

With RS facing, using MC and the Cable Cast-On method, cast 24 sts onto LH needle (at the end of main body sts), then tightly join CC and cast on a further 9 sts using CC.

Set-up row 1 (RS): K8, k1tbl, k23, ssk (1 st from border with 1 st from body), turn.

Set-up row 2 (WS): Sl1 wyif, k23, p1tbl, k8, turn.

Reading from the Charts or Written Instructions, working Chart A in MC and Chart B in CC, work Rows 1-50 of Chart A a total of 13 times, then work Rows 1-15 **only** once more continuing to work repeats of the 4-row Chart B throughout. On RS rows Chart B is worked first followed by Chart A, and vice versa on WS rows.

Next row (WS): sl1 wyf, k23, p1tbl, k8.

Cast off knitwise on RS, joining the last st of body to the border.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block to measurements in a crescent shape, taking care to pin-out the eyelets along the edge.

Row 4: Sl1 wyif, k2, p3, p2tog tbl, p1, yo, k7, yo, p1, p2tog, p3, k2.

Row 6: Sl1 wyif, k2, p1, p2tog tbl, p1, yo, k5, p1, k5, yo, p1, p2tog, p1, k2.

Row 7: P2, yo, k2tog tbl, p1, k1, p5, k1tbl, p5, k1, p1, sssb, yo, p2, ssk.

Row 8: Sl1 wyif, k2, p1, p1tbl, k1, [p1tbl, k5] twice, p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, p1, k2.



Row 9: P2, yo, k2tog tbl, p1, k1tbl, p5, k1tbl, p5, k1tbl, p1, ssb, yo, p2, ssk.

Row 10: S11 wyif, k2, p1, p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, k4, p1, p1tbl, p1, k4, p1tbl, k1, p1tbl, p1, k2.

Row 11: P2, yo, k2tog tbl, p1, k1tbl, p3, k2tog, yo, k1tbl, yo, ssk, p3, k1tbl, p1, ssb, yo, p2, ssk.

Row 33: P2, yo, k1, ssk, k3, k2tog, k1, yo, p1, yo, k1, ssk, k3, k2tog, k1, yo, p2, ssk.

Row 34: S11 wyif, k2, [p1, yo, p1, p2tog, p1, p2tog tbl, p1, yo, p1, k1] twice, k1.

Row 35: P2, k2, yo, k1, sssk, k1, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo, k2, p2, ssk.

Row 36: S11 wyif, k2, p3, yo, p1, p2tog, p3, k1, p3, p2tog tbl, p1, yo, p3, k2.

Row 37: P2, k4, yo, k1, ssk, k2, p1, k2, k2tog, k1, yo, k4, p2, ssk.

Row 38: S11 wyif, k2, p5, yo, p1, p2tog, p1, k1, p1, p2tog tbl, p1, yo, p5, k2.

Row 39: P2, [yo, k1, ssk, k3, k2tog, k1, yo, p1] twice, p1, ssk.

Row 40: S11 wyif, k2, [p1, yo, p1, p2tog, p1, p2tog tbl, p1, yo, p1, k1] twice, k1.

Row 41: P2, k2, yo, k1, k3tog, k1, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, k1, sssk, k1, yo, k2, p2, ssk.

Row 42: S11 wyif, k2, p3, p2tog tbl, p1, yo, p3, k1, p3, yo, p1, p2tog, p3, k2.

Row 43: P2, k2, k2tog, k1, yo, k4, p1, k4, yo, k1, ssk, k2, p2, ssk.

Row 44: S11 wyif, k2, p1, p2tog tbl, p1, yo, p5, k1, p5, yo, p1, p2tog, p1, k2.

Row 45: P2, yo, k1, ssk, k3, k2tog, k1, yo, p1, yo, k1, ssk, k3, k2tog, k1, yo, p2, ssk.

Rows 46-50: As Rows 34-38.
Rep Rows 1-50 for pattern.

Row 1 (RS): S11 wyif, [k2, p1] twice, k1, k1tbl.

Row 2 (WS): P1tbl, k8.

Row 3: Cast off 3 sts (1 st on RH needle), k4, k1tbl. 3 sts dec

Row 4: P1tbl, k1, [yo] twice, k2tog, [yo] twice, k2. 3 sts inc
Rep Rows 1-4 for pattern.

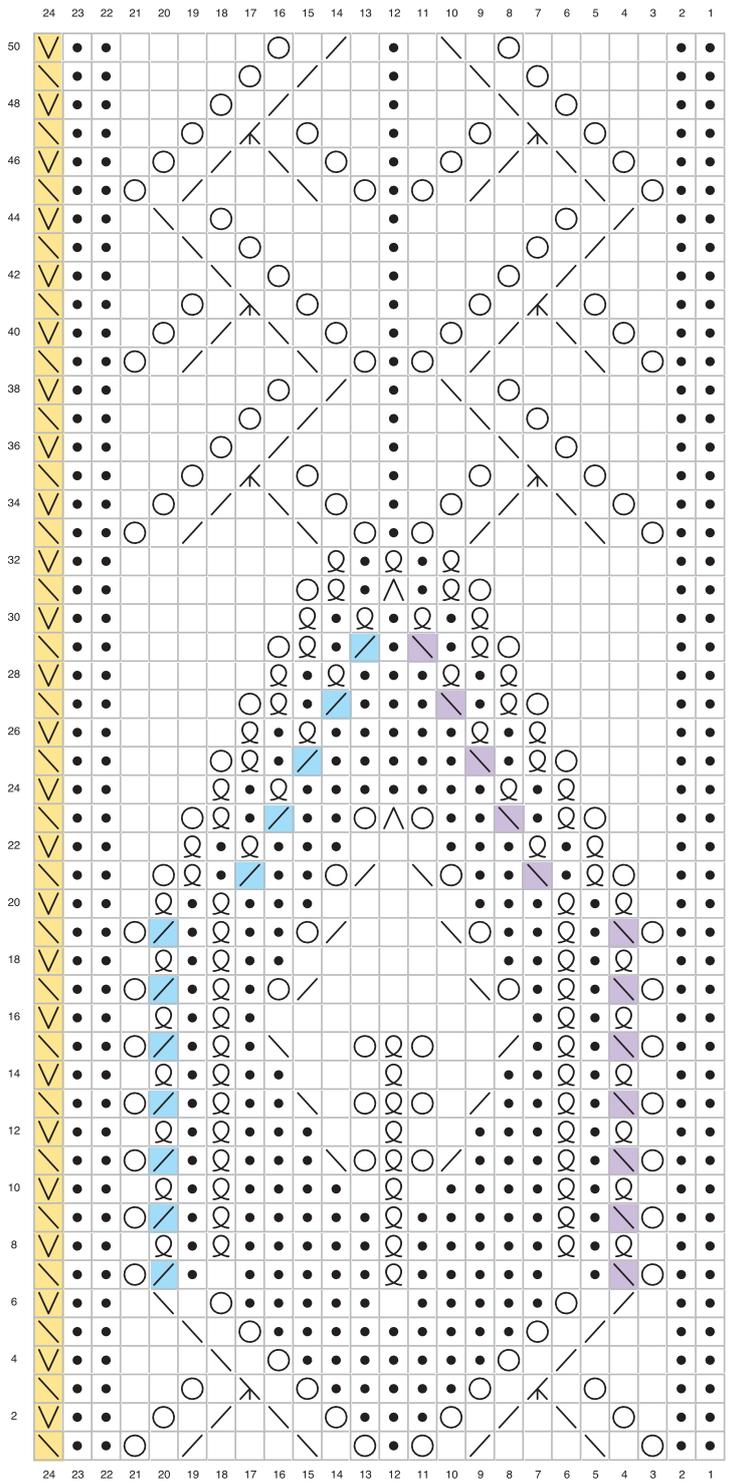
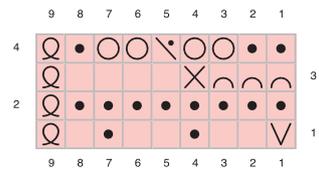
